Introduction

In the study of the church, we see the Greek word ekklesia (*ek-klay-see'-ah*) has been translated as church and means those called out to assemble. Other terms have also been used to identify born-again or regenerate believers placed in the body of Christ. The terms include Disciple, Elect, Chosen, Christian, Sheep, Believers, Saints and of course Brethren which includes Brothers and Sisters all of which describe the individual and collective members of the body of Christ. We exegete each reference of individual members of the church in the topical bible study section of our church website under ecclesiology. The individual members we will study today are the Brethren, the brothers and sisters in the Lord.

Consistent with God looking at His elect in context of family, often these terms are used to describe brothers and sisters in the Lord and brotherly love for one another. When used in this manner it is inclusive of women much in the same way as man and mankind includes both genders. Family, brothers and sisters are used frequently when referring to the people of God. In fact, God created marriage and family to help us learn about how we are to relate to and with God through family relationships. That helps to explain why marriage and family is such a high-valued target for the adversary.

When used in applying our relationship with God and the family of God, it is meant to illustrate our tight bond and unity in love, spirit, purpose, beliefs and worship. That too has made the family of God a high-valued target for attacks and splintering of the church family as well. Let's begin with our examination of brothers and sisters in the Lord.

- Luke 20:29 "Now there were seven brothers <80 adelphos>; and the first took a wife and died childless;

- Luke 21:16 "But you will be betrayed even by parents and brothers <80 adelphos> and relatives and friends, and they will put *some* of you to death,
- Luke 22:32 but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers <80 adelphos>."
- John 1:40 One of the two who heard John *speak* and followed Him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- John 1:41 He *found first his own brother <80 adelphos> Simon and *said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which translated means Christ).
- John 2:12 After this He went down to Capernaum, He and His mother and *His* brothers **<80 adelphos>** and His disciples; and they stayed there a few days.
- John 6:8 One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother **<80 adelphos>**, *said to Him.
- John 7:3 Therefore His brothers <80 adelphos> said to Him, "Leave here and go into Judea, so that Your disciples also may see Your works which You are doing.
- John 7:5 For not even His brothers <80 adelphos> were believing in Him.
- John 7:10 But when His brothers **<80 adelphos>** had gone up to the feast, then He Himself also went up, not publicly, but as if, in secret.
- John 11:2 It was the Mary who anointed the Lord with ointment, and wiped His feet with her hair, whose brother **<80 adelphos>** Lazarus was sick.
- John 11:19 and many of the Jews had come to Martha and Mary, to console them concerning *their* brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- John 11:21 Martha then said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother **<80** adelphos> would not have died.
- John 11:23 Jesus *said to her, "Your brother <80 adelphos> will rise again."
- John 11:32 Therefore, when Mary came where Jesus was, she saw Him, and fell at His feet, saying to Him, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother <80 adelphos> would not have died."
- John 20:17 Jesus *said to her, "Stop clinging to Me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father; but go to My brethren **<80 adelphos>** and say to them, 'I ascend to My Father and your Father, and My God and your God."
- John 21:23 Therefore this saying went out among the brethren **<80 adelphos>** that that disciple would not die; yet Jesus did not say to him that he would not die, but *only*, "If I want him to remain until I come, what *is that* to you?"
- Acts 1:14 These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with *the* women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers **<80** adelphos>.
- Acts 1:15 At this time Peter stood up in the midst of the brethren <80 adelphos> (a gathering of about one hundred and twenty persons was there together), and said,
- Acts 1:16 "Brethren <80 adelphos>, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit foretold by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus.
- Acts 2:29 "Brethren <80 adelphos>, I may confidently say to you regarding the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day.
- Acts 2:37 Now when they heard *this*, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, what shall we do?"

- Acts 3:17 "And now, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, I know that you acted in ignorance, just as your rulers did also.
- Acts 3:22 "Moses said, 'THE LORD GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN **<80** adelphos>; TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you.
- Acts 6:3 "Therefore, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, select from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task.
- Acts 7:2 And he said, "Hear me, brethren <80 adelphos> and fathers! The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Haran.
- Acts 7:13 "On the second *visit* Joseph made himself known to his brothers **<80 adelphos>**, and Joseph's family was disclosed to Pharaoh.
- Acts 7:23 "But when he was approaching the age of forty, it entered his mind to visit his brethren **<80 adelphos>**, the sons of Israel.
- Acts 7:25 "And he supposed that his brethren **<80 adelphos>** understood that God was granting them deliverance through him, but they did not understand.
- Acts 7:26 "On the following day he appeared to them as they were fighting together, and he tried to reconcile them in peace, saying, 'Men, you are brethren <80 adelphos>, why do you injure one another?'
- Acts 7:37 "This is the Moses who said to the sons of Israel, 'GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM YOUR BRETHREN **<80 adelphos>**.'
- Acts 9:17 So Ananias departed and entered the house, and after laying his hands on him said, "Brother <80 adelphos> Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road by which you were coming, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit."
- Acts 9:30 But when the brethren **<80 adelphos>** learned *of it,* they brought him down to Caesarea and sent him away to Tarsus.
- Acts 10:23 So he invited them in and gave them lodging. And on the next day he got up and went away with them, and some of the brethren **<80 adelphos>** from Joppa accompanied him.
- Acts 11:1 Now the apostles and the brethren **<80 adelphos>** who were throughout Judea heard that the Gentiles also had received the word of God.
- Acts 11:12 "The Spirit told me to go with them without misgivings. These six brethren <80 adelphos> also went with me and we entered the man's house.
- Acts 11:29 And in the proportion that any of the disciples had means, each of them determined to send *a contribution* for the relief of the brethren **<80 adelphos>** living in Judea.
- Acts 12:2 And he had James the brother **<80 adelphos>** of John put to death with a sword.
- Acts 12:17 But motioning to them with his hand to be silent, he described to them how the Lord had led him out of the prison. And he said, "Report these things to James and the brethren **<80 adelphos>**." Then he left and went to another place.
- Acts 13:15 After the reading of the Law and the Prophets the synagogue officials sent to them, saying, "Brethren <80 adelphos>, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say it."

- Acts 13:26 "Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, sons of Abraham's family, and those among you who fear God, to us the message of this salvation has been sent.
- Acts 13:38 "Therefore let it be known to you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, that through Him forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you,
- Acts 14:2 But the Jews who disbelieved stirred up the minds of the Gentiles and embittered them against the brethren **<80 adelphos>**.
- Acts 15:1 Some men came down from Judea and *began* teaching the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, "Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved."
- Acts 15:3 Therefore, being sent on their way by the church, they were passing through both Phoenicia and Samaria, describing in detail the conversion of the Gentiles, and were bringing great joy to all the brethren <80 adelphos>.
- Acts 15:7 After there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles would hear the word of the gospel and believe.
- Acts 15:13 After they had stopped speaking, James answered, saying, "Brethren <80 adelphos>, listen to me.
- Acts 15:22 Then it seemed good to the apostles and the elders, with the whole church, to choose men from among them to send to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas—Judas called Barsabbas, and Silas, leading men among the brethren **<80 adelphos>**,
- Acts 15:23 and they sent this letter by them, "The apostles and the brethren <80 adelphos> who are elders, to the brethren <80 adelphos> in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia who are from the Gentiles, greetings.
- Acts 15:32 Judas and Silas, also being prophets themselves, encouraged and strengthened the brethren **<80 adelphos>** with a lengthy message.
- Acts 15:33 After they had spent time *there*, they were sent away from the brethren **<80 adelphos>** in peace to those who had sent them out.
- Acts 15:36 After some days Paul said to Barnabas, "Let us return and visit the brethren <80 adelphos> in every city in which we proclaimed the word of the Lord, and see how they are."
- Acts 15:40 But Paul chose Silas and left, being committed by the brethren <80 adelphos> to the grace of the Lord.
- Acts 16:2 and he was well spoken of by the brethren **<80 adelphos>** who were in Lystra and Iconium.
- Acts 16:40 They went out of the prison and entered *the house of* Lydia, and when they saw the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, they encouraged them and departed.
- Acts 17:6 When they did not find them, they *began* dragging Jason and some brethren **<80 adelphos>** before the city authorities, shouting, "These men who have upset the world have come here also;
- Acts 17:10 The brethren **<80 adelphos>** immediately sent Paul and Silas away by night to Berea, and when they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews.
- Acts 17:14 Then immediately the brethren **<80 adelphos>** sent Paul out to go as far as the sea; and Silas and Timothy remained there.

