- Luke 12:47 "And that **slave <1401 doulos>** who knew his master's will and did not get ready or act in accord with his will, will receive many lashes,
- Luke 14:17 and at the dinner hour he sent his **slave <1401 doulos>** to say to those who had been invited, 'Come; for everything is ready now.'
- Luke 14:21 "And the **slave <1401 doulos>** came *back* and reported this to his master. Then the head of the household became angry and said to his **slave <1401**

- **doulos>**, 'Go out at once into the streets and lanes of the city and bring in here the poor and crippled and blind and lame.'
- Luke 14:22 "And the **slave <1401 doulos>** said, 'Master, what you commanded has been done, and still there is room.'
- Luke 14:23 "And the master said to the **slave <1401 doulos>**, 'Go out into the highways and along the hedges, and compel *them* to come in, so that my house may be filled.
- Luke 15:22 "But the father said to his **slaves <1401 doulos>**, 'Quickly bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet;

- John 4:51 As he was now going down, *his* **slaves <1401 doulos>** met him, saying that his son was living.
- John 8:34 Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the **slave <1401 doulos>** of sin.
- John 8:35 "The **slave <1401 doulos>** does not remain in the house forever; the son does remain forever.
- John 13:16 "Truly, truly, I say to you, a **slave <1401 doulos>** is not greater than his master, nor *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him.
- John 15:15 "No longer do I call you **slaves <1401 doulos>**, for the slave <1401 doulos> does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you.

- John 15:20 "Remember the word that I said to you, 'A **slave <1401 doulos>** is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you; if they kept My word, they will keep yours also.
- John 18:10 Simon Peter then, having a sword, drew it and struck the high priest's **slave** <1401 doulos>, and cut off his right ear; and the **slave's** <1401 doulos> name was Malchus.
- John 18:18 Now the **slaves <1401 doulos>** and the officers were standing *there*, having made a charcoal fire, for it was cold and they were warming themselves; and Peter was also with them, standing and warming himself.

- Romans 6:17 But thanks be to God that though you were **slaves <1401 doulos>** of sin, you became obedient from the heart to that form of teaching to which you were committed.

- Romans 6:19 I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as **slaves <1401 doulos>** to impurity and to lawlessness, resulting in *further* lawlessness, so now present your members as **slaves <1401 doulos>** to righteousness, resulting in sanctification.
- Romans 6:20 For when you were **slaves <1401 doulos>** of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness.

- 1 Corinthians 7:22 For he who was called in the Lord while a **slave <1401 doulos>**, is the Lord's freedman; likewise he who was called while free, is Christ's **slave <1401 doulos>**.
- 1 Corinthians 7:23 You were bought with a price; do not become **slaves <1401 doulos>** of men.
- 1Co 9:19 ¶ For though I am free from all [men,] I have **made myself a slave <1402 douloo>** to all, so that I may win more.
- 1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether **slaves <1401 doulos>** or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 4:5 For we do not preach ourselves but Christ Jesus as Lord, and ourselves as your **bond-servants <1401 doulos>** for Jesus' sake.
- Galatians 1:10 For am I now seeking the favor of men, or of God? Or am I striving to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a **bond-servant** <1401 doulos> of Christ.
- Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither **slave <1401 doulos>** nor free man, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Galatians 4:1 Now I say, as long as the heir is a child, he does not differ at all from a slave <1401 doulos> although he is owner of everything,
- Galatians 4:3 So also we, while we were children, were **held in bondage <1402 douloo>** under the elemental things of the world.
- Galatians 4:7 Therefore you are no longer a **slave <1401 doulos>**, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.
- Ephesians 6:5 **Slaves <1401 doulos>**, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in the sincerity of your heart, as to Christ;
- Ephesians 6:6 not by way of eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as **slaves <1401 doulos>** of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart.
- Ephesians 6:8 knowing that whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether **slave <1401 doulos>** or free.
- Philippians 1:1 Paul and Timothy, **bond-servants <1401 doulos>** of Christ Jesus, To all the saints in Christ Jesus who are in Philippi, including the overseers and deacons:
- Philippians 2:7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a **bond-servant <1401 doulos>**, *and* being made in the likeness of men.
- Colossians 3:11 *a renewal* in which there is no *distinction between* Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, **slave <1401 doulos>** and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.
- Colossians 3:22 **Slaves <1401 doulos>**, in all things obey those who are your masters on earth, not with external service, as those who *merely* please men, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord.
- Colossians 4:1 Masters, grant to your **slaves <1401 doulos>** justice and fairness, knowing that you too have a Master in heaven.
- Colossians 4:12 Epaphras, who is one of your number, a **bondslave <1401 doulos>** of Jesus Christ, sends you his greetings, always laboring earnestly for you in his prayers, that you may stand perfect and fully assured in all the will of God.

