Introduction

I want to take the time to answer in general a Christian's duty in this conflict with evil ... for that is precisely what it is. President Bush is on record stating this is a war against evil. Christians take careful note of that. Don't confuse Divine Intervention with Politics.

Many Christians understand their PERSONAL duty as a child of God (love, evangelism, repentance) but don't understand how God often responds to evil and how we should respond to God's response to evil. Do we understand that the God of the Old Testament is the second person of the Triune? The same who became Jesus? This is covered in our bible study under God: Is Jesus God? The Scriptures clearly proclaim Jehovah or Yahweh to be the second person of the Triune Godhead.

I want to focus on what you are probably not hearing from the pulpit of the chuurches nor at any bible studies. First and foremost, I believe the events of September 11, 2001 to be a wake up call from God. (see Wake Up Call in the events/announcements section of the TLC Fellowship website) This is a call to individual and national *repentance*. The church as a whole needs to repent from *not teaching* the full message of God but only that which people want to hear; We need to repent from our sins and turn our hearts and mind to God and His *truths*. Much of the truths concerning God, His Justice, His Wrath and His Vengeance and punishment of evil and wickedness of men is swept under the rug for the softer message. While that softer side of God is true, it's only half right.

This study is on the aspect of God you'd probably rather not know about. It frightens us ... it scares us ... and most people would rather close their eyes and pretend that this is not the Word of God ... but it is! Dear children, please heed the message of this study.

INDIVIDUAL DUTIES OF THE BELIEVER

- 1. Individuals are forbidden to take "upon themselves" the punishment for evil. That is the exclusive prerogative of God.
- 2. Individuals are to love their enemies and pray for their repentance ... and ours as well.
- 3. God hates evil, evil men and evil governments. <u>God will punish evil</u> now and in the life to come.

- 5. When God punishes evil in the here and now, He does so through governments or occasionally by Divine means apart from man.

- 6. Individuals are to yield to the governing authorities, for they are indeed the instruments of God.
- 7. Individuals are to rejoice with God when he punishes evil here on earth and in the hereafter.

Let's examine a "few" scriptures to support the above statements.

1. Individuals are forbidden to take "upon themselves" the punishment for evil.

The execution of justice is the exclusive prerogative of God .

Leviticus 19:18

You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the sons of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself; I am the LORD.

Genesis 4:15

So the LORD said to him, "Therefore whoever kills Cain, vengeance will be taken on him sevenfold." And the LORD appointed a sign for Cain, so that no one finding him would slay him.

Romans 12:19

<u>Never</u> take your own revenge, beloved, but <u>leave room for the wrath of God</u>, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord.

Revelation 6:9-10

When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained; and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

2. Individuals are to love their enemies and pray for their repentance.

Matthew 5:44

"But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you,

Luke 6:28

bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.

James 5:16

Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

3. God hates evil, evil men and evil governments. <u>God</u> will punish evil now

Psalms 26:5

I hate the assembly of evildoers, And I will not sit with the wicked.

Deuteronomy 32:41

If I sharpen My flashing sword, And My hand takes hold on justice, I will render vengeance on My adversaries, And I will repay those who hate Me.

Deuteronomy 32:35

'Vengeance is Mine, and retribution, In due time their foot will slip; For the day of their calamity is near, And the impending things are hastening upon them.'

... and in the life to come

Matthew 8:12

but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Matthew 13:42

and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and

gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 13:50

and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 22:13

"Then the king said to the servants, 'Bind him hand and foot, and throw him into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

Matthew 24:51

and will cut him in pieces and assign him a place with the hypocrites; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 25:30

"Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

God indeed will punish evil, those who hate Him. God includes all false religions as evil. God also calls those ministers and pastors who falsely teach the commandments of men as if they are the commandments of God as evil people. One needs to exercise extreme caution and diligence in what is taugh and what we believe in the name of God.

Most Christians correctly understand "some" of their personal role in obeying God but do not know the fullness of our obedience to God. Now is the time for us to see how the GOD you worship treats evil. All false religions hate the true God. Some hate Israel, Christians and the USA. We pray for their repentance. Let's see what God does to evil and evil people.

4. Individuals are to join with God in His hatred of evil.

Psalms 119:104

From Your precepts I get understanding; Therefore I hate every false way.

Psalms 38:20

And those who repay evil for good, They oppose me, because I follow what is good.

In fact, God says if we love WITHOUT HATING EVIL, we are HYPOCRITES!

Romans 12:9

[Let] love [be] without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good.

We must hate / abhor evil. However, we are NOT to do repay evil for evil.

Proverbs 20:22

Do not say, "I will repay evil"; Wait for the LORD, and He will save you.

Proverbs 8:13

"The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverted mouth, I hate.

This is the command to us as individuals. God commands us to love our enemies and to pray for their repentance, to be still and **give room for GOD to execute His judgement**.

Romans 12:19

<u>Never</u> take your own revenge, beloved, but <u>leave room for the wrath of God</u>, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord.

Are you obeying the command to leave room for God to repay evil? GOD repays evil through the governments which are upon His shoulders. This leads us to our next point.

5. When God punishes evil in the here and now through governments and Divine Intervention.

Numbers 31:3

Moses spoke to the people, saying, "<u>Arm men from among you for the war</u>, that they may go against Midian to execute the LORD'S vengeance on Midian.

Note this scripture. God executes His judgement through government by preparing an army and going to war.

6. Individuals yield to governing authorities, for they are instruments of God.

Romans 13:1-2

Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.

To resist the godly appointed leader that God lifts up is to resist God Himself. The ONLY time Christians are called to oppose this is when an evil government is contrary to God or if government passes a law that is in opposition to God and His laws, for example- mandatory abortion laws. With these limited exceptions aside, let's procede.

However, many Christians do not seem to understand what the role of individual believers is when our GOD is PUNISHING EVIL. Someone asked me where in the bible does Jesus punish evil and not show love and compassion. When God punishes evil that is the epitomy of love and compassion. Read the book of the REVELATION OF JESUS. It's written by John but the whole book is the revelation of Jesus. Read it, it is relevant to us and this situation. You may have been taught that the book is not that relevant to the believer because you will be raptured before the time described in the book ... but this is NOT what the bible teaches. Believers WILL be on the earth until the physical return of Jesus and Relevation tells us when that is. GOD uses governments to punish evil, not His church. The church will judge angels and men but we don't execute judgemnet upon evil - God does. Here are some scriptures you should know as well:

Vengeance IS to be taken out on behalf of Cain BY GOD for anyone inclined to do evil upon the murderer. GOD will do it through government not individuals.

7. Individuals are to rejoice with God when he punishes evil here on earth and in the hereafter.

Psalms 58:10

The righteous will rejoice when he sees the vengeance; He will wash his feet in the blood of the wicked.

Psalms 94:1

O LORD, God of vengeance, God of vengeance, shine forth!

Psalms 149:7 To execute vengeance on the nations And punishment on the peoples,

Ezekiel 25:17

"I will execute great vengeance on them with wrathful rebukes; and they will know that I am the LORD when I lay My vengeance on them.""

Micah 5:15

"And I will execute vengeance in anger and wrath On the nations which have not obeyed."

Nahum 1:2

A jealous and avenging God is the LORD; The LORD is avenging and wrathful. The LORD takes vengeance on His adversaries, And He reserves wrath for His enemies.

Luke 21:22

because these are days of vengeance, so that all things which are written will be fulfilled.

Jeremiah 20:12

Yet, O LORD of hosts, You who test the righteous, Who see the mind and the heart; Let me see Your vengeance on them; For to You I have set forth my cause.

Jeremiah 46:10

For that day belongs to the Lord GOD of hosts, A day of vengeance, so as to avenge Himself on His foes; And the sword will devour and be satiated And drink its fill of their blood; For there will be a slaughter for the Lord GOD of hosts, In the land of the north by the river Euphrates.

Jeremiah 50:15

"Raise your battle cry against her on every side! She has given herself up, her pillars have fallen, Her walls have been torn down. For this is the vengeance of the LORD: Take vengeance on her; As she has done to others, so do to her.

Jeremiah 50:28

There is a sound of fugitives and refugees from the land of Babylon, To declare in Zion the vengeance of the LORD our God, Vengeance for His temple.

Jeremiah 51:6

Flee from the midst of Babylon, And each of you save his life! Do not be destroyed in her punishment, For this is the LORD'S time of vengeance; He is going to render recompense to her.

Jeremiah 51:11

Sharpen the arrows, fill the quivers! The LORD has aroused the spirit of the kings of the Medes, Because His purpose is against Babylon to destroy it; For it is the vengeance of the LORD, vengeance for His temple.

Jeremiah 51:36

Therefore thus says the LORD, "Behold, I am going to plead your case And exact full vengeance for you; And I will dry up her sea And make her fountain dry.

What does God reveal in His Word concerning His view on war?

God and War

Yahweh God ... Yeshua Himself, the second person of the Triune God ... is a Warrior

Exodus 15:3 "The LORD is a warrior; The LORD is His name.

- Exodus 17:16 and he said, "The LORD has sworn; the LORD will have war against Amalek from generation to generation."
- 1 Chronicles 5:22 For many fell slain, because the war was of God. And they settled in their place until the exile.
- 2 Chronicles 32:21 And the LORD sent an angel who destroyed every mighty warrior, commander and officer in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned in shame to his own land. And when he had entered the temple of his god, some of his own children killed him there with the sword.
- Isaiah 31:4 For thus says the LORD to me, "As the lion or the young lion growls over his prey, Against which a band of shepherds is called out, *And* he will not be terrified at their voice nor disturbed at their noise, So will the LORD of hosts come down to wage war on Mount Zion and on its hill."
- Isaiah 42:13 The LORD will go forth like a warrior, He will arouse *His* zeal like a man of war. He will utter a shout, yes, He will raise a war cry. He will prevail against His enemies.
- Jeremiah 21:5 "I Myself will war against you with an outstretched hand and a mighty arm, even in anger and wrath and great indignation.
- Jeremiah 49:2 "Therefore behold, the days are coming," declares the LORD, "That I will cause a trumpet blast of war to be heard Against Rabbah of the sons of Ammon; And it will become a desolate heap, And her towns will be set on fire. Then Israel will take possession of his possessors," Says the LORD.
- Zephaniah 3:17 "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.
- Zechariah 9:13 For I will bend Judah as My bow, I will fill the bow with Ephraim. And I will stir up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece; And I will make you like a warrior's sword.

- Revelation 17:14 "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful."
- Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war.

Census: Age 20 to fight in War

- Numbers 1:3 from twenty years old and upward, whoever *is able to* go out to war in Israel, you and Aaron shall number them by their armies.
- Numbers 1:45 So all the numbered men of the sons of Israel by their fathers' households, from twenty years old and upward, whoever *was able to* go out to war in Israel,

Bible Teachings on Rules of War

- Numbers 10:9 "When you go to war in your land against the adversary who attacks you, then you shall **sound an alarm** with the trumpets, that you may be remembered before the LORD your God, and be saved from your enemies.
- Numbers 21:14 Therefore it is said in the **Book of the Wars of the LORD**, "Waheb in Suphah, And the wadis of the Arnon,
- Numbers 31:27 and **divide the booty** between the warriors who went out to battle and all the congregation.
- Numbers 31:28 "Levy a tax for the LORD from the men of war who went out to battle, one in five hundred of the persons and of the cattle and of the donkeys and of the sheep;
- Numbers 31:53 The men of war had taken booty, every man for himself.

Deuteronomy 20:10-20

10 ¶ "When you approach a city to fight against it, you shall offer it terms of peace.

- 11 "If it agrees to make peace with you and opens to you, then all the people who are found in it shall become your forced labor and shall serve you.
- 12 "However, <u>if it does not make peace with you</u>, but makes war against you, **then you shall besiege it**.
- 13 "When the LORD your God gives it into your hand, you shall strike all the men in it with the edge of the sword.
- 14 "Only the women and the children and the animals and all that is in the city, all its spoil, you shall take as booty for yourself; and you shall use the spoil of your enemies which the LORD your God has given you.
- 15 "Thus you shall do to all the cities that are very far from you, which are not of the cities of these nations nearby.
- 16 "Only in the cities of these peoples that the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance, you shall not leave alive anything that breathes.
- 17 "But you shall utterly destroy them, the Hittite and the Amorite, the Canaanite and the Perizzite, the Hivite and the Jebusite, as the LORD your God has commanded you,

- 18 so that they may not teach you to do according to all their detestable things which they have done for their gods, so that you would sin against the LORD your God.
- 19 "When you besiege a city a long time, to make war against it in order to capture it, you shall not destroy its trees by swinging an axe against them; for you may eat from them, and you shall not cut them down. For is the tree of the field a man, that it should be besieged by you?
- 20 "Only the trees which you know are not fruit trees you shall destroy and cut down, that you may construct siegeworks against the city that is making war with you until it falls.

The Lord Exucutes His Judgement Through Nations and Wars

Numbers 31:3-7

- 3 Moses spoke to the people, saying, "Arm men from among you for the war, that they may go against Midian to execute the LORD'S vengeance on Midian.
- 4 "A thousand from each tribe of all the tribes of Israel you shall send to the war."
- 5 So there were furnished from the thousands of Israel, a thousand from each tribe, twelve thousand armed for war.
- 6 Moses sent them, a thousand from each tribe, to the war, and Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, to the war with them, and the holy vessels and the trumpets for the alarm in his hand.
- 7 So they made war against Midian, just as the LORD had commanded Moses, and they killed every male.

Jeremiah 51:20-23

- 20 He says, "You are My war-club, My weapon of war; And with you I shatter nations, And with you I destroy kingdoms.
- 21 "With you I shatter the horse and his rider, And with you I shatter the chariot and its rider,
- 22 And with you I shatter man and woman, And with you I shatter old man and youth, And with you I shatter young man and virgin,
- 23 And with you I shatter the shepherd and his flock, And with you I shatter the farmer and his team, And with you I shatter governors and prefects.
- God will also use nations not serving Him to execute His judgement. God will defeat

any nation that interferes eith His judgement, even is that nation is one of His people.

2 Chronicles 35:21 But Neco sent messengers to him, saying, "What have we to do with each other, O King of Judah? *I am* not *coming* against you today but against the house with which I am at war, and God has ordered me to hurry. Stop for your own sake from *interfering with* God who is with me, so that He will not destroy you."

God Expects His People to be prepared to fight in any war He proclaimed.

- Numbers 32:6 But Moses said to the sons of Gad and to the sons of Reuben, "Shall your brothers go to war while you yourselves sit here?
- Numbers 32:20 So Moses said to them, "If you will do this, if you will arm yourselves before the LORD for the war,
- Numbers 32:27 while your servants, everyone who is armed for war, will cross over in the presence of the LORD to battle, just as my lord says."
- Joshua 8:1 Now the LORD said to Joshua, "Do not fear or be dismayed. Take all the people of war with you and arise, go up to Ai; see, I have given into your hand the king of Ai, his people, his city, and his land.
- Joshua 8:3 So Joshua rose with all the people of war to go up to Ai; and Joshua chose 30,000 men, valiant warriors, and sent them out at night.
- Judges 3:1 Now these are the nations which the LORD left, to test Israel by them (*that is,* all who had not experienced any of the wars of Canaan;
- Judges 3:2 only in order that the generations of the sons of Israel might be taught war, those who had not experienced it formerly).
- Judges 6:12 The angel of the LORD appeared to him and said to him, "The LORD is with you, O valiant warrior."
- 1 Chronicles 12:23 Now these are the numbers of the divisions equipped for war, who came to David at Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 17:16 and next to him Amasiah the son of Zichri, who volunteered for the LORD, and with him 200,000 valiant warriors;
- Psalms 144:1 <<*A Psalm* of David.>> Blessed be the LORD, my rock, Who trains my hands for war, *And* my fingers for battle;
- Ecclesiastes 3:8 A time to love and a time to hate; A time for war and a time for peace.

Not doing so is *Sin*!

- Deuteronomy 1:41 "Then you said to me, 'We have sinned against the LORD; we will indeed go up and fight, just as the LORD our God commanded us.' And every man of you girded on his weapons of war, and regarded it as easy to go up into the hill country.
- Judges 5:23 'Curse Meroz,' said the angel of the LORD, 'Utterly curse its inhabitants; Because they did not come to the help of the LORD, To the help of the LORD against the warriors.'

Priests are Sanctifed From war

The lord requires that the hands of the priests and the hands of those who build His Temple not be stained by the blood of War for the temple is holy and those who are called are sanctified or set apart by the Lord. The tribe of Levi was not called to fight in any war of the Lord. (Numbers 1)

David was not permitted to build the temple for he was a warrior.

- 1 Kings 5:3 "You know that David my father was unable to build a house for the name of the LORD his God because of the wars which surrounded him, until the LORD put them under the soles of his feet.
- 1 Chronicles 22:8 "But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, 'You have shed much blood and have waged great wars; you shall not build a house to My name, because you have shed *so* much blood on the earth before Me.
- 1 Chronicles 28:3 "But God said to me, 'You shall not build a house for My name because you are a man of war and have shed blood.'

God Will Punish Disobedient Nations: Victims of War

- 2 Chronicles 16:9 "For the eyes of the LORD move to and fro throughout the earth that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His. You have acted foolishly in this. Indeed, from now on you will surely have wars."
- Psalms 68:30 Rebuke the beasts in the reeds, The herd of bulls with the calves of the peoples, Trampling under foot the pieces of silver; He has scattered the peoples who delight in war.

God will protect obedient nations: Victors of War

- Job 5:20 "In famine He will redeem you from death, And in war from the power of the sword.
- Psalms 27:3 Though a host encamp against me, My heart will not fear; Though war arise against me, In *spite of* this I shall be confident.
- Psalms 33:16 The king is not saved by a mighty army; A warrior is not delivered by great strength.
- Psalms 76:5 The stouthearted were plundered, They sank into sleep; And none of the warriors could use his hands.
- Isaiah 7:1 Now it came about in the days of Ahaz, the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, that Rezin the king of Aram and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up to Jerusalem to *wage* war against it, but could not conquer it.

Isaiah 41:12 "You will seek those who quarrel with you, but will not find them, Those who war with you will be as nothing and non-existent.

- **Numbers 10:9** "When you go to war in your land against the adversary who attacks you, then you shall sound an alarm with the trumpets, that you may be remembered before the LORD your God, and be saved from your enemies.
- **Numbers 21:14** Therefore it is said in the Book of the Wars of the LORD, "Waheb in Suphah, And the wadis of the Arnon,
- Numbers 26:2 "Take a census of all the congregation of the sons of Israel from twenty years old and upward, by their fathers' households, whoever is able to go out to war in Israel."
- **Numbers 31:3** Moses spoke to the people, saying, "Arm men from among you for the war, that they may go against Midian to execute the LORD'S vengeance on Midian.
- Numbers 31:4 "A thousand from each tribe of all the tribes of Israel you shall send to the war."
- **Numbers 31:5** So there were furnished from the thousands of Israel, a thousand from each tribe, twelve thousand armed for war.
- **Numbers 31:6** Moses sent them, a thousand from each tribe, to the war, and Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, to the war with them, and the holy vessels and the trumpets for the alarm in his hand.
- **Numbers 31:7** So they made war against Midian, just as the LORD had commanded Moses, and they killed every male.
- Numbers 31:14 Moses was angry with the officers of the army, the captains of thousands and the captains of hundreds, who had come from service in the war.
- Numbers 31:21 Then Eleazar the priest said to the men of war who had gone to battle, "This is the statute of the law which the LORD has commanded Moses:
- **Numbers 31:27** and divide the booty between the warriors who went out to battle and all the congregation.
- Numbers 31:28 "Levy a tax for the LORD from the men of war who went out to battle, one in five hundred of the persons and of the cattle and of the donkeys and of the sheep;
- **Numbers 31:32** Now the booty that remained from the spoil which the men of war had plundered was 675,000 sheep,
- Numbers 31:36 The half, the portion of those who went out to war, was as follows: the number of sheep was 337,500,
- Numbers 31:42 As for the sons of Israel's half, which Moses separated from the men who had gone to war—
- **Numbers 31:49** and they said to Moses, "Your servants have taken a census of men of war who are in our charge, and no man of us is missing.
- Numbers 31:53 The men of war had taken booty, every man for himself.
- **Numbers 32:6** But Moses said to the sons of Gad and to the sons of Reuben, "Shall your brothers go to war while you yourselves sit here?
- Numbers 32:20 So Moses said to them, "If you will do this, if you will arm yourselves before the LORD for the war,
- Numbers 32:27 while your servants, everyone who is armed for war, will cross over in the presence of the LORD to battle, just as my lord says."

