- Luke 12:45 "But if that slave says in his heart, 'My master **<2962 kurios>** will be a long time in coming,' and begins to beat the slaves, *both* men and women, and to eat and drink and get drunk;
- Luke 12:46 the master <2962 kurios> of that slave will come on a day when he does not expect *him* and at an hour he does not know, and will cut him in pieces, and assign him a place with the unbelievers.
- Luke 12:47 "And that slave who knew his master's <2962 kurios> will and did not get ready or act in accord with his will, will receive many lashes,
- Luke 13:8 "And he answered and said to him, 'Let it alone, sir <2962 kurios>, for this year too, until I dig around it and put in fertilizer;

- Luke 13:15 But the Lord <2962 kurios> answered him and said, "You hypocrites, does not each of you on the Sabbath untie his ox or his donkey from the stall and lead him away to water *him*?
- Luke 13:23 And someone said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, are there *just* a few who are being saved?" And He said to them,
- Luke 13:25 "Once the head of the house gets up and shuts the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock on the door, saying, 'Lord <2962 kurios>, open up to us!' then He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know where you are from.'
- Luke 13:35 "Behold, your house is left to you *desolate;* and I say to you, you will not see Me until *the time* comes when you say, 'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>!'"
- Luke 14:21 "And the slave came *back* and reported this to his master **<2962 kurios>**. Then the head of the household became angry and said to his slave, 'Go out at once into the streets and lanes of the city and bring in here the poor and crippled and blind and lame.'
- Luke 14:22 "And the slave said, 'Master <2962 kurios>, what you commanded has been done, and still there is room.'
- Luke 14:23 "And the master <2962 kurios> said to the slave, 'Go out into the highways and along the hedges, and compel them to come in, so that my house may be filled.
- Luke 16:3 "The manager said to himself, 'What shall I do, since my master <2962 kurios> is taking the management away from me? I am not strong enough to dig; I am ashamed to beg.
- Luke 16:5 "And he summoned each one of his master's <2962 kurios> debtors, and he began saying to the first, 'How much do you owe my master <2962 kurios>?'
- Luke 16:8 "And his master <2962 kurios> praised the unrighteous manager because he had acted shrewdly; for the sons of this age are more shrewd in relation to their own kind than the sons of light.
- Luke 16:13 "No servant can serve two masters <2962 kurios>; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth."
- Luke 17:5 The apostles said to the Lord <2962 kurios>, "Increase our faith!"
- Luke 17:6 And the Lord <2962 kurios> said, "If you had faith like a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and be planted in the sea'; and it would obey you.
- Luke 17:37 And answering they *said to Him, "Where, Lord <2962 kurios>?" And He said to them, "Where the body *is*, there also the vultures will be gathered."
- Luke 18:6 And the Lord <2962 kurios> said, "Hear what the unrighteous judge *said;
- Luke 18:41 "What do you want Me to do for you?" And he said, "Lord <2962 kurios>, *I want* to regain my sight!"
- Luke 19:8 Zaccheus stopped and said to the Lord <2962 kurios>, "Behold, Lord <2962 kurios>, half of my possessions I will give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I will give back four times as much."
- Luke 19:16 "The first appeared, saying, 'Master <2962 kurios>, your mina has made ten minas more.'
- Luke 19:18 "The second came, saying, 'Your mina, master <2962 kurios>, has made five minas.'
- Luke 19:20 "Another came, saying, 'Master <2962 kurios>, here is your mina, which I kept put away in a handkerchief;

- Luke 19:25 "And they said to him, 'Master <2962 kurios>, he has ten minas already.'
- Luke 19:31 "If anyone asks you, 'Why are you untying it?' you shall say, 'The Lord <2962 kurios> has need of it.'"
- Luke 19:33 As they were untying the colt, its owners <2962 kurios> said to them, "Why are you untying the colt?"
- Luke 19:34 They said, "The Lord <2962 kurios> has need of it."
- Luke 19:38 shouting: "BLESSED IS THE KING WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- Luke 20:13 "The owner <2962 kurios> of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my beloved son; perhaps they will respect him.'
- Luke 20:15 "So they threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. What, then, will the owner <2962 kurios> of the vineyard do to them?
- Luke 20:37 "But that the dead are raised, even Moses showed, in the *passage about the burning* bush, where he calls the Lord **<2962 kurios>** THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, AND THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB.
- Luke 20:42 "For David himself says in the book of Psalms, 'THE LORD <2962 kurios> SAID TO MY LORD <2962 kurios>, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND,
- Luke 20:44 "Therefore David calls Him 'Lord <2962 kurios>,' and how is He his son?"
- Luke 22:33 But he said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, with You I am ready to go both to prison and to death!"
- Luke 22:38 They said, "Lord <2962 kurios>, look, here are two swords." And He said to them, "It is enough."
- Luke 22:49 When those who were around Him saw what was going to happen, they said, "Lord <2962 kurios>, shall we strike with the sword?"
- Luke 22:61 The Lord **<2962 kurios>** turned and looked at Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, how He had told him, "Before a rooster crows today, you will deny Me three times."
- Luke 24:3 but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.
- Luke 24:34 saying, "The Lord <2962 kurios> has really risen and has appeared to Simon."
- John 1:23 He said, "I am A VOICE OF ONE CRYING IN THE WILDERNESS, 'MAKE STRAIGHT THE WAY OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>,' as Isaiah the prophet said."
- John 4:1 Therefore when the Lord <2962 kurios> knew that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John
- John 4:11 She *said to Him, "Sir <2962 kurios>, You have nothing to draw with and the well is deep; where then do You get that living water?
- John 4:15 The woman *said to Him, "Sir <2962 kurios>, give me this water, so I will not be thirsty nor come all the way here to draw."
- John 4:19 The woman *said to Him, "Sir <2962 kurios>, I perceive that You are a prophet.
- John 4:49 The royal official *said to Him, "Sir <2962 kurios>, come down before my child dies."
- John 5:4 for an angel of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** went down at certain seasons into the pool and stirred up the water; whoever then first, after the stirring up of the water, stepped in was made well from whatever disease with which he was afflicted.]]
- John 5:7 The sick man answered Him, "Sir <2962 kurios>, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up, but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

- John 6:23 There came other small boats from Tiberias near to the place where they ate the bread after the Lord <2962 kurios> had given thanks.
- John 6:34 Then they said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, always give us this bread."
- John 6:68 Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life.
- John 8:11 She said, "No one, Lord <2962 kurios>." And Jesus said, "I do not condemn you, either. Go. From now on sin no more."]]
- John 9:36 He answered, "Who is He, Lord <2962 kurios>, that I may believe in Him?"
- John 9:38 And he said, "Lord <2962 kurios>, I believe." And he worshiped Him.
- John 11:2 It was the Mary who anointed the Lord <2962 kurios> with ointment, and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.
- John 11:3 So the sisters sent *word* to Him, saying, "Lord <2962 kurios>, behold, he whom You love is sick."
- John 11:12 The disciples then said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, if he has fallen asleep, he will recover."
- John 11:21 Martha then said to Jesus, "Lord <2962 kurios>, if You had been here, my brother would not have died.
- John 11:27 She *said to Him, "Yes, Lord <2962 kurios>; I have believed that You are the Christ, the Son of God, *even* He who comes into the world."
- John 11:32 Therefore, when Mary came where Jesus was, she saw Him, and fell at His feet, saying to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, if You had been here, my brother would not have died."
- John 11:34 and said, "Where have you laid him?" They *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, come and see."
- John 11:39 Jesus *said, "Remove the stone." Martha, the sister of the deceased, *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, by this time there will be a stench, for he has been *dead* four days."
- John 12:13 took the branches of the palm trees and went out to meet Him, and *began* to shout, "Hosanna! BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>, even the King of Israel."
- John 12:21 these then came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and *began to* ask him, saying, "Sir <2962 kurios>, we wish to see Jesus."
- John 12:38 *This was* to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet which he spoke: "LORD <2962 kurios>, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT? AND TO WHOM HAS THE ARM OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> BEEN REVEALED?"
- John 13:6 So He *came to Simon Peter. He *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, do You wash my feet?"
- John 13:9 Simon Peter *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, *then wash* not only my feet, but also my hands and my head."
- John 13:13 "You call Me Teacher and Lord <2962 kurios>; and you are right, for so I am.
- John 13:14 "If I then, the Lord <2962 kurios> and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.
- John 13:16 "Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master <2962 kurios>, nor *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him.
- John 13:25 He, leaning back thus on Jesus' bosom, *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, who is it?"