- Acts 18:18 Paul, having remained many days longer, took leave of the brethren <80 adelphos> and put out to sea for Syria, and with him were Priscilla and Aquila. In Cenchrea he had his hair cut, for he was keeping a vow.
- Acts 18:27 And when he wanted to go across to Achaia, the brethren <80 adelphos> encouraged him and wrote to the disciples to welcome him; and when he had arrived, he greatly helped those who had believed through grace,
- Acts 21:7 When we had finished the voyage from Tyre, we arrived at Ptolemais, and after greeting the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, we stayed with them for a day.
- Acts 21:17 After we arrived in Jerusalem, the brethren **<80 adelphos>** received us gladly.
- Acts 21:20 And when they heard it they *began* glorifying God; and they said to him, "You see, brother **<80 adelphos>**, how many thousands there are among the Jews of those who have believed, and they are all zealous for the Law;
- Acts 22:1 "Brethren **<80 adelphos>** and fathers, hear my defense which I now *offer* to you."
- Acts 22:5 as also the high priest and all the Council of the elders can testify. From them I also received letters to the brethren <80 adelphos>, and started off for Damascus in order to bring even those who were there to Jerusalem as prisoners to be punished.
- Acts 22:13 came to me, and standing near said to me, 'Brother <80 adelphos> Saul, receive your sight!' And at that very time I looked up at him.
- Acts 23:1 Paul, looking intently at the Council, said, "Brethren <80 adelphos>, I have lived my life with a perfectly good conscience before God up to this day."
- Acts 23:5 And Paul said, "I was not aware, brethren <80 adelphos>, that he was high priest; for it is written, 'YOU SHALL NOT SPEAK EVIL OF A RULER OF YOUR PEOPLE.'"
- Acts 23:6 But perceiving that one group were Sadducees and the other Pharisees, Paul began crying out in the Council, "Brethren <80 adelphos>, I am a Pharisee, a son of Pharisees; I am on trial for the hope and resurrection of the dead!"
- Acts 28:14 There we found *some* brethren **<80 adelphos>**, and were invited to stay with them for seven days; and thus we came to Rome.
- Acts 28:15 And the brethren <80 adelphos>, when they heard about us, came from there as far as the Market of Appius and Three Inns to meet us; and when Paul saw them, he thanked God and took courage.
- Acts 28:17 After three days Paul called together those who were the leading men of the Jews, and when they came together, he *began* saying to them, "Brethren <80 adelphos>, though I had done nothing against our people or the customs of our fathers, yet I was delivered as a prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.
- Acts 28:21 They said to him, "We have neither received letters from Judea concerning you, nor have any of the brethren **<80 adelphos>** come here and reported or spoken anything bad about you.
- Romans 1:13 I do not want you to be unaware, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, that often I have planned to come to you (and have been prevented so far) so that I may obtain some fruit among you also, even as among the rest of the Gentiles.

- Romans 7:1 Or do you not know, brethren **<80 adelphos>** (for I am speaking to those who know the law), that the law has jurisdiction over a person as long as he lives?
- Romans 7:4 Therefore, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, you also were made to die to the Law through the body of Christ, so that you might be joined to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.
- Romans 8:12 So then, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, we are under obligation, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh—
- Romans 8:29 For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to become* conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren **<80** adelphos>;
- Romans 9:3 For I could wish that I myself were accursed, *separated* from Christ for the sake of my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, my kinsmen according to the flesh,
- Romans 10:1 Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, my heart's desire and my prayer to God for them is for *their* salvation.
- Romans 11:25 For I do not want you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;
- Romans 12:1 Therefore I urge you, brethren <80 adelphos>, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship.
- Romans 14:10 But you, why do you judge your brother **<80 adelphos>**? Or you again, why do you regard your brother **<80 adelphos>** with contempt? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God.
- Romans 14:13 Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather determine this—not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's **<80 adelphos>** way.
- Romans 14:15 For if because of food your brother **<80 adelphos>** is hurt, you are no longer walking according to love. Do not destroy with your food him for whom Christ died.
- Romans 14:21 It is good not to eat meat or to drink wine, or *to do anything* by which your brother **<80 adelphos>** stumbles.
- Romans 15:14 And concerning you, my brethren <80 adelphos>, I myself also am convinced that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able also to admonish one another.
- Romans 15:30 Now I urge you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God for me,
- Romans 16:14 Greet Asyncritus, Phlegon, Hermes, Patrobas, Hermas and the brethren <80 adelphos> with them.
- Romans 16:17 Now I urge you, brethren <80 adelphos>, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them.
- Romans 16:23 Gaius, host to me and to the whole church, greets you. Erastus, the city treasurer greets you, and Quartus, the brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- 1 Corinthians 1:1 Paul, called as an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother <80 adelphos>,

- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I exhort you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- 1 Corinthians 1:11 For I have been informed concerning you, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, by Chloe's *people*, that there are quarrels among you.
- 1 Corinthians 1:26 For consider your calling, brethren <80 adelphos>, that there were not many wise according to the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble;
- 1 Corinthians 2:1 And when I came to you, brethren <80 adelphos>, I did not come with superiority of speech or of wisdom, proclaiming to you the testimony of God.
- 1 Corinthians 3:1 And I, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 4:6 Now these things, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, I have figuratively applied to myself and Apollos for your sakes, so that in us you may learn not to exceed what is written, so that no one of you will become arrogant in behalf of one against the other.
- 1 Corinthians 5:11 But actually, I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother **<80 adelphos>** if he is an immoral person, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler—not even to eat with such a one.
- 1 Corinthians 6:5 I say *this* to your shame. *Is it* so, *that* there is not among you one wise man who will be able to decide between his brethren **<80 adelphos>**,
- 1 Corinthians 6:6 but brother **<80 adelphos>** goes to law with brother **<80 adelphos>**, and that before unbelievers?
- 1 Corinthians 6:8 On the contrary, you yourselves wrong and defraud. *You do* this even to *your* brethren **<80 adelphos>**.
- 1 Corinthians 7:12 But to the rest I say, not the Lord, that if any brother <80 adelphos> has a wife who is an unbeliever, and she consents to live with him, he must not divorce her.
- 1 Corinthians 7:14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified through his wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified through her believing <80 adelphos> husband <80 adelphos>; for otherwise your children are unclean, but now they are holy.
- 1 Corinthians 7:15 Yet if the unbelieving one leaves, let him leave; the brother <80 adelphos> or the sister is not under bondage in such *cases*, but God has called us to peace.
- 1 Corinthians 7:24 Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, each one is to remain with God in that *condition* in which he was called.
- 1 Corinthians 7:29 But this I say, brethren <80 adelphos>, the time has been shortened, so that from now on those who have wives should be as though they had none;
- 1 Corinthians 8:11 For through your knowledge he who is weak is ruined, the brother **<80 adelphos>** for whose sake Christ died.
- 1 Corinthians 8:12 And so, by sinning against the brethren <80 adelphos> and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 8:13 Therefore, if food causes my brother **<80 adelphos>** to stumble, I will never eat meat again, so that I will not cause my brother **<80 adelphos>** to stumble.

