Often used of the glorious manifestation of the gods, and esp. of their advent to help; in the NT the advent of Christ, --not only that which has already taken place and by which his presence and power appear in the saving light he has shed upon mankind, but also that illustrious return from heaven to earth to occur in the future.

## Matthew 24:3

And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what *shall be* the sign of thy **coming <3952 parousia>**, and of the end of the world?

#### **Matthew 24:27**

For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the **coming** <3952 parousia> of the Son of man be.

## **Matthew 24:37**

But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the **coming <3952 parousia>** of the Son of man be.

## **Matthew 24:39**

And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the **coming <3952 parousia>** of the Son of man be.

## 1 Corinthians 15:23

But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at His **coming** <3952 parousia>.

## 1 Corinthians 16:17

I am glad of the **coming <3952 parousia>** of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus: for that which was lacking on your part they have supplied.

At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast **revealed <601 apokalupto>** them unto babes.

Matthew 11:27

All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and *he* to whomsoever the Son will **reveal <601 apokalupto>** *him*.

Matthew 16:17

And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood **hath not revealed <601 apokalupto>** *it* unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven.

Luke 2:35

(Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul also,) that the thoughts of many hearts may be **revealed** <601 apokalupto>.

For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time *are* not worthy *to be compared* with the glory which shall be **revealed <601 apokalupto>** in us.

#### 1 Corinthians 2:10

But God hath **revealed <601** apokalupto> *them* unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

#### 1 Corinthians 3:13

Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be **revealed <601 apokalupto>** by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

#### 1 Corinthians 14:30

If any thing be **revealed <601** apokalupto> to another that sitteth by, let the first hold his peace.

#### Galatians 1:16

To **reveal <601 apokalupto>** his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:

#### Galatians 3:23

But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed <601 apokalupto>.

## Ephesians 3:5

Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as **it is now revealed <601 apokalupto>** unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

## Philippians 3:15

¶ Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall **reveal <601** apokalupto> even this unto you.

#### 2 Thessalonians 2:3

Let no man deceive you by any means: for *that day shall not come*, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be **revealed <601 apokalupto>**, the son of perdition;

## 2 Thessalonians 2:6

And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be **revealed <601 apokalupto>** in his time.

### 2 Thessalonians 2:8

And then **shall <601 apokalupto>** that Wicked be **revealed <601 apokalupto>**, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

#### 1 Peter 1:5

Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be **revealed <601 apokalupto>** in the last time.

## 1 Peter 1:12

Unto whom it was **revealed <601 apokalupto>**, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

#### 1 Peter 5:1

The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be **revealed <601 apokalupto>**:

## Luke 2:32

A light to **lighten <602** apokalupsis> the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel.

#### Romans 2:5

But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and **revelation <602 apokalupsis>** of the righteous judgment of God;

## **Romans 8:19**

For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the **manifestation <602 apokalupsis>** of the sons of God.

#### Romans 16:25

¶ Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the **revelation <602** apokalupsis> of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

## 1 Corinthians 1:7

So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the **coming <602 apokalupsis>** of our Lord Jesus Christ:

## 1 Corinthians 14:6

¶ Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by **revelation <602 apokalupsis>**, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?

## 1 Corinthians 14:26

How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a **revelation <602 apokalupsis>**, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.

## 2 Corinthians 12:1

It is not expedient for me doubtless to glory. I will come to visions and **revelations** <**602 apokalupsis**> of the Lord.

#### 2 Corinthians 12:7

And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the **revelations** <**602 apokalupsis**>, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

## Galatians 1:12

For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught *it*, but by the **revelation <602 apokalupsis>** of Jesus Christ.

#### Galatians 2:2

And I went up by **revelation <602 apokalupsis>**, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

## Ephesians 1:17

That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and **revelation <602 apokalupsis>** in the knowledge of him:

#### Ephesians 3:3

How that by <u>revelation <602 apokalupsis></u> he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

#### 2 Thessalonians 1:6-7

Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be **revealed <602 apokalupsis>** from heaven with his mighty angels,

## 1 Peter 1:7

That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the **appearing <602 apokalupsis>** of Jesus Christ:

#### 1 Peter 1:13

¶ Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the **revelation <602 apokalupsis>** of Jesus Christ;

## 1 Peter 4:13

But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be **revealed** <602 apokalupsis>, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.