- John 13:36 Simon Peter *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, where are You going?" Jesus answered, "Where I go, you cannot follow Me now; but you will follow later."
- John 13:37 Peter *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, why can I not follow You right now? I will lay down my life for You."
- John 14:5 Thomas *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, we do not know where You are going, how do we know the way?"
- John 14:8 Philip *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, show us the Father, and it is enough for us."
- John 14:22 Judas (not Iscariot) *said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, what then has happened that You are going to disclose Yourself to us and not to the world?"
- John 15:15 "No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master <2962 **kurios**> is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.
- John 15:20 "Remember the word that I said to you, 'A slave is not greater than his master **<2962 kurios>**.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.
- John 20:2 So she *ran and *came to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and *said to them, "They have taken away the Lord <2962 kurios> out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him."
- John 20:13 And they *said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She *said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord <2962 kurios>, and I do not know where they have laid Him."
- John 20:15 Jesus *said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" Supposing Him to be the gardener, she *said to Him, "Sir <2962 kurios>, if you have carried Him away, tell me where you have laid Him, and I will take Him away."
- John 20:18 Mary Magdalene *came, announcing to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord <2962 **kurios**>," and *that* He had said these things to her.
- John 20:20 And when He had said this, He showed them both His hands and His side. The disciples then rejoiced when they saw the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- John 20:25 So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord <2962 kurios>!" But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."
- John 20:28 Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord <2962 kurios> and my God!"
- John 21:7 Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved *said to Peter, "It is the Lord <2962 kurios>." So when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord <2962 kurios>, he put his outer garment on (for he was stripped *for work*), and threw himself into the sea.
- John 21:12 Jesus *said to them, "Come *and* have breakfast." None of the disciples ventured to question Him, "Who are You?" knowing that it was the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- John 21:15 So when they had finished breakfast, Jesus *said to Simon Peter, "Simon, *son* of John, do you love Me more than these?" He *said to Him, "Yes, Lord **<2962 kurios**>; You know that I love You." He *said to him, "Tend My lambs."
- John 21:16 He *said to him again a second time, "Simon, *son* of John, do you love Me?" He *said to Him, "Yes, Lord **<2962 kurios>**; You know that I love You." He *said to him, "Shepherd My sheep."

- John 21:17 He *said to him the third time, "Simon, *son* of John, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, "Lord <2962 kurios>, You know all things; You know that I love You." Jesus *said to him, "Tend My sheep.
- John 21:20 Peter, turning around, *saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following *them*; the one who also had leaned back on His bosom at the supper and said, "Lord <2962 kurios>, who is the one who betrays You?"
- John 21:21 So Peter seeing him *said to Jesus, "Lord <2962 kurios>, and what about this man?"
- Acts 1:6 So when they had come together, they were asking Him, saying, "Lord <2962 kurios>, is it at this time You are restoring the kingdom to Israel?"
- Acts 1:21 "Therefore it is necessary that of the men who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus went in and out among us—
- Acts 1:24 And they prayed and said, "You, Lord **<2962 kurios>**, who know the hearts of all men, show which one of these two You have chosen
- Acts 2:20 'THE SUN WILL BE TURNED INTO DARKNESS AND THE MOON INTO BLOOD, BEFORE THE GREAT AND GLORIOUS DAY OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> SHALL COME.
- Acts 2:21 'AND IT SHALL BE THAT EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> WILL BE SAVED.'
- Acts 2:25 "For David says of Him, 'I SAW THE LORD <2962 kurios> ALWAYS IN MY PRESENCE; FOR HE IS AT MY RIGHT HAND, SO THAT I WILL NOT BE SHAKEN.
- Acts 2:34 "For it was not David who ascended into heaven, but he himself says: 'THE LORD <2962 kurios> SAID TO MY LORD <2962 kurios>, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND,
- Acts 2:36 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord <2962 kurios> and Christ—this Jesus whom you crucified."
- Acts 2:39 "For the promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord <2962 kurios> our God will call to Himself."
- Acts 2:47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord <2962 kurios> was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved.
- Acts 3:19 "Therefore repent and return, so that your sins may be wiped away, in order that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord <2962 kurios>;
- Acts 3:22 "Moses said, 'THE LORD <2962 kurios> GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN; TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you.
- Acts 4:26 'THE KINGS OF THE EARTH TOOK THEIR STAND, AND THE RULERS WERE GATHERED TOGETHER AGAINST THE LORD <2962 kurios> AND AGAINST HIS CHRIST.'
- Acts 4:29 "And now, Lord <2962 kurios>, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bondservants may speak Your word with all confidence,
- Acts 4:33 And with great power the apostles were giving testimony to the resurrection of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, and abundant grace was upon them all.
- Acts 5:9 Then Peter *said* to her, "Why is it that you have agreed together to put the Spirit of the Lord <2962 kurios> to the test? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out *as well*."

- Acts 5:14 And all the more believers in the Lord <2962 kurios>, multitudes of men and women, were constantly added to *their number*,
- Acts 5:19 But during the night an angel of the Lord <2962 kurios> opened the gates of the prison, and taking them out he said,
- Acts 7:31 "When Moses saw it, he marveled at the sight; and as he approached to look *more* closely, there came the voice of the Lord <2962 kurios>:
- Acts 7:33 "BUT THE LORD <2962 kurios> SAID TO HIM, 'TAKE OFF THE SANDALS FROM YOUR FEET, FOR THE PLACE ON WHICH YOU ARE STANDING IS HOLY GROUND.
- Acts 7:49 'HEAVEN IS MY THRONE, AND EARTH IS THE FOOTSTOOL OF MY FEET; WHAT KIND OF HOUSE WILL YOU BUILD FOR ME?' says the Lord <2962 kurios>, 'OR WHAT PLACE IS THERE FOR MY REPOSE?
- Acts 7:59 They went on stoning Stephen as he called on *the Lord* and said, "Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, receive my spirit!"
- Acts 7:60 Then falling on his knees, he cried out with a loud voice, "Lord <2962 kurios>, do not hold this sin against them!" Having said this, he fell asleep.
- Acts 8:16 For He had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.
- Acts 8:22 "Therefore repent of this wickedness of yours, and pray the Lord <2962 kurios> that, if possible, the intention of your heart may be forgiven you.
- Acts 8:24 But Simon answered and said, "Pray to the Lord <2962 kurios> for me yourselves, so that nothing of what you have said may come upon me."
- Acts 8:25 So, when they had solemnly testified and spoken the word of the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, they started back to Jerusalem, and were preaching the gospel to many villages of the Samaritans.
- Acts 8:26 But an angel of the Lord <2962 kurios> spoke to Philip saying, "Get up and go south to the road that descends from Jerusalem to Gaza." (This is a desert *road.*)
- Acts 8:39 When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord <2962 kurios> snatched Philip away; and the eunuch no longer saw him, but went on his way rejoicing.
- Acts 9:1 Now Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord <2962 kurios>, went to the high priest,
- Acts 9:5 And he said, "Who are You, Lord <2962 kurios>?" And He said, "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting,
- Acts 9:10 Now there was a disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and the Lord <2962 kurios> said to him in a vision, "Ananias." And he said, "Here I am, Lord <2962 kurios>."
- Acts 9:11 And the Lord <2962 kurios> said to him, "Get up and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for a man from Tarsus named Saul, for he is praying,
- Acts 9:13 But Ananias answered, "Lord <2962 kurios>, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he did to Your saints at Jerusalem;
- Acts 9:15 But the Lord <2962 kurios> said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen instrument of Mine, to bear My name before the Gentiles and kings and the sons of Israel;
- Acts 9:17 So Ananias departed and entered the house, and after laying his hands on him said, "Brother Saul, the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, who appeared to you on the road by which you were coming, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."