- 1 Corinthians 9:5 Do we not have a right to take along a believing wife, even as the rest of the apostles and the brothers **<80 adelphos>** of the Lord and Cephas?
- 1 Corinthians 10:1 For I do not want you to be unaware, brethren <80 adelphos>, that our fathers were all under the cloud and all passed through the sea;
- 1 Corinthians 11:33 So then, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, when you come together to eat, wait for one another.
- 1 Corinthians 12:1 Now concerning spiritual *gifts*, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, I do not want you to be unaware.
- 1 Corinthians 14:6 But now, brethren <80 adelphos>, if I come to you speaking in tongues, what will I profit you unless I speak to you either by way of revelation or of knowledge or of prophecy or of teaching?
- 1 Corinthians 14:20 Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, do not be children in your thinking; yet in evil be infants, but in your thinking be mature.
- 1 Corinthians 14:26 What is *the outcome* then, brethren **<80 adelphos>**? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.
- 1 Corinthians 14:39 Therefore, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak in tongues.
- 1 Corinthians 15:1 Now I make known to you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand,
- 1 Corinthians 15:6 After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren <80 adelphos> at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep;
- 1 Corinthians 15:31 I affirm, brethren <80 adelphos>, by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.
- 1 Corinthians 15:50 Now I say this, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.
- 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brethren **<80 adelphos>**, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your toil is not *in* vain in the Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 16:11 So let no one despise him. But send him on his way in peace, so that he may come to me; for I expect him with the brethren **<80 adelphos>**.
- 1 Corinthians 16:12 But concerning Apollos our brother **<80 adelphos>**, I encouraged him greatly to come to you with the brethren **<80 adelphos>**; and it was not at all *his* desire to come now, but he will come when he has opportunity.
- 1 Corinthians 16:15 Now I urge you, brethren <80 adelphos> (you know the household of Stephanas, that they were the first fruits of Achaia, and that they have devoted themselves for ministry to the saints),
- 1 Corinthians 16:20 All the brethren **<80 adelphos>** greet you. Greet one another with a holy kiss.
- 2 Corinthians 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy *our* brother **<80 adelphos>**, To the church of God which is at Corinth with all the saints who are throughout Achaia:
- 2 Corinthians 1:8 For we do not want you to be unaware, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, of our affliction which came *to us* in Asia, that we were burdened excessively, beyond our strength, so that we despaired even of life;

- 2 Corinthians 2:13 I had no rest for my spirit, not finding Titus my brother <80 adelphos>; but taking my leave of them, I went on to Macedonia.
- 2 Corinthians 8:1 Now, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, we *wish to* make known to you the grace of God which has been given in the churches of Macedonia,
- 2 Corinthians 8:18 We have sent along with him the brother **<80 adelphos>** whose fame in *the things of* the gospel *has spread* through all the churches;
- 2 Corinthians 8:22 We have sent with them our brother **<80 adelphos>**, whom we have often tested and found diligent in many things, but now even more diligent because of *his* great confidence in you.
- 2 Corinthians 8:23 As for Titus, *he is* my partner and fellow worker among you; as for our brethren **<80 adelphos>**, *they are* messengers of the churches, a glory to Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 9:3 But I have sent the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, in order that our boasting about you may not be made empty in this case, so that, as I was saying, you may be prepared;
- 2 Corinthians 9:5 So I thought it necessary to urge the brethren <80 adelphos> that they would go on ahead to you and arrange beforehand your previously promised bountiful gift, so that the same would be ready as a bountiful gift and not affected by covetousness.
- 2 Corinthians 11:9 and when I was present with you and was in need, I was not a burden to anyone; for when the brethren **<80 adelphos>** came from Macedonia they fully supplied my need, and in everything I kept myself from being a burden to you, and will continue to do so.
- 2 Corinthians 12:18 I urged Titus *to go,* and I sent the brother **<80 adelphos>** with him. Titus did not take any advantage of you, did he? Did we not conduct ourselves in the same spirit *and walk* in the same steps?
- 2 Corinthians 13:11 Finally, brethren <80 adelphos>, rejoice, be made complete, be comforted, be like-minded, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you.
- Galatians 1:2 and all the brethren **<80 adelphos>** who are with me, To the churches of Galatia:
- Galatians 1:11 For I would have you know, brethren <80 adelphos>, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man.
- Galatians 1:19 But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- Galatians 3:15 Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, I speak in terms of human relations: even though it is *only* a man's covenant, yet when it has been ratified, no one sets it aside or adds conditions to it.
- Galatians 4:12 I beg of you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, become as I *am*, for I also *have become* as you *are*. You have done me no wrong;
- Galatians 4:28 And you brethren <80 adelphos>, like Isaac, are children of promise.
- Galatians 4:31 So then, brethren <80 adelphos>, we are not children of a bondwoman, but of the free woman.
- Galatians 5:11 But I, brethren <80 adelphos>, if I still preach circumcision, why am I still persecuted? Then the stumbling block of the cross has been abolished.

- Galatians 5:13 For you were called to freedom, brethren **<80 adelphos>**; only *do* not *turn* your freedom into an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; *each one* looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted.
- Galatians 6:18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brethren **<80** adelphos>. Amen.
- Ephesians 6:21 But that you also may know about my circumstances, how I am doing, Tychicus, the beloved brother **<80 adelphos>** and faithful minister in the Lord, will make everything known to you.
- Ephesians 6:23 Peace be to the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Philippians 1:12 Now I want you to know, brethren <80 adelphos>, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the gospel,
- Philippians 1:14 and that most of the brethren <80 adelphos>, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.
- Philippians 2:25 But I thought it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother <80 adelphos> and fellow worker and fellow soldier, who is also your messenger and minister to my need:
- Philippians 3:1 Finally, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things *again* is no trouble to me, and it is a safeguard for you.
- Philippians 3:13 Brethren **<80 adelphos>**, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of *it* yet; but one thing *I do:* forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead,
- Philippians 3:17 Brethren <80 adelphos>, join in following my example, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us.
- Philippians 4:1 Therefore, my beloved brethren **<80 adelphos>** whom I long *to see,* my joy and crown, in this way stand firm in the Lord, my beloved.
- Philippians 4:8 Finally, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, dwell on these things.
- Philippians 4:21 Greet every saint in Christ Jesus. The brethren **<80 adelphos>** who are with me greet you.
- Colossians 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy our brother **<80** adelphos>,
- Colossians 1:2 To the saints and faithful brethren <80 adelphos> in Christ who are at Colossae: Grace to you and peace from God our Father.
- Colossians 4:7 As to all my affairs, Tychicus, *our* beloved brother **<80 adelphos>** and faithful servant and fellow bond-servant in the Lord, will bring you information.
- Colossians 4:9 and with him Onesimus, *our* faithful and beloved brother **<80 adelphos>**, who is one of your *number*. They will inform you about the whole situation here.

