Old Testament

- Genesis 15:14 "But I will also judge the nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with many possessions.
- Genesis 16:5 And Sarai said to Abram, "May the wrong done me be upon you. I gave my maid into your arms, but when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her sight. May the LORD judge between you and me."
- Genesis 18:25 "Far be it from You to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are *treated* alike. Far be it from You! Shall not the <u>Judge</u> of all the earth deal justly?"
- Genesis 19:9 But they said, "Stand aside." Furthermore, they said, "This one came in as an alien, and already he is acting like a judge; now we will treat you worse than them." So they pressed hard against Lot and came near to break the door.
- Genesis 31:42 "If the God of my father, the God of Abraham, and the fear of Isaac, had not been for me, surely now you would have sent me away empty-handed. God has seen my affliction and the toil of my hands, so He rendered judgment last night."
- Genesis 31:53 "The God of Abraham and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, judge between us." So Jacob swore by the fear of his father Isaac.
- Genesis 49:16 "Dan shall judge his people, As one of the tribes of Israel.
- Exodus 2:14 But he said, "Who made you a prince or a judge over us? Are you intending to kill me as you killed the Egyptian?" Then Moses was afraid and said, "Surely the matter has become known."
- Exodus 5:21 They said to them, "May the LORD look upon you and judge you, for you have made us odious in Pharaoh's sight and in the sight of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to kill us."
- Exodus 6:6 "Say, therefore, to the sons of Israel, 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from their bondage. I will also redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.
- Exodus 7:4 "When Pharaoh does not listen to you, then I will lay My hand on Egypt and bring out My hosts, My people the sons of Israel, from the land of Egypt by great judgments.
- Exodus 12:12 'For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments—I am the LORD.
- Exodus 18:13 It came about the next day that Moses sat to judge the people, and the people stood about Moses from the morning until the evening.

- Exodus 18:14 Now when Moses' father-in-law saw all that he was doing for the people, he said, "What is this thing that you are doing for the people? Why do you alone sit *as* <u>judge</u> and all the people stand about you from morning until evening?"
- Exodus 18:16 "When they have a dispute, it comes to me, and I judge between a man and his neighbor and make known the statutes of God and His laws."
- Exodus 18:22 "Let them judge the people at all times; and let it be that every major dispute they will bring to you, but every minor dispute they themselves will judge. So it will be easier for you, and they will bear *the burden* with you.
- Exodus 18:26 They judged the people at all times; the difficult dispute they would bring to Moses, but every minor dispute they themselves would judge.
- Exodus 21:22 "If men struggle with each other and strike a woman with child so that she gives birth prematurely, yet there is no injury, he shall surely be fined as the woman's husband may demand of him, and he shall pay as the judges decide.
- Exodus 22:8 "If the thief is not caught, then the owner of the house shall appear before the judges, to determine whether he laid his hands on his neighbor's property.
- Exodus 22:9 "For every breach of trust, *whether it is* for ox, for donkey, for sheep, for clothing, *or* for any lost thing about which one says, 'This is it,' the case of both parties shall come before the judges; he whom the judges condemn shall pay double to his neighbor.
- Exodus 28:15 "You shall make a breastpiece of judgment, the work of a skillful workman; like the work of the ephod you shall make it: of gold, of blue and purple and scarlet *material* and fine twisted linen you shall make it.
- Exodus 28:29 "Aaron shall carry the names of the sons of Israel in the breastpiece of judgment over his heart when he enters the holy place, for a memorial before the LORD continually.
- Exodus 28:30 "You shall put in the breastpiece of judgment the Urim and the Thummim, and they shall be over Aaron's heart when he goes in before the LORD; and Aaron shall carry the judgment of the sons of Israel over his heart before the LORD continually.
- Leviticus 18:4 'You are to perform My judgments and keep My statutes, to live in accord with them; I am the LORD your God.
- Leviticus 18:5 'So you shall keep My statutes and My judgments, by which a man may live if he does them; I am the LORD.
- Leviticus 18:26 'But as for you, you are to keep My statutes and My judgments and shall not do any of these abominations, *neither* the native, nor the alien who sojourns among you
- Leviticus 19:15 'You shall do no injustice in judgment; you shall not be partial to the poor nor defer to the great, but you are to judge your neighbor fairly.

Leviticus 19:35 'You shall do no wrong in judgment, in measurement of weight, or capacity.