- Acts 9:27 But Barnabas took hold of him and brought him to the apostles and described to them how he had seen the Lord <2962 kurios> on the road, and that He had talked to him, and how at Damascus he had spoken out boldly in the name of Jesus.
- Acts 9:28 And he was with them, moving about freely in Jerusalem, speaking out boldly in the name of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Acts 9:31 So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord <2962 kurios> and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it continued to increase.
- Acts 9:35 And all who lived at Lydda and Sharon saw him, and they turned to the Lord **<2962 kurios>**.
- Acts 9:42 It became known all over Joppa, and many believed in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Acts 10:4 And fixing his gaze on him and being much alarmed, he said, "What is it, Lord **<2962 kurios>**?" And he said to him, "Your prayers and alms have ascended as a memorial before God.
- Acts 10:14 But Peter said, "By no means, Lord <2962 kurios>, for I have never eaten anything unholy and unclean."
- Acts 10:33 "So I sent for you immediately, and you have been kind enough to come. Now then, we are all here present before God to hear all that you have been commanded by the Lord <2962 kurios>."
- Acts 10:36 "The word which He sent to the sons of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ (He is Lord <2962 kurios> of all)—
- Acts 11:8 "But I said, 'By no means, Lord <2962 kurios>, for nothing unholy or unclean has ever entered my mouth.'
- Acts 11:16 "And I remembered the word of the Lord <2962 kurios>, how He used to say, 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'
- Acts 11:17 "Therefore if God gave to them the same gift as *He gave* to us also after believing in the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, who was I that I could stand in God's way?"
- Acts 11:20 But there were some of them, men of Cyprus and Cyrene, who came to Antioch and *began* speaking to the Greeks also, preaching the Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus.
- Acts 11:21 And the hand of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** was with them, and a large number who believed turned to the Lord **<2962 kurios>**.
- Acts 11:23 Then when he arrived and witnessed the grace of God, he rejoiced and *began* to encourage them all with resolute heart to remain *true* to the Lord <2962 kurios>;
- Acts 11:24 for he was a good man, and full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And considerable numbers were brought to the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Acts 12:7 And behold, an angel of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** suddenly appeared and a light shone in the cell; and he struck Peter's side and woke him up, saying, "Get up quickly." And his chains fell off his hands.
- Acts 12:11 When Peter came to himself, he said, "Now I know for sure that the Lord <2962 kurios> has sent forth His angel and rescued me from the hand of Herod and from all that the Jewish people were expecting."
- Acts 12:17 But motioning to them with his hand to be silent, he described to them how the Lord <2962 kurios> had led him out of the prison. And he said, "Report these things to James and the brethren." Then he left and went to another place.

- Acts 12:23 And immediately an angel of the Lord <2962 kurios> struck him because he did not give God the glory, and he was eaten by worms and died.
- Acts 12:24 But the word of the Lord <2962 kurios> continued to grow and to be multiplied.
- Acts 13:2 While they were ministering to the Lord **<2962 kurios>** and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."
- Acts 13:10 and said, "You who are full of all deceit and fraud, you son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease to make crooked the straight ways of the Lord <2962 kurios>?
- Acts 13:11 "Now, behold, the hand of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** is upon you, and you will be blind and not see the sun for a time." And immediately a mist and a darkness fell upon him, and he went about seeking those who would lead him by the hand.
- Acts 13:12 Then the proconsul believed when he saw what had happened, being amazed at the teaching of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Acts 13:47 "For so the Lord <2962 kurios> has commanded us, 'I HAVE PLACED YOU AS A LIGHT FOR THE GENTILES, THAT YOU MAY BRING SALVATION TO THE END OF THE EARTH.'"
- Acts 13:48 When the Gentiles heard this, they *began* rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord <2962 kurios>; and as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed.
- Acts 13:49 And the word of the Lord <2962 kurios> was being spread through the whole region.
- Acts 14:3 Therefore they spent a long time *there* speaking boldly *with reliance* upon the Lord <2962 kurios>, who was testifying to the word of His grace, granting that signs and wonders be done by their hands.
- Acts 14:23 When they had appointed elders for them in every church, having prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord <2962 kurios> in whom they had believed.
- Acts 15:11 "But we believe that we are saved through the grace of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, in the same way as they also are."
- Acts 15:17 SO THAT THE REST OF MANKIND MAY SEEK THE LORD <2962 kurios>, AND ALL THE GENTILES WHO ARE CALLED BY MY NAME,'
- Acts 15:18 SAYS THE LORD <2962 kurios>, WHO MAKES THESE THINGS KNOWN FROM LONG AGO.
- Acts 15:26 men who have risked their lives for the name of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ.
- Acts 15:35 But Paul and Barnabas stayed in Antioch, teaching and preaching with many others also, the word of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Acts 15:36 After some days Paul said to Barnabas, "Let us return and visit the brethren in every city in which we proclaimed the word of the Lord <2962 kurios>, and see how they are."
- Acts 15:40 But Paul chose Silas and left, being committed by the brethren to the grace of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Acts 16:14 A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics, a worshiper of God, was listening; and the Lord <2962 kurios> opened her heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul.
- Acts 16:15 And when she and her household had been baptized, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord <2962 kurios>, come into my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.

- Acts 16:16 It happened that as we were going to the place of prayer, a slave-girl having a spirit of divination met us, who was bringing her masters <2962 kurios> much profit by fortune-telling.
- Acts 16:19 But when her masters <2962 kurios> saw that their hope of profit was gone, they seized Paul and Silas and dragged them into the market place before the authorities,
- Acts 16:30 and after he brought them out, he said, "Sirs <2962 kurios>, what must I do to be saved?"
- Acts 16:31 They said, "Believe in the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."
- Acts 16:32 And they spoke the word of the Lord <2962 kurios> to him together with all who were in his house.
- Acts 17:24 "The God who made the world and all things in it, since He is Lord <2962 kurios> of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands;
- Acts 18:8 Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, believed in the Lord <2962 kurios> with all his household, and many of the Corinthians when they heard were believing and being baptized.
- Acts 18:9 And the Lord <2962 kurios> said to Paul in the night by a vision, "Do not be afraid *any longer*, but go on speaking and do not be silent;
- Acts 18:25 This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord <2962 kurios>; and being fervent in spirit, he was speaking and teaching accurately the things concerning Jesus, being acquainted only with the baptism of John;
- Acts 19:5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.
- Acts 19:10 This took place for two years, so that all who lived in Asia heard the word of the Lord <2962 kurios>, both Jews and Greeks.
- Acts 19:13 But also some of the Jewish exorcists, who went from place to place, attempted to name over those who had the evil spirits the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, saying, "I adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preaches."
- Acts 19:17 This became known to all, both Jews and Greeks, who lived in Ephesus; and fear fell upon them all and the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus was being magnified.
- Acts 19:20 So the word of the Lord <2962 kurios> was growing mightily and prevailing.
- Acts 20:19 serving the Lord <2962 kurios> with all humility and with tears and with trials which came upon me through the plots of the Jews;
- Acts 20:21 solemnly testifying to both Jews and Greeks of repentance toward God and faith in our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- Acts 20:24 "But I do not consider my life of any account as dear to myself, so that I may finish my course and the ministry which I received from the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, to testify solemnly of the gospel of the grace of God.
- Acts 20:35 "In everything I showed you that by working hard in this manner you must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, that He Himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"
- Acts 21:13 Then Paul answered, "What are you doing, weeping and breaking my heart? For I am ready not only to be bound, but even to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus."
- Acts 21:14 And since he would not be persuaded, we fell silent, remarking, "The will of the Lord <2962 kurios> be done!"

