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## **Amillennialism**

Advocates of this millenial view maintain that no millennium is to be looked for except that which they claim to be is "in progress" now in the gospel age, the age of the Spirit or the age of grace.

The amillennialists interpretation "spiritualizes" or gives a mystical meaning to the prophesies concerning the vast Kingdom promises of the Old Testament. They generally contend that Zion is constructed not to mean Zion but to refer to the Christian Church. They make no differentialtion between Israel and the church, which is a correct understanding, but misapply this meaning. The amillennialists claim John the Baptists prophesy of the baptism of the Spirit and Jesus' reference to this in Acts 1:5 means the Church is the fulfillment of "all" the prophesies of the Kingdom.

Two key teaching for amillennial theology is the teaching that the thousand year period is not a literal thousand year reign but an undefined or indeterminate period of time and that Satan is already bound based upon that teaching.

The Satan is bound theory hardly seems worthy to warrant challenge. All one needs to do is open their eyes, look around and smell the coffee. Is this society the best Jesus can do?

Let's focus on their exegetical claim that the Millenium is not to be understood as a literal 1,000 year period of time.

### The Millennium

The term millennium is a combined Latin word, "mille" meaning thousand and "annum" meaning year. The word millennium only appears in the Scoffield translation of the the bible. In other translations the Greek is rendered as a thousand years and refers to the reign of Christ upon the earth. The various views postulated are based upon when that period begins in relation to the return of Christ.

In Christianity, the millennial views include Post-Millennialism, Christ returns after the 1,000 year reign ...which is all but dead due to history; Pre-Millenialism, the return of Christ begins the thousand year reign of Christ; and A-Millenialism, there is no literal reign, the kingdom is now.

# **Exegesis**

Several Greek words have been translated "thousand" in the New Testament. (Appendix A) We'll examine all of these words and also the key words use in Revelation when referring to a "thousand year reign" to determine whether this is a literal period of time or a figurative

period of time. A central concept for amillennialism is this is an undetermined period of time.

Let's begin with an examination of the verses in Revelation 20, then see how these words are used elsewhere in scripture.

Revelation 20:2-8 (emphasis mine)

- And he laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and <u>Satan, and bound</u> him for a thousand years;
- and he threw him into the abyss, and shut it and sealed it over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.
- Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the <u>souls of those who had been beheaded</u> because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, **and** those who had not worshiped the <u>beast or his image</u>, **and** had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; **and** they came to life and reigned with Christ for **a thousand years**.
- The rest of the dead did not come to life until **the thousand** years were completed. This is the first resurrection.
- Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years.
- When **the thousand** years are completed, <u>Satan will be released</u> from his prison,
- and <u>will come out to deceive the nations</u> which are in the four corners of the earth, <u>Gog and Magog</u>, to <u>gather them together for the war</u>; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.

# The Binding of Satan

We see one of the characteristics of this period of time is that Satan is "bound" meaning he cannot deceive anyone during this period of time. This is not some figurative binding because we see in verse 7 that he is released. The binding in verse 2 is referring to the second coming of Jesus our Messiah to defeat Satan at the battle of Armegeddon, and the the release of Satan (verse 8) brings about the war of Gog and Magog. This thousand year period begins and ends with war.

For Amillennialism to be valid, they would need to demonstarte any period of time that begins and ends with war where the the people of the earth were not deceived "during" that period of time. There is no time period in human history we can look to where the peoples of the earth are NOT under the sway and deceiving power of Satan that begins and ends with war. Their position that the Calvary event is the period of time that binds Satan is not scripturally valid for the peoples of the earth are still being deceived by Satan. If we were to postulate that all that the myriad of cults and world religions were all indeed part of the body of Christ (which I do not believe are) we would be forced at a minimum to conclude that

Satan has power to deceive the Church. Even if we "excluded" the those that embrace heresy, we are still left with a myriad of conflicting denominational teaching. This thinking would still force one to conclude Satan is deceiving the body of Christ - His Church. This would serve to render Satan more powerful than God the Holy Spirit which is absolutely false.

If we were to conclude that the "period of time" expressed as a "thousand years" is not a literal time period of 1,000 years, and it bagan when Christ crushed the head of Satan by His resurrection to life, then God's Word could not be looked upon as infallible. There is just no way to reconcile the texts with the Amillemial position.

#### A Thousand Years

The Greek translated a thousand years in Revelation 20, verses 2-8 is cil ioi chilioi (*khil'-ee-oy*) which also appears in 2 Peter 3:8 and Revelation 11:3, 12:6.

2 Peter 3:8

But do not let this one *fact* escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like **a thousand <5507chilio>** years, **and a thousand <5507chilio>** years like one day.

Revelation 11:3

"And I will grant *authority* to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for **twelve hundred <5507 chilioi>** and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."

Revelation 12:6

Then the woman fled into the wilderness where she \*had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished **for one thousand <5507 chilioi>** two hundred and sixty days.

It is difficult to state this is referring to an unknown period of time when the word chilioi is used in Revelation to calculate a specific period of time, 1,260.

It is also important to note that when the the root chilioi is also used to determind specific numbers cil iav chilias (*khil-ee-as'*); 5,000 in Acts 4:4, 10,000 and 20,000 in Luke 14:31; 23,000 in 1 Corinthians 10:8; and in counting the number of each of the tribes in Revelation 7:4-8 as it does in the remainder of it's uses with the sole exception being Revelation 5:11.

Revelation 5:11

Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads <3461 murias> of myriads <3461 murias>, and thousands <5505 chilias> of thousands <5505 chilias>.

We see the use of the term thousand in this scripture is in context of multiplying a thousand by a thousand to express a very large number. This is done much in the same way that Jesus uses the expression of 70 time seven to express a very large unknown amount. I don't think anybody would take the position that Jesus meant to issue a quota of 490 as the number of times one should forgive their brother. The word muriav murias (moo-ree'-as) that has been translated as myriad is used to further express the same thought in Revelation 5:11 and when combined with the expression of thousands of thousands the thought is meant to represent a multitudinous number too large to count.

The other Greek words in the New Testament that use the root chilioi to represent a "specific" number are: discil ioi dischilioi (dis-khil'-ee-oy) 2,000; tetrakiscil ioi tetrakischilioi (tet-rak-is-khil'-ee-oy) 4,000; pentakiscil ioi pentakischilioi (pen-tak-is-khil'-ee-oy) 5,000; and eptakiscil ioi heptakischilioi (hep-tak-is-khil'-ee-oy) 7,000.

Scriptures, and the Greek language simply do not support the teaching that the word chilioi may be used to express an unknown or uncertain period of time or number. Context and exegesis both support the understanding of the word chilioi to mean 1,000.

#### A Period of Time Still In The Future

Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

### Souls of those who had been beheaded ...

Those saints who suffered martyrdom for Jesus and the Word of God. This represents all who died for God throughout the ages.

### Those who had not worshipped the beast or his image ...

Those who were not deceived by nor worshipped the beast is referring to a time yet to come. This prophesy is yet to be fulfilled ... it represents a time yet in the future. This verse is talking about the workings of the anti-christ and the beasts of Revelation.

### They came and reigned with Christ a thousand years ...

This refers to the resurrection of the believers ... the first resurrection. This is the blessed hope and the glorious coming of our Lord Jesus.

The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed

This is the Great White Throne Judgement at the end of the millennium when Jesus puts down the Gog and Magog war and raises the remaining dead for final judgement.
