- Isaiah 23:4 Be ashamed <0954 buwsh>, O Sidon; For the sea speaks, the stronghold of the sea, saying, "I have neither travailed nor given birth, I have neither brought up young men *nor* reared virgins."

- Isaiah 42:17 They will be turned back *and* be utterly put to shame <0954 buwsh>, Who trust in idols, Who say to molten images, "You are our gods."
- Isaiah 44:9 Those who fashion a graven image are all of them futile, and their precious things are of no profit; even their own witnesses fail to see or know, so that they will be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**.
- Isaiah 44:11 Behold, all his companions will be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**, for the craftsmen themselves are mere men. Let them all assemble themselves, let them stand up, let them tremble, let them together be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**.
- Isaiah 45:16 They will be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>** and even humiliated, all of them; The manufacturers of idols will go away together in humiliation.

- **Isaiah 49:23** "Kings will be your guardians, And their princesses your nurses. They will bow down to you with their faces to the earth And lick the dust of your feet; And *you* will know that I am the LORD; Those who hopefully wait for Me will not be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**.

- Jeremiah 10:14 Every man is stupid, devoid of knowledge; Every goldsmith is **put to shame <0954 buwsh>** by his idols; For his molten images are deceitful, And there is no breath in them.
- Jeremiah 12:13 "They have sown wheat and have reaped thorns, They have strained themselves to no profit. But be ashamed <0954 bussl> of your harvest Because of the fierce anger of the LORD."
- Jeremiah 14:3 "Their nobles have sent their servants for water; They have come to the cisterns and found no water. They have returned with their vessels empty; They have **been put to shame <0954 buwsh>** and humiliated, And they cover their heads.
- Jeremiah 14:4 "Because the ground is cracked, For there has been no rain on the land; The farmers have **been put to shame <0954 buwsh>**, They have covered their heads.
- Jeremiah 15:9 "She who bore seven *sons* pines away; Her breathing is labored. Her sun has set while it was yet day; She has **been shamed <0954 buwsh>** and humiliated. So I will give over their survivors to the sword Before their enemies," declares the LORD.
- Jeremiah 17:13 O LORD, the hope of Israel, All who forsake You will be put to shame <0954 buwsh>. Those who turn away on earth will be written down, Because they have forsaken the fountain of living water, even the LORD.
- Jeremiah 17:18 Let those who persecute me be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**, but as for me, let me not be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**; Let them be dismayed, but let me not be dismayed. Bring on them a day of disaster, And crush them with twofold destruction!
- Jeremiah 20:11 But the LORD is with me like a dread champion; Therefore my persecutors will stumble and not prevail. They will be utterly **ashamed <0954 buwsh>**, because they have failed, With an everlasting disgrace that will not be forgotten.
- Jeremiah 22:22 "The wind will sweep away all your shepherds, And your lovers will go into captivity; Then you will surely be ashamed <0954 bussl> and humiliated Because of all your wickedness.
- Jeremiah 31:19 'For after I turned back, I repented; And after I was instructed, I smote on *my* thigh; I was ashamed <0954 buwsh> and also humiliated Because I bore the reproach of my youth.'
- Jeremiah 46:24 "The daughter of Egypt has been put to shame <0954 buwsh>, Given over to the power of the people of the north."

- Jeremiah 48:1 Concerning Moab. Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, "Woe to Nebo, for it has been destroyed; Kiriathaim has been put to shame <0954 buwsh>, it has been captured; The lofty stronghold has been put to shame <0954 buwsh> and shattered.
- Jeremiah 48:13 "And Moab will be **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** of Chemosh, as the house of Israel was **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** of Bethel, their confidence.
- Jeremiah 48:20 "Moab has been put to shame <0954 buwsh>, for it has been shattered. Wail and cry out; Declare by the Arnon That Moab has been destroyed.
- Jeremiah 48:39 "How shattered it is! *How* they have wailed! How Moab has turned his back—he is ashamed <0954 buwsh>! So Moab will become a laughingstock and an object of terror to all around him."
- Jeremiah 49:23 Concerning Damascus. "Hamath and Arpad are **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**, For they have heard bad news; They are disheartened. There is anxiety by the sea, It cannot be calmed.
- Jeremiah 50:2 "Declare and proclaim among the nations. Proclaim it and lift up a standard. Do not conceal *it but* say, 'Babylon has been captured, Bel has been put to shame <0954 buwsh>, Marduk has been shattered; Her images have been put to shame <0954 buwsh>, her idols have been shattered.'
- Jeremiah 50:12 Your mother will be greatly ashamed <0954 Duwsh>, She who gave you birth will be humiliated. Behold, *she will be* the least of the nations, A wilderness, a parched land and a desert.
- Jeremiah 51:17 All mankind is stupid, devoid of knowledge; Every goldsmith is **put to shame <0954 buwsh>** by his idols, For his molten images are deceitful, And there is no breath in them.
- Jeremiah 51:47 Therefore behold, days are coming When I will punish the idols of Babylon; And her whole land will be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>** And all her slain will fall in her midst.
- Jeremiah 51:51 We are **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** because we have heard reproach; Disgrace has covered our faces, For aliens have entered The holy places of the LORD'S house.
- Ezekiel 16:52 "Also bear your disgrace in that you have made judgment favorable for your sisters. Because of your sins in which you acted more abominably than they, they are more in the right than you. Yes, be also **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** and bear your disgrace, in that you made your sisters appear righteous.
- Ezekiel 16:63 so that you may remember and be **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** and never open your mouth anymore because of your humiliation, when I have forgiven you for all that you have done," the Lord GOD declares.
- Ezekiel 32:30 "There also are the chiefs of the north, all of them, and all the Sidonians, who in spite of the terror resulting from their might, in shame <0954 buwsh> went down with the slain. So they lay down uncircumcised with those slain by the sword and bore their disgrace with those who go down to the pit.
- Ezekiel 36:32 "I am not doing *this* for your sake," declares the Lord GOD, "let it be known to you. Be **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** and confounded for your ways, O house of Israel!"
- Hosea 2:5 "For their mother has played the harlot; She who conceived them has acted shamefully <0954 **buwsh>**. For she said, 'I will go after my lovers, Who give *me* my bread and my water, My wool and my flax, my oil and my drink.'
- Hosea 4:19 The wind wraps them in its wings, And they will be **ashamed** <0954 **Duwsh**> because of their sacrifices.
- Hosea 10:6 The thing itself will be carried to Assyria As tribute to King Jareb; Ephraim will be seized with shame And Israel will be ashamed <0954 bussle> of its own counsel.
- Hosea 13:15 Though he flourishes among the reeds, An east wind will come, The wind of the LORD coming up from the wilderness; And his fountain will become dry <0954 buwsh> And his spring will be dried up; It will plunder *his* treasury of every precious article.
- Joel 1:11 Be ashamed <0954 buwsh>, O farmers, Wail, O vinedressers, For the wheat and the barley; Because the harvest of the field is destroyed.

- Joel 2:26 "You will have plenty to eat and be satisfied And praise the name of the LORD your God, Who has dealt wondrously with you; Then My people will never be put to shame <0954 buwsh>.
- Joel 2:27 "Thus you will know that I am in the midst of Israel, And that I am the LORD your God, And there is no other; And My people will never be **put to shame <0954 buwsh>**.
- Micah 3:7 The seers will be **ashamed <0954 buwsh>** And the diviners will be embarrassed. Indeed, they will all cover *their* mouths Because there is no answer from God.
- Micah 7:16 Nations will see and be ashamed <0954 **DUWSI**> Of all their might. They will put *their* hand on *their* mouth, Their ears will be deaf.