- **Deuteronomy 1:41** "Then you said to me, 'We have sinned against the LORD; we will indeed go up and fight, just as the LORD our God commanded us.' And every man of you girded on his weapons of war, and regarded it as easy to go up into the hill country.
- Deuteronomy 2:9 "Then the LORD said to me, 'Do not harass Moab, nor provoke them to war, for I will not give you any of their land as a possession, because I have given Ar to the sons of Lot as a possession.
- Deuteronomy 2:14 "Now the time that it took for us to come from Kadesh-barnea until we crossed over the brook Zered was thirty-eight years, until all the generation of the men of war perished from within the camp, as the LORD had sworn to them.
- Deuteronomy 2:16 "So it came about when all the men of war had finally perished from among the people,
- **Deuteronomy 4:34** "Or has a god tried to go to take for himself a nation from within *another* nation by trials, by signs and wonders and by war and by a mighty hand and by an outstretched arm and by great terrors, as the LORD your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes?
- **Deuteronomy 20:12** "However, if it does not make peace with you, but makes war against you, then you shall besiege it.
- **Deuteronomy 20:19** "When you besiege a city a long time, to make war against it in order to capture it, you shall not destroy its trees by swinging an axe against them; for you may eat from them, and you shall not cut them down. For is the tree of the field a man, that it should be besieged by you?
- **Deuteronomy 20:20** "Only the trees which you know are not fruit trees you shall destroy and cut down, that you may construct siegeworks against the city that is making war with you until it falls.
- **Joshua 1:14** "Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle shall remain in the land which Moses gave you beyond the Jordan, but you shall cross before your brothers in battle array, all your valiant warriors, and shall help them,
- **Joshua 4:13** about 40,000 equipped for war, crossed for battle before the LORD to the desert plains of Jericho.
- Joshua 5:4 This is the reason why Joshua circumcised them: all the people who came out of Egypt who were males, all the men of war, died in the wilderness along the way after they came out of Egypt.
- Joshua 5:6 For the sons of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, until all the nation, *that is,* the men of war who came out of Egypt, perished because they did not listen to the voice of the LORD, to whom the LORD had sworn that He would not let them see the land which the LORD had sworn to their fathers to give us, a land flowing with milk and honey.
- Joshua 6:2 The LORD said to Joshua, "See, I have given Jericho into your hand, with its king *and* the valiant warriors.
- Joshua 6:3 "You shall march around the city, all the men of war circling the city once. You shall do so for six days.
- **Joshua 8:1** Now the LORD said to Joshua, "Do not fear or be dismayed. Take all the people of war with you and arise, go up to Ai; see, I have given into your hand the king of Ai, his people, his city, and his land.

- **Joshua 8:3** So Joshua rose with all the people of war to go up to Ai; and Joshua chose 30,000 men, valiant warriors, and sent them out at night.
- **Joshua 8:11** Then all the people of war who *were* with him went up and drew near and arrived in front of the city, and camped on the north side of Ai. Now *there was* a valley between him and Ai.
- Joshua 9:12 "This our bread *was* warm *when* we took it for our provisions out of our houses on the day that we left to come to you; but now behold, it is dry and has become crumbled.
- **Joshua 10:7** So Joshua went up from Gilgal, he and all the people of war with him and all the valiant warriors.
- **Joshua 10:24** When they brought these kings out to Joshua, Joshua called for all the men of Israel, and said to the chiefs of the men of war who had gone with him, "Come near, put your feet on the necks of these kings." So they came near and put their feet on their necks.
- **Joshua 11:7** So Joshua and all the people of war with him came upon them suddenly by the waters of Merom, and attacked them.
- Joshua 11:18 Joshua waged war a long time with all these kings.
- Joshua 11:23 So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD had spoken to Moses, and Joshua gave it for an inheritance to Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. Thus the land had rest from war.
- **Joshua 14:11** "I am still as strong today as I was in the day Moses sent me; as my strength was then, so my strength is now, for war and for going out and coming in.
- Joshua 14:15 Now the name of Hebron was formerly Kiriath-arba; for Arba was the greatest man among the Anakim. Then the land had rest from war.
- Joshua 17:1 Now *this* was the lot for the tribe of Manasseh, for he was the firstborn of Joseph. To Machir the firstborn of Manasseh, the father of Gilead, were allotted Gilead and Bashan, because he was a man of war.
- Joshua 22:12 When the sons of Israel heard *of it,* the whole congregation of the sons of Israel gathered themselves at Shiloh to go up against them in war.
- Joshua 22:33 The word pleased the sons of Israel, and the sons of Israel blessed God; and they did not speak of going up against them in war to destroy the land in which the sons of Reuben and the sons of Gad were living.
- **Judges 3:1** Now these are the nations which the LORD left, to test Israel by them (*that is,* all who had not experienced any of the wars of Canaan;
- Judges 3:2 only in order that the generations of the sons of Israel might be taught war, those who had not experienced it formerly).
- **Judges 3:10** The Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel. When he went out to war, the LORD gave Cushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand, so that he prevailed over Cushan-rishathaim.
- **Judges 5:8** "New gods were chosen; Then war *was* in the gates. Not a shield or a spear was seen Among forty thousand in Israel.
- Judges 5:13 "Then survivors came down to the nobles; The people of the LORD came down to me as warriors.
- **Judges 5:23** 'Curse Meroz,' said the angel of the LORD, 'Utterly curse its inhabitants; Because they did not come to the help of the LORD, To the help of the LORD against the warriors.'

- Judges 5:30 'Are they not finding, are they not dividing the spoil? A maiden, two maidens for every warrior; To Sisera a spoil of dyed work, A spoil of dyed work embroidered, Dyed work of double embroidery on the neck of the spoiler?'
- **Judges 6:12** The angel of the LORD appeared to him and said to him, "The LORD is with you, O valiant warrior."
- Judges 11:1 Now Jephthah the Gileadite was a valiant warrior, but he was the son of a harlot. And Gilead was the father of Jephthah.
- Judges 11:27 'I therefore have not sinned against you, but you are doing me wrong by making war against me; may the LORD, the Judge, judge today between the sons of Israel and the sons of Ammon.'"
- Judges 18:11 Then from the family of the Danites, from Zorah and from Eshtaol, six hundred men armed with weapons of war set out.
- Judges 18:16 The six hundred men armed with their weapons of war, who were of the sons of Dan, stood by the entrance of the gate.
- Judges 18:17 Now the five men who went to spy out the land went up *and* entered there, *and* took the graven image and the ephod and household idols and the molten image, while the priest stood by the entrance of the gate with the six hundred men armed with weapons of war.
- Judges 20:17 Then the men of Israel besides Benjamin were numbered, 400,000 men who draw the sword; all these were men of war.
- Judges 20:44 Thus 18,000 men of Benjamin fell; all these were valiant warriors.
- Judges 20:46 So all of Benjamin who fell that day were 25,000 men who draw the sword; all these were valiant warriors.
- Judges 21:10 And the congregation sent 12,000 of the valiant warriors there, and commanded them, saying, "Go and strike the inhabitants of Jabesh-gilead with the edge of the sword, with the women and the little ones.
- **1 Samuel 8:12** "He will appoint for himself commanders of thousands and of fifties, and *some* to do his plowing and to reap his harvest and to make his weapons of war and equipment for his chariots.
- 1 Samuel 14:52 Now the war against the Philistines was severe all the days of Saul; and when Saul saw any mighty man or any valiant man, he attached him to his staff.
- **1 Samuel 16:18** Then one of the young men said, "Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite who is a skillful musician, a mighty man of valor, a warrior, one prudent in speech, and a handsome man; and the LORD is with him."
- 1 Samuel 17:20 So David arose early in the morning and left the flock with a keeper and took *the supplies* and went as Jesse had commanded him. And he came to the circle of the camp while the army was going out in battle array shouting the war cry.
- 1 Samuel 17:33 Then Saul said to David, "You are not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him; for you are *but* a youth while he has been a warrior from his youth."
- 1 Samuel 18:5 So David went out wherever Saul sent him, *and* prospered; and Saul set him over the men of war. And it was pleasing in the sight of all the people and also in the sight of Saul's servants.
- 1 Samuel 19:8 When there was war again, David went out and fought with the Philistines and defeated them with great slaughter, so that they fled before him.
- 1 Samuel 23:8 So Saul summoned all the people for war, to go down to Keilah to besiege David and his men.

- 1 Samuel 28:1 Now it came about in those days that the Philistines gathered their armed camps for war, to fight against Israel. And Achish said to David, "Know assuredly that you will go out with me in the camp, you and your men."
- 1 Samuel 28:15 Then Samuel said to Saul, "Why have you disturbed me by bringing me up?" And Saul answered, "I am greatly distressed; for the Philistines are waging war against me, and God has departed from me and no longer answers me, either through prophets or by dreams; therefore I have called you, that you may make known to me what I should do."
- 2 Samuel 1:27 "How have the mighty fallen, And the weapons of war perished!"
- 2 Samuel 3:1 Now there was a long war between the house of Saul and the house of David; and David grew steadily stronger, but the house of Saul grew weaker continually.
- 2 Samuel 3:6 It came about while there was war between the house of Saul and the house of David that Abner was making himself strong in the house of Saul.
- 2 Samuel 8:10 Toi sent Joram his son to King David to greet him and bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer and defeated him; for Hadadezer had been at war with Toi. And *Joram* brought with him articles of silver, of gold and of bronze.
- 2 Samuel 11:7 When Uriah came to him, David asked concerning the welfare of Joab and the people and the state of the war.
- 2 Samuel 11:18 Then Joab sent and reported to David all the events of the war.
- 2 Samuel 11:19 He charged the messenger, saying, "When you have finished telling all the events of the war to the king,
- 2 Samuel 17:8 Moreover, Hushai said, "You know your father and his men, that they are mighty men and they are fierce, like a bear robbed of her cubs in the field. And your father is an expert in warfare, and will not spend the night with the people.
- 2 Samuel 21:15 Now when the Philistines were at war again with Israel, David went down and his servants with him; and as they fought against the Philistines, David became weary.
- 2 Samuel 21:18 Now it came about after this that there was war again with the Philistines at Gob; then Sibbecai the Hushathite struck down Saph, who was among the descendants of the giant.
- 2 Samuel 21:19 There was war with the Philistines again at Gob, and Elhanan the son of Jaare-oregim the Bethlehemite killed Goliath the Gittite, the shaft of whose spear was like a weaver's beam.
- 2 Samuel 21:20 There was war at Gath again, where there was a man of *great* stature who had six fingers on each hand and six toes on each foot, twenty-four in number; and he also had been born to the giant.
- 1 Kings 2:5 "Now you also know what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, what he did to the two commanders of the armies of Israel, to Abner the son of Ner, and to Amasa the son of Jether, whom he killed; he also shed the blood of war in peace. And he put the blood of war on his belt about his waist, and on his sandals on his feet.
- **1 Kings 5:3** "You know that David my father was unable to build a house for the name of the LORD his God because of the wars which surrounded him, until the LORD put them under the soles of his feet.

- 1 Kings 9:22 But Solomon did not make slaves of the sons of Israel; for they were men of war, his servants, his princes, his captains, his chariot commanders, and his horsemen.
- 1 Kings 11:28 Now the man Jeroboam was a valiant warrior, and when Solomon saw that the young man was industrious, he appointed him over all the forced labor of the house of Joseph.
- **1 Kings 12:21** Now when Rehoboam had come to Jerusalem, he assembled all the house of Judah and the tribe of Benjamin, 180,000 chosen men who were warriors, to fight against the house of Israel to restore the kingdom to Rehoboam the son of Solomon.
- 1 Kings 14:19 Now the rest of the acts of Jeroboam, how he made war and how he reigned, behold, they are written in the Book of the Chronicles of the Kings of Israel.
- 1 Kings 14:30 There was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam continually.
- 1 Kings 15:6 There was war between Rehoboam and Jeroboam all the days of his life.
- 1 Kings 15:7 Now the rest of the acts of Abijam and all that he did, are they not written in the Book of the Chronicles of the Kings of Judah? And there was war between Abijam and Jeroboam.
- 1 Kings 15:16 Now there was war between Asa and Baasha king of Israel all their days.
- 1 Kings 15:32 There was war between Asa and Baasha king of Israel all their days.
- 1 Kings 20:18 Then he said, "If they have come out for peace, take them alive; or if they have come out for war, take them alive."
- 1 Kings 22:1 Three years passed without war between Aram and Israel.
- 1 Kings 22:45 Now the rest of the acts of Jehoshaphat, and his might which he showed and how he warred, are they not written in the Book of the Chronicles of the Kings of Judah?
- 2 Kings 5:1 Now Naaman, captain of the army of the king of Aram, was a great man with his master, and highly respected, because by him the LORD had given victory to Aram. The man was also a valiant warrior, *but he was* a leper.
- 2 Kings 6:8 Now the king of Aram was warring against Israel; and he counseled with his servants saying, "In such and such a place shall be my camp."
- 2 Kings 6:10 The king of Israel sent to the place about which the man of God had told him; thus he warned him, so that he guarded himself there, more than once or twice.
- 2 Kings 8:28 Then he went with Joram the son of Ahab to war against Hazael king of Aram at Ramoth-gilead, and the Arameans wounded Joram.
- 2 Kings 10:22 He said to the one who *was* in charge of the wardrobe, "Bring out garments for all the worshipers of Baal." So he brought out garments for them.
- 2 Kings 13:25 Then Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz took again from the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities which he had taken in war from the hand of Jehoahaz his father. Three times Joash defeated him and recovered the cities of Israel.
- 2 Kings 14:7 He killed *of* Edom in the Valley of Salt 10,000 and took Sela by war, and named it Joktheel to this day.
- 2 Kings 16:5 Then Rezin king of Aram and Pekah son of Remaliah, king of Israel, came up to Jerusalem to *wage* war; and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome him.
- 2 Kings 18:20 "You say (but *they are* only empty words), '*I have* counsel and strength for the war.' Now on whom do you rely, that you have rebelled against me?

- 2 Kings 24:16 All the men of valor, seven thousand, and the craftsmen and the smiths, one thousand, all strong and fit for war, and these the king of Babylon brought into exile to Babylon.
- 2 Kings 25:4 Then the city was broken into, and all the men of war *fled* by night by way of the gate between the two walls beside the king's garden, though the Chaldeans were all around the city. And they went by way of the Arabah.
- 2 Kings 25:19 From the city he took one official who was overseer of the men of war, and five of the king's advisers who were found in the city; and the scribe of the captain of the army who mustered the people of the land; and sixty men of the people of the land who were found in the city.
- 1 Chronicles 5:10 In the days of Saul they made war with the Hagrites, who fell by their hand, so that they occupied their tents throughout all the land east of Gilead.
- 1 Chronicles 5:18 The sons of Reuben and the Gadites and the half-tribe of Manasseh, *consisting* of valiant men, men who bore shield and sword and shot with bow and *were* skillful in battle, *were* 44,760, who went to war.
- 1 Chronicles 5:19 They made war against the Hagrites, Jetur, Naphish and Nodab.
- 1 Chronicles 5:22 For many fell slain, because the war *was* of God. And they settled in their place until the exile.
- 1 Chronicles 7:4 With them by their generations according to their fathers' households were 36,000 troops of the army for war, for they had many wives and sons.
- 1 Chronicles 7:11 All these *were* sons of Jediael, according to the heads of their fathers' households, 17,200 mighty men of valor, who were ready to go out with the army to war.
- 1 Chronicles 7:40 All these *were* the sons of Asher, heads of the fathers' houses, choice and mighty men of valor, heads of the princes. And the number of them enrolled by genealogy for service in war was 26,000 men.
- 1 Chronicles 12:1 Now these are the ones who came to David at Ziklag, while he was still restricted because of Saul the son of Kish; and they were among the mighty men who helped *him* in war.
- 1 Chronicles 12:8 From the Gadites there came over to David in the stronghold in the wilderness, mighty men of valor, men trained for war, who could handle shield and spear, and whose faces were like the faces of lions, and *they were* as swift as the gazelles on the mountains.
- 1 Chronicles 12:23 Now these are the numbers of the divisions equipped for war, who came to David at Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.
- 1 Chronicles 12:24 The sons of Judah who bore shield and spear *were* 6,800, equipped for war.
- 1 Chronicles 12:25 Of the sons of Simeon, mighty men of valor for war, 7,100.
- 1 Chronicles 12:33 Of Zebulun, there were 50,000 who went out in the army, who could draw up in battle formation with all kinds of weapons of war and helped *David* with an undivided heart.
- 1 Chronicles 12:37 From the other side of the Jordan, of the Reubenites and the Gadites and of the half-tribe of Manasseh, *there were* 120,000 with all *kinds* of weapons of war for the battle.

- 1 Chronicles 12:38 All these, being men of war who could draw up in battle formation, came to Hebron with a perfect heart to make David king over all Israel; and all the rest also of Israel were of one mind to make David king.
- 1 Chronicles 18:10 he sent Hadoram his son to King David to greet him and to bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer and had defeated him; for Hadadezer had been at war with Tou. And *Hadoram brought* all kinds of articles of gold and silver and bronze.
- 1 Chronicles 20:4 Now it came about after this, that war broke out at Gezer with the Philistines; then Sibbecai the Hushathite killed Sippai, one of the descendants of the giants, and they were subdued.
- 1 Chronicles 20:5 And there was war with the Philistines again, and Elhanan the son of Jair killed Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, the shaft of whose spear *was* like a weaver's beam.
- 1 Chronicles 20:6 Again there was war at Gath, where there was a man of *great* stature who had twenty-four fingers and toes, six *fingers on each hand* and six *toes on each foot;* and he also was descended from the giants.
- 1 Chronicles 22:8 "But the word of the LORD came to me, saying, 'You have shed much blood and have waged great wars; you shall not build a house to My name, because you have shed *so* much blood on the earth before Me.
- 1 Chronicles 28:3 "But God said to me, 'You shall not build a house for My name because you are a man of war and have shed blood.'
- 2 Chronicles 8:9 But Solomon did not make slaves for his work from the sons of Israel; they were men of war, his chief captains and commanders of his chariots and his horsemen.
- 2 Chronicles 11:1 Now when Rehoboam had come to Jerusalem, he assembled the house of Judah and Benjamin, 180,000 chosen men who were warriors, to fight against Israel to restore the kingdom to Rehoboam.
- 2 Chronicles 12:15 Now the acts of Rehoboam, from first to last, are they not written in the records of Shemaiah the prophet and of Iddo the seer, according to genealogical enrollment? And *there were* wars between Rehoboam and Jeroboam continually.
- 2 Chronicles 13:2 He reigned three years in Jerusalem; and his mother's name was Micaiah the daughter of Uriel of Gibeah. Now there was war between Abijah and Jeroboam.
- 2 Chronicles 13:3 Abijah began the battle with an army of valiant warriors, 400,000 chosen men, while Jeroboam drew up in battle formation against him with 800,000 chosen men *who were* valiant warriors.
- 2 Chronicles 13:15 Then the men of Judah raised a war cry, and when the men of Judah raised the war cry, then it was that God routed Jeroboam and all Israel before Abijah and Judah.
- 2 Chronicles 14:6 He built fortified cities in Judah, since the land was undisturbed, and there was no one at war with him during those years, because the LORD had given him rest.
- 2 Chronicles 14:8 Now Asa had an army of 300,000 from Judah, bearing large shields and spears, and 280,000 from Benjamin, bearing shields and wielding bows; all of them were valiant warriors.
- 2 Chronicles 15:19 And there was no more war until the thirty-fifth year of Asa's reign.