- 1 Timothy 6:1 All who are under the yoke as **slaves <1401 doulos>** are to regard their own masters as worthy of all honor so that the name of God and *our* doctrine will not be spoken against.
- 2 Timothy 2:24 The Lord's **bond-servant <1401 doulos>** must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged,
- Titus 1:1 Paul, a bond-servant <1401 doulos> of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the faith of those chosen of God and the knowledge of the truth which is according to godliness,
- Titus 2:3 Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor **enslaved <1402 douloo>** to much wine, teaching what is good,
- Titus 2:9 *Urge* **bondslaves <1401 doulos>** to be subject to their own masters in everything, to be well-pleasing, not argumentative,
- Philemon 1:16 no longer as a **slave <1401 doulos>**, but more than a **slave <1401 doulos>**, a beloved brother, especially to me, but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.
- James 1:1 James, a bond-servant <1401 doulos> of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes who are dispersed abroad: Greetings.
- 1 Peter 2:16 *Act* as free men, and do not use your freedom as a covering for evil, but *use it* as **bondslaves <1401 doulos>** of God.
- 2 Peter 1:1 Simon Peter, a **bond-servant <1401 doulos>** and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who have received a faith of the same kind as ours, by the righteousness of our God and Savior, Jesus Christ:
- 2 Peter 2:19 promising them freedom while they themselves are **slaves <1401 doulos>** of corruption; for by what a man is overcome, by this he is enslaved **enslaved <1402 douloo>**.
- Jude 1:1 Jude, a **bond-servant <1401 doulos>** of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, To those who are the called, beloved in God the Father, and kept for Jesus Christ:
- Revelation 1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His **bond-servants <1401 doulos>**, the things which must soon take place; and He sent and communicated *it* by His angel to His **bond-servant <1401 doulos>** John.
- Revelation 2:20 'But I have *this* against you, that you tolerate the woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and leads My **bond-servants <1401 doulos>** astray so that they commit *acts of* immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols.
- Revelation 6:15 Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the commanders and the rich and the strong and every **slave <1401 doulos>** and free man hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains;
- Revelation 7:3 saying, "Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees until we have sealed the **bond-servants <1401 doulos>** of our God on their foreheads."
- Revelation 10:7 but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is finished, as He preached to His **servants <1401 doulos>** the prophets.
- Revelation 11:18 "And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time came for the dead to be judged, and the time to reward Your bond-servants <1401 doulos> the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth."

- Revelation 13:16 And he causes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free men and the **slaves <1401 doulos>**, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead,
- Revelation 15:3 And they *sang the song of Moses, the **bond-servant <1401 doulos>** of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, "Great and marvelous are Your works, O Lord God, the Almighty; Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations!

- Revelation 19:18 so that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of commanders and the flesh of mighty men and the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them and the flesh of all men, both free men and slaves <1401 doulos>, and small and great."
- Revelation 22:3 There will no longer be any curse; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His **bond-servants <1401 doulos>** will serve Him;