- Colossians 4:15 Greet the brethren **<80 adelphos>** who are in Laodicea and also Nympha and the church that is in her house.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:4 knowing, brethren **<80 adelphos>** beloved by God, *Hi*s choice of you;
- 1 Thessalonians 2:1 For you yourselves know, brethren <80 adelphos>, that our coming to you was not in vain,
- 1 Thessalonians 2:9 For you recall, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, our labor and hardship, how working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:14 For you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, became imitators of the churches of God in Christ Jesus that are in Judea, for you also endured the same sufferings at the hands of your own countrymen, even as they *did* from the Jews,
- 1 Thessalonians 2:17 But we, brethren <80 adelphos>, having been taken away from you for a short while—in person, not in spirit—were all the more eager with great desire to see your face.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:2 and we sent Timothy, our brother <80 adelphos> and God's fellow worker in the gospel of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you as to your faith.
- 1 Thessalonians 3:7 for this reason, brethren <80 adelphos>, in all our distress and affliction we were comforted about you through your faith;
- 1 Thessalonians 4:1 Finally then, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us *instruction* as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:6 and that no man transgress and defraud his brother **<80** adelphos> in the matter because the Lord is *the* avenger in all these things, just as we also told you before and solemnly warned *you*.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:10 for indeed you do practice it toward all the brethren <80 adelphos> who are in all Macedonia. But we urge you, brethren <80 adelphos>, to excel still more,
- 1 Thessalonians 4:13 But we do not want you to be uninformed, brethren **<80** adelphos>, about those who are asleep, so that you will not grieve as do the rest who have no hope.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:1 Now as to the times and the epochs, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, you have no need of anything to be written to you.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:4 But you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, are not in darkness, that the day would overtake you like a thief:
- 1 Thessalonians 5:12 But we request of you, brethren <80 adelphos>, that you appreciate those who diligently labor among you, and have charge over you in the Lord and give you instruction,
- 1 Thessalonians 5:14 We urge you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, admonish the unruly, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with everyone.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:25 Brethren <80 adelphos>, pray for us.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:26 Greet all the brethren <80 adelphos> with a holy kiss.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:27 I adjure you by the Lord to have this letter read to all the brethren <80 adelphos>.

- 2 Thessalonians 1:3 We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brethren <80 adelphos>, as is *only* fitting, because your faith is greatly enlarged, and the love of each one of you toward one another grows *ever* greater;
- 2 Thessalonians 2:1 Now we request you, brethren <80 adelphos>, with regard to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him,
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren <80 adelphos> beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:15 So then, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, stand firm and hold to the traditions which you were taught, whether by word *of mouth* or by letter from us.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:1 Finally, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as *it did* also with you;
- 2 Thessalonians 3:6 Now we command you, brethren <80 adelphos>, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you keep away from every brother <80 adelphos> who leads an unruly life and not according to the tradition which you received from us.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:13 But as for you, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, do not grow weary of doing good.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:15 *Yet* do not regard him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- 1 Timothy 4:6 In pointing out these things to the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, *constantly* nourished on the words of the faith and of the sound doctrine which you have been following.
- 1 Timothy 5:1 Do not sharply rebuke an older man, but *rather* appeal to *him* as a father, *to* the younger men as brothers **<80 adelphos>**,
- 1 Timothy 6:2 Those who have believers as their masters must not be disrespectful to them because they are brethren <80 adelphos>, but must serve them all the more, because those who partake of the benefit are believers and beloved. Teach and preach these *principles*.
- 2 Timothy 4:21 Make every effort to come before winter. Eubulus greets you, also Pudens and Linus and Claudia and all the brethren **<80 adelphos>**.
- Philemon 1:1 Paul, a prisoner of Christ Jesus, and Timothy our brother <80 adelphos>, To Philemon our beloved *brother* and fellow worker,
- Philemon 1:7 For I have come to have much joy and comfort in your love, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed through you, brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- Philemon 1:16 no longer as a slave, but more than a slave, a beloved brother **<80** adelphos>, especially to me, but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.
- Philemon 1:20 Yes, brother **<80 adelphos>**, let me benefit from you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ.
- Hebrews 2:11 For both He who sanctifies and those who are sanctified are all from one *Father;* for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren **<80 adelphos>**,
- Hebrews 2:12 saying, "I WILL PROCLAIM YOUR NAME TO MY BRETHREN <80 adelphos>, IN THE MIDST OF THE CONGREGATION I WILL SING YOUR PRAISE."

- Hebrews 2:17 Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren <80 adelphos> in all things, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
- Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brethren **<80 adelphos>**, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession;
- Hebrews 3:12 Take care, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God.
- Hebrews 7:5 And those indeed of the sons of Levi who receive the priest's office have commandment in the Law to collect a tenth from the people, that is, from their brethren **<80 adelphos>**, although these are descended from Abraham.
- Hebrews 8:11 "AND THEY SHALL NOT TEACH EVERYONE HIS FELLOW CITIZEN, AND EVERYONE HIS BROTHER **<80 adelphos>**, SAYING, 'KNOW THE LORD,' FOR ALL WILL KNOW ME, FROM THE LEAST TO THE GREATEST OF THEM.
- Hebrews 10:19 Therefore, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus,
- Hebrews 13:22 But I urge you, brethren <80 adelphos>, bear with this word of exhortation, for I have written to you briefly.
- Hebrews 13:23 Take notice that our brother <80 adelphos> Timothy has been released, with whom, if he comes soon, I will see you.
- James 1:2 Consider it all joy, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, when you encounter various trials,
- James 1:9 But the brother **<80 adelphos>** of humble circumstances is to glory in his high position;
- James 1:16 Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren <80 adelphos>.
- James 1:19 *This* you know, my beloved brethren **<80 adelphos>**. But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak *and* slow to anger;
- James 2:1 My brethren **<80 adelphos>**, do not hold your faith in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ with *an attitude of* personal favoritism.
- James 2:5 Listen, my beloved brethren **<80 adelphos>**: did not God choose the poor of this world *to be* rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him?
- James 2:14 What use is it, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, if someone says he has faith but he has no works? Can that faith save him?
- James 2:15 If a brother **<80 adelphos>** or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food,
- James 3:1 Let not many *of you* become teachers, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, knowing that as such we will incur a stricter judgment.
- James 3:10 from the same mouth come *both* blessing and cursing. My brethren **<80 adelphos>**, these things ought not to be this way.
- James 3:12 Can a fig tree, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, produce olives, or a vine produce figs? Nor *can* salt water produce fresh.
- James 4:11 Do not speak against one another, brethren <80 adelphos>. He who speaks against a brother <80 adelphos> or judges his brother <80 adelphos>, speaks against the law and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge of it.

