Titus 2:13

Looking for that blessed hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

There is no scriptural foundation to suppose that the blessed hope is the rapture and the glorious coming is the second advent of our Lord. This is a shameless treatment of scripture as the following exegesis will demonstrate.

1680 elpis (el-pece');

from a primary elpo (to anticipate, ususally with pleasure); expectation (abstractly or concretely) or confidence: KJV-- faith, hope.

Acts 2:26

Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>:

Acts 16:19

And when her masters saw that the hope $\leq 1680 \text{ elpis} >$ of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew *them* into the marketplace unto the rulers,

Acts 23:6

But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men *and* brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

Acts 24:15

And have hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Acts 26:6

And now I stand and am judged for the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of the promise made of God unto our fathers:

Acts 26:7

Unto which *promise* our twelve tribes, instantly serving *God* day and night, hope to come. For which hope's sake <<u>1680 elpis></u>, king Agrippa, I am accused of the Jews.

Acts 27:20

And when neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on *us*, all hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> that we should be saved was then taken away.

Acts 28:20

For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see you, and to speak with you:

because that for the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of Israel I am bound with this chain.

Romans 4:18

Who against hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> believed in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

Romans 5:2

By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of the glory of God.

Romans 5:4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>:

Romans 5:5

And hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Romans 8:20

For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected *the same* in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>,

Romans 8:24

For we are saved by hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>: but hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> that is seen is not hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

Romans 12:12

Rejoicing in hope <1680 elpis>; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

Romans 15:4

For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>.

Romans 15:13

Now the God of hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

1 Corinthians 9:10

Or saith he *it* altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, *this* is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>; and that he that thresheth in hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> should be partaker of his hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>.

1 Corinthians 13:13

And now abideth faith, hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, charity, these three; but the greatest of these *is* charity.

2 Corinthians 1:7

And our hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of you *is* stedfast, knowing, that as ye are partakers of the sufferings, so *shall ye be* also of the consolation.

2 Corinthians 3:12

Seeing then that we have such hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, we use great plainness of speech:

2 Corinthians 10:15

Not boasting of things without *our* measure, *that is*, of other men's labours; but having hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, when your faith is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to our rule abundantly,

Galatians 5:5

For we through the Spirit wait for the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of righteousness by faith.

Ephesians 1:18

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope <<u>(1680 elpis)</u> of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Ephesians 2:12

Ephesians 4:4

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of your calling;

Philippians 1:20

According to my earnest expectation and my hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but *that* with all boldness, as always, *so* now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether *it be* by life, or by death.

Colossians 1:5

For the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

Colossians 1:23

If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and *be* not moved away from the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of the gospel, which ye have heard, *and* which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

Colossians 1:27

To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of glory:

1 Thessalonians 1:3

Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

1 Thessalonians 2:19

For what *is* our hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? *Are* not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?

1 Thessalonians 4:13

But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>.

1 Thessalonians 5:8

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of salvation.

2 Thessalonians 2:16

Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given *us* everlasting consolation and good hope <u><1680 elpis></u> through grace,

1 Timothy 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, *which is* our hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>;

Titus 1:2

In hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> of <u>eternal life</u>, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

Titus 2:13

Looking for that blessed hope <<u>1680 elpis></u>, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Titus 3:7

That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope <<u>1680</u> <u>elpis></u> of <u>eternal life</u>.

Hebrews 3:6

But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> firm unto the end.

Is Our Blessed Hope The Rapture?

Hebrews 6:11

And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> unto the end:

Hebrews 6:18

That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> set before us:

Hebrews 7:19

For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> *did*; by the which we draw nigh unto God.

Hebrews 10:23

Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith <<u>1680 elpis></u> without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

1 Peter 1:3

Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope <u><1680 elpis></u> by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1 Peter 1:21

Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> might be in God.

1 Peter 3:15

But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and *be* ready always to *give* an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope <a>

<1680 elpis> that is in you with meekness and fear:

1 John 3:3

And every man that hath this hope <<u>1680 elpis></u> in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.
