The following is in **Raw Data Format**. That means this information is *unedited*. This is a sequential listing of the all instances where the words: *God* and *is*; *Man* and *is*; are side by side in order for every verse of the bible sequentially by Book. Some verses listed may not reveal anything about God or man. For instance, when a sentence ends with God or man and the next sentence begins with is. Nonetheless, the results are very revealing and you need to review each verse for yourself to determine what is being said or revealed.

My primary motivation for the main study is to dispel the myth, which is heretical when twisted and distorted that some groups attempt to use to falsely teach that man is a god, but a *lesser* god than God is God; man is god and may become *equal* or *greater* to God as God is God; man will *become* god as God is God after his resurrection; Triune God in essence has a physical body; God is not Triune in nature; God like man. - Genesis 21:22 Now it came about at that time that Abimelech and Phicol, the commander of his army, spoke to Abraham, saying, "God is with you in all that you do;
- Genesis 31:50 "If you mistreat my daughters, or if you take wives besides my daughters, *although* no man is with us, see, God is witness between you and me."
- Leviticus 21:12 nor shall he go out of the sanctuary nor profane the sanctuary of his God, for the consecration of the anointing oil of his God is on him; I am the LORD.
- Numbers 6:7 'He shall not make himself unclean for his father or for his mother, for his brother or for his sister, when they die, because his separation to God is on his head.

- Zephaniah 3:17 "The LORD your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy.
- Zechariah 8:23 "Thus says the LORD of hosts, 'In those days ten men from all the nations will grasp the garment of a Jew, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you."

- Matthew 3:9 and do not suppose that you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham for our father'; for I say to you that from these stones God is able to raise up children to Abraham.
- Mark 1:15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."
- Mark 4:26 And He was saying, "The kingdom of God is like a man who casts seed upon the soil; Mark 12:29 Jesus answered, "The foremost is, 'HEAR, O ISRAEL! THE LORD OUR GOD IS ONE LORD;
- Luke 3:8 "Therefore bear fruits in keeping with repentance, and do not begin to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham for our father,' for I say to you that from these stones God is able to raise up children to Abraham.
- Luke 7:28 "I say to you, among those born of women there is no one greater than John; yet he who is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."
- Luke 17:20 Now having been questioned by the Pharisees as to when the kingdom of God was coming, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed;
- Luke 17:21 nor will they say, 'Look, here *it is!*' or, 'There *it is!*' For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst."
- Luke 21:31 "So you also, when you see these things happening, recognize that the kingdom of God is near.
- John 3:2 this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God as a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."
- John 3:33 "He who has received His testimony has set his seal to this, that God is true.
- John 4:24 "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."
- John 6:33 "For the bread of God is that which comes down out of heaven, and gives life to the world."

- John 13:31 Therefore when he had gone out, Jesus *said, "Now is the Son of Man glorified, and God is glorified in Him;
- John 13:32 if God is glorified in Him, God will also glorify Him in Himself, and will glorify Him immediately.
- Acts 10:34 Opening his mouth, Peter said: "I most certainly understand *now* that God is not one to show partiality,
- Acts 17:30 "Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all *people* everywhere should repent,
- Acts 23:3 Then Paul said to him, "God is going to strike you, you whitewashed wall! Do you sit to try me according to the Law, and in violation of the Law order me to be struck?"
- Romans 1:17 For in it *the* righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "BUT THE RIGHTEOUS *man* SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."
- Romans 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,
- Romans 1:19 because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.
- Romans 2:24 For "THE NAME OF GOD IS BLASPHEMED AMONG THE GENTILES BECAUSE OF YOU," just as it is written.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Romans 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us?
- Romans 8:33 Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies;
- Romans 9:14 What shall we say then? There is no injustice with God, is there? May it never be!
- Romans 11:23 And they also, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.
- Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
- Romans 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 1:9 God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
- 1 Corinthians 1:25 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.
- 1 Corinthians 3:17 If any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, and that is what you are.
- 1 Corinthians 9:9 For it is written in the Law of Moses, "YOU SHALL NOT MUZZLE THE OX WHILE HE IS THRESHING." God is not concerned about oxen, is He?
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I want you to understand that Christ is the head of every man, and the man is the head of a woman, and God is the head of Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 14:25 the secrets of his heart are disclosed; and so he will fall on his face and worship God, declaring that God is certainly among you.