#### Revelation 1:1

¶ The **Revelation** <**602 apokalupsis**> of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified *it* by his angel unto his servant John:

## 2015 epiphaneia (*ep-if-an'-i-ah*)

## 2 Thessalonians 2:8

And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the **brightness** <**2015** epiphaneia > of his coming:

## 1 Timothy 6:14

That thou keep *this* commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the **appearing <2015 epiphaneia >** of our Lord Jesus Christ:

## 2 Timothy 1:10

But is now made manifest by the **appearing <2015 epiphaneia >** of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

## 2 Timothy 4:1

¶ I charge *thee* therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his **appearing <2015 epiphaneia>** and his kingdom;

## 2 Timothy 4:8

Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his **appearing <2015 epiphaneia>**.

## **Titus 2:13**

Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious **appearing <2015 epiphaneia >** of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

## Acts 2:20

The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and **notable <2016 epiphanes>** day of the Lord come:

## Rapture: 726 harpazo (har-pad'-zo)

#### Matthew 11:12

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by **force** <**726 harpazo**>.

## Matthew 13:19

When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth *it* not, then cometh the wicked *one*, and **catcheth away <726 harpazo>** that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side.

#### John 6:15

¶ When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and **take him by force <726 harpazo>**, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

## John 10:12

But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf **catcheth** <**726** harpazo> them, and scattereth the sheep.

## John 10:28

And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck <726 harpazo> them out of my hand.

#### John 10:29

My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to **pluck <726 harpazo>** *them* out of my Father's hand.

## Acts 8:39

And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord **caught away <726** harpazo> Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

#### Acts 23:10

And when there arose a great dissension, the chief captain, fearing lest Paul should have been pulled in pieces of them, commanded the soldiers to go down, and to **take him by force <726 harpazo>** from among them, and to bring *him* into the castle.

## 2 Corinthians 12:2

I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one **caught up <726** harpazo> to the third heaven.

#### 2 Corinthians 12:4

How that he was **caught up <726 harpazo>** into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter.

## 1 Thessalonians 4:17

Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be **caught up <726 harpazo>** together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

## Jude 1:23

And others save with fear, **pulling <726** harpazo> *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

#### Revelation 12:5

And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was **caught up <726 harpazo>** unto God, and *to* his throne.

## Blessed Hope: 3107 makarios (mak-ar'-ee-os) -with- 1680 elpis (elpece)

## **Titus 2:13**

looking for the **blessed <3107 makarios> hope <1680 elpis>** and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ.

#### Acts 2:26

Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in **hope** <1680 elpis>:

## Acts 16:19

And when her masters saw that the **hope** <**1680 elpis**> of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew *them* into the marketplace unto the rulers,

## Acts 23:6

But when Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men *and* brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the **hope** <1680 elpis> and resurrection of the dead I am called in question.

## Acts 24:15

And have **hope <1680 elpis>** toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

#### Acts 26:6

And now I stand and am judged for the **hope** <1680 elpis> of the promise made of God unto our fathers:

## Acts 26:7

Unto which *promise* our twelve tribes, instantly serving *God* day and night, hope to come. For which **hope's sake <1680 elpis>**, king Agrippa, I am accused of the Jews.

#### Acts 27:20

And when neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on us, all **hope** <1680 elpis> that we should be saved was then taken away.

#### Acts 28:20

For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see *you*, and to speak with *you*: because that for the **hope** <**1680 elpis**> of Israel I am bound with this chain.

#### Romans 4:18

Who against **hope** <**1680 elpis**> believed in **hope** <**1680 elpis**>, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

#### Romans 5:2

By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in **hope** <1680 **elpis**> of the glory of God.

