Elders hold the office of **Diakonos (***dee-ak'-on-os***)** which means servant and also of the **Episkope (***ep-is-kop-ay'***)** which means the overseers. Therefore, an elder is both servant and overseer. This term diakonos has been translated as deacon six times in Scripture and is not to be seen as a singular office but as a category for multiple offices for which ministers, teachers, preachers, deacons also occupy. Please see the study on <u>Church: Forms and Practices</u> for a fuller study on this and other key points of Scripture.

"Why do Your disciples break the tradition of the **elders** <<u>4245 presbuteros></u>? For they do not wash their hands when they eat bread."

Matthew 16:21

From that time Jesus began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the **elders** <<u>4245 presbuteros></u> and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day.

Matthew 21:23

When He entered the temple, the chief priests and the **elders** <<u>4245 presbuteros></u> of the people came to Him while He was teaching, and said, "By what authority are You doing these things, and who gave You this authority?"

Immediately while He was still speaking, Judas, one of the twelve, *came up accompanied by a crowd with swords and clubs, *who were* from the chief priests and the scribes and the **elders** <4245 presbuteros>.

Mark 14:53

They led Jesus away to the high priest; and all the chief priests and the **elders** <u><4245</u> <u>presbuteros></u> and the scribes *gathered together.

Mark 15:1

Early in the morning the chief priests with the **elders** <4245 presbuteros> and scribes and the whole Council, immediately held a consultation; and binding Jesus, they led Him away and delivered Him to Pilate.

Luke 7:3

When he heard about Jesus, he sent some Jewish **elders** <<u>4245</u> presbuteros> asking Him to come and save the life of his slave.

Acts 21:18

And the following day Paul went in with us to James, and all the elders were elders were elders we

Acts 22:5

as also the high priest and all the Council of elders ≤ 4244 presbuterion> can testify. From them I also received letters to the brethren, and started off for Damascus in order to bring even those who were there to Jerusalem as prisoners to be punished.

Acts 23:14

They came to the chief priests and the **elders** \leq 4245 presbuteros> and said, "We have bound ourselves under a solemn oath to taste nothing until we have killed Paul.

the **older women** <u><4245 presbuteros></u> as mothers, *and* the younger **women** <u><4245</u> <u>presbuteros></u> as sisters, in all purity.

1 Timothy 5:17

The **elders** <u><4245 presbuteros></u> who rule well are to be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who work hard at preaching and teaching.

1 Timothy 5:19

Do not receive an accusation against an **elder** <4245 presbuteros> except on the basis of two or three witnesses.

Titus 1:5

For this reason I left you in Crete, that you would set in order what remains and appoint elders <4245 presbuteros> in every city as I directed you,

Hebrews 11:2 For by it the **men of old** <<u>4245 presbuteros></u> gained approval.

James 5:14

Is anyone among you sick? *Then* he must call for the **elders** <<u>4245</u> presbuteros> of the church and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord;

The **elder** ≤ 4245 presbuteros> to the chosen lady and her children, whom I love in truth; and not only I, but also all who know the truth,

The **elder** <u><4245 presbuteros></u> to the beloved Gaius, whom I love in truth.

Revelation 4:4

Around the throne *were* twenty-four thrones; and upon the thrones *I saw* twenty-four **elders** <4245 presbuteros> sitting, clothed in white garments, and golden crowns on their heads.

Revelation 4:10

the twenty-four **elders** <4245 presbuteros> will fall down before Him who sits on the throne, and will worship Him who lives forever and ever, and will cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

Revelation 5:5
