Hebrews 11:27 By <u>faith</u> he left Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured, as seeing Him who is unseen.

Hebrews 11:28 By <u>faith</u> he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of the blood, so that he who destroyed the firstborn would not touch them.

Hebrews 11:29 By <u>faith</u> they passed through the Red Sea as though *they were passing* through dry land; and the Egyptians, when they attempted it, were drowned.

- Hebrews 11:30 By <u>faith</u> the walls of Jericho fell down after they had been encircled for seven days.
- Hebrews 11:31 By <u>faith</u> Rahab the harlot did not perish along with those who were disobedient, after she had welcomed the spies in peace.
- Hebrews 11:33 who by <u>faith</u> conquered kingdoms, performed *acts of* righteousness, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions,

- 1 John 5:4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our <u>faith</u>.
- Jude 1:3 Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you contend earnestly for the <u>faith</u> which was once for all handed down to the saints.
- Jude 1:20 But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy <u>faith</u>, praying in the Holy Spirit,
- Revelation 2:13 'I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is; and you hold fast My name, and did not deny My <u>faith</u> even in the days of Antipas, My witness, My faithful one, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.
- Revelation 2:19 'I know your deeds, and your love and <u>faith</u> and service and perseverance, and that your deeds of late are greater than at first.
- Revelation 13:10 If anyone *is destined* for captivity, to captivity he goes; if anyone kills with the sword, with the sword he must be killed. Here is the perseverance and the <u>faith</u> of the saints.
- Revelation 14:12 Here is the perseverance of the saints who keep the commandments of God and their <u>faith</u> in Jesus.