- Leviticus 25:18 'You shall thus observe My statutes and keep My judgments, so as to carry them out, that you may live securely on the land.
- Numbers 25:5 So Moses said to the judges of Israel, "Each of you slay his men who have joined themselves to Baal of Peor."
- Numbers 27:21 "Moreover, he shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall inquire for him by the judgment of the Urim before the LORD. At his command they shall go out

and at his command they shall come in, *both* he and the sons of Israel with him, even all the congregation."

- Numbers 33:4 while the Egyptians were burying all their firstborn whom the LORD had struck down among them. The LORD had also executed judgments on their gods.
- Numbers 35:24 then the congregation shall judge between the slayer and the blood avenger according to these ordinances.
- Deuteronomy 1:16 "Then I charged your judges at that time, saying, 'Hear *the cases* between your fellow countrymen, and judge righteously between a man and his fellow countryman, or the alien who is with him.
- Deuteronomy 1:17 'You shall not show partiality in judgment; you shall hear the small and the great alike. You shall not fear man, for the judgment is God's. The case that is too hard for you, you shall bring to me, and I will hear it.'
- Deuteronomy 4:1 "Now, O Israel, listen to the statutes and the judgments which I am teaching you to perform, so that you may live and go in and take possession of the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, is giving you.
- Deuteronomy 4:5 "See, I have taught you statutes and judgments just as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do thus in the land where you are entering to possess it.
- Deuteronomy 4:8 "Or what great nation is there that has statutes and judgments as righteous as this whole law which I am setting before you today?
- Deuteronomy 4:14 "The LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and judgments, that you might perform them in the land where you are going over to possess it.
- Deuteronomy 5:31 'But as for you, stand here by Me, that I may speak to you all the commandments and the statutes and the judgments which you shall teach them, that they may observe *them* in the land which I give them to possess.'
- Deuteronomy 6:1 "Now this is the commandment, the statutes and the judgments which the LORD your God has commanded *me* to teach you, that you might do *them* in the land where you are going over to possess it,
- Deuteronomy 6:20 "When your son asks you in time to come, saying, 'What *do* the testimonies and the statutes and the judgments *mean* which the LORD our God commanded you?'
- Deuteronomy 7:11 "Therefore, you shall keep the commandment and the statutes and the judgments which I am commanding you today, to do them.
- Deuteronomy 7:12 "Then it shall come about, because you listen to these judgments and keep and do them, that the LORD your God will keep with you His covenant and His lovingkindness which He swore to your forefathers.
- Deuteronomy 11:32 and you shall be careful to do all the statutes and the judgments which I am setting before you today.
- Deuteronomy 12:1 "These are the statutes and the judgments which you shall carefully observe in the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, has given you to possess as long as you live on the earth.
- Deuteronomy 16:18 "You shall appoint for yourself judges and officers in all your towns which the LORD your God is giving you, according to your tribes, and they shall judge the people with righteous judgment.

- Deuteronomy 17:9 "So you shall come to the Levitical priest or the judge who is *in office* in those days, and you shall inquire *of them* and they will declare to you the verdict in the case.
- Deuteronomy 17:12 "The man who acts presumptuously by not listening to the priest who stands there to serve the LORD your God, nor to the judge, that man shall die; thus you shall purge the evil from Israel.
- Deuteronomy 19:17 then both the men who have the dispute shall stand before the LORD, before the priests and the judges who will be *in office* in those days.
- Deuteronomy 19:18 "The judges shall investigate thoroughly, and if the witness is a false witness *and* he has accused his brother falsely,
- Deuteronomy 21:2 then your elders and your judges shall go out and measure *the distance* to the cities which are around the slain one.
- Deuteronomy 25:1 "If there is a dispute between men and they go to court, and the judges decide their case, and they justify the righteous and condemn the wicked,
- Deuteronomy 25:2 then it shall be if the wicked man deserves to be beaten, the judge shall then make him lie down and be beaten in his presence with the number of stripes according to his guilt.
- Deuteronomy 30:16 in that I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in His ways and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, that you may live and multiply, and that the LORD your God may bless you in the land where you are entering to possess it.
- Deuteronomy 32:31 "Indeed their rock is not like our Rock, Even our enemies themselves judge this.
- Joshua 8:33 All Israel with their elders and officers and their judges were standing on both sides of the ark before the Levitical priests who carried the ark of the covenant of the LORD, the stranger as well as the native. Half of them *stood* in front of Mount Gerizim and half of them in front of Mount Ebal, just as Moses the servant of the LORD had given command at first to bless the people of Israel.
- Joshua 20:6 'He shall dwell in that city until he stands before the congregation for <u>judgment</u>, until the death of the one who is high priest in those days. Then the manslayer shall return to his own city and to his own house, to the city from which he fled.'"
- Joshua 23:2 that Joshua called for all Israel, for their elders and their heads and their judges and their officers, and said to them, "I am old, advanced in years.
- Joshua 24:1 Then Joshua gathered all the tribes of Israel to Shechem, and called for the elders of Israel and for their heads and their judges and their officers; and they presented themselves before God.
- Judges 2:16 Then the LORD raised up judges who delivered them from the hands of those who plundered them.
- Judges 2:17 Yet they did not listen to their judges, for they played the harlot after other gods and bowed themselves down to them. They turned aside quickly from the way in which their fathers had walked in obeying the commandments of the LORD; they did not do as *their fathers*.
- Judges 2:18 When the LORD raised up judges for them, the LORD was with the judge and delivered them from the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge; for the LORD

