Gospel Account

Matthew 10:23

When you are persecuted in one place, flee to another. I tell you the truth, you will not finish going through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes.

Matt 16:27-28

- 27 "For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.
- 28 "Assuredly, I say to you, there are some standing here who shall not taste death till they see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom."

Matt 24:3

- 37 "But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

Matt 24:39

- 42 "Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.
- 43 But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up.
- 44 "Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.
- 46 Blessed [is] that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.
- 48 "But if that evil servant says in his heart, 'My master is delaying his coming,'

Parable Accounts

Matthew 22:3-15 Speaks to the first coming of Jesus, not the second He sent his servants to those who had been invited to the banquet to tell them to come, but they refused to come.

Matt 25:1-13

- 1 "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom.
- 2 "Now five of them were wise, and five were foolish.
- 3 "Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them,
- 4 "but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.
- 5 "But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept.
- 6 "And at midnight a cry was heard: 'Behold, the bridegroom is coming; go out to meet him!'
- 7 "Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps.
- 8 "And the foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.'
- 9 "But the wise answered, saying, 'No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.'

- 10 "And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut.
- 11 "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!'
- 12 "But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.'
- 13 "Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming. (NKJ)

Matt 25:14-46

- 14 "For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them.
- 15 "And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey.
- 16 "Then he who had received the five talents went and traded with them, and made another five talents.
- 17 "And likewise he who had received two gained two more also.
- 18 "But he who had received one went and dug in the ground, and hid his lord's money.
- 19 "After a long time the lord of those servants came and settled accounts with them.
- 20 "So he who had received five talents came and brought five other talents, saying, 'Lord, you delivered to me five talents; look, I have gained five more talents besides them.'
- 21 "His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'
- 22 "He also who had received two talents came and said, 'Lord, you delivered to me two talents; look, I have gained two more talents besides them.'
- 23 "His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'
- 24 "Then he who had received the one talent came and said, 'Lord, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you have not sown, and gathering where you have not scattered seed.
- 25 'And I was afraid, and went and hid your talent in the ground. Look, there you have what is yours.'
- 26 "But his lord answered and said to him, 'You wicked and lazy servant, you knew that I reap where I have not sown, and gather where I have not scattered seed.
- 27 'So you ought to have deposited my money with the bankers, and at my coming I would have received back my own with interest.
- 28 'Therefore take the talent from him, and give it to him who has ten talents.
- 29 'For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away.
- 30 'And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'
- 31 "When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.

- 32 "All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats.
- 33 "And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left.
- 34 "Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:
- 35 'for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in;
- 36 'I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.'
- 37 "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink?
- 38 'When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You?
- 39 'Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?'
- 40 "And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.'
- 41 "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels:
- 42 'for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink;
- 43 'I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.'
- 44 "Then they also will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?'
- 45 "Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.'
- 46 "And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life." (NKJ)

Mark 12:9

"What then will the owner of the vineyard do? He will come and kill those tenants and give the vineyard to others.

Mark 13:32-37

- 32 "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.
- 33 "Take heed, watch and pray; for you do not know when the time is.
- 34 "It is like a man going to a far country, who left his house and gave authority to his servants, and to each his work, and commanded the doorkeeper to watch.
- 35 "Watch therefore, for you do not know when the master of the house is coming-in the evening, at midnight, at the crowing of the rooster, or in the morning--
- 36 "lest, coming suddenly, he find you sleeping.
- 37 "And what I say to you, I say to all: Watch!" (NKJ)

Luke 12:35-49

35 "Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning;

- 36 "and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately.
- 37 "Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them.
- 38 "And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants.
- 39 "But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into.
- 40 "Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."
- 41 Then Peter said to Him, "Lord, do You speak this parable only to us, or to all people?"
- 42 And the Lord said, "Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season?
- 43 "Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes.
- 44 "Truly, I say to you that he will make him ruler over all that he has.
- 45 "But if that servant says in his heart, 'My master is delaying his coming,' and begins to beat the male and female servants, and to eat and drink and be drunk,
- 46 "the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.
- 47 "And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.
- 48 "But he who did not know, yet committed things deserving of stripes, shall be beaten with few. For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more.
- 49 "I came to send fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!

Luke 13:6-9

- 6 He also spoke this parable: "A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none.
- 7 "Then he said to the keeper of his vineyard, 'Look, for three years I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree and find none. Cut it down; why does it use up the ground?'
- 8 "But he answered and said to him, 'Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and fertilize it.
- 9 'And if it bears fruit, well. But if not, after that you can cut it down.' " (NKJ)

Luke 14:12-24

12 Then He also said to him who invited Him, "When you give a dinner or a supper, do not ask your friends, your brothers, your relatives, nor rich neighbors, lest they also invite you back, and you be repaid.