- 2 Chronicles 16:9 "For the eyes of the LORD move to and fro throughout the earth that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His. You have acted foolishly in this. Indeed, from now on you will surely have wars."
- **2 Chronicles 17:10** Now the dread of the LORD was on all the kingdoms of the lands which *were* around Judah, so that they did not make war against Jehoshaphat.
- 2 Chronicles 17:13 He had large supplies in the cities of Judah, and warriors, valiant men, in Jerusalem.
- 2 Chronicles 17:14 This was their muster according to their fathers' households: of Judah, commanders of thousands, Adnah *was* the commander, and with him 300,000 valiant warriors;
- 2 Chronicles 17:16 and next to him Amasiah the son of Zichri, who volunteered for the LORD, and with him 200,000 valiant warriors;
- 2 Chronicles 17:17 and of Benjamin, Eliada a valiant warrior, and with him 200,000 armed with bow and shield;
- 2 Chronicles 17:18 and next to him Jehozabad, and with him 180,000 equipped for war.
- 2 Chronicles 20:1 Now it came about after this that the sons of Moab and the sons of Ammon, together with some of the Meunites, came to make war against Jehoshaphat.
- 2 Chronicles 22:5 He also walked according to their counsel, and went with Jehoram the son of Ahab king of Israel to wage war against Hazael king of Aram at Ramoth-gilead. But the Arameans wounded Joram.
- 2 Chronicles 25:5 Moreover, Amaziah assembled Judah and appointed them according to *their* fathers' households under commanders of thousands and commanders of hundreds throughout Judah and Benjamin; and he took a census of those from twenty years old and upward and found them to be 300,000 choice men, *able* to go to war *and* handle spear and shield.
- 2 Chronicles 25:6 He hired also 100,000 valiant warriors out of Israel for one hundred talents of silver.
- 2 Chronicles 26:6 Now he went out and warred against the Philistines, and broke down the wall of Gath and the wall of Jabneh and the wall of Ashdod; and he built cities in *the area of* Ashdod and among the Philistines.
- 2 Chronicles 26:12 The total number of the heads of the households, of valiant warriors, was 2,600.
- 2 Chronicles 26:13 Under their direction was an elite army of 307,500, who could wage war with great power, to help the king against the enemy.
- 2 Chronicles 26:15 In Jerusalem he made engines *of war* invented by skillful men to be on the towers and on the corners for the purpose of shooting arrows and great stones. Hence his fame spread afar, for he was marvelously helped until he *was* strong.
- 2 Chronicles 27:7 Now the rest of the acts of Jotham, even all his wars and his acts, behold, they are written in the Book of the Kings of Israel and Judah.
- 2 Chronicles 32:2 Now when Hezekiah saw that Sennacherib had come and that he intended to make war on Jerusalem,
- 2 Chronicles 32:3 he decided with his officers and his warriors to cut off the *supply* of water from the springs which *were* outside the city, and they helped him.

- 2 Chronicles 32:21 And the LORD sent an angel who destroyed every mighty warrior, commander and officer in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned in shame to his own land. And when he had entered the temple of his god, some of his own children killed him there with the sword.
- 2 Chronicles 35:20 After all this, when Josiah had set the temple in order, Neco king of Egypt came up to make war at Carchemish on the Euphrates, and Josiah went out to engage him.
- 2 Chronicles 35:21 But Neco sent messengers to him, saying, "What have we to do with each other, O King of Judah? *I am* not *coming* against you today but against the house with which I am at war, and God has ordered me to hurry. Stop for your own sake from *interfering with* God who is with me, so that He will not destroy you."
- 2 Chronicles 35:22 However, Josiah would not turn away from him, but disguised himself in order to make war with him; nor did he listen to the words of Neco from the mouth of God, but came to make war on the plain of Megiddo.
- Nehemiah 11:14 and their brothers, valiant warriors, 128. And their overseer was Zabdiel, the son of Haggedolim.
- **Job 5:20** "In famine He will redeem you from death, And in war from the power of the sword.
- Job 16:14 "He breaks through me with breach after breach; He runs at me like a warrior.
- **Job 38:23** Which I have reserved for the time of distress, For the day of war and battle?
- Job 39:25 "As often as the trumpet *sounds* he says, 'Aha!' And he scents the battle from afar, And the thunder of the captains and the war cry.
- **Psalms 27:3** Though a host encamp against me, My heart will not fear; Though war arise against me, In *spite of* this I shall be confident.
- **Psalms 33:16** The king is not saved by a mighty army; A warrior is not delivered by great strength.
- **Psalms 46:9** He makes wars to cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariots with fire.
- Psalms 55:21 His speech was smoother than butter, But his heart was war; His words were softer than oil, Yet they were drawn swords.
- **Psalms 68:30** Rebuke the beasts in the reeds, The herd of bulls with the calves of the peoples, Trampling under foot the pieces of silver; He has scattered the peoples who delight in war.
- **Psalms 76:3** There He broke the flaming arrows, The shield and the sword and the weapons of war. Selah.
- **Psalms 76:5** The stouthearted were plundered, They sank into sleep; And none of the warriors could use his hands.
- Psalms 78:65 Then the Lord awoke as *if from* sleep, Like a warrior overcome by wine.
- Psalms 120:4 Sharp arrows of the warrior, With the *burning* coals of the broom tree.

Psalms 120:7 I am for peace, but when I speak, They are for war.

- Psalms 127:4 Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So are the children of one's youth.
- Psalms 140:2 Who devise evil things in *their* hearts; They continually stir up wars.
- **Psalms 144:1** <<*A Psalm* of David.>> Blessed be the LORD, my rock, Who trains my hands for war, *And* my fingers for battle;

Proverbs 20:18 Prepare plans by consultation, And make war by wise guidance.

Proverbs 24:6 For by wise guidance you will wage war, And in abundance of counselors there is victory.

Ecclesiastes 3:8 A time to love and a time to hate; A time for war and a time for peace.

- Ecclesiastes 8:8 No man has authority to restrain the wind with the wind, or authority over the day of death; and there is no discharge in the time of war, and evil will not deliver those who practice it.
- **Ecclesiastes 9:11** I again saw under the sun that the race is not to the swift and the battle is not to the warriors, and neither is bread to the wise nor wealth to the discerning nor favor to men of ability; for time and chance overtake them all.
- Ecclesiastes 9:18 Wisdom is better than weapons of war, but one sinner destroys much good.
- Ecclesiastes 12:12 But beyond this, my son, be warned: the writing of many books is endless, and excessive devotion *to books* is wearying to the body.
- **Song of Solomon 3:8** "All of them are wielders of the sword, Expert in war; Each man has his sword at his side, *Guarding* against the terrors of the night.
- **Isaiah 2:4** And He will judge between the nations, And will render decisions for many peoples; And they will hammer their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not lift up sword against nation, And never again will they learn war.
- **Isaiah 3:2** The mighty man and the warrior, The judge and the prophet, The diviner and the elder,
- **Isaiah 7:1** Now it came about in the days of Ahaz, the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, that Rezin the king of Aram and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up to Jerusalem to *wage* war against it, but could not conquer it.
- Isaiah 9:5 For every boot of the booted warrior in the *battle* tumult, And cloak rolled in blood, will be for burning, fuel for the fire.

Isaiah 10:16 Therefore the Lord, the GOD of hosts, will send a wasting disease among his stout warriors; And under his glory a fire will be kindled like a burning flame.

- Isaiah 13:3 I have commanded My consecrated ones, I have even called My mighty warriors, My proudly exulting ones, To *execute* My anger.
- **Isaiah 29:7** And the multitude of all the nations who wage war against Ariel, Even all who wage war against her and her stronghold, and who distress her, Will be like a dream, a vision of the night.
- **Isaiah 29:8** It will be as when a hungry man dreams— And behold, he is eating; But when he awakens, his hunger is not satisfied, Or as when a thirsty man dreams— And behold, he is drinking, But when he awakens, behold, he is faint And his thirst is not quenched. Thus the multitude of all the nations will be Who wage war against Mount Zion.
- **Isaiah 31:4** For thus says the LORD to me, "As the lion or the young lion growls over his prey, Against which a band of shepherds is called out, *And* he will not be terrified at their voice nor disturbed at their noise, So will the LORD of hosts come down to wage war on Mount Zion and on its hill."
- **Isaiah 36:5** "I say, 'Your counsel and strength for the war are only empty words.' Now on whom do you rely, that you have rebelled against me?

- Isaiah 40:2 "Speak kindly to Jerusalem; And call out to her, that her warfare has ended, That her iniquity has been removed, That she has received of the LORD'S hand Double for all her sins."
- **Isaiah 41:12** "You will seek those who quarrel with you, but will not find them, Those who war with you will be as nothing and non-existent.
- Isaiah 42:13 The LORD will go forth like a warrior, He will arouse *His* zeal like a man of war. He will utter a shout, yes, He will raise a war cry. He will prevail against His enemies.
- Jeremiah 4:19 My soul, my soul! I am in anguish! Oh, my heart! My heart is pounding in me; I cannot be silent, Because you have heard, O my soul, The sound of the trumpet, The alarm of war.
- Jeremiah 6:4 "Prepare war against her; Arise, and let us attack at noon. Woe to us, for the day declines, For the shadows of the evening lengthen!
- Jeremiah 21:2 "Please inquire of the LORD on our behalf, for Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon is warring against us; perhaps the LORD will deal with us according to all His wonderful acts, so that *the enemy* will withdraw from us."
- Jeremiah 21:4 'Thus says the LORD God of Israel, "Behold, I am about to turn back the weapons of war which are in your hands, with which you are warring against the king of Babylon and the Chaldeans who are besieging you outside the wall; and I will gather them into the center of this city.
- **Jeremiah 21:5** "I Myself will war against you with an outstretched hand and a mighty arm, even in anger and wrath and great indignation.
- Jeremiah 28:8 "The prophets who were before me and before you from ancient times prophesied against many lands and against great kingdoms, of war and of calamity and of pestilence.
- Jeremiah 38:4 Then the officials said to the king, "Now let this man be put to death, inasmuch as he is discouraging the men of war who are left in this city and all the people, by speaking such words to them; for this man is not seeking the well-being of this people but rather their harm."
- Jeremiah 39:4 When Zedekiah the king of Judah and all the men of war saw them, they fled and went out of the city at night by way of the king's garden through the gate between the two walls; and he went out toward the Arabah.
- Jeremiah 41:3 Ishmael also struck down all the Jews who were with him, *that is* with Gedaliah at Mizpah, and the Chaldeans who were found there, the men of war.
- Jeremiah 42:14 saying, "No, but we will go to the land of Egypt, where we will not see war or hear the sound of a trumpet or hunger for bread, and we will stay there";
- Jeremiah 46:12 The nations have heard of your shame, And the earth is full of your cry of distress; For one warrior has stumbled over another, And both of them have fallen down together.
- Jeremiah 48:14 "How can you say, 'We are mighty warriors, And men valiant for battle'?
- **Jeremiah 49:2** "Therefore behold, the days are coming," declares the LORD, "That I will cause a trumpet blast of war to be heard Against Rabbah of the sons of Ammon; And it will become a desolate heap, And her towns will be set on fire. Then Israel will take possession of his possessors," Says the LORD.

- Jeremiah 49:26 "Therefore, her young men will fall in her streets, And all the men of war will be silenced in that day," declares the LORD of hosts.
- **Jeremiah 50:9** "For behold, I am going to arouse and bring up against Babylon A horde of great nations from the land of the north, And they will draw up *their* battle lines against her; From there she will be taken captive. Their arrows will be like an expert warrior Who does not return empty-handed.
- Jeremiah 50:30 "Therefore her young men will fall in her streets, And all her men of war will be silenced in that day," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 51:20 He says, "You are My war-club, My weapon of war; And with you I shatter nations, And with you I destroy kingdoms.
- Jeremiah 51:32 The fords also have been seized, And they have burned the marshes with fire, And the men of war are terrified.
- Jeremiah 52:7 Then the city was broken into, and all the men of war fled and went forth from the city at night by way of the gate between the two walls which *was* by the king's garden, though the Chaldeans were all around the city. And they went by way of the Arabah.
- Jeremiah 52:25 He also took from the city one official who was overseer of the men of war, and seven of the king's advisers who were found in the city, and the scribe of the commander of the army who mustered the people of the land, and sixty men of the people of the land who were found in the midst of the city.
- Ezekiel 17:17 'Pharaoh with *his* mighty army and great company will not help him in the war, when they cast up ramps and build siege walls to cut off many lives.
- Ezekiel 27:10 "Persia and Lud and Put were in your army, your men of war. They hung shield and helmet in you; they set forth your splendor.
- Ezekiel 32:27 "Nor do they lie beside the fallen heroes of the uncircumcised, who went down to Sheol with their weapons of war and whose swords were laid under their heads; but the punishment for their iniquity rested on their bones, though the terror of *these* heroes *was once* in the land of the living.
- Ezekiel 33:3 and he sees the sword coming upon the land and blows on the trumpet and warns the people,
- Ezekiel 33:4 then he who hears the sound of the trumpet and does not take warning, and a sword comes and takes him away, his blood will be on his *own* head.
- Ezekiel 33:5 'He heard the sound of the trumpet but did not take warning; his blood will be on himself. But had he taken warning, he would have delivered his life.
- Ezekiel 33:6 'But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet and the people are not warned, and a sword comes and takes a person from them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood I will require from the watchman's hand.'
- Ezekiel 39:9 "Then those who inhabit the cities of Israel will go out and make fires with the weapons and burn *them*, both shields and bucklers, bows and arrows, war clubs and spears, and for seven years they will make fires of them.
- Ezekiel 39:20 "You will be glutted at My table with horses and charioteers, with mighty men and all the men of war," declares the Lord GOD.
- Daniel 3:20 He commanded certain valiant warriors who *were* in his army to tie up Shadrach, Meshach and Abed-nego in order to cast *them* into the furnace of blazing fire.

- Daniel 7:21 "I kept looking, and that horn was waging war with the saints and overpowering them
- Daniel 9:26 "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end *will come* with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.
- Daniel 11:10 "His sons will mobilize and assemble a multitude of great forces; and one of them will keep on coming and overflow and pass through, that he may again wage war up to his *very* fortress.
- Daniel 11:25 "He will stir up his strength and courage against the king of the South with a large army; so the king of the South will mobilize an extremely large and mighty army for war; but he will not stand, for schemes will be devised against him.
- Hosea 2:18 "In that day I will also make a covenant for them With the beasts of the field, The birds of the sky And the creeping things of the ground. And I will abolish the bow, the sword and war from the land, And will make them lie down in safety.
- Hosea 10:13 You have plowed wickedness, you have reaped injustice, You have eaten the fruit of lies. Because you have trusted in your way, in your numerous warriors,
- Joel 2:4 Their appearance is like the appearance of horses; And like war horses, so they run.
- Joel 3:9 Proclaim this among the nations: Prepare a war; rouse the mighty men! Let all the soldiers draw near, let them come up!
- Amos 1:14 "So I will kindle a fire on the wall of Rabbah And it will consume her citadels Amid war cries on the day of battle, And a storm on the day of tempest.
- Amos 2:2 "So I will send fire upon Moab And it will consume the citadels of Kerioth; And Moab will die amid tumult, With war cries and the sound of a trumpet.
- Amos 2:16 "Even the bravest among the warriors will flee naked in that day," declares the LORD.
- Micah 2:8 "Recently My people have arisen as an enemy— You strip the robe off the garment From unsuspecting passers-by, *From* those returned from war.
- Micah 3:5 Thus says the LORD concerning the prophets Who lead my people astray; When they have *something* to bite with their teeth, They cry, "Peace," But against him who puts nothing in their mouths They declare holy war.
- Micah 4:3 And He will judge between many peoples And render decisions for mighty, distant nations. Then they will hammer their swords into plowshares And their spears into pruning hooks; Nation will not lift up sword against nation, And never again will they train for war.
- Nahum 2:3 The shields of his mighty men are *colored* red, The warriors are dressed in scarlet, The chariots are *enveloped* in flashing steel When he is prepared *to march*, And the cypress *spears* are brandished.
- Zephaniah 1:14 Near is the great day of the LORD, Near and coming very quickly; Listen, the day of the LORD! In it the warrior cries out bitterly.
- Zephaniah 3:17 "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.

- Zechariah 9:10 I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim And the horse from Jerusalem; And the bow of war will be cut off. And He will speak peace to the nations; And His dominion will be from sea to sea, And from the River to the ends of the earth.
- Zechariah 9:13 For I will bend Judah as My bow, I will fill the bow with Ephraim. And I will stir up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece; And I will make you like a warrior's sword.
- Zechariah 14:12 Now this will be the plague with which the LORD will strike all the peoples who have gone to war against Jerusalem; their flesh will rot while they stand on their feet, and their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongue will rot in their mouth.
- Matthew 24:6 "You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for *those things* must take place, but *that* is not yet the end.
- Mark 13:7 "When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be frightened; *those things* must take place; but *that is* not yet the end.
- Luke 21:9 "When you hear of wars and disturbances, do not be terrified; for these things must take place first, but the end *does* not *follow* immediately."
- Romans 7:23 but I see a different law in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin which is in my members.
- 2 Corinthians 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh,
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses.
- James 4:1 What is the source of quarrels and conflicts among you? Is not the source your pleasures that wage war in your members?
- 1 Peter 2:11 Beloved, I urge you as aliens and strangers to abstain from fleshly lusts which wage war against the soul.
- Revelation 2:16 'Therefore repent; or else I am coming to you quickly, and I will make war against them with the sword of My mouth.
- Revelation 11:7 When they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up out of the abyss will make war with them, and overcome them and kill them.
- Revelation 12:7 And there was war in heaven, Michael and his angels waging war with the dragon. The dragon and his angels waged war,
- Revelation 12:17 So the dragon was enraged with the woman, and went off to make war with the rest of her children, who keep the commandments of God and hold to the testimony of Jesus.
- Revelation 13:4 they worshiped the dragon because he gave his authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, "Who is like the beast, and who is able to wage war with him?"
- Revelation 13:7 It was also given to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them, and authority over every tribe and people and tongue and nation was given to him.
- Revelation 16:14 for they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them together for the war of the great day of God, the Almighty.

- Revelation 17:14 "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful."
- Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war.
- Revelation 19:19 And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.
- Revelation 20:8 and will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.

- Genesis 8:21 The LORD smelled the soothing aroma; and the LORD said to Himself, "I will never again curse the ground on account of man, for the intent of man's heart is <u>evil</u> from his youth; and I will never again destroy every living thing, as I have done.

- Genesis 2:9 Out of the ground the LORD God caused to grow every tree that is pleasing to the sight and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and <u>evil</u>.

- Genesis 44:4 They had *just* gone out of the city, *and* were not far off, when Joseph said to his house steward, "Up, follow the men; and when you overtake them, say to them, 'Why have you repaid <u>evil</u> for good?
- Genesis 44:34 "For how shall I go up to my father if the lad is not with me—for fear that I see the evil that would overtake my father?"
- Genesis 48:16 The angel who has redeemed me from all <u>evil</u>, Bless the lads; And may my name live on in them, And the names of my fathers Abraham and Isaac; And may they grow into a multitude in the midst of the earth."
- Genesis 50:20 "As for you, you meant <u>evil</u> against me, *but* God meant it for good in order to bring about this present result, to preserve many people alive.
- Exodus 10:10 Then he said to them, "Thus may the LORD be with you, if ever I let you and your little ones go! Take heed, for <u>evil</u> is in your mind.
- Exodus 23:2 "You shall not follow the masses in doing <u>evil</u>, nor shall you testify in a dispute so as to turn aside after a multitude in order to pervert *justice;*
- Exodus 32:12 "Why should the Egyptians speak, saying, 'With <u>evil</u> *intent* He brought them out to kill them in the mountains and to destroy them from the face of the earth'? Turn from Your burning anger and change Your mind about *doing* harm to Your people.
- Exodus 32:22 Aaron said, "Do not let the anger of my lord burn; you know the people yourself, that they are prone to <u>evil</u>.
- Leviticus 5:4 'Or if a person swears thoughtlessly with his lips to do <u>evil</u> or to do good, in whatever matter a man may speak thoughtlessly with an oath, and it is hidden from him, and then he comes to know *it*, he will be guilty in one of these.
- Numbers 14:27 "How long *shall I bear* with this <u>evil</u> congregation who are grumbling against Me? I have heard the complaints of the sons of Israel, which they are making against Me.
- Numbers 14:35 'I, the LORD, have spoken, surely this I will do to all this <u>evil</u> congregation who are gathered together against Me. In this wilderness they shall be destroyed, and there they will die.'"
- Numbers 32:13 "So the LORD'S anger burned against Israel, and He made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until the entire generation of those who had done <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD was destroyed.
- Deuteronomy 1:35 'Not one of these men, this <u>evil</u> generation, shall see the good land which I swore to give your fathers,
- Deuteronomy 1:39 'Moreover, your little ones who you said would become a prey, and your sons, who this day have no knowledge of good or <u>evil</u>, shall enter there, and I will give it to them and they shall possess it.
- Deuteronomy 4:25 "When you become the father of children and children's children and have remained long in the land, and act corruptly, and make an idol in the form of anything, and do that which is <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD your God *so as* to provoke Him to anger,

- Deuteronomy 9:18 "I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and nights; I neither ate bread nor drank water, because of all your sin which you had committed in doing what was <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD to provoke Him to anger.
- Deuteronomy 13:5 "But that prophet or that dreamer of dreams shall be put to death, because he has counseled rebellion against the LORD your God who brought you from the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of slavery, to seduce you from the way in which the LORD your God commanded you to walk. So you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from among you.
- Deuteronomy 17:2 "If there is found in your midst, in any of your towns, which the LORD your God is giving you, a man or a woman who does what is <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD your God, by transgressing His covenant,
- Deuteronomy 17:5 then you shall bring out that man or that woman who has done this <u>evil</u> deed to your gates, *that is,* the man or the woman, and you shall stone them to death.
- Deuteronomy 17:7 "The hand of the witnesses shall be first against him to put him to death, and afterward the hand of all the people. So you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from your midst.
- Deuteronomy 17:12 "The man who acts presumptuously by not listening to the priest who stands there to serve the LORD your God, nor to the judge, that man shall die; thus you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from Israel.
- Deuteronomy 19:19 then you shall do to him just as he had intended to do to his brother. Thus you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from among you.
- Deuteronomy 19:20 "The rest will hear and be afraid, and will never again do such an <u>evil</u> thing among you.
- Deuteronomy 21:21 "Then all the men of his city shall stone him to death; so you shall remove the <u>evil</u> from your midst, and all Israel will hear *of it* and fear.
- Deuteronomy 22:21 then they shall bring out the girl to the doorway of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her to death because she has committed an act of folly in Israel by playing the harlot in her father's house; thus you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from among you.
- Deuteronomy 22:22 "If a man is found lying with a married woman, then both of them shall die, the man who lay with the woman, and the woman; thus you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from Israel.
- Deuteronomy 22:24 then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city and you shall stone them to death; the girl, because she did not cry out in the city, and the man, because he has violated his neighbor's wife. Thus you shall purge the <u>evil</u> from among you.