## Romans 5:4

And patience, experience; and experience, hope <1680 elpis>:

## Romans 5:5

And **hope** <**1680 elpis**> maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

## **Romans 8:20**

For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected *the same* in **hope** <**1680 elpis>**,

#### **Romans 8:24**

For we are saved by **hope <1680 elpis>:** but **hope <1680 elpis>** that is seen is not **hope <1680 elpis>:** for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

#### **Romans 12:12**

Rejoicing in **hope <1680 elpis>**; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

#### **Romans 15:4**

For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have **hope** <1680 elpis>.

## **Romans 15:13**

Now the God of **hope** <**1680 elpis**> fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in **hope** <**1680 elpis**>, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

## 1 Corinthians 9:10

Or saith he *it* altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, *this* is written: that he that ploweth should plow in **hope** <1680 **elpis>**; and that he that thresheth in hope <1680 **elpis>** should be partaker of his **hope** <1680 **elpis>**.

## 1 Corinthians 13:13

And now abideth faith, **hope** <1680 elpis>, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.

## 2 Corinthians 1:7

And our **hope** <**1680 elpis**> of you *is* stedfast, knowing, that as ye are partakers of the sufferings, so *shall ye be* also of the consolation.

## 2 Corinthians 3:12

Seeing then that we have such **hope <1680 elpis>**, we use great plainness of speech:

## 2 Corinthians 10:15

Not boasting of things without *our* measure, *that is*, of other men's labours; but having **hope** <**1680 elpis>**, when your faith is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to our rule abundantly,

## Galatians 5:5

For we through the Spirit wait for the **hope <1680 elpis>** of righteousness by faith.

## **Ephesians 1:18**

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the **hope <1680 elpis>** of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

## **Ephesians 2:12**

That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no **hope** <1680 elpis>, and without God in the world:

## **Ephesians 4:4**

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope <1680 elpis> of your calling;

## Philippians 1:20

According to my earnest expectation and my hope <1680 elpis>, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death.

## Colossians 1:5

For the **hope <1680 elpis>** which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

## Colossians 1:23

If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and *be* not moved away from the **hope** <**1680 elpis**> of the gospel, which ye have heard, *and* which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

## Colossians 1:27

To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the **hope <1680 elpis>** of glory:

#### 1 Thessalonians 1:3

Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of **hope <1680 elpis>** in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

#### 1 Thessalonians 2:19

For what *is* our **hope** <**1680 elpis>**, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? *Are* not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?

## 1 Thessalonians 4:13

But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no **hope** <1680 elpis>.

#### 1 Thessalonians 5:8

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the **hope** <1680 elpis> of salvation.

#### 2 Thessalonians 2:16

Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given *us* everlasting consolation and good **hope** <**1680 elpis**> through grace,

## 1 Timothy 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, *which is* our **hope** <**1680 elpis>**;

## **Titus 1:2**

In **hope <1680 elpis>** of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

## **Titus 2:13**

Looking for that blessed **hope** <1680 elpis>, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

#### **Titus 3:7**

That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the **hope <1680 elpis>** of <u>eternal</u> life.

## Hebrews 3:6

But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the **hope** <1680 elpis> firm unto the end.

## Hebrews 6:11

And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of **hope** <**1680 elpis**> unto the end:

## Hebrews 6:18

That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the **hope** <**1680 elpis**> set before us:

## Hebrews 7:19

For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better **hope** <1680 elpis> *did*; by the which we draw nigh unto God.

## Hebrews 10:23

Let us hold fast the profession of *our* **faith** <**1680 elpis**> without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

## 1 Peter 1:3

Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively **hope** <1680 elpis> by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

## 1 Peter 1:21

Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope <1680 elpis> might be in God.

## 1 Peter 3:15

But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and *be* ready always to *give* an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the **hope** <**1680 elpis**> that is in you with meekness and fear:

## 1 John 3:3

And every man that hath this **hope <1680 elpis>** in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.
