Matthew 4:23-24

- 23 Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing <2323 therapeuo> every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.
- 24 The news about Him spread throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all who were ill, those suffering with various diseases and pains, demoniacs, epileptics, paralytics; and He healed <2323 therapeuo> them.

Matthew 8:7

Jesus *said to him, "I will come and heal <2323 therapeuo> him."

Matthew 8:16

When evening came, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed; and He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed <2323 therapeuo> all who were ill.

Matthew 9:35

Jesus was going through all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing **<2323 therapeuo>** every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

Matthew 10:1

Jesus summoned His twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal <2323 therapeuo> every kind of disease and every kind of sickness.

Matthew 10:8

"Heal **<2323 therapeuo>** *the* sick, raise *the* dead, cleanse *the* lepers, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

Matthew 12:10

And a man was there whose hand was withered. And they questioned Jesus, asking, "Is it lawful to heal **<2323 therapeuo>** on the Sabbath?"—so that they might accuse Him.

Matthew 21:14

And *the* blind and *the* lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed **<2323 therapeuo>** them.

Mark 1:34

And He healed <2323 therapeuo> many who were ill with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He was not permitting the demons to speak, because they knew who He was.

Mark 3:2

They were watching Him *to see* if He would heal **<2323 therapeuo>** him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him.

Mark 3:10

for He had healed <2323 therapeuo> many, with the result that all those who had afflictions pressed around Him in order to touch Him.

Mark 6:5

And He could do no miracle there except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed <2323 therapeuo> them.

Mark 6:13

And they were casting out many demons and were anointing with oil many sick people and healing **<2323 therapeuo>** them.

Luke 4:23

And He said to them, "No doubt you will quote this proverb to Me, 'Physician, heal <2323 therapeuo> yourself! Whatever we heard was done at Capernaum, do here in your hometown as well."

And Jesus answered and spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, "Is it lawful to heal **<2323 therapeuo>** on the Sabbath, or not?"

John 5:10

So the Jews were saying to the man who was cured <2323 therapeuo>, "It is the Sabbath, and it is not permissible for you to carry your pallet."

Acts 4:14

And seeing the man who had been healed <2323 therapeuo> standing with them, they had nothing to say in reply.

Acts 5:16

Also the people from the cities in the vicinity of Jerusalem were coming together, bringing people who were sick or afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all being healed<2323 therapeuo>.

For in the case of many who had unclean spirits, they were coming out of them shouting

to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing **<2386 iama>** by the one Spirit,

Matthew 12:13

So the crowd marveled as they saw the mute speaking, the crippled restored **<5199 hugies>**, and the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

Mark 5:34

And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace and be healed <5199 hugies> of your affliction."

John 5:4

for an angel of the Lord went down at certain seasons into the pool and stirred up the water; whoever then first, after the stirring up of the water, stepped in was made well **<5199 hugies>** from whatever disease with which he was afflicted.]]

John 5:6

When Jesus saw him lying *there*, and knew that he had already been a long time *in that condition*, He *said to him, "Do you wish to get well **<5199 hugies>?**"

John 5:9

Immediately the man became well **<5199 hugies>**, and picked up his pallet and *began* to walk. Now it was the Sabbath on that day.

John 5:11

But he answered them, "He who made me well **<5199 hugies>** was the one who said to me, 'Pick up your pallet and walk.'"