- 2 Kings 21:15 because they have done <u>evil</u> in My sight, and have been provoking Me to anger since the day their fathers came from Egypt, even to this day."
- 2 Kings 21:16 Moreover, Manasseh shed very much innocent blood until he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; besides his sin with which he made Judah sin, in doing <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD.
- 2 Kings 21:20 He did evil in the sight of the LORD, as Manasseh his father had done.

- 2 Kings 22:16 thus says the LORD, "Behold, I bring <u>evil</u> on this place and on its inhabitants, *even* all the words of the book which the king of Judah has read.
- 2 Kings 22:20 "Therefore, behold, I will gather you to your fathers, and you will be gathered to your grave in peace, and your eyes will not see all the <u>evil</u> which I will bring on this place."" So they brought back word to the king.
- 2 Kings 23:32 He did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.
- 2 Kings 23:37 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his fathers had done.
- 2 Kings 24:9 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father had done.
- 2 Kings 24:19 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD, according to all that Jehoiakim had done.
- 2 Kings 25:27 Now it came about in the thirty-seventh year of the exile of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the twenty-seventh *day* of the month, that <u>Evil</u>-merodach king of Babylon, in the year that he became king, released Jehoiachin king of Judah from prison;
- 2 Chronicles 12:14 He did evil because he did not set his heart to seek the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 18:7 The king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, "There is yet one man by whom we may inquire of the LORD, but I hate him, for he never prophesies good concerning me but always <u>evil</u>. He is Micaiah, son of Imla." But Jehoshaphat said, "Let not the king say so."
- 2 Chronicles 18:17 Then the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, "Did I not tell you that he would not prophesy good concerning me, but <u>evil</u>?"
- 2 Chronicles 20:9 'Should evil come upon us, the sword, *or* judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we will stand before this house and before You (for Your name is in this house) and cry to You in our distress, and You will hear and deliver *us.*'
- 2 Chronicles 21:6 He walked in the way of the kings of Israel, just as the house of Ahab did (for Ahab's daughter was his wife), and he did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 22:4 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD like the house of Ahab, for they were his counselors after the death of his father, to his destruction.
- 2 Chronicles 29:6 "For our fathers have been unfaithful and have done <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD our God, and have forsaken Him and turned their faces away from the dwelling place of the LORD, and have turned *their* backs.
- 2 Chronicles 33:2 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD dispossessed before the sons of Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 33:6 He made his sons pass through the fire in the valley of Ben-hinnom; and he practiced witchcraft, used divination, practiced sorcery and dealt with mediums and spiritists. He did much <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD, provoking Him *to anger.*
- 2 Chronicles 33:9 Thus Manasseh misled Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to do more <u>evil</u> than the nations whom the LORD destroyed before the sons of Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 33:22 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD as Manasseh his father had done, and Amon sacrificed to all the carved images which his father Manasseh had made, and he served them.

- 2 Chronicles 34:24 thus says the LORD, "Behold, I am bringing <u>evil</u> on this place and on its inhabitants, *even* all the curses written in the book which they have read in the presence of the king of Judah.
- 2 Chronicles 34:28 "Behold, I will gather you to your fathers and you shall be gathered to your grave in peace, so your eyes will not see all the <u>evil</u> which I will bring on this place and on its inhabitants."^{('''} And they brought back word to the king.
- 2 Chronicles 36:5 Jehoiakim was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned eleven years in Jerusalem; and he did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD his God.
- 2 Chronicles 36:9 Jehoiachin was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned three months and ten days in Jerusalem, and he did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD.
- 2 Chronicles 36:12 He did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the LORD his God; he did not humble himself before Jeremiah the prophet who spoke for the LORD.
- Ezra 4:12 let it be known to the king that the Jews who came up from you have come to us at Jerusalem; they are rebuilding the rebellious and <u>evil</u> city and are finishing the walls and repairing the foundations.
- Ezra 9:13 "After all that has come upon us for our <u>evil</u> deeds and our great guilt, since You our God have requited *us* less than our iniquities *deserve*, and have given us an escaped remnant as this,
- Nehemiah 6:13 He was hired for this reason, that I might become frightened and act accordingly and sin, so that they might have an <u>evil</u> report in order that they could reproach me.
- Nehemiah 13:17 Then I reprimanded the nobles of Judah and said to them, "What is this <u>evil</u> thing you are doing, by profaning the sabbath day?
- Nehemiah 13:27 "Do we then hear about you that you have committed all this great <u>evil</u> by acting unfaithfully against our God by marrying foreign women?"
- Esther 8:3 Then Esther spoke again to the king, fell at his feet, wept and implored him to avert the <u>evil</u> scheme of Haman the Agagite and his plot which he had devised against the Jews.
- Job 1:1 There was a man in the land of Uz whose name was Job; and that man was blameless, upright, fearing God and turning away from <u>evil</u>.
- Job 1:8 The LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man, fearing God and turning away from <u>evil</u>."
- Job 2:3 The LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job? For there is no one like him on the earth, a blameless and upright man fearing God and turning away from <u>evil</u>. And he still holds fast his integrity, although you incited Me against him to ruin him without cause."
- Job 5:19 "From six troubles He will deliver you, Even in seven evil will not touch you.
- Job 8:20 "Lo, God will not reject a man of integrity, Nor will He support the evildoers.
- Job 20:12 "Though evil is sweet in his mouth And he hides it under his tongue,
- Job 28:28 "And to man He said, 'Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; And to depart from <u>evil</u> is understanding.'"
- Job 30:26 "When I expected good, then evil came; When I waited for light, then darkness came.

- Job 31:29 "Have I rejoiced at the extinction of my enemy, Or exulted when evil befell him?
- Job 35:12 "There they cry out, but He does not answer Because of the pride of <u>evil</u> men.
- Job 36:10 "He opens their ear to instruction, And commands that they return from evil.
- Job 36:21 "Be careful, do not turn to evil, For you have preferred this to affliction.
- Psalms 5:4 For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness; No evil dwells with You.
- Psalms 7:4 If I have rewarded <u>evil</u> to my friend, Or have plundered him who without cause was my adversary,
- Psalms 7:9 O let the <u>evil</u> of the wicked come to an end, but establish the righteous; For the righteous God tries the hearts and minds.
- Psalms 10:15 Break the arm of the wicked and the <u>evildoer</u>, Seek out his wickedness until You find none.
- Psalms 15:3 He does not slander with his tongue, Nor does <u>evil</u> to his neighbor, Nor takes up a reproach against his friend;
- Psalms 21:11 Though they intended <u>evil</u> against You *And* devised a plot, They will not succeed.
- Psalms 22:16 For dogs have surrounded me; A band of <u>evildoers</u> has encompassed me; They pierced my hands and my feet.
- Psalms 23:4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I fear no <u>evil</u>, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.
- Psalms 26:5 I hate the assembly of evildoers, And I will not sit with the wicked.
- Psalms 27:2 When <u>evildoers</u> came upon me to devour my flesh, My adversaries and my enemies, they stumbled and fell.
- Psalms 28:3 Do not drag me away with the wicked And with those who work iniquity, Who speak peace with their neighbors, While evil is in their hearts.
- Psalms 28:4 Requite them according to their work and according to the <u>evil</u> of their practices; Requite them according to the deeds of their hands; Repay them their recompense.
- Psalms 34:13 Keep your tongue from evil And your lips from speaking deceit.
- Psalms 34:14 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.
- Psalms 34:16 The face of the LORD is against <u>evildoers</u>, To cut off the memory of them from the earth.
- Psalms 34:21 Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who hate the righteous will be condemned.
- Psalms 35:4 Let those be ashamed and dishonored who seek my life; Let those be turned back and humiliated who devise <u>evil</u> against me.
- Psalms 35:12 They repay me evil for good, To the bereavement of my soul.
- Psalms 36:4 He plans wickedness upon his bed; He sets himself on a path that is not good; He does not despise <u>evil</u>.
- Psalms 37:1 <<*A Psalm* of David.>> Do not fret because of <u>evildoers</u>, Be not envious toward wrongdoers.
- Psalms 37:8 Cease from anger and forsake wrath; Do not fret; *it leads* only to evildoing.
- Psalms 37:9 For <u>evildoers</u> will be cut off, But those who wait for the LORD, they will inherit the land.

Psalms 37:19 They will not be ashamed in the time of <u>evil</u>, And in the days of famine they will have abundance.

Psalms 37:27 Depart from evil and do good, So you will abide forever.

Psalms 38:20 And those who repay evil for good, They oppose me, because I follow what is good.

- Psalms 40:12 For <u>evils</u> beyond number have surrounded me; My iniquities have overtaken me, so that I am not able to see; They are more numerous than the hairs of my head, And my heart has failed me.
- Psalms 41:5 My enemies speak evil against me, "When will he die, and his name perish?"
- Psalms 50:19 "You let your mouth loose in evil And your tongue frames deceit.
- Psalms 51:4 Against You, You only, I have sinned And done what is <u>evil</u> in Your sight, So that You are justified when You speak And blameless when You judge.
- Psalms 52:1 <<For the choir director. A Maskil of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul and said to him, "David has come to the house of Ahimelech.">> Why do you boast in <u>evil</u>, O mighty man? The lovingkindness of God *endures* all day long.
- Psalms 52:3 You love <u>evil</u> more than good, Falsehood more than speaking what is right. Selah.
- Psalms 52:7 "Behold, the man who would not make God his refuge, But trusted in the abundance of his riches *And* was strong in his *evil* desire."

Psalms 54:5 He will recompense the evil to my foes; Destroy them in Your faithfulness.

- Psalms 55:15 Let death come deceitfully upon them; Let them go down alive to Sheol, For evil is in their dwelling, in their midst.
- Psalms 56:5 All day long they distort my words; All their thoughts are against me for <u>evil</u>.
- Psalms 64:2 Hide me from the secret counsel of <u>evildoers</u>, From the tumult of those who do iniquity,
- Psalms 64:5 They hold fast to themselves an <u>evil</u> purpose; They talk of laying snares secretly; They say, "Who can see them?"
- Psalms 90:15 Make us glad according to the days You have afflicted us, *And* the years we have seen evil.
- Psalms 91:10 No evil will befall you, Nor will any plague come near your tent.
- Psalms 92:11 And my eye has looked *exultantly* upon my foes, My ears hear of the <u>evildoers</u> who rise up against me.
- Psalms 94:16 Who will stand up for me against <u>evildoers</u>? Who will take his stand for me against those who do wickedness?
- Psalms 94:23 He has brought back their wickedness upon them And will destroy them in their evil; The LORD our God will destroy them.
- Psalms 97:10 Hate <u>evil</u>, you who love the LORD, Who preserves the souls of His godly ones; He delivers them from the hand of the wicked.
- Psalms 99:8 O LORD our God, You answered them; You were a forgiving God to them, And *yet* an avenger of their *evil* deeds.
- Psalms 101:4 A perverse heart shall depart from me; I will know no evil.
- Psalms 109:5 Thus they have repaid me evil for good And hatred for my love.

- Psalms 109:20 Let this be the reward of my accusers from the LORD, And of those who speak evil against my soul.
- Psalms 112:7 He will not fear evil tidings; His heart is steadfast, trusting in the LORD.
- Psalms 119:101 I have restrained my feet from every <u>evil</u> way, That I may keep Your word.
- Psalms 119:115 Depart from me, evildoers, That I may observe the commandments of my God.
- Psalms 121:7 The LORD will protect you from all evil; He will keep your soul.
- Psalms 140:1 <<For the choir director. A Psalm of David.>> Rescue me, O LORD, from evil men; Preserve me from violent men
- Psalms 140:2 Who devise evil things in *their* hearts; They continually stir up wars.
- Psalms 140:8 "Do not grant, O LORD, the desires of the wicked; Do not promote his evil device, that they not be exalted. Selah.
- Psalms 140:11 "May a slanderer not be established in the earth; May evil hunt the violent man speedily."
- Psalms 141:4 Do not incline my heart to any <u>evil</u> thing, To practice deeds of wickedness With men who do iniquity; And do not let me eat of their delicacies.
- Psalms 144:10 Who gives salvation to kings, Who rescues David His servant from the <u>evil</u> sword.
- Proverbs 1:16 For their feet run to evil And they hasten to shed blood.
- Proverbs 1:33 "But he who listens to me shall live securely And will be at ease from the dread of evil."
- Proverbs 2:12 To deliver you from the way of <u>evil</u>, From the man who speaks perverse things;
- Proverbs 2:14 Who delight in doing evil And rejoice in the perversity of evil;
- Proverbs 3:7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and turn away from evil.
- Proverbs 4:14 Do not enter the path of the wicked And do not proceed in the way of evil men.
- Proverbs 4:16 For they cannot sleep unless they do <u>evil</u>; And they are robbed of sleep unless they make *someone* stumble.
- Proverbs 4:27 Do not turn to the right nor to the left; Turn your foot from evil.
- Proverbs 6:14 Who *with* perversity in his heart continually devises <u>evil</u>, Who spreads strife.
- Proverbs 6:18 A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that run rapidly to evil,
- Proverbs 6:24 To keep you from the <u>evil</u> woman, From the smooth tongue of the adulteress.
- Proverbs 8:13 "The fear of the LORD is to hate <u>evil</u>; Pride and arrogance and the <u>evil</u> way And the perverted mouth, I hate.
- Proverbs 11:19 He who is steadfast in righteousness *will attain* to life, And he who pursues <u>evil</u> *will bring about* his own death.
- Proverbs 11:21 Assuredly, the <u>evil</u> man will not go unpunished, But the descendants of the righteous will be delivered.
- Proverbs 11:27 He who diligently seeks good seeks favor, But he who seeks <u>evil</u>, <u>evil</u> will come to him.
- Proverbs 12:2 A good man will obtain favor from the LORD, But He will condemn a man who devises <u>evil</u>.

- Proverbs 12:12 The wicked man desires the booty of <u>evil</u> men, But the root of the righteous yields *fruit*.
- Proverbs 12:13 An <u>evil</u> man is ensnared by the transgression of his lips, But the righteous will escape from trouble.
- Proverbs 12:20 Deceit is in the heart of those who devise <u>evil</u>, But counselors of peace have joy.
- Proverbs 13:19 Desire realized is sweet to the soul, But it is an abomination to fools to turn away from <u>evil</u>.
- Proverbs 14:16 A wise man is cautious and turns away from <u>evil</u>, But a fool is arrogant and careless.
- Proverbs 14:17 A quick-tempered man acts foolishly, And a man of <u>evil</u> devices is hated.
- Proverbs 14:19 The <u>evil</u> will bow down before the good, And the wicked at the gates of the righteous.
- Proverbs 14:22 Will they not go astray who devise <u>evil</u>? But kindness and truth *will be to* those who devise good.
- Proverbs 15:3 The eyes of the LORD are in every place, Watching the <u>evil</u> and the good.
- Proverbs 15:26 Evil plans are an abomination to the LORD, But pleasant words are pure.
- Proverbs 15:28 The heart of the righteous ponders how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours out <u>evil</u> things.
- Proverbs 16:4 The LORD has made everything for its own purpose, Even the wicked for the day of <u>evil</u>.
- Proverbs 16:6 By lovingkindness and truth iniquity is atoned for, And by the fear of the LORD one keeps away from <u>evil</u>.
- Proverbs 16:17 The highway of the upright is to depart from <u>evil</u>; He who watches his way preserves his life.
- Proverbs 16:27 A worthless man digs up evil, While his words are like scorching fire.
- Proverbs 16:30 He who winks his eyes *does so* to devise perverse things; He who compresses his lips brings <u>evil</u> to pass.
- Proverbs 17:4 An <u>evildoer</u> listens to wicked lips; A liar pays attention to a destructive tongue.
- Proverbs 17:11 A rebellious man seeks only <u>evil</u>, So a cruel messenger will be sent against him.
- Proverbs 17:13 He who returns evil for good, Evil will not depart from his house.
- Proverbs 17:20 He who has a crooked mind finds no good, And he who is perverted in his language falls into evil.
- Proverbs 19:23 The fear of the LORD *leads* to life, So that one may sleep satisfied, untouched by <u>evil</u>.
- Proverbs 20:8 Å king who sits on the throne of justice Disperses all evil with his eyes.
- Proverbs 20:22 Do not say, "I will repay evil"; Wait for the LORD, and He will save you.
- Proverbs 20:30 Stripes that wound scour away <u>evil</u>, And strokes *reach* the innermost parts.
- Proverbs 21:10 The soul of the wicked desires <u>evil</u>; His neighbor finds no favor in his eyes.

- Proverbs 21:27 The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination, How much more when he brings it with <u>evil</u> intent!
- Proverbs 22:3 The prudent sees the <u>evil</u> and hides himself, But the naive go on, and are punished for it.
- Proverbs 24:1 Do not be envious of evil men, Nor desire to be with them;
- Proverbs 24:8 One who plans to do evil, Men will call a schemer.
- Proverbs 24:19 Do not fret because of evildoers Or be envious of the wicked;
- Proverbs 24:20 For there will be no future for the <u>evil</u> man; The lamp of the wicked will be put out.
- Proverbs 25:10 Or he who hears *it* will reproach you, And the <u>evil</u> report about you will not pass away.
- Proverbs 27:12 A prudent man sees <u>evil</u> and hides himself, The naive proceed and pay the penalty.
- Proverbs 28:5 <u>Evil</u> men do not understand justice, But those who seek the LORD understand all things.
- Proverbs 28:10 He who leads the upright astray in an <u>evil</u> way Will himself fall into his own pit, But the blameless will inherit good.
- Proverbs 28:22 A man with an <u>evil</u> eye hastens after wealth And does not know that want will come upon him.
- Proverbs 29:6 By transgression an <u>evil</u> man is ensnared, But the righteous sings and rejoices.
- Proverbs 30:32 If you have been foolish in exalting yourself Or if you have plotted *evil, put your* hand on your mouth.
- Proverbs 31:12 She does him good and not evil All the days of her life.
- Ecclesiastes 2:21 When there is a man who has labored with wisdom, knowledge and skill, then he gives his legacy to one who has not labored with them. This too is vanity and a great evil.
- Ecclesiastes 4:3 But better *off* than both of them is the one who has never existed, who has never seen the <u>evil</u> activity that is done under the sun.
- Ecclesiastes 5:1 Guard your steps as you go to the house of God and draw near to listen rather than to offer the sacrifice of fools; for they do not know they are doing <u>evil</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 5:13 There is a grievous <u>evil</u> which I have seen under the sun: riches being hoarded by their owner to his hurt.
- Ecclesiastes 5:16 This also is a grievous <u>evil</u>—exactly as a man is born, thus will he die. So what is the advantage to him who toils for the wind?
- Ecclesiastes 6:1 There is an <u>evil</u> which I have seen under the sun and it is prevalent among men—
- Ecclesiastes 7:25 I directed my mind to know, to investigate and to seek wisdom and an explanation, and to know the <u>evil</u> of folly and the foolishness of madness.
- Ecclesiastes 8:3 "Do not be in a hurry to leave him. Do not join in an <u>evil</u> matter, for he will do whatever he pleases."
- Ecclesiastes 8:8 No man has authority to restrain the wind with the wind, or authority over the day of death; and there is no discharge in the time of war, and <u>evil</u> will not deliver those who practice it.