- 13 "But when you give a feast, invite the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind.
- 14 "And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just."
- 15 Now when one of those who sat at the table with Him heard these things, he said to Him, "Blessed is he who shall eat bread in the kingdom of God!"
- 16 Then He said to him, "A certain man gave a great supper and invited many,
- 17 "and sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, 'Come, for all things are now ready.'
- 18 "But they all with one accord began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a piece of ground, and I must go and see it. I ask you to have me excused.'
- 19 "And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I am going to test them. I ask you to have me excused.'
- 20 "Still another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.'
- 21 "So that servant came and reported these things to his master. Then the master of the house, being angry, said to his servant, 'Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in here the poor and the maimed and the lame and the blind.'
- 22 "And the servant said, 'Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.'
- 23 "Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.
- 24 'For I say to you that none of those men who were invited shall taste my supper.'" (NKJ)

Luke 19:11-28

- 11 Now as they heard these things, He spoke another parable, because He was near Jerusalem and because they thought the kingdom of God would appear immediately.
- 12 Therefore He said: "A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom and to return.
- 13 "So he called ten of his servants, delivered to them ten minas, and said to them, 'Do business till I come.'
- 14 "But his citizens hated him, and sent a delegation after him, saying, 'We will not have this man to reign over us.'
- 15 "And so it was that when he returned, having received the kingdom, he then commanded these servants, to whom he had given the money, to be called to him, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading.
- 16 "Then came the first, saying, 'Master, your mina has earned ten minas.'
- 17 "And he said to him, 'Well done, good servant; because you were faithful in a very little, have authority over ten cities.'
- 18 "And the second came, saying, 'Master, your mina has earned five minas.'
- 19 "Likewise he said to him, 'You also be over five cities.'
- 20 "Then another came, saying, 'Master, here is your mina, which I have kept put away in a handkerchief.

- 21 'For I feared you, because you are an austere man. You collect what you did not deposit, and reap what you did not sow.'
- 22 "And he said to him, 'Out of your own mouth I will judge you, you wicked servant. You knew that I was an austere man, collecting what I did not deposit and reaping what I did not sow.
- 23 'Why then did you not put my money in the bank, that at my coming I might have collected it with interest?'
- 24 "And he said to those who stood by, 'Take the mina from him, and give it to him who has ten minas.'
- 25 ("But they said to him, 'Master, he has ten minas.')
- 26 'For I say to you, that to everyone who has will be given; and from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him.
- 27 'But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay them before me.'"
- 28 When He had said this, He went on ahead, going up to Jerusalem. (NKJ)

Luke 21:6-28

- 6 "These things which you see-- the days will come in which not one stone shall be left upon another that shall not be thrown down."
- 7 So they asked Him, saying, "Teacher, but when will these things be? And what sign will there be when these things are about to take place?"
- 8 And He said: "Take heed that you not be deceived. For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am He,' and, 'The time has drawn near.' Therefore do not go after them.
- 9 "But when you hear of wars and commotions, do not be terrified; for these things must come to pass first, but the end will not come immediately."
- 10 Then He said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom.
- 11 "And there will be great earthquakes in various places, and famines and pestilences; and there will be fearful sights and great signs from heaven.
- 12 "But before all these things, they will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons. You will be brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake.
- 13 "But it will turn out for you as an occasion for testimony.
- 14 "Therefore settle it in your hearts not to meditate beforehand on what you will answer;
- 15 "for I will give you a mouth and wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist.
- 16 "You will be betrayed even by parents and brothers, relatives and friends; and they will put some of you to death.
- 17 "And you will be hated by all for My name's sake.
- 18 "But not a hair of your head shall be lost.
- 19 "By your patience possess your souls.
- 20 "But when you see Jerusalem surrounded by armies, then know that its desolation is near.

- 21 "Then let those in Judea flee to the mountains, let those who are in the midst of her depart, and let not those who are in the country enter her.
- 22 "For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.
- 23 "But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people.
- 24 "And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.
- 25 "And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring;
- 26 "men's hearts failing them from fear and the expectation of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of heaven will be shaken.
- 27 "Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory.
- 28 "Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near." (NKJ)

Luke 21:29-31

- 29 Then He spoke to them a parable: "Look at the fig tree, and all the trees.
- 30 "When they are already budding, you see and know for yourselves that summer is now near.
- 31 "So you also, when you see these things happening, know that the kingdom of God is near.
- 32 "Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all things take place.
- 33 "Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.
- 34 "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly.
- 35 "For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth.
- 36 "Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." (NKJ)

13 Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

"That Day" and the White Throne Judgment

The following scripture refer to the Great White Throne Judgment of the Lord that occurs after the Millenium. This does not speak to the Second Coming of Jesus which happens before the Millenium.

Matt 7:22

"Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?'

Luke 10:12 "But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city.

Events surrounding the Great White Throne Judgment.

This happens after the Millenium, after the final rebellion of Satan.

Rev 20:7-21:5

- 7 Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison
- 8 and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea.
- 9 They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.
- 10 The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
- 11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them.

- 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.
- 13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.
- 14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- 15 And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

CHAPTER 21

- 1 Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea.
- 2 Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
- 3 And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.
- 4 "And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."
- 5 Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."