- Acts 22:8 "And I answered, 'Who are You, Lord <2962 kurios>?' And He said to me, 'I am Jesus the Nazarene, whom you are persecuting.'
- Acts 22:10 "And I said, 'What shall I do, Lord <2962 kurios>?' And the Lord <2962 kurios> said to me, 'Get up and go on into Damascus, and there you will be told of all that has been appointed for you to do.'
- Acts 22:19 "And I said, 'Lord <2962 kurios>, they themselves understand that in one synagogue after another I used to imprison and beat those who believed in You.
- Acts 23:11 But on the night *immediately* following, the Lord **<2962 kurios>** stood at his side and said, "Take courage; for as you have solemnly witnessed to My cause at Jerusalem, so you must witness at Rome also."
- Acts 25:26 "Yet I have nothing definite about him to write to my lord **<2962 kurios**>. Therefore I have brought him before you *all* and especially before you, King Agrippa, so that after the investigation has taken place, I may have something to write.
- Acts 26:15 "And I said, 'Who are You, Lord <2962 kurios>?' And the Lord <2962 kurios> said, 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting.
- Acts 28:31 preaching the kingdom of God and teaching concerning the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ with all openness, unhindered.
- Romans 1:4 who was declared the Son of God with power by the resurrection from the dead, according to the Spirit of holiness, Jesus Christ our Lord <2962 kurios>,
- Romans 1:7 to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called *as* saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- Romans 4:8 "BLESSED IS THE MAN WHOSE SIN THE LORD <2962 kurios> WILL NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT."
- Romans 4:24 but for our sake also, to whom it will be credited, as those who believe in Him who raised Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios> from the dead,
- Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ,
- Romans 5:11 And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.
- Romans 5:21 so that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 7:25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord **<2962 kurios>**! So then, on the one hand I myself with my mind am serving the law of God, but on the other, with my flesh the law of sin.
- Romans 8:39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 9:28 FOR THE LORD <2962 kurios> WILL EXECUTE HIS WORD ON THE EARTH, THOROUGHLY AND QUICKLY."
- Romans 9:29 And just as Isaiah foretold, "UNLESS THE LORD **<2962 kurios>** OF SABAOTH HAD LEFT TO US A POSTERITY, WE WOULD HAVE BECOME LIKE SODOM, AND WOULD HAVE RESEMBLED GOMORRAH."
- Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord **<2962 kurios>**, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

- Romans 10:12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same *Lord* is Lord <2962 kurios> of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him;
- Romans 10:13 for "WHOEVER WILL CALL ON THE NAME OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> WILL BE SAVED."
- Romans 10:16 However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, "LORD <2962 kurios>, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?"
- Romans 11:3 "Lord **<2962 kurios>**, THEY HAVE KILLED YOUR PROPHETS, THEY HAVE TORN DOWN YOUR ALTARS, AND I ALONE AM LEFT, AND THEY ARE SEEKING MY LIFE."
- Romans 11:34 For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>, OR WHO BECAME HIS COUNSELOR?
- Romans 12:11 not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord <2962 kurios>;
- Romans 12:19 Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath *of God*, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord **<2962 kurios**>.
- Romans 13:14 But put on the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to *its* lusts.
- Romans 14:4 Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master <2962 kurios> he stands or falls; and he will stand, for the Lord <2962 kurios> is able to make him stand.
- Romans 14:6 He who observes the day, observes it for the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, and he who eats, does so for the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, for he gives thanks to God; and he who eats not, for the Lord **<2962 kurios>** he does not eat, and gives thanks to God.
- Romans 14:8 for if we live, we live for the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, or if we die, we die for the Lord **<2962 kurios>**; therefore whether we live or die, we are the Lord's **<2962 kurios>**.
- Romans 14:11 For it is written, "AS I LIVE, SAYS THE LORD <2962 kurios>, EVERY KNEE SHALL BOW TO ME, AND EVERY TONGUE SHALL GIVE PRAISE TO GOD."
- Romans 14:14 I know and am convinced in the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus that nothing is unclean in itself; but to him who thinks anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean.
- Romans 15:6 so that with one accord you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- Romans 15:11 And again, "PRAISE THE LORD <2962 kurios> ALL YOU GENTILES, AND LET ALL THE PEOPLES PRAISE HIM."
- Romans 15:30 Now I urge you, brethren, by our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God for me,
- Romans 16:2 that you receive her in the Lord <2962 kurios> in a manner worthy of the saints, and that you help her in whatever matter she may have need of you; for she herself has also been a helper of many, and of myself as well.
- Romans 16:8 Greet Ampliatus, my beloved in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 16:11 Greet Herodion, my kinsman. Greet those of the household of Narcissus, who are in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 16:12 Greet Tryphaena and Tryphosa, workers in the Lord <2962 kurios>. Greet Persis the beloved, who has worked hard in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 16:13 Greet Rufus, a choice man in the Lord <2962 kurios>, also his mother and mine.

- Romans 16:18 For such men are slaves, not of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting.
- Romans 16:20 The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus be with you.
- Romans 16:20 The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus be with you.
- Romans 16:22 I, Tertius, who write this letter, greet you in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Romans 16:24 [[The grace of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.]]
- 1 Corinthians 1:2 To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus, saints by calling, with all who in every place call on the name of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, their *Lord* and ours:
- 1 Corinthians 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 1:7 so that you are not lacking in any gift, awaiting eagerly the revelation of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ,
- 1 Corinthians 1:8 who will also confirm you to the end, blameless in the day of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- 1 Corinthians 1:31 so that, just as it is written, "LET HIM WHO BOASTS, BOAST IN THE LORD <2962 kurios>."
- 1 Corinthians 2:8 *the wisdom* which none of the rulers of this age has understood; for if they had understood it they would not have crucified the Lord <2962 kurios> of glory;
- 1 Corinthians 2:16 For WHO HAS KNOWN THE MIND OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>, THAT HE WILL INSTRUCT HIM? But we have the mind of Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 3:5 What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord <2962 kurios> gave *opportunity* to each one.
- 1 Corinthians 3:20 and again, "THE LORD <2962 kurios> KNOWS THE REASONINGS of the wise, THAT THEY ARE USELESS."
- 1 Corinthians 4:4 For I am conscious of nothing against myself, yet I am not by this acquitted; but the one who examines me is the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 4:5 Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, *but wait* until the Lord <2962 kurios> comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of *men*'s hearts; and then each man's praise will come to him from God.
- 1 Corinthians 4:17 For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, who is my beloved and faithful child in the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, and he will remind you of my ways which are in Christ, just as I teach everywhere in every church.
- 1 Corinthians 4:19 But I will come to you soon, if the Lord <2962 kurios> wills, and I shall find out, not the words of those who are arrogant but their power.
- 1 Corinthians 5:4 In the name of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, when you are assembled, and I with you in spirit, with the power of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus,