- 1 Corinthians 14:33 for God is not *a God* of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.
- 2 Corinthians 1:18 But as God is faithful, our word to you is not yes and no.
- 2 Corinthians 9:8 And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed;
- Galatians 3:11 Now that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, "THE RIGHTEOUS MAN SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."
- Galatians 3:20 Now a mediator is not for one party only; whereas God is only one.
- Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.
- Philippians 1:8 For God is my witness, how I long for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus.
- Philippians 3:19 whose end is destruction, whose god is *their* appetite, and *whose* glory is in their shame, who set their minds on earthly things.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:5 For we never came with flattering speech, as you know, nor with a pretext for greed—God is witness—
- 1 Timothy 4:4 For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with gratitude;
- 2 Timothy 2:9 for which I suffer hardship even to imprisonment as a criminal; but the word of God is not imprisoned.
- Hebrews 1:8 But of the Son *He says*, "YOUR THRONE, O GOD, IS FOREVER AND EVER, AND THE RIGHTEOUS SCEPTER IS THE SCEPTER OF HIS KINGDOM.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
- Hebrews 6:10 For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.
- Hebrews 11:16 But as it is, they desire a better *country*, that is, a heavenly one. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God; for He has prepared a city for them.
- Hebrews 11:19 He considered that God is able to raise *people* even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type.
- Hebrews 12:29 for our God is a consuming fire.
- Hebrews 13:16 And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.
- James 2:19 You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder.
- James 4:6 But He gives a greater grace. Therefore *it* says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE."
- 1 Peter 5:5 You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.
- 1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.
- 1 John 3:20 in whatever our heart condemns us; for God is greater than our heart and knows all things.
- 1 John 4:8 The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

- 1 John 4:16 We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.
- 1 John 5:9 If we receive the testimony of men, the testimony of God is greater; for the testimony of God is this, that He has testified concerning His Son.
- Revelation 10:7 but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of God is finished, as He preached to His servants the prophets.
- Revelation 15:1 Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels who had seven plagues, *which are* the last, because in them the wrath of God is finished.
- Revelation 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne, saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them,

Old Testament: Man Is...

- Genesis 31:50 "If you mistreat my daughters, or if you take wives besides my daughters, *although* no man is with us, see, God is witness between you and me."
- Exodus 34:3 "No man is to come up with you, nor let any man be seen anywhere on the mountain; even the flocks and the herds may not graze in front of that mountain."
- Deuteronomy 22:22 "If a man is found lying with a married woman, then both of them shall die, the man who lay with the woman, and the woman; thus you shall purge the evil from Israel.
- Deuteronomy 24:7 "If a man is caught kidnapping any of his countrymen of the sons of Israel, and he deals with him violently or sells him, then that thief shall die; so you shall purge the evil from among you.
- Ruth 2:20 Naomi said to her daughter-in-law, "May he be blessed of the LORD who has not withdrawn his kindness to the living and to the dead." Again Naomi said to her, "The man is our relative, he is one of our closest relatives."
- 1 Samuel 9:6 He said to him, "Behold now, there is a man of God in this city, and the man is held in honor; all that he says surely comes true. Now let us go there, perhaps he can tell us about our journey on which we have set out."
- 1 Samuel 28:14 He said to her, "What is his form?" And she said, "An old man is coming up, and he is wrapped with a robe." And Saul knew that it was Samuel, and he bowed with his face to the ground and did homage.
- 1 Kings 20:7 Then the king of Israel called all the elders of the land and said, "Please observe and see how this man is looking for trouble; for he sent to me for my wives and my children and my silver and my gold, and I did not refuse him."
- 2 Kings 5:7 When the king of Israel read the letter, he tore his clothes and said, "Am I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man is sending *word* to me to cure a man of his leprosy? But consider now, and see how he is seeking a quarrel against me."
- Job 5:7 For man is born for trouble, As sparks fly upward.
- Job 12:4 "I am a joke to my friends, The one who called on God and He answered him; The just *and* blameless *man* is a joke.
- Job 33:19 "Man is also chastened with pain on his bed, And with unceasing complaint in his bones;
- Job 34:7 "What man is like Job, Who drinks up derision like water,