was moved to pity by their groaning because of those who oppressed and afflicted them.

- Judges 2:19 But it came about when the judge died, that they would turn back and act more corruptly than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them and bow down to them; they did not abandon their practices or their stubborn ways.
- Judges 3:10 The Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel. When he went out to war, the LORD gave Cushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand, so that he prevailed over Cushan-rishathaim.
- Judges 4:4 Now Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lappidoth, was judging Israel at that time.
- Judges 4:5 She used to sit under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in the hill country of Ephraim; and the sons of Israel came up to her for judgment.

Judges 10:2 He judged Israel twenty-three years. Then he died and was buried in Shamir.

- Judges 10:3 After him, Jair the Gileadite arose and judged Israel twenty-two years.
- Judges 11:27 'I therefore have not sinned against you, but you are doing me wrong by making war against me; may the LORD, the <u>Judge</u>, <u>judge</u> today between the sons of Israel and the sons of Ammon.'"
- Judges 12:7 Jephthah judged Israel six years. Then Jephthah the Gileadite died and was buried in *one of* the cities of Gilead.
- Judges 12:8 Now Ibzan of Bethlehem judged Israel after him.
- Judges 12:9 He had thirty sons, and thirty daughters *whom* he gave in marriage outside *the family,* and he brought in thirty daughters from outside for his sons. And he judged Israel seven years.
- Judges 12:11 Now Elon the Zebulunite judged Israel after him; and he judged Israel ten years.
- Judges 12:13 Now Abdon the son of Hillel the Pirathonite judged Israel after him.
- Judges 12:14 He had forty sons and thirty grandsons who rode on seventy donkeys; and he judged Israel eight years.
- Judges 15:20 So he judged Israel twenty years in the days of the Philistines.
- Judges 16:31 Then his brothers and all his father's household came down, took him, brought him up and buried him between Zorah and Eshtaol in the tomb of Manoah his father. Thus he had judged Israel twenty years.
- Ruth 1:1 Now it came about in the days when the judges governed, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Bethlehem in Judah went to sojourn in the land of Moab with his wife and his two sons.
- 1 Samuel 2:10 "Those who contend with the LORD will be shattered; Against them He will thunder in the heavens, The LORD will judge the ends of the earth; And He will give strength to His king, And will exalt the horn of His anointed."
- 1 Samuel 3:13 "For I have told him that I am about to judge his house forever for the iniquity which he knew, because his sons brought a curse on themselves and he did not rebuke them.
- 1 Samuel 4:18 When he mentioned the ark of God, Eli fell off the seat backward beside the gate, and his neck was broken and he died, for he was old and heavy. Thus he judged Israel forty years.