- 1 Corinthians 5:5 *I have decided* to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 6:11 Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.
- 1 Corinthians 6:13 Food is for the stomach and the stomach is for food, but God will do away with both of them. Yet the body is not for immorality, but for the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, and the Lord **<2962 kurios>** is for the body.
- 1 Corinthians 6:14 Now God has not only raised the Lord <2962 kurios>, but will also raise us up through His power.
- 1 Corinthians 6:17 But the one who joins himself to the Lord **<2962 kurios>** is one spirit *with Him*.
- 1 Corinthians 7:10 But to the married I give instructions, not I, but the Lord <2962 kurios>, that the wife should not leave her husband
- 1 Corinthians 7:12 But to the rest I say, not the Lord <2962 kurios>, that if any brother has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, he must not divorce her.
- 1 Corinthians 7:17 Only, as the Lord <2962 kurios> has assigned to each one, as God has called each, in this manner let him walk. And so I direct in all the churches.
- 1 Corinthians 7:22 For he who was called in the Lord **<2962 kurios>** while a slave, is the Lord's **<2962 kurios>** freedman; likewise he who was called while free, is Christ's slave.
- 1 Corinthians 7:25 Now concerning virgins I have no command of the Lord <2962 kurios>, but I give an opinion as one who by the mercy of the Lord <2962 kurios> is trustworthy.
- 1 Corinthians 7:32 But I want you to be free from concern. One who is unmarried is concerned about the things of the Lord <2962 kurios>, how he may please the Lord <2962 kurios>;
- 1 Corinthians 7:34 and *his interests* are divided. The woman who is unmarried, and the virgin, is concerned about the things of the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, that she may be holy both in body and spirit; but one who is married is concerned about the things of the world, how she may please her husband.
- 1 Corinthians 7:35 This I say for your own benefit; not to put a restraint upon you, but to promote what is appropriate and *to secure* undistracted devotion to the Lord **<2962 kurios>**.
- 1 Corinthians 7:39 A wife is bound as long as her husband lives; but if her husband is dead, she is free to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 8:5 For even if there are so-called gods whether in heaven or on earth, as indeed there are many gods and many lords <2962 kurios>,
- 1 Corinthians 8:6 yet for us there is *but* one God, the Father, from whom are all things and we *exist* for Him; and one Lord **<2962 kurios>**, Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we *exist* through Him.
- 1 Corinthians 9:1 Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord **<2962 kurios**>? Are you not my work in the Lord **<2962** kurios>?
- 1 Corinthians 9:2 If to others I am not an apostle, at least I am to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 9:5 Do we not have a right to take along a believing wife, even as the rest of the apostles and the brothers of the Lord <2962 kurios> and Cephas?
- 1 Corinthians 9:14 So also the Lord <2962 kurios> directed those who proclaim the gospel to get their living from the gospel.

- 1 Corinthians 10:9 Nor let us try the Lord <2962 kurios>, as some of them did, and were destroyed by the serpents.
- 1 Corinthians 10:21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord <2962 kurios> and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of the table of the Lord <2962 kurios> and the table of demons.
- 1 Corinthians 10:22 Or do we provoke the Lord <2962 kurios> to jealousy? We are not stronger than He, are we?
- 1 Corinthians 10:26 FOR THE EARTH IS THE LORD'S **<2962 kurios>**, AND ALL IT CONTAINS.
- 1 Corinthians 11:11 However, in the Lord <2962 kurios>, neither is woman independent of man, nor is man independent of woman.
- 1 Corinthians 11:23 For I received from the Lord <2962 kurios> that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread;
- 1 Corinthians 11:26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's <2962 kurios> death until He comes.
- 1 Corinthians 11:27 Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord <2962 kurios> in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 11:32 But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord <2962 kurios> so that we will not be condemned along with the world.
- 1 Corinthians 12:3 Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord **<2962 kurios**>," except by the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 12:5 And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 14:21 In the Law it is written, "BY MEN OF STRANGE TONGUES AND BY THE LIPS OF STRANGERS I WILL SPEAK TO THIS PEOPLE, AND EVEN SO THEY WILL NOT LISTEN TO ME," says the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 14:37 If anyone thinks he is a prophet or spiritual, let him recognize that the things which I write to you are the Lord's <2962 kurios> commandment.
- 1 Corinthians 15:31 I affirm, brethren, by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>, I die daily.
- 1 Corinthians 15:57 but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord **<2962 kurios**> Jesus Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord <2962 kurios>, knowing that your toil is not *in* vain in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Corinthians 16:7 For I do not wish to see you now *just* in passing; for I hope to remain with you for some time, if the Lord <2962 kurios> permits.
- 1 Corinthians 16:10 Now if Timothy comes, see that he is with you without cause to be afraid, for he is doing the Lord's <2962 kurios> work, as I also am.
- 1 Corinthians 16:19 The churches of Asia greet you. Aquila and Prisca greet you heartily in the Lord <2962 kurios>, with the church that is in their house.
- 1 Corinthians 16:22 If anyone does not love the Lord <2962 kurios>, he is to be accursed. Maranatha.
- 1 Corinthians 16:23 The grace of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus be with you.

- 2 Corinthians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,
- 2 Corinthians 1:14 just as you also partially did understand us, that we are your reason to be proud as you also are ours, in the day of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.
- 2 Corinthians 2:12 Now when I came to Troas for the gospel of Christ and when a door was opened for me in the Lord <2962 kurios>,
- 2 Corinthians 3:16 but whenever a person turns to the Lord <2962 kurios>, the veil is taken away.
- 2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord **<2962 kurios>** is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** is, *there* is liberty.
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord <2962 kurios>, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord <2962 kurios>, the Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 4:5 For we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord <2962 kurios>, and ourselves as your bond-servants for Jesus' sake.
- 2 Corinthians 4:14 knowing that He who raised the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and will present us with you.
- 2 Corinthians 5:6 Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord <2962 kurios>—
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 2 Corinthians 5:11 Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord <2962 kurios>, we persuade men, but we are made manifest to God; and I hope that we are made manifest also in your consciences.
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 "Therefore, COME OUT FROM THEIR MIDST AND BE SEPARATE," says the Lord <2962 kurios>. "AND DO NOT TOUCH WHAT IS UNCLEAN; And I will welcome you.
- 2 Corinthians 6:18 "And I will be a father to you, And you shall be sons and daughters to Me," Says the Lord <2962 kurios> Almighty.
- 2 Corinthians 8:5 and *this*, not as we had expected, but they first gave themselves to the Lord **<2962 kurios>** and to us by the will of God.
- 2 Corinthians 8:9 For you know the grace of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich.
- 2 Corinthians 8:19 and not only *this*, but he has also been appointed by the churches to travel with us in this gracious work, which is being administered by us for the glory of the Lord <2962 kurios> Himself, and *to show* our readiness,
- 2 Corinthians 8:21 for we have regard for what is honorable, not only in the sight of the Lord <2962 kurios>, but also in the sight of men.
- 2 Corinthians 10:8 For even if I boast somewhat further about our authority, which the Lord <2962 kurios> gave for building you up and not for destroying you, I will not be put to shame,
- 2 Corinthians 10:17 But HE WHO BOASTS IS TO BOAST IN THE LORD <2962 kurios>.