- Psalms 39:11 "With reproofs You chasten a man for iniquity; You consume as a moth what is precious to him; Surely every man is a mere breath. Selah.
- Psalms 60:11 O give us help against the adversary, For deliverance by man is in vain.
- Psalms 108:12 Oh give us help against the adversary, For deliverance by man is in vain.
- Psalms 144:4 Man is like a mere breath; His days are like a passing shadow.
- Proverbs 6:12 A worthless person, a wicked man, Is the one who walks with a perverse mouth,
- Proverbs 12:13 An evil man is ensnared by the transgression of his lips, But the righteous will escape from trouble.
- Proverbs 12:15 The way of a fool is right in his own eyes, But a wise man is he who listens to counsel.
- Proverbs 12:27 A lazy man does not roast his prey, But the precious possession of a man is diligence.
- Proverbs 14:16 A wise man is cautious and turns away from evil, But a fool is arrogant and careless.
- Proverbs 18:12 Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, But humility goes before honor.
- Proverbs 19:4 Wealth adds many friends, But a poor man is separated from his friend.
- Proverbs 19:6 Many will seek the favor of a generous man, And every man is a friend to him who gives gifts.
- Proverbs 19:22 What is desirable in a man is his kindness, And *it is* better to be a poor man than a liar.
- Proverbs 20:5 A plan in the heart of a man is *like* deep water, But a man of understanding draws it out
- Proverbs 20:27 The spirit of man is the lamp of the LORD, Searching all the innermost parts of his being.
- Proverbs 21:8 The way of a guilty man is crooked, But as for the pure, his conduct is upright.
- Proverbs 24:5 A wise man is strong, And a man of knowledge increases power.
- Proverbs 28:11 The rich man is wise in his own eyes, But the poor who has understanding sees through him.
- Proverbs 29:6 By transgression an evil man is ensnared, But the righteous sings and rejoices.
- Proverbs 29:27 An unjust man is abominable to the righteous, And he who is upright in the way is abominable to the wicked.
- Ecclesiastes 1:8 All things are wearisome; Man is not able to tell *it*. The eye is not satisfied with seeing, Nor is the ear filled with hearing.
- Ecclesiastes 5:12 The sleep of the working man is pleasant, whether he eats little or much; but the full stomach of the rich man does not allow him to sleep.
- Ecclesiastes 5:16 This also is a grievous evil—exactly as a man is born, thus will he die. So what is the advantage to him who toils for the wind?
- Ecclesiastes 6:10 Whatever exists has already been named, and it is known what man is; for he cannot dispute with him who is stronger than he is.
- Ecclesiastes 9:2 It is the same for all. There is one fate for the righteous and for the wicked; for the good, for the clean and for the unclean; for the man who offers a sacrifice and for the one who does not sacrifice. As the good man is, so is the sinner; as the swearer is, so is the one who is afraid to swear.
- Ecclesiastes 9:16 So I said, "Wisdom is better than strength." But the wisdom of the poor man is despised and his words are not heeded.

- Isaiah 57:1 The righteous man perishes, and no man takes it to heart; And devout men are taken away, while no one understands. For the righteous man is taken away from evil,
- Jeremiah 10:14 Every man is stupid, devoid of knowledge; Every goldsmith is put to shame by his idols; For his molten images are deceitful, And there is no breath in them.
- Jeremiah 38:4 Then the officials said to the king, "Now let this man be put to death, inasmuch as he is discouraging the men of war who are left in this city and all the people, by speaking such words to them; for this man is not seeking the well-being of this people but rather their harm."
- Ezekiel 8:17 He said to me, "Do you see *this*, son of man? Is it too light a thing for the house of Judah to commit the abominations which they have committed here, that they have filled the land with violence and provoked Me repeatedly? For behold, they are putting the twig to their nose.
- Ezekiel 18:5 "But if a man is righteous and practices justice and righteousness,
- Hosea 9:7 The days of punishment have come, The days of retribution have come; Let Israel know *this!* The prophet is a fool, The inspired man is demented, Because of the grossness of your iniquity, And *because* your hostility is *so* great.
- Hosea 9:12 Though they bring up their children, Yet I will bereave them until not a man is left. Yes, woe to them indeed when I depart from them!

New Testament: Man Is...