- 1 Samuel 7:6 They gathered to Mizpah, and drew water and poured it out before the LORD, and fasted on that day and said there, "We have sinned against the LORD." And Samuel judged the sons of Israel at Mizpah.
- 1 Samuel 7:15 Now Samuel judged Israel all the days of his life.
- 1 Samuel 7:16 He used to go annually on circuit to Bethel and Gilgal and Mizpah, and he judged Israel in all these places.
- 1 Samuel 7:17 Then his return *was* to Ramah, for his house *was* there, and there he judged Israel; and he built there an altar to the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 8:1 And it came about when Samuel was old that he appointed his sons judges over Israel.
- 1 Samuel 8:2 Now the name of his firstborn was Joel, and the name of his second, Abijah; *they* were <u>judging</u> in Beersheba.
- 1 Samuel 8:5 and they said to him, "Behold, you have grown old, and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now appoint a king for us to judge us like all the nations."
- 1 Samuel 8:6 But the thing was displeasing in the sight of Samuel when they said, "Give us a king to judge us." And Samuel prayed to the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 8:20 that we also may be like all the nations, that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles."
- 1 Samuel 24:12 "May the LORD judge between you and me, and may the LORD avenge me on you; but my hand shall not be against you.
- 1 Samuel 24:15 "The LORD therefore be judge and decide between you and me; and may He see and plead my cause and deliver me from your hand."
- 2 Samuel 7:11 even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel; and I will give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also declares to you that the LORD will make a house for you.
- 2 Samuel 15:2 Absalom used to rise early and stand beside the way to the gate; and when any man had a suit to come to the king for judgment, Absalom would call to him and say, "From what city are you?" And he would say, "Your servant is from one of the tribes of Israel."
- 2 Samuel 15:4 Moreover, Absalom would say, "Oh that one would appoint me judge in the land, then every man who has any suit or cause could come to me and I would give him justice."
- 2 Samuel 15:6 In this manner Absalom dealt with all Israel who came to the king for judgment; so Absalom stole away the hearts of the men of Israel.
- 1 Kings 3:9 "So give Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people to discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?"
- 1 Kings 3:28 When all Israel heard of the judgment which the king had handed down, they feared the king, for they saw that the wisdom of God was in him to administer justice.
- 1 Kings 7:7 He made the hall of the throne where he was to judge, the hall of judgment, and it was paneled with cedar from floor to floor.
- 1 Kings 8:32 then hear in heaven and act and judge Your servants, condemning the wicked by bringing his way on his own head and justifying the righteous by giving him according to his righteousness.
- 1 Kings 20:40 "While your servant was busy here and there, he was gone." And the king of Israel said to him, "So shall your judgment be; you yourself have decided *it.*"

- 2 Kings 15:5 The LORD struck the king, so that he was a leper to the day of his death. And he lived in a separate house, while Jotham the king's son was over the household, judging the people of the land.
- 2 Kings 23:22 Surely such a Passover had not been celebrated from the days of the judges who judged Israel, nor in all the days of the kings of Israel and of the kings of Judah.
- 1 Chronicles 16:12 Remember His wonderful deeds which He has done, His marvels and the judgments from His mouth,
- 1 Chronicles 16:14 He is the LORD our God; His judgments are in all the earth.
- 1 Chronicles 16:33 Then the trees of the forest will sing for joy before the LORD; For He is coming to judge the earth.
- 1 Chronicles 17:6 "In all places where I have walked with all Israel, have I spoken a word with any of the judges of Israel, whom I commanded to shepherd My people, saying, 'Why have you not built for Me a house of cedar?'"
- 1 Chronicles 17:10 even from the day that I commanded judges to be over My people Israel. And I will subdue all your enemies. Moreover, I tell you that the LORD will build a house for you.
- 1 Chronicles 23:4 Of these, 24,000 were to oversee the work of the house of the LORD; and 6,000 *were* officers and judges,
- 1 Chronicles 26:29 As for the Izharites, Chenaniah and his sons were *assigned* to outside duties for Israel, as officers and judges.
- 2 Chronicles 1:2 Solomon spoke to all Israel, to the commanders of thousands and of hundreds and to the judges and to every leader in all Israel, the heads of the fathers' *households.*
- 2 Chronicles 6:23 then hear from heaven and act and judge Your servants, punishing the wicked by bringing his way on his own head and justifying the righteous by giving him according to his righteousness.
- 2 Chronicles 19:5 He appointed judges in the land in all the fortified cities of Judah, city by city.
- 2 Chronicles 19:6 He said to the judges, "Consider what you are doing, for you do not judge for man but for the LORD who is with you when you render judgment.
- 2 Chronicles 19:8 In Jerusalem also Jehoshaphat appointed some of the Levites and priests, and some of the heads of the fathers' *households* of Israel, for the judgment of the LORD and to judge disputes among the inhabitants of Jerusalem.
- 2 Chronicles 20:9 'Should evil come upon us, the sword, *or* judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we will stand before this house and before You (for Your name is in this house) and cry to You in our distress, and You will hear and deliver *us.*'
- 2 Chronicles 20:12 "O our God, will You not judge them? For we are powerless before this great multitude who are coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are on You."
- 2 Chronicles 22:8 It came about when Jehu was executing judgment on the house of Ahab, he found the princes of Judah and the sons of Ahaziah's brothers ministering to Ahaziah, and slew them.