- Ecclesiastes 8:11 Because the sentence against an <u>evil</u> deed is not executed quickly, therefore the hearts of the sons of men among them are given fully to do <u>evil</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 8:12 Although a sinner does evil a hundred times and may lengthen his life, still I know that it will be well for those who fear God, who fear Him openly.
- Ecclesiastes 8:13 But it will not be well for the <u>evil</u> man and he will not lengthen his days like a shadow, because he does not fear God.
- Ecclesiastes 8:14 There is futility which is done on the earth, that is, there are righteous men to whom it happens according to the deeds of the wicked. On the other hand, there are <u>evil</u> men to whom it happens according to the deeds of the righteous. I say that this too is futility.
- Ecclesiastes 9:3 This is an <u>evil</u> in all that is done under the sun, that there is one fate for all men. Furthermore, the hearts of the sons of men are full of <u>evil</u> and insanity is in their hearts throughout their lives. Afterwards they *go* to the dead.
- Ecclesiastes 12:1 Remember also your Creator in the days of your youth, before the <u>evil</u> days come and the years draw near when you will say, "I have no delight in them";
- Ecclesiastes 12:14 For God will bring every act to judgment, everything which is hidden, whether it is good or <u>evil</u>.
- Isaiah 1:4 Alas, sinful nation, People weighed down with iniquity, Offspring of <u>evildoers</u>, Sons who act corruptly! They have abandoned the LORD, They have despised the Holy One of Israel, They have turned away from Him.
- Isaiah 1:16 "Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; Remove the <u>evil</u> of your deeds from My sight. Cease to do <u>evil</u>,
- Isaiah 3:9 The expression of their faces bears witness against them, And they display their sin like Sodom; They do not *even* conceal *it.* Woe to them! For they have brought <u>evil</u> on themselves.
- Isaiah 5:20 Woe to those who call <u>evil</u> good, and good <u>evil</u>; Who substitute darkness for light and light for darkness; Who substitute bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter!
- Isaiah 7:5 'Because Aram, *with* Ephraim and the son of Remaliah, has planned <u>evil</u> against you, saying,
- Isaiah 7:15 "He will eat curds and honey at the time He knows *enough* to refuse <u>evil</u> and choose good.
- Isaiah 7:16 "For before the boy will know *enough* to refuse <u>evil</u> and choose good, the land whose two kings you dread will be forsaken.
- Isaiah 9:17 Therefore the Lord does not take pleasure in their young men, Nor does He have pity on their orphans or their widows; For every one of them is godless and an <u>evildoer</u>, And every mouth is speaking foolishness. In *spite of* all this, His anger does not turn away And His hand is still stretched out.
- Isaiah 10:1 Woe to those who enact <u>evil</u> statutes And to those who constantly record unjust decisions,
- Isaiah 13:11 Thus I will punish the world for its <u>evil</u> And the wicked for their iniquity; I will also put an end to the arrogance of the proud And abase the haughtiness of the ruthless.
- Isaiah 14:20 "You will not be united with them in burial, Because you have ruined your country, You have slain your people. May the offspring of <u>evildoers</u> not be mentioned forever.

- Isaiah 29:20 For the ruthless will come to an end and the scorner will be finished, Indeed all who are intent on doing <u>evil</u> will be cut off;
- Isaiah 31:2 Yet He also is wise and will bring disaster And does not retract His words, But will arise against the house of <u>evildoers</u> And against the help of the workers of iniquity.
- Isaiah 32:7 As for a rogue, his weapons are <u>evil</u>; He devises wicked schemes To destroy *the* afflicted with slander, Even though *the* needy one speaks what is right.
- Isaiah 33:15 He who walks righteously and speaks with sincerity, He who rejects unjust gain And shakes his hands so that they hold no bribe; He who stops his ears from hearing about bloodshed And shuts his eyes from looking upon <u>evil</u>;
- Isaiah 41:23 Declare the things that are going to come afterward, That we may know that you are gods; Indeed, do good or <u>evil</u>, that we may anxiously look about us and fear together.
- Isaiah 47:11 "But <u>evil</u> will come on you Which you will not know how to charm away; And disaster will fall on you For which you cannot atone; And destruction about which you do not know Will come on you suddenly.
- Isaiah 56:2 "How blessed is the man who does this, And the son of man who takes hold of it; Who keeps from profaning the sabbath, And keeps his hand from doing any <u>evil</u>."
- Isaiah 57:1 The righteous man perishes, and no man takes it to heart; And devout men are taken away, while no one understands. For the righteous man is taken away from <u>evil</u>,
- Isaiah 59:7 Their feet run to <u>evil</u>, And they hasten to shed innocent blood; Their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity, Devastation and destruction are in their highways.
- Isaiah 59:15 Yes, truth is lacking; And he who turns aside from <u>evil</u> makes himself a prey. Now the LORD saw, And it was displeasing in His sight that there was no justice.

Isaiah 65:12 I will destine you for the sword, And all of you will bow down to the slaughter. Because I called, but you did not answer; I spoke, but you did not hear. And you did <u>evil</u> in My sight And chose that in which I did not delight."

- Isaiah 65:25 "The wolf and the lamb will graze together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox; and dust will be the serpent's food. They will do no <u>evil</u> or harm in all My holy mountain," says the LORD.
- Isaiah 66:4 So I will choose their punishments And will bring on them what they dread. Because I called, but no one answered; I spoke, but they did not listen. And they did <u>evil</u> in My sight And chose that in which I did not delight."
- Jeremiah 1:14 Then the LORD said to me, "Out of the north the <u>evil</u> will break forth on all the inhabitants of the land.
- Jeremiah 2:3 "Israel was holy to the LORD, The first of His harvest. All who ate of it became guilty; <u>Evil</u> came upon them," declares the LORD.'"
- Jeremiah 2:13 "For My people have committed two <u>evils</u>: They have forsaken Me, The fountain of living waters, To hew for themselves cisterns, Broken cisterns That can hold no water.
- Jeremiah 2:19 "Your own wickedness will correct you, And your apostasies will reprove you; Know therefore and see that it is <u>evil</u> and bitter For you to forsake the LORD your God, And the dread of Me is not in you," declares the Lord GOD of hosts.

- Jeremiah 3:5 'Will He be angry forever? Will He be indignant to the end?' Behold, you have spoken And have done <u>evil</u> things, And you have had your way."
- Jeremiah 3:17 "At that time they will call Jerusalem 'The Throne of the LORD,' and all the nations will be gathered to it, to Jerusalem, for the name of the LORD; nor will they walk anymore after the stubbornness of their <u>evil</u> heart.
- Jeremiah 4:4 "Circumcise yourselves to the LORD And remove the foreskins of your heart, Men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, Or else My wrath will go forth like fire And burn with none to quench it, Because of the <u>evil</u> of your deeds."
- Jeremiah 4:6 "Lift up a standard toward Zion! Seek refuge, do not stand *still,* For I am bringing <u>evil</u> from the north, And great destruction.
- Jeremiah 4:14 Wash your heart from <u>evil</u>, O Jerusalem, That you may be saved. How long will your wicked thoughts Lodge within you?
- Jeremiah 4:18 "Your ways and your deeds Have brought these things to you. This is your <u>evil</u>. How bitter! How it has touched your heart!"
- Jeremiah 4:22 "For My people are foolish, They know Me not; They are stupid children And have no understanding. They are shrewd to do <u>evil</u>, But to do good they do not know."
- Jeremiah 6:1 "Flee for safety, O sons of Benjamin, From the midst of Jerusalem! Now blow a trumpet in Tekoa And raise a signal over Beth-haccerem; For <u>evil</u> looks down from the north, And a great destruction.
- Jeremiah 7:24 "Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but walked in *their own* counsels *and* in the stubbornness of their <u>evil</u> heart, and went backward and not forward.
- Jeremiah 7:26 "Yet they did not listen to Me or incline their ear, but stiffened their neck; they did more <u>evil</u> than their fathers.
- Jeremiah 7:30 "For the sons of Judah have done that which is <u>evil</u> in My sight," declares the LORD, "they have set their detestable things in the house which is called by My name, to defile it.
- Jeremiah 8:3 "And death will be chosen rather than life by all the remnant that remains of this <u>evil</u> family, that remains in all the places to which I have driven them," declares the LORD of hosts.
- Jeremiah 9:3 "They bend their tongue *like* their bow; Lies and not truth prevail in the land; For they proceed from <u>evil</u> to <u>evil</u>, And they do not know Me," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 11:8 'Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but walked, each one, in the stubbornness of his <u>evil</u> heart; therefore I brought on them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded *them* to do, but they did not.'"
- Jeremiah 11:17 The LORD of hosts, who planted you, has pronounced <u>evil</u> against you because of the <u>evil</u> of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done to provoke Me by offering up sacrifices to Baal.
- Jeremiah 13:23 "Can the Ethiopian change his skin Or the leopard his spots? *Then* you also can do good Who are accustomed to doing <u>evil</u>.
- Jeremiah 16:12 'You too have done <u>evil</u>, *even* more than your forefathers; for behold, you are each one walking according to the stubbornness of his own <u>evil</u> heart, without listening to Me.

- Jeremiah 18:8 if that nation against which I have spoken turns from its <u>evil</u>, I will relent concerning the calamity I planned to bring on it.
- Jeremiah 18:10 if it does evil in My sight by not obeying My voice, then I will think better of the good with which I had promised to bless it.
- Jeremiah 18:11 "So now then, speak to the men of Judah and against the inhabitants of Jerusalem saying, 'Thus says the LORD, "Behold, I am fashioning calamity against you and devising a plan against you. Oh turn back, each of you from his <u>evil</u> way, and reform your ways and your deeds."
- Jeremiah 18:12 "But they will say, 'It's hopeless! For we are going to follow our own plans, and each of us will act according to the stubbornness of his <u>evil</u> heart.'
- Jeremiah 18:20 Should good be repaid with <u>evil</u>? For they have dug a pit for me. Remember how I stood before You To speak good on their behalf, So as to turn away Your wrath from them.
- Jeremiah 20:13 Sing to the LORD, praise the LORD! For He has delivered the soul of the needy one From the hand of <u>evildoers</u>.
- Jeremiah 21:12 O house of David, thus says the LORD: "Administer justice every morning; And deliver the *person* who has been robbed from the power of *his* oppressor, That My wrath may not go forth like fire And burn with none to extinguish *it*, Because of the <u>evil</u> of their deeds.
- Jeremiah 23:2 Therefore thus says the LORD God of Israel concerning the shepherds who are tending My people: "You have scattered My flock and driven them away, and have not attended to them; behold, I am about to attend to you for the <u>evil</u> of your deeds," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 23:10 For the land is full of adulterers; For the land mourns because of the curse. The pastures of the wilderness have dried up. Their course also is <u>evil</u> And their might is not right.
- Jeremiah 23:14 "Also among the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen a horrible thing: The committing of adultery and walking in falsehood; And they strengthen the hands of <u>evildoers</u>, So that no one has turned back from his wickedness. All of them have become to Me like Sodom, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.
- Jeremiah 23:22 "But if they had stood in My council, Then they would have announced My words to My people, And would have turned them back from their <u>evil</u> way And from the <u>evil</u> of their deeds.
- Jeremiah 24:9 'I will make them a terror *and an* <u>evil</u> for all the kingdoms of the earth, as a reproach and a proverb, a taunt and a curse in all places where I will scatter them.
- Jeremiah 25:5 saying, 'Turn now everyone from his <u>evil</u> way and from the <u>evil</u> of your deeds, and dwell on the land which the LORD has given to you and your forefathers forever and ever;
- Jeremiah 25:32 Thus says the LORD of hosts, "Behold, <u>evil</u> is going forth From nation to nation, And a great storm is being stirred up From the remotest parts of the earth.
- Jeremiah 26:3 'Perhaps they will listen and everyone will turn from his <u>evil</u> way, that I may repent of the calamity which I am planning to do to them because of the <u>evil</u> of their deeds.'
- Jeremiah 26:19 "Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him to death? Did he not fear the LORD and entreat the favor of the LORD, and the LORD changed His

mind about the misfortune which He had pronounced against them? But we are committing a great evil against ourselves."

- Jeremiah 32:30 "Indeed the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah have been doing only <u>evil</u> in My sight from their youth; for the sons of Israel have been only provoking Me to anger by the work of their hands," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 32:32 because of all the <u>evil</u> of the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah which they have done to provoke Me to anger—they, their kings, their leaders, their priests, their prophets, the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem.
- Jeremiah 35:15 "Also I have sent to you all My servants the prophets, sending *them* again and again, saying: 'Turn now every man from his <u>evil</u> way and amend your deeds, and do not go after other gods to worship them. Then you will dwell in the land which I have given to you and to your forefathers; but you have not inclined your ear or listened to Me.
- Jeremiah 36:3 "Perhaps the house of Judah will hear all the calamity which I plan to bring on them, in order that every man will turn from his <u>evil</u> way; then I will forgive their iniquity and their sin."
- Jeremiah 36:7 "Perhaps their supplication will come before the LORD, and everyone will turn from his <u>evil</u> way, for great is the anger and the wrath that the LORD has pronounced against this people."
- Jeremiah 41:11 But Johanan the son of Kareah and all the commanders of the forces that were with him heard of all the <u>evil</u> that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had done.
- Jeremiah 44:22 "So the LORD was no longer able to endure *it*, because of the <u>evil</u> of your deeds, because of the abominations which you have committed; thus your land has become a ruin, an object of horror and a curse, without an inhabitant, as *it is* this day.
- Jeremiah 51:24 "But I will repay Babylon and all the inhabitants of Chaldea for all their <u>evil</u> that they have done in Zion before your eyes," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 52:2 He did evil in the sight of the LORD like all that Jehoiakim had done.
- Jeremiah 52:31 Now it came about in the thirty-seventh year of the exile of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the twenty-fifth of the month, that <u>Evil</u>-merodach king of Babylon, in the *first* year of his reign, showed favor to Jehoiachin king of Judah and brought him out of prison.
- Ezekiel 6:9 "Then those of you who escape will remember Me among the nations to which they will be carried captive, how I have been hurt by their adulterous hearts which turned away from Me, and by their eyes which played the harlot after their idols; and they will loathe themselves in their own sight for the <u>evils</u> which they have committed, for all their abominations.
- Ezekiel 6:11 "Thus says the Lord GOD, 'Clap your hand, stamp your foot and say, "Alas, because of all the <u>evil</u> abominations of the house of Israel, which will fall by sword, famine and plague!
- Ezekiel 11:2 He said to me, "Son of man, these are the men who devise iniquity and give evil advice in this city,
- Ezekiel 20:43 "There you will remember your ways and all your deeds with which you have defiled yourselves; and you will loathe yourselves in your own sight for all the <u>evil</u> things that you have done.

- Ezekiel 20:44 "Then you will know that I am the LORD when I have dealt with you for My name's sake, not according to your <u>evil</u> ways or according to your corrupt deeds, O house of Israel," declares the Lord GOD."
- Ezekiel 30:12 "Moreover, I will make the Nile canals dry And sell the land into the hands of <u>evil</u> men. And I will make the land desolate And all that is in it, By the hand of strangers; I the LORD have spoken."
- Ezekiel 33:11 "Say to them, 'As I live!' declares the Lord GOD, 'I take no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but rather that the wicked turn from his way and live. Turn back, turn back from your <u>evil</u> ways! Why then will you die, O house of Israel?'
- Ezekiel 36:31 "Then you will remember your <u>evil</u> ways and your deeds that were not good, and you will loathe yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and your abominations.
- Ezekiel 38:10 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "It will come about on that day, that thoughts will come into your mind and you will devise an <u>evil</u> plan,
- Daniel 11:27 "As for both kings, their hearts will be *intent* on <u>evil</u>, and they will speak lies *to each other* at the same table; but it will not succeed, for the end is still *to come* at the appointed time.
- Hosea 7:1 When I would heal Israel, The iniquity of Ephraim is uncovered, And the <u>evil</u> deeds of Samaria, For they deal falsely; The thief enters in, Bandits raid outside,
- Hosea 7:15 Although I trained *and* strengthened their arms, Yet they devise <u>evil</u> against Me.
- Hosea 9:15 All their <u>evil</u> is at Gilgal; Indeed, I came to hate them there! Because of the wickedness of their deeds I will drive them out of My house! I will love them no more; All their princes are rebels.
- Joel 2:13 And rend your heart and not your garments." Now return to the LORD your God, For He is gracious and compassionate, Slow to anger, abounding in lovingkindness And relenting of <u>evil</u>.
- Amos 5:13 Therefore at such a time the prudent person keeps silent, for it is an <u>evil</u> time.
- Amos 5:14 Seek good and not <u>evil</u>, that you may live; And thus may the LORD God of hosts be with you, Just as you have said!
- Amos 5:15 Hate <u>evil</u>, love good, And establish justice in the gate! Perhaps the LORD God of hosts May be gracious to the remnant of Joseph.
- Amos 9:4 "And though they go into captivity before their enemies, From there I will command the sword that it slay them, And I will set My eyes against them for <u>evil</u> and not for good."
- Micah 2:1 Woe to those who scheme iniquity, Who work out <u>evil</u> on their beds! When morning comes, they do it, For it is in the power of their hands.
- Micah 2:3 Therefore thus says the LORD, "Behold, I am planning against this family a calamity From which you cannot remove your necks; And you will not walk haughtily, For it will be an <u>evil</u> time.
- Micah 3:2 "You who hate good and love <u>evil</u>, Who tear off their skin from them And their flesh from their bones,
- Micah 3:4 Then they will cry out to the LORD, But He will not answer them. Instead, He will hide His face from them at that time Because they have practiced <u>evil</u> deeds.

- Micah 7:3 Concerning <u>evil</u>, both hands do it well. The prince asks, also the judge, for a bribe, And a great man speaks the desire of his soul; So they weave it together.
- Nahum 1:11 From you has gone forth One who plotted <u>evil</u> against the LORD, A wicked counselor.
- Nahum 3:19 There is no relief for your breakdown, Your wound is incurable. All who hear about you Will clap *their* hands over you, For on whom has not your <u>evil</u> passed continually?
- Habakkuk 1:13 Your eyes are too pure to approve <u>evil</u>, And You can not look on wickedness *with favor*. Why do You look with favor On those who deal treacherously? Why are You silent when the wicked swallow up Those more righteous than they?
- Zephaniah 1:12 "It will come about at that time That I will search Jerusalem with lamps, And I will punish the men Who are stagnant in spirit, Who say in their hearts, 'The LORD will not do good or <u>evil</u>!'
- Zechariah 1:4 "Do not be like your fathers, to whom the former prophets proclaimed, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, "Return now from your <u>evil</u> ways and from your <u>evil</u> deeds." But they did not listen or give heed to Me," declares the LORD.
- Zechariah 7:10 and do not oppress the widow or the orphan, the stranger or the poor; and do not devise <u>evil</u> in your hearts against one another.'
- Zechariah 8:17 'Also let none of you devise <u>evil</u> in your heart against another, and do not love perjury; for all these are what I hate,' declares the LORD."
- Malachi 1:8 "But when you present the blind for sacrifice, is it not <u>evil</u>? And when you present the lame and sick, is it not <u>evil</u>? Why not offer it to your governor? Would he be pleased with you? Or would he receive you kindly?" says the LORD of hosts.
- Malachi 2:17 You have wearied the LORD with your words. Yet you say, "How have we wearied *Him?*" In that you say, "Everyone who does <u>evil</u> is good in the sight of the LORD, and He delights in them," or, "Where is the God of justice?"
- Malachi 4:1 "For behold, the day is coming, burning like a furnace; and all the arrogant and every <u>evildoer</u> will be chaff; and the day that is coming will set them ablaze," says the LORD of hosts, "so that it will leave them neither root nor branch."
- Matthew 5:11 "Blessed are you when *people* insult you and persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of <u>evil</u> against you because of Me.
- Matthew 5:37 "But let your statement be, 'Yes, yes' *or* 'No, no'; anything beyond these is of <u>evil</u>.
- Matthew 5:39 "But I say to you, do not resist an <u>evil</u> person; but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also.
- Matthew 5:45 so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven; for He causes His sun to rise on *the* <u>evil</u> and *the* good, and sends rain on *the* righteous and *the* unrighteous.
- Matthew 6:13 'And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from <u>evil</u>. [[For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.]]'
- Matthew 7:11 "If you then, being <u>evil</u>, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him!
- Matthew 9:4 And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, "Why are you thinking <u>evil</u> in your hearts?