- James 5:7 Therefore be patient, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, until the coming of the Lord. The farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being patient about it, until it gets the early and late rains.
- James 5:9 Do not complain, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.
- James 5:10 As an example, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, of suffering and patience, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.
- James 5:12 But above all, my brethren **<80 adelphos>**, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or with any other oath; but your yes is to be yes, and your no, no, so that you may not fall under judgment.
- James 5:19 My brethren **<80 adelphos>**, if any among you strays from the truth and one turns him back,
- 1 Peter 2:17 Honor all people, love the brotherhood **<81 adelphotes>**, fear God, honor the king.
- 1 Peter 5:9 But resist him, firm in *your* faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren **<81 adelphotes>** who are in the world.
- 1 Peter 5:12 Through Silvanus, our faithful brother **<80 adelphos>** (for so I regard *him*), I have written to you briefly, exhorting and testifying that this is the true grace of God. Stand firm in it!
- 2 Peter 1:10 Therefore, brethren **<80 adelphos>**, be all the more diligent to make certain about His calling and choosing you; for as long as you practice these things, you will never stumble;
- 2 Peter 3:15 and regard the patience of our Lord *as* salvation; just as also our beloved brother **<80 adelphos>** Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you,
- 1 John 2:9 The one who says he is in the Light and *yet* hates his brother **<80 adelphos>** is in the darkness until now.
- 1 John 2:10 The one who loves his brother **<80 adelphos>** abides in the Light and there is no cause for stumbling in him.
- 1 John 2:11 But the one who hates his brother **<80 adelphos>** is in the darkness and walks in the darkness, and does not know where he is going because the darkness has blinded his eyes.
- 1 John 3:10 By this the children of God and the children of the devil are obvious: anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love his brother **<80 adelphos>**.
- 1 John 3:12 not as Cain, *who* was of the evil one and slew his brother **<80 adelphos>**. And for what reason did he slay him? Because his deeds were evil, and his brother's **<80 adelphos>** were righteous.
- 1 John 3:13 Do not be surprised, brethren <80 adelphos>, if the world hates you.
- 1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren **<80 adelphos>**. He who does not love abides in death.
- 1 John 3:15 Everyone who hates his brother **<80 adelphos>** is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.
- 1 John 3:16 We know love by this, that He laid down His life for us; and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren **<80 adelphos>**.

- 1 John 3:17 But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother <80 adelphos> in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?
- 1 John 4:20 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother **<80 adelphos>**, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother **<80 adelphos>** whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen.
- 1 John 4:21 And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother **<80 adelphos>** also.
- 1 John 5:16 If anyone sees his brother **<80 adelphos>** committing a sin not *leading* to death, he shall ask and *God* will for him give life to those who commit sin not *leading* to death. There is a sin *leading* to death; I do not say that he should make request for this.
- 3 John 1:3 For I was very glad when brethren **<80 adelphos>** came and testified to your truth, *that is,* how you are walking in truth.
- 3 John 1:5 Beloved, you are acting faithfully in whatever you accomplish for the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, and especially *when they are* strangers;
- 3 John 1:10 For this reason, if I come, I will call attention to his deeds which he does, unjustly accusing us with wicked words; and not satisfied with this, he himself does not receive the brethren **<80 adelphos>**, either, and he forbids those who desire to do so and puts them out of the church.
- Jude 1:1 Jude, a bond-servant of Jesus Christ, and brother **<80 adelphos>** of James, To those who are the called, beloved in God the Father, and kept for Jesus Christ:
- Revelation 1:9 I, John, your brother **<80 adelphos>** and fellow partaker in the tribulation and kingdom and perseverance *which are* in Jesus, was on the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.
- Revelation 6:11 And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until *the number of* their fellow servants and their brethren **<80 adelphos>** who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.
- Revelation 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren <80 adelphos> has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night.
- Revelation 19:10 Then I fell at his feet to worship him. But he *said to me, "Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren **<80 adelphos>** who hold the testimony of Jesus; worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."
- Revelation 22:9 But he *said to me, "Do not do that. I am a fellow servant of yours and of your brethren **<80 adelphos>** the prophets and of those who heed the words of this book. Worship God."

435 aner (an'-ayr)

Matthew 1:16 Jacob was the father of Joseph the husband **<435 aner>** of Mary, by whom Jesus was born, who is called the Messiah.

- Matthew 1:19 And Joseph her husband <435 aner>, being a righteous man and not wanting to disgrace her, planned to send her away secretly.
- Matthew 7:24 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine and acts on them, may be compared to a wise man **<435 aner>** who built his house on the rock.
- Matthew 7:26 "Everyone who hears these words of Mine and does not act on them, will be like a foolish man <435 aner> who built his house on the sand.
- Matthew 12:41 "The men <435 aner> of Nineveh will stand up with this generation at the judgment, and will condemn it because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and behold, something greater than Jonah is here.
- Matthew 14:21 There were about five thousand men <435 aner> who ate, besides women and children.
- Matthew 14:35 And when the men **<435** aner**>** of that place recognized Him, they sent word into all that surrounding district and brought to Him all who were sick;
- Matthew 15:38 And those who ate were four thousand men <435 aner>, besides women and children.
- Mark 6:20 for Herod was afraid of John, knowing that he was a righteous and holy man <435 aner>, and he kept him safe. And when he heard him, he was very perplexed; but he used to enjoy listening to him.
- Mark 6:44 There were five thousand men <435 aner> who ate the loaves.
- Mark 10:2 *Some* Pharisees came up to Jesus, testing Him, and *began* to question Him whether it was lawful for a man **<435 aner>** to divorce a wife.
- Mark 10:12 and if she herself divorces her husband **<435 aner>** and marries another man, she is committing adultery."
- Luke 1:27 to a virgin engaged to a man <435 aner> whose name was Joseph, of the descendants of David; and the virgin's name was Mary.
- Luke 1:34 Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin <435 aner>?"
- Luke 2:36 And there was a prophetess, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was advanced in years and had lived with *her* husband **<435 aner>** seven years after her marriage,
- Luke 5:8 But when Simon Peter saw *that,* he fell down at Jesus' feet, saying, "Go away from me Lord, for I am a sinful man **<435 aner>**, O Lord!"
- Luke 5:12 While He was in one of the cities, behold, *there was* a man **<435 aner>** covered with leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."
- Luke 5:18 And *some* men **<435** aner> *were* carrying on a bed a man who was paralyzed; and they were trying to bring him in and to set him down in front of Him.
- Luke 6:8 But He knew what they were thinking, and He said to the man <435 aner> with the withered hand, "Get up and come forward!" And he got up and came forward.
- Luke 7:20 When the men <435 aner> came to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, to ask, 'Are You the Expected One, or do we look for someone else?'"
- Luke 8:27 And when He came out onto the land, He was met by a man <435 aner> from the city who was possessed with demons; and who had not put on any clothing for a long time, and was not living in a house, but in the tombs.

- Luke 8:38 But the man <435 aner> from whom the demons had gone out was begging Him that he might accompany Him; but He sent him away, saying,
- Luke 8:41 And there came a man <435 aner> named Jairus, and he was an official of the synagogue; and he fell at Jesus' feet, and *began* to implore Him to come to his house;
- Luke 9:14 (For there were about five thousand men <435 aner>.) And He said to His disciples, "Have them sit down *to eat* in groups of about fifty each."
- Luke 9:30 And behold, two men **<435** aner> were talking with Him; and they were Moses and Elijah,
- Luke 9:32 Now Peter and his companions had been overcome with sleep; but when they were fully awake, they saw His glory and the two men <435 aner> standing with Him.
- Luke 9:38 And a man **<435 aner>** from the crowd shouted, saying, "Teacher, I beg You to look at my son, for he is my only *boy*,
- Luke 11:31 "The Queen of the South will rise up with the men <435 aner> of this generation at the judgment and condemn them, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.
- Luke 11:32 "The men <435 aner> of Nineveh will stand up with this generation at the judgment and condemn it, because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and behold, something greater than Jonah is here.
- Luke 14:24 'For I tell you, none of those men <435 aner> who were invited shall taste of my dinner.'"
- Luke 16:18 "Everyone who divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery, and he who marries one who is divorced from a husband **<435 aner>** commits adultery.
- Luke 17:12 As He entered a village, ten leprous men <435 aner> who stood at a distance met Him;
- Luke 19:2 And there was a man <435 aner> called by the name of Zaccheus; he was a chief tax collector and he was rich.
- Luke 19:7 When they saw it, they all *began* to grumble, saying, "He has gone to be the guest of a man **<435 aner>** who is a sinner."
- Luke 22:63 Now the men <435 aner> who were holding Jesus in custody were mocking Him and beating Him,
- Luke 23:50 And a man <435 aner> named Joseph, who was a member of the Council, a good and righteous man <435 aner>
- Luke 24:4 While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men <435 aner> suddenly stood near them in dazzling clothing;
- John 1:13 who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man <435 aner>, but of God.
- John 1:30 "This is He on behalf of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man <435 aner> who has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me.'
- John 4:16 He *said to her, "Go, call your husband <435 aner> and come here."
- John 4:17 The woman answered and said, "I have no husband **<435 aner>**." Jesus *said to her, "You have correctly said, 'I have no husband **<435 aner>**';