- 2 Chronicles 24:24 Indeed the army of the Arameans came with a small number of men; yet the LORD delivered a very great army into their hands, because they had forsaken the LORD, the God of their fathers. Thus they executed judgment on Joash.
- 2 Chronicles 26:21 King Uzziah was a leper to the day of his death; and he lived in a separate house, being a leper, for he was cut off from the house of the LORD. And Jotham his son *was* over the king's house judging the people of the land.
- Ezra 4:9 then *wrote* Rehum the commander and Shimshai the scribe and the rest of their colleagues, the judges and the lesser governors, the officials, the secretaries, the men of Erech, the Babylonians, the men of Susa, that is, the Elamites,
- Ezra 7:25 "You, Ezra, according to the wisdom of your God which is in your hand, appoint magistrates and judges that they may judge all the people who are in *the province* beyond the River, *even* all those who know the laws of your God; and you may teach anyone who is ignorant *of them.*
- Ezra 7:26 "Whoever will not observe the law of your God and the law of the king, let <u>judgment</u> be executed upon him strictly, whether for death or for banishment or for confiscation of goods or for imprisonment."
- Ezra 10:14 "Let our leaders represent the whole assembly and let all those in our cities who have married foreign wives come at appointed times, together with the elders and judges of each city, until the fierce anger of our God on account of this matter is turned away from us."
- Job 9:15 "For though I were right, I could not answer; I would have to implore the mercy of my judge.
- Job 9:24 "The earth is given into the hand of the wicked; He covers the faces of its judges. If *it is* not *He*, then who is it?
- Job 12:17 "He makes counselors walk barefoot And makes fools of judges.
- Job 14:3 "You also open Your eyes on him And bring him into judgment with Yourself.
- Job 19:29 "*Then* be afraid of the sword for yourselves, For wrath *brings* the punishment of the sword, So that you may know there is judgment."
- Job 21:22 "Can anyone teach God knowledge, In that He judges those on high?
- Job 22:4 "Is it because of your reverence that He reproves you, That He enters into judgment against you?
- Job 22:13 "You say, 'What does God know? Can He judge through the thick darkness?
- Job 23:7 "There the upright would reason with Him; And I would be delivered forever from my Judge.
- Job 31:11 "For that would be a lustful crime; Moreover, it would be an iniquity *punishable by* judges.
- Job 31:28 That too would have been an iniquity *calling for* judgment, For I would have denied God above.
- Job 34:23 "For He does not *need to* consider a man further, That he should go before God in judgment.
- Job 36:17 "But you were full of judgment on the wicked; Judgment and justice take hold of you.
- Job 36:31 "For by these He judges peoples; He gives food in abundance.