- Matthew 12:34 "You brood of vipers, how can you, being <u>evil</u>, speak what is good? For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart.
- Matthew 12:35 "The good man brings out of *his* good treasure what is good; and the <u>evil</u> man brings out of *his* <u>evil</u> treasure what is <u>evil</u>.
- Matthew 12:39 But He answered and said to them, "An <u>evil</u> and adulterous generation craves for a sign; and *yet* no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet;

Matthew 12:45 "Then it goes and takes along with it seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they go in and live there; and the last state of that man becomes worse than the first. That is the way it will also be with this <u>evil</u> generation."

- Matthew 13:19 "When anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the <u>evil</u> one comes and snatches away what has been sown in his heart. This is the one on whom seed was sown beside the road.
- Matthew 13:38 and the field is the world; and *as for* the good seed, these are the sons of the kingdom; and the tares are the sons of the <u>evil</u> one;
- Matthew 15:4 "For God said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND MOTHER,' and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER IS TO BE PUT TO DEATH.'
- Matthew 15:19 "For out of the heart come <u>evil</u> thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, slanders.
- Matthew 16:4 "An <u>evil</u> and adulterous generation seeks after a sign; and a sign will not be given it, except the sign of Jonah." And He left them and went away.
- Matthew 22:10 "Those slaves went out into the streets and gathered together all they found, both <u>evil</u> and good; and the wedding hall was filled with dinner guests.
- Matthew 24:48 "But if that evil slave says in his heart, 'My master is not coming for a long time,'
- Matthew 27:23 And he said, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they kept shouting all the more, saying, "Crucify Him!"
- Mark 7:10 "For Moses said, 'HONOR YOUR FATHER AND YOUR MOTHER'; and, 'HE WHO SPEAKS EVIL OF FATHER OR MOTHER, IS TO BE PUT TO DEATH';
- Mark 7:21 "For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed the <u>evil</u> thoughts, fornications, thefts, murders, adulteries,
- Mark 7:23 "All these evil things proceed from within and defile the man."
- Mark 9:39 But Jesus said, "Do not hinder him, for there is no one who will perform a miracle in My name, and be able soon afterward to speak <u>evil</u> of Me.
- Mark 15:14 But Pilate said to them, "Why, what evil has He done?" But they shouted all the more, "Crucify Him!"
- Luke 6:22 "Blessed are you when men hate you, and ostracize you, and insult you, and scorn your name as <u>evil</u>, for the sake of the Son of Man.
- Luke 6:35 "But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High; for He Himself is kind to ungrateful and <u>evil</u> men.
- Luke 6:45 "The good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth what is good; and the <u>evil</u> man out of the <u>evil</u> treasure brings forth what is <u>evil</u>; for his mouth speaks from that which fills his heart.
- Luke 7:21 At that very time He cured many *people* of diseases and afflictions and <u>evil</u> spirits; and He gave sight to many *who were* blind.

- Luke 8:2 and *also* some women who had been healed of <u>evil</u> spirits and sicknesses: Mary who was called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out,
- Luke 11:13 "If you then, being <u>evil</u>, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?"
- Luke 11:26 "Then it goes and takes *along* seven other spirits more <u>evil</u> than itself, and they go in and live there; and the last state of that man becomes worse than the first."
- Luke 13:27 and He will say, 'I tell you, I do not know where you are from; DEPART FROM ME, ALL YOU EVILDOERS.'
- Luke 23:22 And he said to them the third time, "Why, what <u>evil</u> has this man done? I have found in Him no guilt *demanding* death; therefore I will punish Him and release Him."
- John 3:19 "This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were <u>evil</u>.
- John 3:20 "For everyone who does evil hates the Light, and does not come to the Light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.
- John 5:29 and will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the <u>evil</u> *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.
- John 7:7 "The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it, that its deeds are <u>evil</u>.
- John 17:15 "I do not ask You to take them out of the world, but to keep them from the <u>evil</u> one.
- John 18:30 They answered and said to him, "If this Man were not an <u>evildoer</u>, we would not have delivered Him to you."
- Acts 19:9 But when some were becoming hardened and disobedient, speaking <u>evil</u> of the Way before the people, he withdrew from them and took away the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus.
- Acts 19:12 so that handkerchiefs or aprons were even carried from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the <u>evil</u> spirits went out.
- Acts 19:13 But also some of the Jewish exorcists, who went from place to place, attempted to name over those who had the <u>evil</u> spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, "I adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preaches."
- Acts 19:15 And the <u>evil</u> spirit answered and said to them, "I recognize Jesus, and I know about Paul, but who are you?"
- Acts 19:16 And the man, in whom was the <u>evil</u> spirit, leaped on them and subdued all of them and overpowered them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- Acts 23:5 And Paul said, "I was not aware, brethren, that he was high priest; for it is written, 'YOU SHALL NOT SPEAK <u>EVIL</u> OF A RULER OF YOUR PEOPLE.'"
- Romans 1:29 being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, <u>evil;</u> full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; *they are* gossips,
- Romans 1:30 slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of <u>evil</u>, disobedient to parents,
- Romans 2:9 *There will be* tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does <u>evil</u>, of the Jew first and also of the Greek,

- Romans 3:8 And why not *say* (as we are slanderously reported and as some claim that we say), "Let us do <u>evil</u> that good may come"? Their condemnation is just.
- Romans 7:19 For the good that I want, I do not do, but I practice the very evil that I do not want.
- Romans 7:21 I find then the principle that <u>evil</u> is present in me, the one who wants to do good.
- Romans 12:9 Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good.
- Romans 12:17 Never pay back <u>evil</u> for <u>evil</u> to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all men.
- Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by <u>evil</u>, but overcome <u>evil</u> with good.
- Romans 13:3 For rulers are not a cause of fear for good behavior, but for <u>evil</u>. Do you want to have no fear of authority? Do what is good and you will have praise from the same;
- Romans 13:4 for it is a minister of God to you for good. But if you do what is <u>evil</u>, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a minister of God, an avenger who brings wrath on the one who practices <u>evil</u>.
- Romans 14:16 Therefore do not let what is for you a good thing be spoken of as evil;
- Romans 14:20 Do not tear down the work of God for the sake of food. All things indeed are clean, but they are <u>evil</u> for the man who eats and gives offense.
- Romans 16:19 For the report of your obedience has reached to all; therefore I am rejoicing over you, but I want you to be wise in what is good and innocent in what is <u>evil</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 10:6 Now these things happened as examples for us, so that we would not crave <u>evil</u> things as they also craved.
- 1 Corinthians 14:20 Brethren, do not be children in your thinking; yet in <u>evil</u> be infants, but in your thinking be mature.
- 2 Corinthians 6:8 by glory and dishonor, by <u>evil</u> report and good report; *regarded* as deceivers and yet true;
- Galatians 1:4 who gave Himself for our sins so that He might rescue us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,
- Ephesians 5:16 making the most of your time, because the days are evil.
- Ephesians 6:13 Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the <u>evil</u> day, and having done everything, to stand firm.
- Ephesians 6:16 in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the <u>evil</u> one.
- Philippians 3:2 Beware of the dogs, beware of the <u>evil</u> workers, beware of the false circumcision;
- Colossians 1:21 And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds,
- Colossians 3:5 Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, <u>evil</u> desire, and greed, which amounts to idolatry.
- Colossians 3:9 Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its <u>evil</u> practices,
- 1 Thessalonians 5:15 See that no one repays another with <u>evil</u> for <u>evil</u>, but always seek after that which is good for one another and for all people.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 abstain from every form of evil.

- 2 Thessalonians 3:2 and that we will be rescued from perverse and <u>evil</u> men; for not all have faith.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.
- 1 Timothy 6:4 he is conceited *and* understands nothing; but he has a morbid interest in controversial questions and disputes about words, out of which arise envy, strife, abusive language, <u>evil</u> suspicions,
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all sorts of <u>evil</u>, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.
- 2 Timothy 3:13 But evil men and impostors will proceed from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived.
- 2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord will rescue me from every <u>evil</u> deed, and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom; to Him *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
- Titus 1:12 One of themselves, a prophet of their own, said, "Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons."
- Hebrews 3:12 Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an <u>evil</u>, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God.
- Hebrews 5:14 But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and <u>evil</u>.
- Hebrews 10:22 let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled *clean* from an <u>evil</u> conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.
- James 1:13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by <u>evil</u>, and He Himself does not tempt anyone.
- James 2:4 have you not made distinctions among yourselves, and become judges with <u>evil</u> motives?
- James 3:8 But no one can tame the tongue; *it is* a restless <u>evil</u> and full of deadly poison.
- James 3:16 For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every <u>evil</u> thing.
- James 4:16 But as it is, you boast in your arrogance; all such boasting is evil.
- 1 Peter 2:12 Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as <u>evildoers</u>, they may because of your good deeds, as they observe *them*, glorify God in the day of visitation.
- 1 Peter 2:14 or to governors as sent by him for the punishment of <u>evildoers</u> and the praise of those who do right.
- 1 Peter 2:16 Act as free men, and do not use your freedom as a covering for <u>evil</u>, but use it as bondslaves of God.
- 1 Peter 3:9 not returning <u>evil</u> for <u>evil</u> or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing.
- 1 Peter 3:10 For, "THE ONE WHO DESIRES LIFE, TO LOVE AND SEE GOOD DAYS, MUST KEEP HIS TONGUE FROM EVIL AND HIS LIPS FROM SPEAKING DECEIT.
- 1 Peter 3:11 "HE MUST TURN AWAY FROM <u>EVIL</u> AND DO GOOD; HE MUST SEEK PEACE AND PURSUE IT.

- 1 Peter 3:12 "FOR THE EYES OF THE LORD ARE TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS, AND HIS EARS ATTEND TO THEIR PRAYER, BUT THE FACE OF THE LORD IS AGAINST THOSE WHO DO <u>EVIL</u>."
- 1 Peter 4:15 Make sure that none of you suffers as a murderer, or thief, or <u>evildoer</u>, or a troublesome meddler;
- 1 John 2:13 I am writing to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I am writing to you, young men, because you have overcome the <u>evil</u> one. I have written to you, children, because you know the Father.
- 1 John 2:14 I have written to you, fathers, because you know Him who has been from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, and you have overcome the <u>evil</u> one.
- 1 John 3:12 not as Cain, *who* was of the <u>evil</u> one and slew his brother. And for what reason did he slay him? Because his deeds were <u>evil</u>, and his brother's were righteous.
- 1 John 5:18 We know that no one who is born of God sins; but He who was born of God keeps him, and the <u>evil</u> one does not touch him.
- 1 John 5:19 We know that we are of God, and that the whole world lies in *the power of* the <u>evil</u> one.
- 2 John $\overline{1:11}$ for the one who gives him a greeting participates in his <u>evil</u> deeds.
- 3 John 1:11 Beloved, do not imitate what is <u>evil</u>, but what is good. The one who does good is of God; the one who does <u>evil</u> has not seen God.
- Revelation 2:2 'I know your deeds and your toil and perseverance, and that you cannot tolerate <u>evil</u> men, and you put to the test those who call themselves apostles, and they are not, and you found them *to be* false;

Wickedness of Man

- Genesis 6:5 Then the LORD saw that the <u>wickedness</u> of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- Genesis 13:13 Now the men of Sodom were <u>wicked</u> exceedingly and sinners against the LORD.
- Genesis 18:23 Abraham came near and said, "Will You indeed sweep away the righteous with the <u>wicked</u>?
- Genesis 18:25 "Far be it from You to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the <u>wicked</u>, so that the righteous and the <u>wicked</u> are *treated* alike. Far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?"
- Genesis 19:7 and said, "Please, my brothers, do not act wickedly.
- Exodus 9:27 Then Pharaoh sent for Moses and Aaron, and said to them, "I have sinned this time; the LORD is the righteous one, and I and my people are the <u>wicked</u> ones.
- Exodus 23:1 "You shall not bear a false report; do not join your hand with a <u>wicked</u> man to be a malicious witness.
- Numbers 16:26 and he spoke to the congregation, saying, "Depart now from the tents of these <u>wicked</u> men, and touch nothing that belongs to them, or you will be swept away in all their sin."
- Deuteronomy 9:4 "Do not say in your heart when the LORD your God has driven them out before you, 'Because of my righteousness the LORD has brought me in to

possess this land,' but *it is* because of the <u>wickedness</u> of these nations *that* the LORD is dispossessing them before you.

- Deuteronomy 9:5 "It is not for your righteousness or for the uprightness of your heart that you are going to possess their land, but *it is* because of the <u>wickedness</u> of these nations *that* the LORD your God is driving them out before you, in order to confirm the oath which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.
- Deuteronomy 9:27 'Remember Your servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; do not look at the stubbornness of this people or at their <u>wickedness</u> or their sin.
- Deuteronomy 13:11 "Then all Israel will hear and be afraid, and will never again do such a <u>wicked</u> thing among you.
- Deuteronomy 25:1 "If there is a dispute between men and they go to court, and the judges decide their case, and they justify the righteous and condemn the <u>wicked</u>,
- Deuteronomy 25:2 then it shall be if the <u>wicked</u> man deserves to be beaten, the judge shall then make him lie down and be beaten in his presence with the number of stripes according to his guilt.
- Judges 9:56 Thus God repaid the <u>wickedness</u> of Abimelech, which he had done to his father in killing his seventy brothers.
- Judges 9:57 Also God returned all the <u>wickedness</u> of the men of Shechem on their heads, and the curse of Jotham the son of Jerubbaal came upon them.
- Judges 19:23 Then the man, the owner of the house, went out to them and said to them, "No, my fellows, please do not act so <u>wickedly</u>; since this man has come into my house, do not commit this act of folly.
- Judges 20:3 (Now the sons of Benjamin heard that the sons of Israel had gone up to Mizpah.) And the sons of Israel said, "Tell *us*, how did this <u>wickedness</u> take place?"
- Judges 20:12 Then the tribes of Israel sent men through the entire tribe of Benjamin, saying, "What is this wickedness that has taken place among you?
- Judges 20:13 "Now then, deliver up the men, the worthless fellows in Gibeah, that we may put them to death and remove *this* <u>wickedness</u> from Israel." But the sons of Benjamin would not listen to the voice of their brothers, the sons of Israel.
- 1 Samuel 2:9 "He keeps the feet of His godly ones, But the <u>wicked</u> ones are silenced in darkness; For not by might shall a man prevail.
- 1 Samuel 12:17 "Is it not the wheat harvest today? I will call to the LORD, that He may send thunder and rain. Then you will know and see that your <u>wickedness</u> is great which you have done in the sight of the LORD by asking for yourselves a king."
- 1 Samuel 12:25 "But if you still do <u>wickedly</u>, both you and your king will be swept away."
- 1 Samuel 17:28 Now Eliab his oldest brother heard when he spoke to the men; and Eliab's anger burned against David and he said, "Why have you come down? And with whom have you left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know your insolence and the <u>wickedness</u> of your heart; for you have come down in order to see the battle."
- 1 Samuel 24:13 "As the proverb of the ancients says, 'Out of the <u>wicked</u> comes forth <u>wickedness</u>'; but my hand shall not be against you.
- 1 Samuel 24:17 He said to David, "You are more righteous than I; for you have dealt well with me, while I have dealt <u>wickedly</u> with you.

- 1 Samuel 30:22 Then all the <u>wicked</u> and worthless men among those who went with David said, "Because they did not go with us, we will not give them any of the spoil that we have recovered, except to every man his wife and his children, that they may lead *them* away and depart."
- 2 Samuel 3:34 "Your hands were not bound, nor your feet put in fetters; As one falls before the <u>wicked</u>, you have fallen." And all the people wept again over him.
- 2 Samuel 4:11 "How much more, when <u>wicked</u> men have killed a righteous man in his own house on his bed, shall I not now require his blood from your hand and destroy you from the earth?"
- 2 Samuel 7:10 "I will also appoint a place for My people Israel and will plant them, that they may live in their own place and not be disturbed again, nor will the <u>wicked</u> afflict them any more as formerly,
- 2 Samuel 22:22 "For I have kept the ways of the LORD, And have not acted <u>wickedly</u> against my God.
- 1 Kings 1:52 Solomon said, "If he is a worthy man, not one of his hairs will fall to the ground; but if <u>wickedness</u> is found in him, he will die."
- 1 Kings 8:32 then hear in heaven and act and judge Your servants, condemning the <u>wicked</u> by bringing his way on his own head and justifying the righteous by giving him according to his righteousness.
- 1 Kings 8:47 if they take thought in the land where they have been taken captive, and repent and make supplication to You in the land of those who have taken them captive, saying, 'We have sinned and have committed iniquity, we have acted <u>wickedly</u>';
- 1 Kings 16:25 Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD, and acted more <u>wickedly</u> than all who *were* before him.
- 2 Kings 21:11 "Because Manasseh king of Judah has done these abominations, having done <u>wickedly</u> more than all the Amorites did who *were* before him, and has also made Judah sin with his idols;
- 1 Chronicles 2:3 The sons of Judah *were* Er, Onan and Shelah; *these* three were born to him by Bath-shua the Canaanitess. And Er, Judah's firstborn, was <u>wicked</u> in the sight of the LORD, so He put him to death.
- 1 Chronicles 17:9 "I will appoint a place for My people Israel, and will plant them, so that they may dwell in their own place and not be moved again; and the <u>wicked</u> will not waste them anymore as formerly,
- 1 Chronicles 21:17 David said to God, "Is it not I who commanded to count the people? Indeed, I am the one who has sinned and done very <u>wickedly</u>, but these sheep, what have they done? O LORD my God, please let Your hand be against me and my father's household, but not against Your people that they should be plagued."
- 2 Chronicles 6:23 then hear from heaven and act and judge Your servants, punishing the <u>wicked</u> by bringing his way on his own head and justifying the righteous by giving him according to his righteousness.
- 2 Chronicles 6:37 if they take thought in the land where they are taken captive, and repent and make supplication to You in the land of their captivity, saying, 'We have sinned, we have committed iniquity and have acted <u>wickedly</u>';

- 2 Chronicles 7:14 and My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray and seek My face and turn from their <u>wicked</u> ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
- 2 Chronicles 19:2 Jehu the son of Hanani the seer went out to meet him and said to King Jehoshaphat, "Should you help the <u>wicked</u> and love those who hate the LORD and so *bring* wrath on yourself from the LORD?
- 2 Chronicles 20:35 After this Jehoshaphat king of Judah allied himself with Ahaziah king of Israel. He acted <u>wickedly</u> in so doing.
- 2 Chronicles 22:3 He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab, for his mother was his counselor to do <u>wickedly</u>.
- 2 Chronicles 24:7 For the sons of the <u>wicked</u> Athaliah had broken into the house of God and even used the holy things of the house of the LORD for the Baals.
- Nehemiah 9:33 "However, You are just in all that has come upon us; For You have dealt faithfully, but we have acted <u>wickedly</u>.
- Esther 7:6 Esther said, "A foe and an enemy is this <u>wicked</u> Haman!" Then Haman became terrified before the king and queen.
- Esther 9:25 But when it came to the king's attention, he commanded by letter that his <u>wicked</u> scheme which he had devised against the Jews, should return on his own head and that he and his sons should be hanged on the gallows.
- Job 3:17 "There the <u>wicked</u> cease from raging, And there the weary are at rest.
- Job 8:22 "Those who hate you will be clothed with shame, And the tent of the <u>wicked</u> will be no longer."
- Job 9:22 "It is all one; therefore I say, 'He destroys the guiltless and the wicked.'
- Job 9:24 "The earth is given into the hand of the <u>wicked</u>; He covers the faces of its judges. If *it is* not *He,* then who is it?
- Job 9:29 "I am accounted wicked, Why then should I toil in vain?
- Job 10:3 'Is it right for You indeed to oppress, To reject the labor of Your hands, And to look favorably on the schemes of the <u>wicked</u>?