- John 4:18 for you have had five husbands <435 aner>, and the one whom you now have is not your husband <435 aner>; this you have said truly."
- John 6:10 Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." Now there was much grass in the place. So the men **<435 aner>** sat down, in number about five thousand.
- Acts 1:10 And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men **<435 aner>** in white clothing stood beside them.
- Acts 1:11 They also said, "Men <435 aner> of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."
- Acts 1:16 "Brethren <435 aner>, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit foretold by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus.
- Acts 1:21 "Therefore it is necessary that of the men <435 aner> who have accompanied us all the time that the Lord Jesus went in and out among us—
- Acts 2:5 Now there were Jews living in Jerusalem, devout men **<435 aner>** from every nation under heaven.
- Acts 2:14 But Peter, taking his stand with the eleven, raised his voice and declared to them: "Men <435 aner> of Judea and all you who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you and give heed to my words.
- Acts 2:22 "Men <435 aner> of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man <435 aner> attested to you by God with miracles and wonders and signs which God performed through Him in your midst, just as you yourselves know—
- Acts 2:29 "Brethren **<435 aner>**, I may confidently say to you regarding the patriarch David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day.
- Acts 2:37 Now when they heard *this*, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren **<435 aner>**, what shall we do?"
- Acts 3:2 And a man <435 aner> who had been lame from his mother's womb was being carried along, whom they used to set down every day at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, in order to beg alms of those who were entering the temple.
- Acts 3:12 But when Peter saw *this*, he replied to the people, "Men <435 aner> of Israel, why are you amazed at this, or why do you gaze at us, as if by our own power or piety we had made him walk?
- Acts 4:4 But many of those who had heard the message believed; and the number of the men **<435 aner>** came to be about five thousand.
- Acts 5:1 But a man <435 aner> named Ananias, with his wife Sapphira, sold a piece of property,
- Acts 5:9 Then Peter *said* to her, "Why is it that you have agreed together to put the Spirit of the Lord to the test? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband **<435 aner>** are at the door, and they will carry you out *as well.*"
- Acts 5:10 And immediately she fell at his feet and breathed her last, and the young men came in and found her dead, and they carried her out and buried her beside her husband **<435 aner>**.
- Acts 5:14 And all the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men <435 aner> and women, were constantly added to *their number*,

- Acts 5:25 But someone came and reported to them, "The men <435 aner> whom you put in prison are standing in the temple and teaching the people!"
- Acts 5:35 And he said to them, "Men <435 aner> of Israel, take care what you propose to do with these men.
- Acts 5:36 "For some time ago Theudas rose up, claiming to be somebody, and a group of about four hundred men <435 aner> joined up with him. But he was killed, and all who followed him were dispersed and came to nothing.
- Acts 6:3 "Therefore, brethren, select from among you seven men <435 aner> of good reputation, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we may put in charge of this task.
- Acts 6:5 The statement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose Stephen, a man <435 aner> full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch.
- Acts 6:11 Then they secretly induced men <435 aner> to say, "We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses and against God."
- Acts 7:2 And he said, "Hear me, brethren <435 aner> and fathers! The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Haran,
- Acts 7:26 "On the following day he appeared to them as they were fighting together, and he tried to reconcile them in peace, saying, 'Men <435 aner>, you are brethren, why do you injure one another?'
- Acts 8:2 Some devout men <435 aner> buried Stephen, and made loud lamentation over him.
- Acts 8:3 But Saul *began* ravaging the church, entering house after house, and dragging off men **<435** aner> and women, he would put them in prison.
- Acts 8:9 Now there was a man <435 aner> named Simon, who formerly was practicing magic in the city and astonishing the people of Samaria, claiming to be someone great;
- Acts 8:12 But when they believed Philip preaching the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, men <435 aner> and women alike.
- Acts 9:2 and asked for letters from him to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any belonging to the Way, both men **<435 aner>** and women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem.
- Acts 9:7 The men **<435 aner>** who traveled with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one.
- Acts 9:12 and he has seen in a vision a man <435 aner> named Ananias come in and lay his hands on him, so that he might regain his sight."
- Acts 9:13 But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man <435 aner>, how much harm he did to Your saints at Jerusalem;
- Acts 9:38 Since Lydda was near Joppa, the disciples, having heard that Peter was there, sent two men **<435 aner>** to him, imploring him, "Do not delay in coming to us."
- Acts 10:1 Now *there was* a man **<435 aner>** at Caesarea named Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian cohort.
- Acts 10:5 "Now dispatch *some* men **<435** aner> to Joppa and send for a man *named* Simon, who is also called Peter;

- Acts 10:17 Now while Peter was greatly perplexed in mind as to what the vision which he had seen might be, behold, the men <435 aner> who had been sent by Cornelius, having asked directions for Simon's house, appeared at the gate;
- Acts 10:19 While Peter was reflecting on the vision, the Spirit said to him, "Behold, three men **<435 aner>** are looking for you.
- Acts 10:21 Peter went down to the men <435 aner> and said, "Behold, I am the one you are looking for; what is the reason for which you have come?"
- Acts 10:22 They said, "Cornelius, a centurion, a righteous and God-fearing man <435 aner> well spoken of by the entire nation of the Jews, was *divinely* directed by a holy angel to send for you *to come* to his house and hear a message from you."
- Acts 10:28 And he said to them, "You yourselves know how unlawful it is for a man <435 aner> who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and *yet* God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean.
- Acts 10:30 Cornelius said, "Four days ago to this hour, I was praying in my house during the ninth hour; and behold, a man <435 aner> stood before me in shining garments,
- Acts 11:3 saying, "You went to uncircumcised men <435 aner> and ate with them."
- Acts 11:11 "And behold, at that moment three men <435 aner> appeared at the house in which we were *staying*, having been sent to me from Caesarea.
- Acts 11:12 "The Spirit told me to go with them without misgivings. These six brethren also went with me and we entered the man's **<435 aner>** house.
- Acts 11:20 But there were some of them, men **<435** aner**>** of Cyprus and Cyrene, who came to Antioch and *began* speaking to the Greeks also, preaching the Lord Jesus.
- Acts 11:24 for he was a good man **<435 aner>**, and full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And considerable numbers were brought to the Lord.
- Acts 13:7 who was with the proconsul, Sergius Paulus, a man <435 aner> of intelligence. This man summoned Barnabas and Saul and sought to hear the word of God.
- Acts 13:15 After the reading of the Law and the Prophets the synagogue officials sent to them, saying, "Brethren <435 aner>, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say it."
- Acts 13:16 Paul stood up, and motioning with his hand said, "Men <435 aner> of Israel, and you who fear God, listen:
- Acts 13:21 "Then they asked for a king, and God gave them Saul the son of Kish, a man **<435 aner>** of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years.
- Acts 13:22 "After He had removed him, He raised up David to be their king, concerning whom He also testified and said, 'I HAVE FOUND DAVID the son of Jesse, A MAN <435 aner> AFTER MY HEART, who will do all My will.'
- Acts 13:26 "Brethren <435 aner>, sons of Abraham's family, and those among you who fear God, to us the message of this salvation has been sent.
- Acts 13:38 "Therefore let it be known to you, brethren **<435 aner>**, that through Him forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you,
- Acts 14:8 At Lystra a man <435 aner> was sitting who had no strength in his feet, lame from his mother's womb, who had never walked.
- Acts 14:15 and saying, "Men <435 aner>, why are you doing these things? We are also men of the same nature as you, and preach the gospel to you that you should turn