- 2 Corinthians 10:18 For it is not he who commends himself that is approved, but he whom the Lord <2962 kurios> commends.
- 2 Corinthians 11:17 What I am saying, I am not saying as the Lord <2962 kurios> would, but as in foolishness, in this confidence of boasting.
- 2 Corinthians 11:31 The God and Father of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus, He who is blessed forever, knows that I am not lying.
- 2 Corinthians 12:1 Boasting is necessary, though it is not profitable; but I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 2 Corinthians 12:8 Concerning this I implored the Lord <2962 kurios> three times that it might leave me.
- 2 Corinthians 13:10 For this reason I am writing these things while absent, so that when present I *need* not use severity, in accordance with the authority which the Lord <2962 kurios> gave me for building up and not for tearing down.
- 2 Corinthians 13:14 The grace of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all.
- Galatians 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ,
- Galatians 1:19 But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's <2962 kurios> brother.
- Galatians 4:1 Now I say, as long as the heir is a child, he does not differ at all from a slave although he is owner <2962 kurios> of everything,
- Galatians 5:10 I have confidence in you in the Lord <2962 kurios> that you will adopt no other view; but the one who is disturbing you will bear his judgment, whoever he is.
- Galatians 6:14 But may it never be that I would boast, except in the cross of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.
- Galatians 6:18 The grace of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brethren. Amen.
- Ephesians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- Ephesians 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,
- Ephesians 1:15 For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus which *exists* among you and your love for all the saints,
- Ephesians 1:17 that the God of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.
- Ephesians 2:21 in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord <2962 kurios>,
- Ephesians 3:11 *This was* in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord **<2962 kurios>**,
- Ephesians 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,
- Ephesians 4:5 one Lord <2962 kurios>, one faith, one baptism,
- Ephesians 4:17 So this I say, and affirm together with the Lord <2962 kurios>, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind,

- Ephesians 5:8 for you were formerly darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord <2962 kurios>; walk as children of Light
- Ephesians 5:10 trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Ephesians 5:17 So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord <2962 kurios> is.
- Ephesians 5:19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord <2962 kurios>;
- Ephesians 5:20 always giving thanks for all things in the name of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ to God, even the Father;
- Ephesians 5:22 Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord <2962 kurios>, for this is right.
- Ephesians 6:4 Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Ephesians 6:5 Slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters <2962 kurios> according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, as to Christ;
- Ephesians 6:7 With good will render service, as to the Lord <2962 kurios>, and not to men,
- Ephesians 6:8 knowing that whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord <2962 kurios>, whether slave or free.
- Ephesians 6:9 And masters <2962 kurios>, do the same things to them, and give up threatening, knowing that both their Master <2962 kurios> and yours is in heaven, and there is no partiality with Him.
- Ephesians 6:10 Finally, be strong in the Lord <2962 kurios> and in the strength of His might.
- Ephesians 6:21 But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus, the beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord <2962 kurios>, will make everything known to you.
- Ephesians 6:23 Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- Ephesians 6:24 Grace be with all those who love our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ with incorruptible *love*.
- Philippians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- Philippians 1:14 and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord <2962 kurios> because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.
- Philippians 2:11 and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord <2962 kurios>, to the glory of God the Father.
- Philippians 2:19 But I hope in the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, so that I also may be encouraged when I learn of your condition.
- Philippians 2:24 and I trust in the Lord <2962 kurios> that I myself also will be coming shortly.
- Philippians 2:29 Receive him then in the Lord <2962 kurios> with all joy, and hold men like him in high regard;
- Philippians 3:1 Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord **<2962 kurios>**. To write the same things *again* is no trouble to me, and it is a safeguard for you.
- Philippians 3:8 More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord <2962 kurios>, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ,

- Philippians 3:20 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ;
- Philippians 4:1 Therefore, my beloved brethren whom I long *to see*, my joy and crown, in this way stand firm in the Lord <2962 kurios>, my beloved.
- Philippians 4:2 I urge Euodia and I urge Syntyche to live in harmony in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord <2962 kurios> always; again I will say, rejoice!
- Philippians 4:5 Let your gentle *spirit* be known to all men. The Lord <2962 kurios> is near.
- Philippians 4:10 But I rejoiced in the Lord <2962 kurios> greatly, that now at last you have revived your concern for me; indeed, you were concerned *before*, but you lacked opportunity.
- Philippians 4:23 The grace of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ be with your spirit.
- Colossians 1:3 We give thanks to God, the Father of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, praying always for you,
- Colossians 1:10 so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord <2962 kurios>, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;
- Colossians 2:6 Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord <2962 kurios>, so walk in Him,
- Colossians 3:13 bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord <2962 kurios> forgave you, so also should you.
- Colossians 3:17 Whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.
- Colossians 3:18 Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Colossians 3:20 Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Colossians 3:22 Slaves, in all things obey those who are your masters **<2962 kurios>** on earth, not with external service, as those who *merely* please men, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord **<2962 kurios>**.
- Colossians 3:23 Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord <2962 kurios> rather than for men,
- Colossians 3:24 knowing that from the Lord <2962 kurios> you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord <2962 kurios> Christ whom you serve.
- Colossians 4:1 Masters <2962 kurios>, grant to your slaves justice and fairness, knowing that you too have a Master <2962 kurios> in heaven.
- Colossians 4:7 As to all my affairs, Tychicus, *our* beloved brother and faithful servant and fellow bond-servant in the Lord <2962 kurios>, will bring you information.
- Colossians 4:17 Say to Archippus, "Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord <2962 kurios>, that you may fulfill it."
- 1 Thessalonians 1:1 Paul and Silvanus and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:3 constantly bearing in mind your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ in the presence of our God and Father,
- 1 Thessalonians 1:6 You also became imitators of us and of the Lord <2962 kurios>, having received the word in much tribulation with the joy of the Holy Spirit,

- 1 Thessalonians 1:8 For the word of the Lord <2962 kurios> has sounded forth from you, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith toward God has gone forth, so that we have no need to say anything.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:15 who both killed the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus and the prophets, and drove us out. They are not pleasing to God, but hostile to all men,
- 1 Thessalonians 2:19 For who is our hope or joy or crown of exultation? Is it not even you, in the presence of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus at His coming?
- 1 Thessalonians 3:8 for now we *really* live, if you stand firm in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:11 Now may our God and Father Himself and Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios> direct our way to you;
- 1 Thessalonians 3:12 and may the Lord <2962 kurios> cause you to increase and abound in love for one another, and for all people, just as we also *do* for you;
- 1 Thessalonians 3:13 so that He may establish your hearts without blame in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus with all His saints.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1 Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus, that as you received from us *instruction* as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:2 For you know what commandments we gave you by *the authority of* the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:6 *and* that no man transgress and defraud his brother in the matter because the Lord **<2962 kurios>** is *the* avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned *you*.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord **<2962 kurios>**, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:16 For the Lord **<2962 kurios>** Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:17 Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord **<2962 kurios>** in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord **<2962 kurios>**.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:2 For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** will come just like a thief in the night.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ,
- 1 Thessalonians 5:12 But we request of you, brethren, that you appreciate those who diligently labor among you, and have charge over you in the Lord <2962 kurios> and give you instruction,
- 1 Thessalonians 5:23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:27 I adjure you by the Lord **<2962 kurios>** to have this letter read to all the brethren.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:28 The grace of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ be with you.