- Job 18:5 "Indeed, the light of the <u>wicked</u> goes out, And the flame of his fire gives no light.
- Job 18:21 "Surely such are the dwellings of the <u>wicked</u>, And this is the place of him who does not know God."
- Job 20:5 That the triumphing of the <u>wicked</u> is short, And the joy of the godless momentary?
- Job 20:29 "This is the <u>wicked</u> man's portion from God, Even the heritage decreed to him by God."
- Job 21:7 "Why do the wicked still live, Continue on, also become very powerful?

- Job 21:16 "Behold, their prosperity is not in their hand; The counsel of the <u>wicked</u> is far from me.

- Job 36:6 "He does not keep the wicked alive, But gives justice to the afflicted.
- Job 36:17 "But you were full of judgment on the <u>wicked</u>; Judgment and justice take hold of you.
- Job 38:13 That it might take hold of the ends of the earth, And the <u>wicked</u> be shaken out of it?
- Job 38:15 "From the <u>wicked</u> their light is withheld, And the uplifted arm is broken.
- Job 40:12 "Look on everyone who is proud, *and* humble him, And tread down the <u>wicked</u> where they stand.
- Psalms 1:1 How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the <u>wicked</u>, Nor stand in the path of sinners, Nor sit in the seat of scoffers!
- Psalms 1:4 The <u>wicked</u> are not so, But they are like chaff which the wind drives away.

- Psalms 7:9 O let the evil of the <u>wicked</u> come to an end, but establish the righteous; For the righteous God tries the hearts and minds.
- Psalms 7:14 Behold, he travails with <u>wickedness</u>, And he conceives mischief and brings forth falsehood.
- Psalms 9:5 You have rebuked the nations, You have destroyed the <u>wicked</u>; You have blotted out their name forever and ever.
- Psalms 9:16 The LORD has made Himself known; He has executed judgment. In the work of his own hands the <u>wicked</u> is snared. Higgaion Selah.
- Psalms 9:17 The wicked will return to Sheol, Even all the nations who forget God.
- Psalms 10:2 In pride the <u>wicked</u> hotly pursue the afflicted; Let them be caught in the plots which they have devised.
- Psalms 10:3 For the <u>wicked</u> boasts of his heart's desire, And the greedy man curses *and* spurns the LORD.

- Psalms 10:15 Break the arm of the <u>wicked</u> and the evildoer, Seek out his <u>wickedness</u> until You find none.
- Psalms 11:2 For, behold, the <u>wicked</u> bend the bow, They make ready their arrow upon the string To shoot in darkness at the upright in heart.
- Psalms 11:5 The LORD tests the righteous and the <u>wicked</u>, And the one who loves violence His soul hates.
- Psalms 11:6 Upon the <u>wicked</u> He will rain snares; Fire and brimstone and burning wind will be the portion of their cup.
- Psalms 12:8 The <u>wicked</u> strut about on every side When vileness is exalted among the sons of men.
- Psalms 14:4 Do all the workers of <u>wickedness</u> not know, Who eat up my people as they eat bread, *And* do not call upon the Lord?
- Psalms 17:9 From the <u>wicked</u> who despoil me, My deadly enemies who surround me.
- Psalms 17:13 Arise, O LORD, confront him, bring him low; Deliver my soul from the <u>wicked</u> with Your sword,

- Psalms 26:5 I hate the assembly of evildoers, And I will not sit with the wicked.

- Psalms 37:17 For the arms of the <u>wicked</u> will be broken, But the LORD sustains the righteous.
- Psalms 37:20 But the <u>wicked</u> will perish; And the enemies of the LORD will be like the glory of the pastures, They vanish—like smoke they vanish away.
- Psalms 37:21 The <u>wicked</u> borrows and does not pay back, But the righteous is gracious and gives.
- Psalms 37:28 For the LORD loves justice And does not forsake His godly ones; They are preserved forever, But the descendants of the <u>wicked</u> will be cut off.
- Psalms 37:32 The <u>wicked</u> spies upon the righteous And seeks to kill him.
- Psalms 37:34 Wait for the LORD and keep His way, And He will exalt you to inherit the land; When the <u>wicked</u> are cut off, you will see it.
- Psalms 37:35 I have seen a <u>wicked</u>, violent man Spreading himself like a luxuriant tree in its native soil.
- Psalms 37:38 But transgressors will be altogether destroyed; The posterity of the <u>wicked</u> will be cut off.
- Psalms 37:40 The LORD helps them and delivers them; He delivers them from the wicked and saves them, Because they take refuge in Him.
- Psalms 39:1 <<For the choir director, for Jeduthun. A Psalm of David.>> I said, "I will guard my ways That I may not sin with my tongue; I will guard my mouth as with a muzzle While the <u>wicked</u> are in my presence."
- Psalms 41:6 And when he comes to see *me*, he speaks falsehood; His heart gathers <u>wickedness</u> to itself; When he goes outside, he tells it.
- Psalms 41:8 "A <u>wicked</u> thing is poured out upon him, That when he lies down, he will not rise up again."
- Psalms 45:7 You have loved righteousness and hated <u>wickedness</u>; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of joy above Your fellows.

- Psalms 50:16 But to the <u>wicked</u> God says, "What right have you to tell of My statutes And to take My covenant in your mouth?
- Psalms 53:4 Have the workers of <u>wickedness</u> no knowledge, Who eat up My people as *though* they ate bread And have not called upon God?
- Psalms 55:3 Because of the voice of the enemy, Because of the pressure of the <u>wicked</u>; For they bring down trouble upon me And in anger they bear a grudge against me.
- Psalms 56:7 Because of <u>wickedness</u>, cast them forth, In anger put down the peoples, O God!
- Psalms 58:3 The <u>wicked</u> are estranged from the womb; These who speak lies go astray from birth.
- Psalms 58:10 The righteous will rejoice when he sees the vengeance; He will wash his feet in the blood of the <u>wicked</u>.

Psalms 66:18 If I regard <u>wickedness</u> in my heart, The Lord will not hear;

- Psalms 68:2 As smoke is driven away, so drive them away; As wax melts before the fire, So let the <u>wicked</u> perish before God.
- Psalms 71:4 Rescue me, O my God, out of the hand of the <u>wicked</u>, Out of the grasp of the wrongdoer and ruthless man,
- Psalms 73:3 For I was envious of the arrogant As I saw the prosperity of the wicked.
- Psalms 73:8 They mock and <u>wickedly</u> speak of oppression; They speak from on high.
- Psalms 73:12 Behold, these are the <u>wicked</u>; And always at ease, they have increased *in* wealth.
- Psalms 75:4 "I said to the boastful, 'Do not boast,' And to the <u>wicked</u>, 'Do not lift up the horn;
- Psalms 75:8 For a cup is in the hand of the LORD, and the wine foams; It is well mixed, and He pours out of this; Surely all the <u>wicked</u> of the earth must drain *and* drink down its dregs.
- Psalms 75:10 And all the horns of the <u>wicked</u> He will cut off, *But* the horns of the righteous will be lifted up.
- Psalms 82:2 How long will you judge unjustly And show partiality to the wicked? Selah.

Psalms 82:4 Rescue the weak and needy; Deliver them out of the hand of the wicked.

Psalms 84:10 For a day in Your courts is better than a thousand *outside*. I would rather stand at the threshold of the house of my God Than dwell in the tents of <u>wickedness</u>.

Psalms 89:22 "The enemy will not deceive him, Nor the son of wickedness afflict him.

Psalms 91:8 You will only look on with your eyes And see the recompense of the <u>wicked</u>.

Psalms 92:7 That when the <u>wicked</u> sprouted up like grass And all who did iniquity flourished, It *was only* that they might be destroyed forevermore.

Psalms 94:3 How long shall the wicked, O LORD, How long shall the wicked exult?

Psalms 94:4 They pour forth *words,* they speak arrogantly; All who do <u>wickedness</u> vaunt themselves.

Psalms 94:13 That You may grant him relief from the days of adversity, Until a pit is dug for the <u>wicked</u>.

Psalms 94:16 Who will stand up for me against evildoers? Who will take his stand for me against those who do <u>wickedness</u>?

- Psalms 94:23 He has brought back their <u>wickedness</u> upon them And will destroy them in their evil; The LORD our God will destroy them.
- Psalms 97:10 Hate evil, you who love the LORD, Who preserves the souls of His godly ones; He delivers them from the hand of the <u>wicked</u>.
- Psalms 101:8 Every morning I will destroy all the <u>wicked</u> of the land, So as to cut off from the city of the LORD all those who do iniquity.
- Psalms 104:35 Let sinners be consumed from the earth And let the <u>wicked</u> be no more. Bless the LORD, O my soul. Praise the LORD!
- Psalms 106:6 We have sinned like our fathers, We have committed iniquity, we have behaved <u>wickedly</u>.
- Psalms 106:18 And a fire blazed up in their company; The flame consumed the wicked.
- Psalms 107:34 A fruitful land into a salt waste, Because of the <u>wickedness</u> of those who dwell in it.
- Psalms 109:2 For they have opened the <u>wicked</u> and deceitful mouth against me; They have spoken against me with a lying tongue.
- Psalms 109:6 Appoint a <u>wicked</u> man over him, And let an accuser stand at his right hand.
- Psalms 112:10 The <u>wicked</u> will see it and be vexed, He will gnash his teeth and melt away; The desire of the <u>wicked</u> will perish.
- Psalms 119:53 Burning indignation has seized me because of the <u>wicked</u>, Who forsake Your law.
- Psalms 119:61 The cords of the <u>wicked</u> have encircled me, *But* I have not forgotten Your law.
- Psalms 119:95 The <u>wicked</u> wait for me to destroy me; I shall diligently consider Your testimonies.
- Psalms 119:110 The <u>wicked</u> have laid a snare for me, Yet I have not gone astray from Your precepts.
- Psalms 119:119 You have removed all the <u>wicked</u> of the earth *like* dross; Therefore I love Your testimonies.
- Psalms 119:150 Those who follow after <u>wickedness</u> draw near; They are far from Your law.
- Psalms 119:155 Salvation is far from the <u>wicked</u>, For they do not seek Your statutes.
- Psalms 125:3 For the scepter of <u>wickedness</u> shall not rest upon the land of the righteous, So that the righteous will not put forth their hands to do wrong.
- Psalms 129:4 The LORD is righteous; He has cut in two the cords of the wicked.
- Psalms 139:19 O that You would slay the <u>wicked</u>, O God; Depart from me, therefore, men of bloodshed.
- Psalms 139:20 For they speak against You <u>wickedly</u>, And Your enemies take Your name in vain.
- Psalms 140:4 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the <u>wicked</u>; Preserve me from violent men Who have purposed to trip up my feet.
- Psalms 140:8 "Do not grant, O LORD, the desires of the <u>wicked</u>; Do not promote his *evil* device, *that* they *not* be exalted. Selah.
- Psalms 141:4 Do not incline my heart to any evil thing, To practice deeds of <u>wickedness</u> With men who do iniquity; And do not let me eat of their delicacies.

Psalms 141:5 Let the righteous smite me in kindness and reprove me; It is oil upon the head; Do not let my head refuse it, For still my prayer is against their <u>wicked</u> deeds.

Psalms 141:10 Let the <u>wicked</u> fall into their own nets, While I pass by safely.

Psalms 145:20 The LORD keeps all who love Him, But all the <u>wicked</u> He will destroy.

Psalms 146:9 The LORD protects the strangers; He supports the fatherless and the widow, But He thwarts the way of the <u>wicked</u>.

- Psalms 147:6 The LORD supports the afflicted; He brings down the <u>wicked</u> to the ground.
- Proverbs 2:22 But the <u>wicked</u> will be cut off from the land And the treacherous will be uprooted from it.
- Proverbs 3:25 Do not be afraid of sudden fear Nor of the onslaught of the <u>wicked</u> when it comes;
- Proverbs 3:33 The curse of the LORD is on the house of the <u>wicked</u>, But He blesses the dwelling of the righteous.
- Proverbs 4:14 Do not enter the path of the <u>wicked</u> And do not proceed in the way of evil men.
- Proverbs 4:17 For they eat the bread of wickedness And drink the wine of violence.
- Proverbs 4:19 The way of the <u>wicked</u> is like darkness; They do not know over what they stumble.
- Proverbs 5:22 His own iniquities will capture the <u>wicked</u>, And he will be held with the cords of his sin.
- Proverbs 6:12 A worthless person, a <u>wicked</u> man, Is the one who walks with a perverse mouth,
- Proverbs 6:18 A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that run rapidly to evil,
- Proverbs 8:7 "For my mouth will utter truth; And <u>wickedness</u> is an abomination to my lips.
- Proverbs 9:7 He who corrects a scoffer gets dishonor for himself, And he who reproves a <u>wicked</u> man *gets* insults for himself.
- Proverbs 10:3 The LORD will not allow the righteous to hunger, But He will reject the craving of the <u>wicked</u>.
- Proverbs 10:6 Blessings are on the head of the righteous, But the mouth of the <u>wicked</u> conceals violence.
- Proverbs 10:7 The memory of the righteous is blessed, But the name of the <u>wicked</u> will rot.
- Proverbs 10:11 The mouth of the righteous is a fountain of life, But the mouth of the <u>wicked</u> conceals violence.
- Proverbs 10:16 The wages of the righteous is life, The income of the <u>wicked</u>, punishment.
- Proverbs 10:20 The tongue of the righteous is *as* choice silver, The heart of the <u>wicked</u> is *worth* little.
- Proverbs 10:23 Doing <u>wickedness</u> is like sport to a fool, And *so is* wisdom to a man of understanding.
- Proverbs 10:24 What the <u>wicked</u> fears will come upon him, But the desire of the righteous will be granted.
- Proverbs 10:25 When the whirlwind passes, the <u>wicked</u> is no more, But the righteous *has* an everlasting foundation.

- Proverbs 10:27 The fear of the LORD prolongs life, But the years of the <u>wicked</u> will be shortened.
- Proverbs 10:28 The hope of the righteous is gladness, But the expectation of the <u>wicked</u> perishes.
- Proverbs 10:30 The righteous will never be shaken, But the <u>wicked</u> will not dwell in the land.
- Proverbs 10:32 The lips of the righteous bring forth what is acceptable, But the mouth of the <u>wicked</u> what is perverted.
- Proverbs 11:5 The righteousness of the blameless will smooth his way, But the <u>wicked</u> will fall by his own <u>wickedness</u>.
- Proverbs 11:7 When a <u>wicked</u> man dies, *his* expectation will perish, And the hope of strong men perishes.
- Proverbs 11:8 The righteous is delivered from trouble, But the <u>wicked</u> takes his place.
- Proverbs 11:10 When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices, And when the wicked perish, there is joyful shouting.
- Proverbs 11:11 By the blessing of the upright a city is exalted, But by the mouth of the wicked it is torn down.
- Proverbs 11:18 The <u>wicked</u> earns deceptive wages, But he who sows righteousness *gets* a true reward.
- Proverbs 11:23 The desire of the righteous is only good, *But* the expectation of the <u>wicked</u> is wrath.
- Proverbs 11:31 If the righteous will be rewarded in the earth, How much more the wicked and the sinner!
- Proverbs 12:3 A man will not be established by <u>wickedness</u>, But the root of the righteous will not be moved.
- Proverbs 12:5 The thoughts of the righteous are just, *But* the counsels of the <u>wicked</u> are deceitful.
- Proverbs 12:6 The words of the <u>wicked</u> lie in wait for blood, But the mouth of the upright will deliver them.
- Proverbs 12:7 The <u>wicked</u> are overthrown and are no more, But the house of the righteous will stand.
- Proverbs 12:10 A righteous man has regard for the life of his animal, But *even* the compassion of the <u>wicked</u> is cruel.
- Proverbs 12:12 The wicked man desires the booty of evil men, But the root of the righteous yields *fruit.*
- Proverbs 12:21 No harm befalls the righteous, But the wicked are filled with trouble.
- Proverbs 12:26 The righteous is a guide to his neighbor, But the way of the <u>wicked</u> leads them astray.
- Proverbs 13:5 A righteous man hates falsehood, But a <u>wicked</u> man acts disgustingly and shamefully.
- Proverbs 13:6 Righteousness guards the one whose way is blameless, But <u>wickedness</u> subverts the sinner.
- Proverbs 13:9 The light of the righteous rejoices, But the lamp of the <u>wicked</u> goes out.
- Proverbs 13:17 A <u>wicked</u> messenger falls into adversity, But a faithful envoy *brings* healing.

- Proverbs 13:25 The righteous has enough to satisfy his appetite, But the stomach of the <u>wicked</u> is in need.
- Proverbs 14:11 The house of the <u>wicked</u> will be destroyed, But the tent of the upright will flourish.
- Proverbs 14:19 The evil will bow down before the good, And the <u>wicked</u> at the gates of the righteous.
- Proverbs 14:32 The <u>wicked</u> is thrust down by his wrongdoing, But the righteous has a refuge when he dies.
- Proverbs 15:6 Great wealth is *in* the house of the righteous, But trouble is in the income of the <u>wicked</u>.
- Proverbs 15:8 The sacrifice of the <u>wicked</u> is an abomination to the LORD, But the prayer of the upright is His delight.
- Proverbs 15:9 The way of the <u>wicked</u> is an abomination to the LORD, But He loves one who pursues righteousness.
- Proverbs 15:28 The heart of the righteous ponders how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours out evil things.
- Proverbs 15:29 The LORD is far from the <u>wicked</u>, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.
- Proverbs 16:4 The LORD has made everything for its own purpose, Even the <u>wicked</u> for the day of evil.
- Proverbs 16:12 It is an abomination for kings to commit <u>wicked</u> acts, For a throne is established on righteousness.
- Proverbs 17:4 An evildoer listens to <u>wicked</u> lips; A liar pays attention to a destructive tongue.
- Proverbs 17:15 He who justifies the <u>wicked</u> and he who condemns the righteous, Both of them alike are an abomination to the LORD.
- Proverbs 17:23 A <u>wicked</u> man receives a bribe from the bosom To pervert the ways of justice.
- Proverbs 18:3 When a <u>wicked</u> man comes, contempt also comes, And with dishonor *comes* scorn.
- Proverbs 18:5 To show partiality to the <u>wicked</u> is not good, *Nor* to thrust aside the righteous in judgment.
- Proverbs 19:28 A rascally witness makes a mockery of justice, And the mouth of the <u>wicked</u> spreads iniquity.
- Proverbs 20:26 A wise king winnows the <u>wicked</u>, And drives the *threshing* wheel over them.
- Proverbs 21:4 Haughty eyes and a proud heart, The lamp of the wicked, is sin.
- Proverbs 21:7 The violence of the <u>wicked</u> will drag them away, Because they refuse to act with justice.
- Proverbs 21:10 The soul of the <u>wicked</u> desires evil; His neighbor finds no favor in his eyes.
- Proverbs 21:12 The righteous one considers the house of the <u>wicked</u>, Turning the <u>wicked</u> to ruin.
- Proverbs 21:18 The <u>wicked</u> is a ransom for the righteous, And the treacherous is in the place of the upright.