- from these vain things to a living God, WHO MADE THE HEAVEN AND THE EARTH AND THE SEA AND ALL THAT IS IN THEM.
- Acts 15:7 After there had been much debate, Peter stood up and said to them, "Brethren <435 aner>, you know that in the early days God made a choice among you, that by my mouth the Gentiles would hear the word of the gospel and believe.
- Acts 15:13 After they had stopped speaking, James answered, saying, "Brethren <435 aner>, listen to me.
- Acts 15:22 Then it seemed good to the apostles and the elders, with the whole church, to choose men <435 aner> from among them to send to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas—Judas called Barsabbas, and Silas, leading men <435 aner> among the brethren.
- Acts 15:25 it seemed good to us, having become of one mind, to select men <435 aner> to send to you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,
- Acts 16:9 A vision appeared to Paul in the night: a man <435 aner> of Macedonia was standing and appealing to him, and saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us."
- Acts 17:5 But the Jews, becoming jealous and taking along some wicked men <435 aner> from the market place, formed a mob and set the city in an uproar; and attacking the house of Jason, they were seeking to bring them out to the people.
- Acts 17:12 Therefore many of them believed, along with a number of prominent Greek women and men <435 aner>.
- Acts 17:22 So Paul stood in the midst of the Areopagus and said, "Men <435 aner> of Athens, I observe that you are very religious in all respects.
- Acts 17:31 because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man **<435 aner>** whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead."
- Acts 17:34 But some men <435 aner> joined him and believed, among whom also were Dionysius the Areopagite and a woman named Damaris and others with them.
- Acts 18:24 Now a Jew named Apollos, an Alexandrian by birth, an eloquent man <435 aner>, came to Ephesus; and he was mighty in the Scriptures.
- Acts 19:7 There were in all about twelve men <435 aner>.
- Acts 19:25 these he gathered together with the workmen of similar *trades*, and said, "Men **<435 aner>**, you know that our prosperity depends upon this business.
- Acts 19:35 After quieting the crowd, the town clerk *said, "Men <435 aner> of Ephesus, what man is there after all who does not know that the city of the Ephesians is guardian of the temple of the great Artemis and of the *image* which fell down from heaven?
- Acts 19:37 "For you have brought these men **<435 aner>** here who are neither robbers of temples nor blasphemers of our goddess.
- Acts 20:30 and from among your own selves men **<435 aner>** will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them.
- Acts 21:11 And coming to us, he took Paul's belt and bound his own feet and hands, and said, "This is what the Holy Spirit says: 'In this way the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man <435 aner> who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles."
- Acts 21:23 "Therefore do this that we tell you. We have four men <435 aner> who are under a vow;

- Acts 21:26 Then Paul took the men <435 aner>, and the next day, purifying himself along with them, went into the temple giving notice of the completion of the days of purification, until the sacrifice was offered for each one of them.
- Acts 21:28 crying out, "Men <435 aner> of Israel, come to our aid! This is the man who preaches to all men everywhere against our people and the Law and this place; and besides he has even brought Greeks into the temple and has defiled this holy place."
- Acts 21:38 "Then you are not the Egyptian who some time ago stirred up a revolt and led the four thousand men **<435 aner>** of the Assassins out into the wilderness?"
- Acts 22:1 "Brethren **<435 aner>** and fathers, hear my defense which I now *offer* to you."
- Acts 22:4 "I persecuted this Way to the death, binding and putting both men <435 aner> and women into prisons,
- Acts 22:12 "A certain Ananias, a man <435 aner> who was devout by the standard of the Law, and well spoken of by all the Jews who lived there,
- Acts 23:1 Paul, looking intently at the Council, said, "Brethren <435 aner>, I have lived my life with a perfectly good conscience before God up to this day."
- Acts 23:6 But perceiving that one group were Sadducees and the other Pharisees, Paul began crying out in the Council, "Brethren <435 aner>, I am a Pharisee, a son of Pharisees; I am on trial for the hope and resurrection of the dead!"
- Acts 23:27 "When this man <435 aner> was arrested by the Jews and was about to be slain by them, I came up to them with the troops and rescued him, having learned that he was a Roman.
- Acts 23:30 "When I was informed that there would be a plot against the man <435 aner>, I sent him to you at once, also instructing his accusers to bring charges against him before you."
- Acts 24:5 "For we have found this man <435 aner> a real pest and a fellow who stirs up dissension among all the Jews throughout the world, and a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes.
- Acts 25:5 "Therefore," he *said, "let the influential men among you go there with me, and if there is anything wrong about the man <435 aner>, let them prosecute him."
- Acts 25:14 While they were spending many days there, Festus laid Paul's case before the king, saying, "There is a man <435 aner> who was left as a prisoner by Felix;
- Acts 25:17 "So after they had assembled here, I did not delay, but on the next day took my seat on the tribunal and ordered the man **<435 aner>** to be brought before me.
- Acts 25:23 So, on the next day when Agrippa came together with Bernice amid great pomp, and entered the auditorium accompanied by the commanders and the prominent men <435 aner> of the city, at the command of Festus, Paul was brought in.
- Acts 25:24 Festus *said, "King Agrippa, and all you gentlemen <435 aner> here present with us, you see this man about whom all the people of the Jews appealed to me, both at Jerusalem and here, loudly declaring that he ought not to live any longer.
- Acts 27:10 and said to them, "Men <435 aner>, I perceive that the voyage will certainly be with damage and great loss, not only of the cargo and the ship, but also of our lives."