- 2 Thessalonians 1:1 Paul and Silvanus and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ:
- 2 Thessalonians 1:2 Grace to you and peace from God the Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:7 and *to give* relief to you who are afflicted and to us as well when the Lord <**2962 kurios>** Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire,
- 2 Thessalonians 1:8 dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.
- 2 Thessalonians 1:9 These will pay the penalty of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord <2962 kurios> and from the glory of His power,
- 2 Thessalonians 1:12 so that the name of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus will be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and *the* Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:1 Now we request you, brethren, with regard to the coming of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him,
- 2 Thessalonians 2:2 that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord <2962 kurios> has come.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:8 Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord <2962 kurios> will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming;
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord <2962 kurios>, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:14 It was for this He called you through our gospel, that you may gain the glory of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:16 Now may our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who has loved us and given us eternal comfort and good hope by grace,
- 2 Thessalonians 3:1 Finally, brethren, pray for us that the word of the Lord <2962 kurios> will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as *it did* also with you;
- 2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord <2962 kurios> is faithful, and He will strengthen and protect you from the evil *one*.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:4 We have confidence in the Lord <2962 kurios> concerning you, that you are doing and will *continue to* do what we command.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:5 May the Lord <2962 kurios> direct your hearts into the love of God and into the steadfastness of Christ.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:6 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, that you keep away from every brother who leads an unruly life and not according to the tradition which you received from us.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:12 Now such persons we command and exhort in the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ to work in quiet fashion and eat their own bread.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:16 Now may the Lord <2962 kurios> of peace Himself continually grant you peace in every circumstance. The Lord <2962 kurios> be with you all!
- 2 Thessalonians 3:18 The grace of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ be with you all.
- 1 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, *my* true child in *the* faith: Grace, mercy *and* peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>.

- 1 Timothy 1:12 I thank Christ Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service,
- 1 Timothy 1:14 and the grace of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** was more than abundant, with the faith and love which are *found* in Christ Jesus.
- 1 Timothy 6:3 If anyone advocates a different doctrine and does not agree with sound words, those of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, and with the doctrine conforming to godliness,
- 1 Timothy 6:14 that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach until the appearing of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ,
- 1 Timothy 6:15 which He will bring about at the proper time—He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord <2962 kurios> of lords,
- 2 Timothy 1:2 To Timothy, my beloved son: Grace, mercy *and* peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 2 Timothy 1:8 Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** or of me His prisoner, but join with *me* in suffering for the gospel according to the power of God,
- 2 Timothy 1:16 The Lord <2962 kurios> grant mercy to the house of Onesiphorus, for he often refreshed me and was not ashamed of my chains;
- 2 Timothy 1:18 the Lord <2962 kurios> grant to him to find mercy from the Lord <2962 kurios> on that day—and you know very well what services he rendered at Ephesus.
- 2 Timothy 2:7 Consider what I say, for the Lord <2962 kurios> will give you understanding in everything.
- 2 Timothy 2:19 Nevertheless, the firm foundation of God stands, having this seal, "The Lord <2962 kurios> knows those who are His," and, "Everyone who names the name of the Lord <2962 kurios> is to abstain from wickedness."
- 2 Timothy 2:22 Now flee from youthful lusts and pursue righteousness, faith, love *and* peace, with those who call on the Lord <2962 kurios> from a pure heart.
- 2 Timothy 2:24 The Lord's <2962 kurios> bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged,
- 2 Timothy 3:11 persecutions, *and* sufferings, such as happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium *and* at Lystra; what persecutions I endured, and out of them all the Lord <2962 kurios> rescued me!
- 2 Timothy 4:8 in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord <2962 kurios>, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.
- 2 Timothy 4:14 Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm; the Lord <2962 kurios> will repay him according to his deeds.
- 2 Timothy 4:17 But the Lord **<2962 kurios>** stood with me and strengthened me, so that through me the proclamation might be fully accomplished, and that all the Gentiles might hear; and I was rescued out of the lion's mouth.
- 2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord <2962 kurios> will rescue me from every evil deed, and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom; to Him *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
- 2 Timothy 4:22 The Lord <2962 kurios> be with your spirit. Grace be with you.
- Philemon 1:3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.

- Philemon 1:5 because I hear of your love and of the faith which you have toward the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus and toward all the saints;
- Philemon 1:16 no longer as a slave, but more than a slave, a beloved brother, especially to me, but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- Philemon 1:20 Yes, brother, let me benefit from you in the Lord <2962 kurios>; refresh my heart in Christ.
- Philemon 1:25 The grace of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ be with your spirit.
- Hebrews 1:10 And, "YOU, LORD <2962 kurios>, IN THE BEGINNING LAID THE FOUNDATION OF THE EARTH, AND THE HEAVENS ARE THE WORKS OF YOUR HANDS:
- Hebrews 2:3 how will we escape if we neglect so great a salvation? After it was at the first spoken through the Lord <2962 kurios>, it was confirmed to us by those who heard,
- Hebrews 7:14 For it is evident that our Lord <2962 kurios> was descended from Judah, a tribe with reference to which Moses spoke nothing concerning priests.
- Hebrews 7:21 (for they indeed became priests without an oath, but He with an oath through the One who said to Him, "THE LORD <2962 kurios> HAS SWORN AND WILL NOT CHANGE HIS MIND, 'YOU ARE A PRIEST FOREVER'");
- Hebrews 8:2 a minister in the sanctuary and in the true tabernacle, which the Lord <2962 kurios> pitched, not man.
- Hebrews 8:8 For finding fault with them, He says, "BEHOLD, DAYS ARE COMING, SAYS THE LORD **<2962 kurios>**, WHEN I WILL EFFECT A NEW COVENANT WITH THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL AND WITH THE HOUSE OF JUDAH;
- Hebrews 8:9 NOT LIKE THE COVENANT WHICH I MADE WITH THEIR FATHERS ON THE DAY WHEN I TOOK THEM BY THE HAND TO LEAD THEM OUT OF THE LAND OF EGYPT; FOR THEY DID NOT CONTINUE IN MY COVENANT, AND I DID NOT CARE FOR THEM, SAYS THE LORD <2962 kurios>.
- Hebrews 8:10 "FOR THIS IS THE COVENANT THAT I WILL MAKE WITH THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL AFTER THOSE DAYS, SAYS THE LORD <2962 kurios>: I WILL PUT MY LAWS INTO THEIR MINDS, AND I WILL WRITE THEM ON THEIR HEARTS. AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD, AND THEY SHALL BE MY PEOPLE.
- Hebrews 8:11 "AND THEY SHALL NOT TEACH EVERYONE HIS FELLOW CITIZEN, AND EVERYONE HIS BROTHER, SAYING, 'KNOW THE LORD <2962 kurios>,' FOR ALL WILL KNOW ME, FROM THE LEAST TO THE GREATEST OF THEM.
- Hebrews 10:16 "THIS IS THE COVENANT THAT I WILL MAKE WITH THEM AFTER THOSE DAYS, SAYS THE LORD <2962 kurios>: I WILL PUT MY LAWS UPON THEIR HEART, AND ON THEIR MIND I WILL WRITE THEM," *He then says,*
- Hebrews 10:30 For we know Him who said, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY." And again, "THE LORD <2962 kurios> WILL JUDGE HIS PEOPLE."
- Hebrews 12:5 and you have forgotten the exhortation which is addressed to you as sons, "MY SON, DO NOT REGARD LIGHTLY THE DISCIPLINE OF THE LORD <2962 kurios>, NOR FAINT WHEN YOU ARE REPROVED BY HIM;
- Hebrews 12:6 FOR THOSE WHOM THE LORD <2962 kurios> LOVES HE DISCIPLINES, AND HE SCOURGES EVERY SON WHOM HE RECEIVES."
- Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord <2962 kurios>.