- Job 40:8 "Will you really annul My judgment? Will you condemn Me that you may be justified?
- Psalms 1:5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.
- Psalms 2:10 Now therefore, O kings, show discernment; Take warning, O judges of the earth.
- Psalms 7:6 Arise, O LORD, in Your anger; Lift up Yourself against the rage of my adversaries, And arouse Yourself for me; You have appointed judgment.
- Psalms 7:8 The LORD judges the peoples; Vindicate me, O LORD, according to my righteousness and my integrity that is in me.
- Psalms 7:11 God is a righteous judge, And a God who has indignation every day.
- Psalms 9:4 For You have maintained my just cause; You have sat on the throne judging righteously.
- Psalms 9:7 But the LORD abides forever; He has established His throne for judgment,
- Psalms 9:8 And He will judge the world in righteousness; He will execute judgment for the peoples with equity.
- Psalms 9:16 The LORD has made Himself known; He has executed judgment. In the work of his own hands the wicked is snared. Higgaion Selah.
- Psalms 9:19 Arise, O LORD, do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged before You.
- Psalms 10:5 His ways prosper at all times; Your judgments are on high, out of his sight; As for all his adversaries, he snorts at them.
- Psalms 17:2 Let my judgment come forth from Your presence; Let Your eyes look with equity.
- Psalms 19:9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the LORD are true; they are righteous altogether.
- Psalms 35:24 <u>Judge</u> me, O LORD my God, according to Your righteousness, And do not let them rejoice over me.
- Psalms 36:6 Your righteousness is like the mountains of God; Your judgments are *like* a great deep. O LORD, You preserve man and beast.
- Psalms 37:6 He will bring forth your righteousness as the light And your judgment as the noonday.
- Psalms 37:33 The LORD will not leave him in his hand Or let him be condemned when he is judged.
- Psalms 48:11 Let Mount Zion be glad, Let the daughters of Judah rejoice Because of Your judgments.
- Psalms 50:4 He summons the heavens above, And the earth, to judge His people:
- Psalms 50:6 And the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is judge. Selah.
- Psalms 51:4 Against You, You only, I have sinned And done what is evil in Your sight, So that You are justified when You speak And blameless when You judge.
- Psalms 58:1 <<For the choir director; *set to* Al-tashheth. A Mikhtam of David.>> Do you indeed speak righteousness, O gods? Do you judge uprightly, O sons of men?
- Psalms 58:11 And men will say, "Surely there is a reward for the righteous; Surely there is a God who judges on earth!"

- Psalms 67:4 Let the nations be glad and sing for joy; For You will judge the peoples with uprightness And guide the nations on the earth. Selah.
- Psalms 68:5 A father of the fatherless and a judge for the widows, Is God in His holy habitation.
- Psalms 72:1 << *A Psalm* of Solomon.>> Give the king Your judgments, O God, And Your righteousness to the king's son.
- Psalms 72:2 May he judge Your people with righteousness And Your afflicted with justice.
- Psalms 75:2 "When I select an appointed time, It is I who judge with equity.
- Psalms 75:7 But God is the <u>Judge</u>; He puts down one and exalts another.
- Psalms 76:8 You caused judgment to be heard from heaven; The earth feared and was still
- Psalms 76:9 When God arose to judgment, To save all the humble of the earth. Selah.
- Psalms 82:1 <<A Psalm of Asaph.>> God takes His stand in His own congregation; He judges in the midst of the rulers.

- Acts 7:35 "This Moses whom they disowned, saying, 'WHO MADE YOU A RULER AND A <u>JUDGE</u>?' is the one whom God sent *to be* both a ruler and a deliverer with the help of the angel who appeared to him in the thorn bush.
- Acts 8:33 "IN HUMILIATION HIS JUDGMENT WAS TAKEN AWAY; WHO WILL RELATE HIS GENERATION? FOR HIS LIFE IS REMOVED FROM THE EARTH."
- Acts 10:42 "And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly to testify that this is the One who has been appointed by God as <u>Judge</u> of the living and the dead.
- Acts 13:20 "After these things He gave *them* judges until Samuel the prophet.
- Acts 13:46 Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and said, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken to you first; since you repudiate it and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles.
- Acts 15:19 "Therefore it is my judgment that we do not trouble those who are turning to God from among the Gentiles,
- Acts 16:15 And when she and her household had been baptized, she urged us, saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house and stay." And she prevailed upon us.
- Acts 17:31 because He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed, having furnished proof to all men by raising Him from the dead."
- Acts 18:12 But while Gallio was proconsul of Achaia, the Jews with one accord rose up against Paul and brought him before the judgment seat,
- Acts 18:15 but if there are questions about words and names and your own law, look after it yourselves; I am unwilling to be a judge of these matters."
- Acts 18:16 And he drove them away from the judgment seat.
- Acts 18:17 And they all took hold of Sosthenes, the leader of the synagogue, and *began* beating him in front of the <u>judgment</u> seat. But Gallio was not concerned about any of these things.
- Acts 24:6 "And he even tried to desecrate the temple; and then we arrested him. [[We wanted to judge him according to our own Law.
- Acts 24:10 When the governor had nodded for him to speak, Paul responded: "Knowing that for many years you have been a judge to this nation, I cheerfully make my defense,

