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Introduction

The term doctrine and concept of doctrine is coming under more and more attack by the scoffers, cultists, and apostates that would seek to bring destructive heresies and false teachings into the body of Christian beliefs and theology. It is also under attack by those claiming to be of the body who have accepted false teachings that were introduced long ago and now seek to preserve as "tradition" that which is contrary to the Word of God.

Sound **doctrine** is that which is **true**, **correct**, and properly reflects mind and intent of God in His Word. No wonder so many false teachers and false churches seek to undermine and claim false those who use the bible as their only standard for doctrine (teachings) and beliefs.

Here is a proper perspective on doctrine:

- Doctrine without devotion is dead
- Devotion without doctrine is dangerous
- Doctrine with devotion is delightful

The following list is a basic summary of the essential bible doctrines (teachings) all New Christians to learn as soon as you are practically able. There are unfortunately many deceivers, false teachers, false churches, false apostles, false Christians and false brothers teaching false doctrines (teachings) yet claim to be Christian teachers and churches. How is a new Christian to know if you may be attending one of these false churches who teach contrary to the fundamental teachings of Jesus, the Apostles and all the New Testament Scripture?

The bible itself will prepare you to learn the truth and to avoid the false. It is up to you to learn how to do that. Work very hard to make daily reading of your bible and daily talking (prayer) to God a daily habit as quickly as you can. Do this and God will place you upon the Solid Rock of Jesus and the chance of you ever becoming deceived by what the bible calls false teachers will be very low indeed.

DEFINITIONS

Exegesis versus Eisegesis

There are two basics tenets of bible study that all students of Scripture need to be aware of and that is Exegesis and Eisegesis. Simply put, **exegesis** is the process of drawing out of Scripture that which is actually there and its counterpart is **eisegesis**, infusing into Scripture presuppositions, agendas, traditions, doctrine or other biases that are not. When studying the Word of God, we must to the extent possible not bring any presuppositions we have about God, the bible, church, salvation and other doctrines we assume to be true. Nobody lives in a vacuum and there will always be suppositions, things we already believe to be true.

What is essential for our growth and development in the Lord to test what we know in light of God's Holy Word. It comes down to two simple questions: What do we believe? And why do we believe it?

While most Christians think all their beliefs have come from the bible, just the opposite is true. Most beliefs come from oral teachings, traditions, society, sermons and presumption. The only way to discern truth is to know truth, and truth comes directly from the pages of Scripture. When a truth of God from the honest and diligent study of His Word directly contradicts a sincerely held belief, what do you do?

Many will try to alter what God's Word says by any number of different ways. Eisegesis is the place where Satan lives and deceives the entire world, "And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world" (Revelation 12:9). Wouldn't it be nice if that dragon always reveals himself as the hideous beast he is, but unfortunately he does not. He tries to disguise himself as an angel of light, a counterfeit to God's genuine truth and holiness, "And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light" (2Corinthians 11:14).

True disciples of Jesus must learn to test the spirit to see where it is from so they may discern good from evil and the light from dark. The deceived never know or realive they are deceived until the light of God illumines their mind.

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.