- Hebrews 13:6 so that we confidently say, "THE LORD <2962 kurios> IS MY HELPER, I WILL NOT BE AFRAID. WHAT WILL MAN DO TO ME?"
- Hebrews 13:20 Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord **<2962 kurios**>,
- James 1:1 James, a bond-servant of God and of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes who are dispersed abroad: Greetings.
- James 1:7 For that man ought not to expect that he will receive anything from the Lord <2962 kurios>,
- James 2:1 My brethren, do not hold your faith in our glorious Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ with *an attitude of* personal favoritism.
- James 3:9 With it we bless *our* Lord **<2962 kurios>** and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the likeness of God;
- James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord <2962 kurios>, and He will exalt you.
- James 4:15 Instead, *you ought* to say, "If the Lord <2962 kurios> wills, we will live and also do this or that."
- James 5:4 Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, *and* which has been withheld by you, cries out *against you;* and the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord **<2962 kurios>** of Sabaoth.
- James 5:7 Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord <2962 kurios>. The farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being patient about it, until it gets the early and late rains.
- James 5:8 You too be patient; strengthen your hearts, for the coming of the Lord <2962 kurios> is near.
- James 5:10 As an example, brethren, of suffering and patience, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- James 5:11 We count those blessed who endured. You have heard of the endurance of Job and have seen the outcome of the Lord's <2962 kurios> dealings, that the Lord <2962 kurios> is full of compassion and *is* merciful.
- James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? *Then* he must call for the elders of the church and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord <2962 kurios>;
- James 5:15 and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord <2962 kurios> will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him.
- 1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
- 1 Peter 1:25 BUT THE WORD OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> ENDURES FOREVER." And this is the word which was preached to you.
- 1 Peter 2:3 if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 1 Peter 2:13 Submit yourselves for the Lord's <2962 kurios> sake to every human institution, whether to a king as the one in authority,
- 1 Peter 3:6 just as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord <2962 kurios>, and you have become her children if you do what is right without being frightened by any fear.

- 1 Peter 3:12 "FOR THE EYES OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> ARE TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS, AND HIS EARS ATTEND TO THEIR PRAYER, BUT THE FACE OF THE LORD <2962 kurios> IS AGAINST THOSE WHO DO EVIL."
- 1 Peter 3:15 but sanctify Christ as Lord **<2962 kurios>** in your hearts, always *being* ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence;
- 2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord <2962 kurios>;
- 2 Peter 1:8 For if these *qualities* are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ.
- 2 Peter 1:11 for in this way the entrance into the eternal kingdom of our Lord <2962 kurios> and Savior Jesus Christ will be abundantly supplied to you.
- 2 Peter 1:14 knowing that the laying aside of my *earthly* dwelling is imminent, as also our Lord **<2962 kurios>** Jesus Christ has made clear to me.
- 2 Peter 1:16 For we did not follow cleverly devised tales when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty.
- 2 Peter 2:9 *then* the Lord <2962 kurios> knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment,
- 2 Peter 2:11 whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord <2962 kurios>.
- 2 Peter 2:20 For if, after they have escaped the defilements of the world by the knowledge of the Lord <2962 kurios> and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and are overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first.
- 2 Peter 3:2 that you should remember the words spoken beforehand by the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord <2962 kurios> and Savior *spoken* by your apostles.
- 2 Peter 3:8 But do not let this one *fact* escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord **<2962 kurios>** one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day.
- 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord <2962 kurios> is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.
- 2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord <2962 kurios> will come like a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a roar and the elements will be destroyed with intense heat, and the earth and its works will be burned up.
- 2 Peter 3:15 and regard the patience of our Lord <2962 kurios> *as* salvation; just as also our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you,
- 2 Peter 3:18 but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord <2962 kurios> and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him *be* the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.
- Jude 1:4 For certain persons have crept in unnoticed, those who were long beforehand marked out for this condemnation, ungodly persons who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and deny our only Master and Lord <2962 kurios>, Jesus Christ.
- Jude 1:5 Now I desire to remind you, though you know all things once for all, that the Lord<2962 kurios>, after saving a people out of the land of Egypt, subsequently destroyed those who did not believe.

- Jude 1:9 But Michael the archangel, when he disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses, did not dare pronounce against him a railing judgment, but said, "The Lord <2962 kurios> rebuke you!"
- Jude 1:14 *It was* also about these men *that* Enoch, *in* the seventh *generation* from Adam, prophesied, saying, "Behold, the Lord <2962 kurios> came with many thousands of His holy ones,
- Jude 1:17 But you, beloved, ought to remember the words that were spoken beforehand by the apostles of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ,
- Jude 1:21 keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus Christ to eternal life.
- Jude 1:25 to the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord <2962 kurios>, *be* glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.
- Revelation 1:8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord <2962 kurios> God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."
- Revelation 4:8 And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say, "HOLY, HOLY, HOLY *is* THE LORD **<2962 kurios>** GOD, THE ALMIGHTY, WHO WAS AND WHO IS AND WHO IS TO COME."
- Revelation 4:11 "Worthy are You, our Lord <2962 kurios> and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they existed, and were created."
- Revelation 7:14 I said to him, "My lord <2962 kurios>, you know." And he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- Revelation 11:4 These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands that stand before the Lord <2962 kurios> of the earth.
- Revelation 11:8 And their dead bodies *will lie* in the street of the great city which mystically is called Sodom and Egypt, where also their Lord <2962 kurios> was crucified.
- Revelation 11:15 Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become *the kingdom* of our Lord **<2962 kurios>** and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever."
- Revelation 11:17 saying, "We give You thanks, O Lord <2962 kurios> God, the Almighty, who are and who were, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign.
- Revelation 14:13 And I heard a voice from heaven, saying, "Write, 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord <2962 kurios> from now on!'" "Yes," says the Spirit, "so that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow with them."
- Revelation 15:3 And they *sang the song of Moses, the bond-servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, "Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord <2962 kurios> God, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations!
- Revelation 15:4 "Who will not fear, O Lord **<2962 kurios>**, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy; For ALL THE NATIONS WILL COME AND WORSHIP BEFORE YOU, FOR YOUR RIGHTEOUS ACTS HAVE BEEN REVEALED."
- Revelation 16:7 And I heard the altar saying, "Yes, O Lord <2962 kurios> God, the Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments."

- Revelation 17:14 "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord <2962 kurios> of lords <2962 kurios> and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful."
- Revelation 18:8 "For this reason in one day her plagues will come, pestilence and mourning and famine, and she will be burned up with fire; for the Lord <2962 kurios> God who judges her is strong.
- Revelation 19:6 Then I heard *something* like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, "Hallelujah! For the Lord <2962 kurios> our God, the Almighty, reigns.
- Revelation 19:16 And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD <2962 kurios> OF LORDS <2962 kurios>."
- Revelation 21:22 I saw no temple in it, for the Lord <2962 kurios> God the Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.
- Revelation 22:5 And there will no longer be *any* night; and they will not have need of the light of a lamp nor the light of the sun, because the Lord <2962 kurios> God will illumine them; and they will reign forever and ever.
- Revelation 22:6 And he said to me, "These words are faithful and true"; and the Lord <2962 kurios>, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel to show to His bond-servants the things which must soon take place.
- Revelation 22:20 He who testifies to these things says, "Yes, I am coming quickly." Amen. Come, Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus.

Revelation 22:21 The grace of the Lord <2962 kurios> Jesus be with all. Amen.