- Acts 24:25 But as he was discussing righteousness, self-control and the judgment to come, Felix became frightened and said, "Go away for the present, and when I find time I will summon you."
- Romans 2:1 Therefore you have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things.
- Romans 2:2 And we know that the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who practice such things.
- Romans 2:3 But do you suppose this, O man, when you pass judgment on those who practice such things and do the same *yourself,* that you will escape the judgment of God?
- Romans 2:5 But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God,
- Romans 2:12 For all who have sinned without the Law will also perish without the Law, and all who have sinned under the Law will be judged by the Law;
- Romans 2:16 on the day when, according to my gospel, God will judge the secrets of men through Christ Jesus.
- Romans 2:27 And he who is physically uncircumcised, if he keeps the Law, will he not judge you who though having the letter of the Lawand circumcision are a transgressor of the Law?
- Romans 3:4 May it never be! Rather, let God be found true, though every man *be found* a liar, as it is written, "THAT YOU MAY BE JUSTIFIED IN YOUR WORDS, AND PREVAIL WHEN YOU ARE <u>JUDGED</u>."
- Romans 3:6 May it never be! For otherwise, how will God judge the world?
- Romans 3:7 But if through my lie the truth of God abounded to His glory, why am I also still being judged as a sinner?
- Romans 5:16 The gift is not like *that which came* through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment arose from one *transgression* resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the free gift arose from many transgressions resulting in justification.
- Romans 11:33 Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and unfathomable His ways!
- Romans 12:3 For through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith.
- Romans 14:1 Now accept the one who is weak in faith, *but* not for *the purpose of* passing judgment on his opinions.
- Romans 14:3 The one who eats is not to regard with contempt the one who does not eat, and the one who does not eat is not to judge the one who eats, for God has accepted him.
- Romans 14:4 Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls; and he will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand.
- Romans 14:10 But you, why do you judge your brother? Or you again, why do you regard your brother with contempt? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God.
- Romans 14:13 Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather determine this—not to put an obstacle or a stumbling block in a brother's way.

- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment.
- 1 Corinthians 4:5 Therefore do not go on passing judgment before the time, *but wait* until the Lord comes who will both bring to light the things hidden in the darkness and disclose the motives of *men's* hearts; and then each man's praise will come to him from God.
- 1 Corinthians 5:3 For I, on my part, though absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged him who has so committed this, as though I were present.
- 1 Corinthians 5:12 For what have I to do with judging outsiders? Do you not judge those who are within *the church*?
- 1 Corinthians 5:13 But those who are outside, God judges. REMOVE THE WICKED MAN FROM AMONG YOURSELVES.
- 1 Corinthians 6:2 Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent *to constitute* the smallest law courts?
- 1 Corinthians 6:3 Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more matters of this life?
- 1 Corinthians 6:4 So if you have law courts dealing with matters of this life, do you appoint them as judges who are of no account in the church?
- 1 Corinthians 9:8 I am not speaking these things according to human judgment, am I? Or does not the Law also say these things?
- 1 Corinthians 10:15 I speak as to wise men; you judge what I say.
- 1 Corinthians 10:29 I mean not your own conscience, but the other *man's;* for why is my freedom judged by another's conscience?
- 1 Corinthians 11:13 <u>Judge</u> for yourselves: is it proper for a woman to pray to God *with her head* uncovered?
- 1 Corinthians 11:29 For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly.
- 1 Corinthians 11:31 But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged.
- 1 Corinthians 11:32 But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world.
- 1 Corinthians 11:34 If anyone is hungry, let him eat at home, so that you will not come together for judgment. The remaining matters I will arrange when I come.
- 1 Corinthians 14:29 Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others pass judgment.
- 2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
- Galatians 5:10 I have confidence in you in the Lord that you will adopt no other view; but the one who is disturbing you will bear his judgment, whoever he is.
- Colossians 2:16 Therefore no one is to act as your judge in regard to food or drink or in respect to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day—
- 2 Thessalonians 1:5 *This is* a plain indication of God's righteous judgment so that you will be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which indeed you are suffering.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:12 in order that they all may be judged who did not believe the truth, but took pleasure in wickedness.

