### HADES: αιδης (hades)

#### Three Greek words translated as Hell: Hades, Gehenna, Tartaroo

##### 86. αιδης *hades* (*hah'-dace*);

from 1 (as negative particle) and 1492; properly, unseen, i.e. "Hades" or the place (state) of departed souls:--grave, hell.

**NAS**-Hades (10).

**AV**-hell 10, grave 1; 11

- 1) name Hades or Pluto, the god of the lower regions
- 2) Orcus, the nether world, the realm of the dead
- 3) later use of this word: the grave, death, hell

In Biblical Greek it is associated with Orcus, the infernal regions, a dark and dismal place in the very depths of the earth, the common receptacle of disembodied spirits. Usually Hades is just the abode of the wicked, Lu 16:23; Re 20:13,14; a very uncomfortable place. TDNT.

Matthew 11:23

And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to **hell <86 hades>**: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

Matthew 16:18

And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of **hell <86 hades>** shall not prevail against it.

**GEHENNA:** **γέεννα** **geenna** (**gheh'-en-nah**;) )

**1067. γέεννα** **geenna** (**gheh'-en-nah**;) )

of Hebrew origin [01516 and 02011]; valley of (the son of) Hinnom; ge-henna (or Ge-Hinnom), a valley of Jerusalem, used (figuratively) as a name for the place (or state) of everlasting punishment:--hell.

Matthew 5:22

But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of **hell <1067 Gehenna>** fire.