- Proverbs 21:27 The sacrifice of the <u>wicked</u> is an abomination, How much more when he brings it with evil intent!
- Proverbs 21:29 A <u>wicked</u> man displays a bold face, But as for the upright, he makes his way sure.
- Proverbs 24:15 Do not lie in wait, O <u>wicked</u> man, against the dwelling of the righteous; Do not destroy his resting place;
- Proverbs 24:16 For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again, But the <u>wicked</u> stumble in *time of* calamity.
- Proverbs 24:19 Do not fret because of evildoers Or be envious of the wicked;
- Proverbs 24:20 For there will be no future for the evil man; The lamp of the <u>wicked</u> will be put out.
- Proverbs 24:24 He who says to the <u>wicked</u>, "You are righteous," Peoples will curse him, nations will abhor him;
- Proverbs 24:25 But to those who rebuke the *wicked* will be delight, And a good blessing will come upon them.
- Proverbs 25:5 Take away the <u>wicked</u> before the king, And his throne will be established in righteousness.
- Proverbs 25:26 *Like* a trampled spring and a polluted well Is a righteous man who gives way before the <u>wicked</u>.
- Proverbs 26:23 *Like* an earthen vessel overlaid with silver dross Are burning lips and a <u>wicked</u> heart.
- Proverbs 26:26 *Though his* hatred covers itself with guile, His <u>wickedness</u> will be revealed before the assembly.
- Proverbs 28:1 The <u>wicked</u> flee when no one is pursuing, But the righteous are bold as a lion.
- Proverbs 28:4 Those who forsake the law praise the <u>wicked</u>, But those who keep the law strive with them.
- Proverbs 28:12 When the righteous triumph, there is great glory, But when the <u>wicked</u> rise, men hide themselves.
- Proverbs 28:15 *Like* a roaring lion and a rushing bear Is a <u>wicked</u> ruler over a poor people.
- Proverbs 28:28 When the <u>wicked</u> rise, men hide themselves; But when they perish, the righteous increase.
- Proverbs 29:2 When the righteous increase, the people rejoice, But when a <u>wicked</u> man rules, people groan.
- Proverbs 29:7 The righteous is concerned for the rights of the poor, The <u>wicked</u> does not understand *such* concern.
- Proverbs 29:12 If a ruler pays attention to falsehood, All his ministers become wicked.
- Proverbs 29:16 When the <u>wicked</u> increase, transgression increases; But the righteous will see their fall.
- Proverbs 29:27 An unjust man is abominable to the righteous, And he who is upright in the way is abominable to the <u>wicked</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 3:16 Furthermore, I have seen under the sun *that* in the place of justice there is <u>wickedness</u> and in the place of righteousness there is <u>wickedness</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 3:17 I said to myself, "God will judge both the righteous man and the <u>wicked</u> man," for a time for every matter and for every deed is there.

- Ecclesiastes 7:15 I have seen everything during my lifetime of futility; there is a righteous man who perishes in his righteousness and there is a <u>wicked</u> man who prolongs *his life* in his <u>wickedness</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 7:17 Do not be excessively <u>wicked</u> and do not be a fool. Why should you die before your time?
- Ecclesiastes 8:10 So then, I have seen the <u>wicked</u> buried, those who used to go in and out from the holy place, and they are *soon* forgotten in the city where they did thus. This too is futility.
- Ecclesiastes 8:14 There is futility which is done on the earth, that is, there are righteous men to whom it happens according to the deeds of the <u>wicked</u>. On the other hand, there are evil men to whom it happens according to the deeds of the righteous. I say that this too is futility.
- Ecclesiastes 9:2 It is the same for all. There is one fate for the righteous and for the <u>wicked</u>; for the good, for the clean and for the unclean; for the man who offers a sacrifice and for the one who does not sacrifice. As the good man is, so is the sinner; as the swearer is, so is the one who is afraid to swear.
- Ecclesiastes 10:13 the beginning of his talking is folly and the end of it is <u>wicked</u> madness.
- Isaiah 3:11 Woe to the <u>wicked</u>! *It will go* badly *with him,* For what he deserves will be done to him.
- Isaiah 5:23 Who justify the <u>wicked</u> for a bribe, And take away the rights of the ones who are in the right!
- Isaiah 9:18 For <u>wickedness</u> burns like a fire; It consumes briars and thorns; It even sets the thickets of the forest aflame And they roll upward in a column of smoke.
- Isaiah 11:4 But with righteousness He will judge the poor, And decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth; And He will strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He will slay the <u>wicked</u>.
- Isaiah 13:11 Thus I will punish the world for its evil And the <u>wicked</u> for their iniquity; I will also put an end to the arrogance of the proud And abase the haughtiness of the ruthless.
- Isaiah 14:5 "The LORD has broken the staff of the <u>wicked</u>, The scepter of rulers
- Isaiah 26:10 *Though* the <u>wicked</u> is shown favor, He does not learn righteousness; He deals unjustly in the land of uprightness, And does not perceive the majesty of the LORD.
- Isaiah 32:6 For a fool speaks nonsense, And his heart inclines toward <u>wickedness</u>: To practice ungodliness and to speak error against the LORD, To keep the hungry person unsatisfied And to withhold drink from the thirsty.
- Isaiah 32:7 As for a rogue, his weapons are evil; He devises <u>wicked</u> schemes To destroy *the* afflicted with slander, Even though *the* needy one speaks what is right.
- Isaiah 47:10 "You felt secure in your <u>wickedness</u> and said, 'No one sees me,' Your wisdom and your knowledge, they have deluded you; For you have said in your heart, 'I am, and there is no one besides me.'
- Isaiah 48:22 "There is no peace for the <u>wicked</u>," says the LORD.
- Isaiah 53:9 His grave was assigned with <u>wicked</u> men, Yet He was with a rich man in His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was there any deceit in His mouth.

- Isaiah 55:7 Let the <u>wicked</u> forsake his way And the unrighteous man his thoughts; And let him return to the LORD, And He will have compassion on him, And to our God, For He will abundantly pardon.
- Isaiah 57:20 But the <u>wicked</u> are like the tossing sea, For it cannot be quiet, And its waters toss up refuse and mud.
- Isaiah 57:21 "There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."
- Isaiah 58:4 "Behold, you fast for contention and strife and to strike with a <u>wicked</u> fist. You do not fast like *you do* today to make your voice heard on high.
- Isaiah 58:6 "Is this not the fast which I choose, To loosen the bonds of <u>wickedness</u>, To undo the bands of the yoke, And to let the oppressed go free And break every yoke?
- Isaiah 58:9 "Then you will call, and the LORD will answer; You will cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.' If you remove the yoke from your midst, The pointing of the finger and speaking <u>wickedness</u>,
- Isaiah 59:3 For your hands are defiled with blood And your fingers with iniquity; Your lips have spoken falsehood, Your tongue mutters <u>wickedness</u>.
- Jeremiah 1:16 "I will pronounce My judgments on them concerning all their <u>wickedness</u>, whereby they have forsaken Me and have offered sacrifices to other gods, and worshiped the works of their own hands.
- Jeremiah 2:19 "Your own <u>wickedness</u> will correct you, And your apostasies will reprove you; Know therefore and see that it is evil and bitter For you to forsake the LORD your God, And the dread of Me is not in you," declares the Lord GOD of hosts.
- Jeremiah 2:33 "How well you prepare your way To seek love! Therefore even the <u>wicked</u> women You have taught your ways.
- Jeremiah 3:2 "Lift up your eyes to the bare heights and see; Where have you not been violated? By the roads you have sat for them Like an Arab in the desert, And you have polluted a land With your harlotry and with your <u>wickedness</u>.
- Jeremiah 4:14 Wash your heart from evil, O Jerusalem, That you may be saved. How long will your <u>wicked</u> thoughts Lodge within you?
- Jeremiah 4:15 For a voice declares from Dan, And proclaims <u>wickedness</u> from Mount Ephraim.
- Jeremiah 5:26 'For <u>wicked</u> men are found among My people, They watch like fowlers lying in wait; They set a trap, They catch men.
- Jeremiah 5:28 'They are fat, they are sleek, They also excel in deeds of <u>wickedness</u>; They do not plead the cause, The cause of the orphan, that they may prosper; And they do not defend the rights of the poor.
- Jeremiah 6:7 "As a well keeps its waters fresh, So she keeps fresh her <u>wickedness</u>. Violence and destruction are heard in her; Sickness and wounds are ever before Me.
- Jeremiah 6:29 The bellows blow fiercely, The lead is consumed by the fire; In vain the refining goes on, But the <u>wicked</u> are not separated.
- Jeremiah 7:12 "But go now to My place which was in Shiloh, where I made My name dwell at the first, and see what I did to it because of the <u>wickedness</u> of My people Israel.
- Jeremiah 8:6 "I have listened and heard, They have spoken what is not right; No man repented of his <u>wickedness</u>, Saying, 'What have I done?' Everyone turned to his course, Like a horse charging into the battle.

- Jeremiah 12:1 Righteous are You, O LORD, that I would plead *my* case with You; Indeed I would discuss matters of justice with You: Why has the way of the <u>wicked</u> prospered? *Why* are all those who deal in treachery at ease?
- Jeremiah 12:4 How long is the land to mourn And the vegetation of the countryside to wither? For the <u>wickedness</u> of those who dwell in it, Animals and birds have been snatched away, Because *men* have said, "He will not see our latter ending."
- Jeremiah 12:14 Thus says the LORD concerning all My <u>wicked</u> neighbors who strike at the inheritance with which I have endowed My people Israel, "Behold I am about to uproot them from their land and will uproot the house of Judah from among them.
- Jeremiah 13:10 'This <u>wicked</u> people, who refuse to listen to My words, who walk in the stubbornness of their hearts and have gone after other gods to serve them and to bow down to them, let them be just like this waistband which is totally worthless.
- Jeremiah 14:16 "The people also to whom they are prophesying will be thrown out into the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword; and there will be no one to bury them—*neither* them, *nor* their wives, nor their sons, nor their daughters—for I will pour out their *own* wickedness on them.
- Jeremiah 14:20 We know our <u>wickedness</u>, O LORD, The iniquity of our fathers, for we have sinned against You.
- Jeremiah 15:21 "So I will deliver you from the hand of the <u>wicked</u>, And I will redeem you from the grasp of the violent."
- Jeremiah 22:22 "The wind will sweep away all your shepherds, And your lovers will go into captivity; Then you will surely be ashamed and humiliated Because of all your <u>wickedness</u>.
- Jeremiah 23:11 "For both prophet and priest are polluted; Even in My house I have found their <u>wickedness</u>," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 23:14 "Also among the prophets of Jerusalem I have seen a horrible thing: The committing of adultery and walking in falsehood; And they strengthen the hands of evildoers, So that no one has turned back from his <u>wickedness</u>. All of them have become to Me like Sodom, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.
- Jeremiah 23:19 "Behold, the storm of the LORD has gone forth in wrath, Even a whirling tempest; It will swirl down on the head of the <u>wicked</u>.
- Jeremiah 25:31 'A clamor has come to the end of the earth, Because the LORD has a controversy with the nations. He is entering into judgment with all flesh; As for the <u>wicked</u>, He has given them to the sword,' declares the LORD."
- Jeremiah 30:23 Behold, the tempest of the LORD! Wrath has gone forth, A sweeping tempest; It will burst on the head of the <u>wicked</u>.
- Jeremiah 33:5 'While *they* are coming to fight with the Chaldeans and to fill them with the corpses of men whom I have slain in My anger and in My wrath, and I have hidden My face from this city because of all their <u>wickedness</u>:
- Jeremiah 38:9 "My lord the king, these men have acted <u>wickedly</u> in all that they have done to Jeremiah the prophet whom they have cast into the cistern; and he will die right where he is because of the famine, for there is no more bread in the city."
- Jeremiah 44:3 because of their <u>wickedness</u> which they committed so as to provoke Me to anger by continuing to burn sacrifices *and* to serve other gods whom they had not known, *neither* they, you, nor your fathers.

- Jeremiah 44:5 'But they did not listen or incline their ears to turn from their <u>wickedness</u>, so as not to burn sacrifices to other gods.
- Jeremiah 44:9 "Have you forgotten the <u>wickedness</u> of your fathers, the <u>wickedness</u> of the kings of Judah, and the <u>wickedness</u> of their wives, your own <u>wickedness</u>, and the <u>wickedness</u> of your wives, which they committed in the land of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?
- Lamentations 1:22 "Let all their <u>wickedness</u> come before You; And deal with them as You have dealt with me For all my transgressions; For my groans are many and my heart is faint."
- Ezekiel 3:18 "When I say to the <u>wicked</u>, 'You will surely die,' and you do not warn him or speak out to warn the <u>wicked</u> from his <u>wicked</u> way that he may live, that <u>wicked</u> man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood I will require at your hand.
- Ezekiel 3:19 "Yet if you have warned the <u>wicked</u> and he does not turn from his <u>wickedness</u> or from his <u>wicked</u> way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered yourself.
- Ezekiel 5:6 'But she has rebelled against My ordinances more <u>wickedly</u> than the nations and against My statutes more than the lands which surround her; for they have rejected My ordinances and have not walked in My statutes.'
- Ezekiel 7:11 'Violence has grown into a rod of <u>wickedness</u>. None of them *shall remain,* none of their people, none of their wealth, nor anything eminent among them.
- Ezekiel 7:21 'I will give it into the hands of the foreigners as plunder and to the <u>wicked</u> of the earth as spoil, and they will profane it.
- Ezekiel 8:9 And He said to me, "Go in and see the <u>wicked</u> abominations that they are committing here."
- Ezekiel 13:22 "Because you disheartened the righteous with falsehood when I did not cause him grief, but have encouraged the <u>wicked</u> not to turn from his <u>wicked</u> way *and* preserve his life,
- Ezekiel 16:23 "Then it came about after all your <u>wickedness</u> ('Woe, woe to you!' declares the Lord GOD),
- Ezekiel 16:57 before your <u>wickedness</u> was uncovered, so now you have become the reproach of the daughters of Edom and of all who are around her, of the daughters of the Philistines—those surrounding *you* who despise you.
- Ezekiel 18:20 "The person who sins will die. The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son's iniquity; the righteousness of the righteous will be upon himself, and the <u>wickedness</u> of the <u>wicked</u> will be upon himself.
- Ezekiel 18:21 "But if the <u>wicked</u> man turns from all his sins which he has committed and observes all My statutes and practices justice and righteousness, he shall surely live; he shall not die.
- Ezekiel 18:23 "Do I have any pleasure in the death of the <u>wicked</u>," declares the Lord GOD, "rather than that he should turn from his ways and live?
- Ezekiel 18:24 "But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness, commits iniquity and does according to all the abominations that a <u>wicked</u> man does, will he live? All his righteous deeds which he has done will not be remembered for his treachery which he has committed and his sin which he has committed; for them he will die.

- Ezekiel 18:27 "Again, when a <u>wicked</u> man turns away from his <u>wickedness</u> which he has committed and practices justice and righteousness, he will save his life.
- Ezekiel 21:3 and say to the land of Israel, 'Thus says the LORD, "Behold, I am against you; and I will draw My sword out of its sheath and cut off from you the righteous and the <u>wicked</u>.
- Ezekiel 21:4 "Because I will cut off from you the righteous and the <u>wicked</u>, therefore My sword will go forth from its sheath against all flesh from south *to* north.
- Ezekiel 21:25 'And you, O slain, <u>wicked</u> one, the prince of Israel, whose day has come, in the time of the punishment of the end,'
- Ezekiel 21:29 while they see for you false visions, while they divine lies for you—to place you on the necks of the <u>wicked</u> who are slain, whose day has come, in the time of the punishment of the end.
- Ezekiel 31:11 therefore I will give it into the hand of a despot of the nations; he will thoroughly deal with it. According to its <u>wickedness</u> I have driven it away.
- Ezekiel 33:8 "When I say to the <u>wicked</u>, 'O <u>wicked</u> man, you will surely die,' and you do not speak to warn the <u>wicked</u> from his way, that <u>wicked</u> man shall die in his iniquity, but his blood I will require from your hand.
- Ezekiel 33:9 "But if you on your part warn a <u>wicked</u> man to turn from his way and he does not turn from his way, he will die in his iniquity, but you have delivered your life.
- Ezekiel 33:11 "Say to them, 'As I live!' declares the Lord GOD, 'I take no pleasure in the death of the <u>wicked</u>, but rather that the <u>wicked</u> turn from his way and live. Turn back, turn back from your evil ways! Why then will you die, O house of Israel?'
- Ezekiel 33:12 "And you, son of man, say to your fellow citizens, 'The righteousness of a righteous man will not deliver him in the day of his transgression, and as for the <u>wickedness</u> of the <u>wicked</u>, he will not stumble because of it in the day when he turns from his <u>wickedness</u>; whereas a righteous man will not be able to live by his righteousness on the day when he commits sin.'
- Ezekiel 33:14 "But when I say to the <u>wicked</u>, 'You will surely die,' and he turns from his sin and practices justice and righteousness,
- Ezekiel 33:15 *if a* <u>wicked</u> man restores a pledge, pays back what he has taken by robbery, walks by the statutes which ensure life without committing iniquity, he shall surely live; he shall not die.
- Ezekiel 33:19 "But when the <u>wicked</u> turns from his <u>wickedness</u> and practices justice and righteousness, he will live by them.
- Daniel 9:5 we have sinned, committed iniquity, acted <u>wickedly</u> and rebelled, even turning aside from Your commandments and ordinances.
- Daniel 9:15 "And now, O Lord our God, who have brought Your people out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand and have made a name for Yourself, as it is this day—we have sinned, we have been <u>wicked</u>.
- Daniel 11:32 "By smooth *words* he will turn to godlessness those who act <u>wickedly</u> toward the covenant, but the people who know their God will display strength and take action.
- Daniel 12:10 "Many will be purged, purified and refined, but the <u>wicked</u> will act <u>wickedly</u>; and none of the <u>wicked</u> will understand, but those who have insight will understand.

- Hosea 7:2 And they do not consider in their hearts That I remember all their <u>wickedness</u>. Now their deeds are all around them; They are before My face.
- Hosea 7:3 With their <u>wickedness</u> they make the king glad, And the princes with their lies.
- Hosea 9:15 All their evil is at Gilgal; Indeed, I came to hate them there! Because of the <u>wickedness</u> of their deeds I will drive them out of My house! I will love them no more; All their princes are rebels.
- Hosea 10:13 You have plowed <u>wickedness</u>, you have reaped injustice, You have eaten the fruit of lies. Because you have trusted in your way, in your numerous warriors,
- Hosea 10:15 Thus it will be done to you at Bethel because of your great <u>wickedness</u>. At dawn the king of Israel will be completely cut off.
- Joel 3:13 Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, tread, for the wine press is full; The vats overflow, for their <u>wickedness</u> is great.
- Jonah 1:2 "Arise, go to Nineveh the great city and cry against it, for their <u>wickedness</u> has come up before Me."
- Jonah 3:8 "But both man and beast must be covered with sackcloth; and let men call on God earnestly that each may turn from his <u>wicked</u> way and from the violence which is in his hands.
- Jonah 3:10 When God saw their deeds, that they turned from their <u>wicked</u> way, then God relented concerning the calamity which He had declared He would bring upon them. And He did not do *it*.
- Micah 6:10 "Is there yet a man in the <u>wicked</u> house, *Along with* treasures of <u>wickedness</u> And a short measure *that is* cursed?
- Micah 6:11 "Can I justify wicked scales And a bag of deceptive weights?
- Nahum 1:11 From you has gone forth One who plotted evil against the LORD, A wicked counselor.
- Nahum 1:15 Behold, on the mountains the feet of him who brings good news, Who announces peace! Celebrate your feasts, O Judah; Pay your vows. For never again will the <u>wicked</u> one pass through you; He is cut off completely.
- Habakkuk 1:3 Why do You make me see iniquity, And cause *me* to look on <u>wickedness</u>? Yes, destruction and violence are before me; Strife exists and contention arises.
- Habakkuk 1:4 Therefore the law is ignored And justice is never upheld. For the <u>wicked</u> surround the righteous; Therefore justice comes out perverted.
- Habakkuk 1:13 Your eyes are too pure to approve evil, And You can not look on wickedness with favor. Why do You look with favor On those who deal treacherously? Why are You silent when the wicked swallow up Those more righteous than they?
- Zephaniah 1:3 "I will remove man and beast; I will remove the birds of the sky And the fish of the sea, And the ruins along with the <u>wicked</u>; And I will cut off man from the face of the earth," declares the LORD.
- Zechariah 5:8 Then he said, "This is <u>Wickedness</u>!" And he threw her down into the middle of the ephah and cast the lead weight on its opening.
- Malachi 1:4 Though Edom says, "We have been beaten down, but we will return and build up the ruins"; thus says the LORD of hosts, "They may build, but I will tear

down; and *men* will call them the <u>wicked</u> territory, and the people toward whom the LORD is indignant forever."

- Malachi 3:15 'So now we call the arrogant blessed; not only are the doers of wickedness built up but they also test God and escape.'"
- Malachi 3:18 So you will again distinguish between the righteous and the <u>wicked</u>, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him.
- Malachi 4:3 "You will tread down the <u>wicked</u>, for they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day which I am preparing," says the LORD of hosts.