- 1 Timothy 5:24 The sins of some men are quite evident, going before them to judgment; for others, their *sins* follow after.
- 2 Timothy 4:1 I solemnly charge *you* in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom:
- 2 Timothy 4:8 in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous <u>Judge</u>, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
- Hebrews 6:2 of instruction about washings and laying on of hands, and the resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment.
- Hebrews 9:27 And inasmuch as it is appointed for men to die once and after this *comes* judgment,
- Hebrews 10:27 but a terrifying expectation of judgment and THE FURY OF A FIRE WHICH WILL CONSUME THE ADVERSARIES.
- Hebrews 10:30 For we know Him who said, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY." And again, "THE LORD WILL JUDGE HIS PEOPLE."
- Hebrews 12:23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God, the Judge of all, and to the spirits of *the* righteous made perfect,
- Hebrews 13:4 Marriage *is to be held* in honor among all, and the *marriage* bed *is to be* undefiled; for fornicators and adulterers God will judge.
- James 2:4 have you not made distinctions among yourselves, and become judges with evil motives?
- James 2:12 So speak and so act as those who are to be judged by the law of liberty.
- James 2:13 For judgment will be merciless to one who has shown no mercy; mercy triumphs over judgment.
- James 3:1 Let not many *of you* become teachers, my brethren, knowing that as such we will incur a stricter judgment.
- James 4:11 Do not speak against one another, brethren. He who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks against the law and judges the law; but if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge of *it*.
- James 4:12 There is *only* one Lawgiver and <u>Judge</u>, the One who is able to save and to destroy; but who are you who judge your neighbor?
- James 5:9 Do not complain, brethren, against one another, so that you yourselves may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing right at the door.
- James 5:12 But above all, my brethren, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or with any other oath; but your yes is to be yes, and your no, no, so that you may not fall under judgment.
- 1 Peter 1:17 If you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay *on earth;*
- 1 Peter 2:23 and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting *Himself* to Him who judges righteously;
- 1 Peter 4:5 but they will give account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.

- 1 Peter 4:6 For the gospel has for this purpose been preached even to those who are dead, that though they are judged in the flesh as men, they may live in the spirit according to *the will of* God.
- 1 Peter 4:7 The end of all things is near; therefore, be of sound judgment and sober *spirit* for the purpose of prayer.
- 1 Peter 4:17 For *it is* time for judgment to begin with the household of God; and if *it begins* with us first, what *will be* the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God?
- 2 Peter 2:3 and in *their* greed they will exploit you with false words; their judgment from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.
- 2 Peter 2:4 For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but cast them into hell and committed them to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment;
- 2 Peter 2:9 *then* the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment,
- 2 Peter 2:11 whereas angels who are greater in might and power do not bring a reviling judgment against them before the Lord.
- 2 Peter 3:7 But by His word the present heavens and earth are being reserved for fire, kept for the day of judgment and destruction of ungodly men.
- 1 John 4:17 By this, love is perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment; because as He is, so also are we in this world.
- Jude 1:6 And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode, He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day,
- Jude 1:9 But Michael the archangel, when he disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses, did not dare pronounce against him a railing judgment, but said, "The Lord rebuke you!"
- Jude 1:15 to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."
- Revelation 6:10 and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"
- Revelation 11:18 "And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time *came* for the dead to be <u>judged</u>, and *the time* to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth."
- Revelation 14:7 and he said with a loud voice, "Fear God, and give Him glory, because the hour of His judgment has come; worship Him who made the heaven and the earth and sea and springs of waters."
- Revelation 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters saying, "Righteous are You, who are and who were, O Holy One, because You judged these things;
- Revelation 16:7 And I heard the altar saying, "Yes, O Lord God, the Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments."
- Revelation 17:1 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, "Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters,

- Revelation 18:8 "For this reason in one day her plagues will come, pestilence and mourning and famine, and she will be burned up with fire; for the Lord God who judges her is strong.
- Revelation 18:10 standing at a distance because of the fear of her torment, saying, 'Woe, woe, the great city, Babylon, the strong city! For in one hour your judgment has come.'
- Revelation 18:20 "Rejoice over her, O heaven, and you saints and apostles and prophets, because God has pronounced judgment for you against her."
- Revelation 19:2 BECAUSE HIS <u>JUDGMENTS</u> ARE TRUE AND RIGHTEOUS; for He has <u>judged</u> the great harlot who was corrupting the earth with her immorality, and HE HAS AVENGED THE BLOOD OF HIS BOND-SERVANTS ON HER."
- Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He <u>judges</u> and wages war.
- Revelation 20:4 Then I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them. And I *saw*the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.
- Revelation 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds.