- Matthew 7:9 "Or what man is there among you who, when his son asks for a loaf, will give him a stone?
- Matthew 8:27 The men were amazed, and said, "What kind of a man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?"
- Matthew 12:8 "For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."
- Matthew 12:11 And He said to them, "What man is there among you who has a sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will he not take hold of it and lift it out?
- Matthew 16:13 Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, He was asking His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"
- Matthew 16:27 "For the Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and WILL THEN REPAY EVERY MAN ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS.
- Matthew 17:12 but I say to you that Elijah already came, and they did not recognize him, but did to him whatever they wished. So also the Son of Man is going to suffer at their hands."
- Matthew 17:22 And while they were gathering together in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men;
- Matthew 24:44 "For this reason you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think *He will*.
- Matthew 26:2 "You know that after two days the Passover is coming, and the Son of Man is to be handed over for crucifixion."
- Matthew 26:24 "The Son of Man *is to* go, just as it is written of Him; but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! It would have been good for that man if he had not been born."

- Matthew 26:45 Then He *came to the disciples and *said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Behold, the hour is at hand and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners
- Matthew 27:47 And some of those who were standing there, when they heard it, *began* saying, "This man is calling for Elijah."
- Mark 2:28 "So the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath."
- Mark 9:31 For He was teaching His disciples and telling them, "The Son of Man is to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, He will rise three days later."
- Mark 14:21 "For the Son of Man is to go just as it is written of Him; but woe to that man by whom the Son of Man is betrayed! *It would have been* good for that man if he had not been born."
- Mark 14:41 And He *came the third time, and *said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? It is enough; the hour has come; behold, the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners.
- Luke 6:5 And He was saying to them, "The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."
- Luke 9:44 "Let these words sink into your ears; for the Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men."
- Luke 12:40 "You too, be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour that you do not expect."
- Luke 17:30 "It will be just the same on the day that the Son of Man is revealed.
- Luke 22:22 "For indeed, the Son of Man is going as it has been determined; but woe to that man by whom He is betrayed!"
- John 7:27 "However, we know where this man is from; but whenever the Christ may come, no one knows where He is from."
- John 9:16 Therefore some of the Pharisees were saying, "This man is not from God, because He does not keep the Sabbath." But others were saying, "How can a man who is a sinner perform such signs?" And there was a division among them.
- John 9:24 So a second time they called the man who had been blind, and said to him, "Give glory to God; we know that this man is a sinner."
- John 11:47 Therefore the chief priests and the Pharisees convened a council, and were saying, "What are we doing? For this man is performing many signs.
- Acts 8:10 and they all, from smallest to greatest, were giving attention to him, saying, "This man is what is called the Great Power of God."
- Acts 19:35 After quieting the crowd, the town clerk *said, "Men of Ephesus, what man is there after all who does not know that the city of the Ephesians is guardian of the temple of the great Artemis and of the *image* which fell down from heaven?
- Acts 22:26 When the centurion heard *this*, he went to the commander and told him, saying, "What are you about to do? For this man is a Roman."
- Acts 26:31 and when they had gone aside, they *began* talking to one another, saying, "This man is not doing anything worthy of death or imprisonment."
- Acts 28:4 When the natives saw the creature hanging from his hand, they *began* saying to one another, "Undoubtedly this man is a murderer, and though he has been saved from the sea, justice has not allowed him to live."
- Romans 3:28 For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from works of the Law.

- 1 Corinthians 7:2 But because of immoralities, each man is to have his own wife, and each woman is to have her own husband.
- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I want you to understand that Christ is the head of every man, and the man is the head of a woman, and God is the head of Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 15:47 The first man is from the earth, earthy; the second man is from heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day.
- 2 Corinthians 12:4 was caught up into Paradise and heard inexpressible words, which a man is not permitted to speak.
- Galatians 1:9 As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!
- Galatians 2:16 nevertheless knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.
- Titus 1:6 *namely*, if any man is above reproach, the husband of one wife, having children who believe, not accused of dissipation or rebellion.
- Titus 3:11 knowing that such a man is perverted and is sinning, being self-condemned.
- James 1:10 and the rich man *is to glory* in his humiliation, because like flowering grass he will pass away.
- James 2:6 But you have dishonored the poor man. Is it not the rich who oppress you and personally drag you into court?
- James 2:24 You see that a man is justified by works and not by faith alone.
- 2 Peter 2:19 promising them freedom while they themselves are slaves of corruption; for by what a man is overcome, by this he is enslaved.