- Acts 27:21 When they had gone a long time without food, then Paul stood up in their midst and said, "Men <435 aner>, you ought to have followed my advice and not to have set sail from Crete and incurred this damage and loss.
- Acts 27:25 "Therefore, keep up your courage, men <435 aner>, for I believe God that it will turn out exactly as I have been told.
- Acts 28:17 After three days Paul called together those who were the leading men of the Jews, and when they came together, he *began* saying to them, "Brethren **<435** aner>, though I had done nothing against our people or the customs of our fathers, yet I was delivered as a prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.
- Romans 4:8 "BLESSED IS THE MAN <435 aner> WHOSE SIN THE LORD WILL NOT TAKE INTO ACCOUNT."
- Romans 7:2 For the married woman is bound by law to her husband <435 aner> while he is living; but if her husband <435 aner> dies, she is released from the law concerning the husband <435 aner>.
- Romans 7:3 So then, if while her husband <435 aner> is living she is joined to another man <435 aner>, she shall be called an adulteress; but if her husband <435 aner> dies, she is free from the law, so that she is not an adulteress though she is joined to another man <435 aner>.
- Romans 11:4 But what is the divine response to him? "I HAVE KEPT for Myself SEVEN THOUSAND MEN <435 aner> WHO HAVE NOT BOWED THE KNEE TO BAAL."
- 1 Corinthians 7:2 But because of immoralities, each man is to have his own wife, and each woman is to have her own husband **<435 aner>**.
- 1 Corinthians 7:3 The husband **<435 aner>** must fulfill his duty to his wife, and likewise also the wife to her husband **<435 aner>**.
- 1 Corinthians 7:4 The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband <435 aner> does; and likewise also the husband <435 aner> does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does.
- 1 Corinthians 7:10 But to the married I give instructions, not I, but the Lord, that the wife should not leave her husband <435 aner>
- 1 Corinthians 7:11 (but if she does leave, she must remain unmarried, or else be reconciled to her husband <435 aner>), and that the husband <435 aner> should not divorce his wife.
- 1 Corinthians 7:13 And a woman who has an unbelieving husband <435 aner>, and he consents to live with her, she must not send her husband <435 aner> away.
- 1 Corinthians 7:14 For the unbelieving husband <435 aner> is sanctified through his wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified through her believing husband; for otherwise your children are unclean, but now they are holy.
- 1 Corinthians 7:16 For how do you know, O wife, whether you will save your husband <435 aner>? Or how do you know, O husband <435 aner>, whether you will save your wife?
- 1 Corinthians 7:34 and *his interests* are divided. The woman who is unmarried, and the virgin, is concerned about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and spirit; but one who is married is concerned about the things of the world, how she may please her husband <435 aner>.

- 1 Corinthians 7:39 A wife is bound as long as her husband **<435 aner>** lives; but if her husband **<435 aner>** is dead, she is free to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I want you to understand that Christ is the head of every man <435 aner>, and the man <435 aner> is the head of a woman, and God is the head of Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 11:4 Every man <435 aner> who has *something* on his head while praying or prophesying disgraces his head.
- 1 Corinthians 11:7 For a man <435 aner> ought not to have his head covered, since he is the image and glory of God; but the woman is the glory of man <435 aner>.
- 1 Corinthians 11:8 For man <435 aner> does not originate from woman, but woman from man <435 aner>;
- 1 Corinthians 11:9 for indeed man <435 aner> was not created for the woman's sake, but woman for the man's <435 aner> sake.
- 1 Corinthians 11:11 However, in the Lord, neither is woman independent of man <435 aner>, nor is man <435 aner> independent of woman.
- 1 Corinthians 11:12 For as the woman originates from the man **<435 aner>**, so also the man **<435 aner>** has his birth through the woman; and all things originate from God.
- 1 Corinthians 11:14 Does not even nature itself teach you that if a man <435 aner> has long hair, it is a dishonor to him,
- 1 Corinthians 13:11 When I was a child, I used to speak like a child, think like a child, reason like a child; when I became a man **<435 aner>**, I did away with childish things.
- 1 Corinthians 14:35 If they desire to learn anything, let them ask their own husbands <435 aner> at home; for it is improper for a woman to speak in church.
- 2 Corinthians 11:2 For I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy; for I betrothed you to one husband <435 aner>, so that to Christ I might present you as a pure virgin.
- Galatians 4:27 For it is written, "REJOICE, BARREN WOMAN WHO DOES NOT BEAR; BREAK FORTH AND SHOUT, YOU WHO ARE NOT IN LABOR; FOR MORE NUMEROUS ARE THE CHILDREN OF THE DESOLATE THAN OF THE ONE WHO HAS A HUSBAND <435 aner>."
- Ephesians 4:13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man <435 aner>, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.
- Ephesians 5:22 Wives, be subject to your own husbands <435 aner>, as to the Lord.
- Ephesians 5:23 For the husband **<435 aner>** is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body.
- Ephesians 5:24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands **<435 aner>** in everything.
- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands <435 aner>, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,
- Ephesians 5:28 So husbands <435 aner> ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself;
- Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to love his own wife even as himself, and the wife must *see to it* that she respects her husband **<435** aner>.

- Colossians 3:18 Wives, be subject to your husbands **<435 aner>**, as is fitting in the Lord.
- Colossians 3:19 Husbands <435 aner>, love your wives and do not be embittered against them.
- 1 Timothy 2:8 Therefore I want the men <435 aner> in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension.
- 1 Timothy 2:12 But I do not allow a woman to teach or exercise authority over a man <435 aner>, but to remain quiet.
- 1 Timothy 3:2 An overseer, then, must be above reproach, the husband **<435 aner>** of one wife, temperate, prudent, respectable, hospitable, able to teach,
- 1 Timothy 3:12 Deacons must be husbands <435 aner> of *only* one wife, *and* good managers of *their* children and their own households.
- 1 Timothy 5:9 A widow is to be put on the list only if she is not less than sixty years old, having been the wife of one man <435 aner>,
- Titus 1:6 *namely,* if any man is above reproach, the husband **<435 aner>** of one wife, having children who believe, not accused of dissipation or rebellion.
- Titus 2:5 *to be* sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands **<435 aner>**, so that the word of God will not be dishonored.
- James 1:8 being a double-minded man <435 aner>, unstable in all his ways.
- James 1:12 Blessed is a man <435 aner> who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which *the Lord* has promised to those who love Him.
- James 1:20 for the anger of man **<435 aner>** does not achieve the righteousness of God.
- James 1:23 For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man <435 aner> who looks at his natural face in a mirror;
- James 2:2 For if a man <435 aner> comes into your assembly with a gold ring and dressed in fine clothes, and there also comes in a poor man in dirty clothes,
- James 3:2 For we all stumble in many *ways*. If anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man **<435 aner>**, able to bridle the whole body as well.
- 1 Peter 3:1 In the same way, you wives, be submissive to your own husbands <435 aner> so that even if any of them are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives,
- 1 Peter 3:5 For in this way in former times the holy women also, who hoped in God, used to adorn themselves, being submissive to their own husbands <435 aner>;
- 1 Peter 3:7 You husbands <435 aner> in the same way, live with *your wives* in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered.
- Revelation 21:2 And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband **<435 aner>**.

5360 philadelphia (fil-ad-el-fee'-ah)

Romans 12:10 Be devoted to one another in **brotherly love <5360 philadelphia>**; give preference to one another in honor;

- 1 Thessalonians 4:9 Now as to the **love of the brethren <5360 philadelphia>**, you have no need for *anyone* to write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another:
- Hebrews 13:1 Let love of the brethren <5360 philadelphia> continue.
- 1 Peter 1:22 Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere **love of the brethren <5360 philadelphia>**, fervently love one another from the heart.
- 2 Peter 1:7 and in *your* godliness, **brotherly kindness <5360 philadelphia>**, and in *your* **brotherly kindness <5360 philadelphia>**, love.

5569 pseudadelphos (psyoo-dad'-el-fos)

- 2 Corinthians 11:26 *I have been* on frequent journeys, in dangers from rivers, dangers from robbers, dangers from *my* countrymen, dangers from the Gentiles, dangers in the city, dangers in the wilderness, dangers on the sea, dangers among **false brethren <5569 pseudadelphos>**;
- Galatians 2:4 But *it was* because of the **false brethren <5569 pseudadelphos>** secretly brought in, who had sneaked in to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, in order to bring us into bondage.
