INTRODUCTION

This is an exegesis to distinguish how the word LIFE is used in the New Testament. This Exegesis on life is one of several appendices to the study: *Personal Eschatology: What Happens After Death?* http://www.thelordschildren.org/bible_study/personal.pdf.

Generally, the New Testament terms translated as life fall into three broad categories:

- 1. Spiritual and Eternal Life: Salvation in Jesus
- 2. Temporal and Biological Life: Flesh & Blood Existence
- 3. Style and Manner of Life: Behaviors, Needs, Wants, Desires, Christian Walk

- Romans 1:23 and exchanged the glory of the **incorruptible <862 aphthartos>** God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures.
- 1 Corinthians 9:25 Everyone who competes in the games exercises self-control in all things. They then *do it* to receive a perishable wreath, but we an **imperishable <862 aphthartos**>.
- 1 Corinthians 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised **imperishable <862 aphthartos>**, and we will be changed.
- 1 Timothy 1:17 Now to the King eternal, **immortal <862 aphthartos>**, invisible, the only God, *be* honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

- John 6:68 Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life <222 zoe>.
- John 8:12 Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life <222 zoe>."
- John 10:10 "The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life <222 zoe>, and have *it* abundantly.
- John 10:28 and I give eternal life <222 zoe> to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of My hand.
- John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life <222 zoe>; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies,
- John 12:25 "He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it to life <222 zoe> eternal.
- John 12:50 "I know that His commandment is eternal life <222 zoe>; therefore the things I speak, I speak just as the Father has told Me."
- John 14:6 Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life <222 zoe>; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
- John 17:2 even as You gave Him authority over all flesh, that to all whom You have given Him, He may give eternal life <222 zoe>.
- John 17:3 "This is eternal life <222 zoe>, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- John 20:31 but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life <222 zoe> in His name.
- Acts 2:28 'YOU HAVE MADE KNOWN TO ME THE WAYS OF LIFE <222 zoe>; YOU WILL MAKE ME FULL OF GLADNESS WITH YOUR PRESENCE.'
- Acts 3:15 but put to death the Prince of life <222 zoe>, *the one* whom God raised from the dead, *a fact* to which we are witnesses.
- Acts 5:20 "Go, stand and speak to the people in the temple the whole message of this Life <222 zoe>."
- Acts 7:19 "It was he who took shrewd advantage of our race and mistreated our fathers so that they would expose their infants and they would not **survive** <2225 zoogoneo>.
- Acts 8:33 "IN HUMILIATION HIS JUDGMENT WAS TAKEN AWAY; WHO WILL RELATE HIS GENERATION? FOR HIS LIFE <222 zoe> IS REMOVED FROM THE EARTH."

- Acts 11:18 When they heard this, they quieted down and glorified God, saying, "Well then, God has granted to the Gentiles also the repentance *that leads* to life <222 zoe>."
- Acts 13:46 Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and said, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken to you first; since you repudiate it and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life <222 zoe>, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles.
- Acts 13:48 When the Gentiles heard this, they *began* rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord; and as many as had been appointed to eternal life <222 zoe> believed.
- Acts 17:25 nor is He served by human hands, as though He needed anything, since He Himself gives to all *people* life <222 zoe> and breath and all things;
- Romans 2:7 to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life <222 zoe>;
- Romans 4:17 (as it is written, "A FATHER OF MANY NATIONS HAVE I MADE YOU") in the presence of Him whom he believed, *even* God, who **gives life <2227 zoopoieo>** to the dead and calls into being that which does not exist.
- Romans 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life <222 zoe>.
- Romans 5:17 For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life <222 zoe> through the One, Jesus Christ.
- Romans 5:18 So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life <222 zoe> to all men.
- Romans 5:21 so that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life <222 zoe> through Jesus Christ our Lord.
- Romans 6:4 Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life <222 zoe>.
- Romans 6:22 But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to God, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life <222 zoe>.
- Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life <222 zoe> in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Romans 7:10 and this commandment, which was to result in life <222 zoe>, proved to result in death for me;
- Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life <222 zoe> in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.
- Romans 8:6 For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life <222 zoe> and peace,
- Romans 8:10 If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, yet the spirit is **alive** <222 zoe> because of righteousness.
- Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also **give life <2227 zoopoieo>** to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.
- Romans 8:38 For I am convinced that neither death, nor life <222 zoe>, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers,
- Romans 11:15 For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will *their* acceptance be but life <222 zoe> from the dead?

- 1 Corinthians 3:22 whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life <222 zoe> or death or things present or things to come; all things belong to you,
- 1 Corinthians 15:19 If we have hoped in Christ in this life <222 zoe> only, we are of all men most to be pitied.
- 1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be **made alive <2227** zoopoieo>.
- 1 Corinthians 15:36 You fool! That which you sow does not **come to life <2227 zoopoieo>** unless it dies;
- 1 Corinthians 15:45 So also it is written, "The first MAN, Adam, BECAME A LIVING SOUL." The last Adam *became* a **life-giving** <2227 zoopoieo> spirit.
- 2 Corinthians 2:16 to the one an aroma from death to death, to the other an aroma from life <222 zoe> to life <222 zoe>. And who is adequate for these things?
- 2 Corinthians 3:6 who also made us adequate *as* servants of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit **gives life <2227 zoopoieo>.**
- 2 Corinthians 4:10 always carrying about in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life <222 zoe> of Jesus also may be manifested in our body.
- 2 Corinthians 4:11 For we who live are constantly being delivered over to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life <222 zoe> of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.
- 2 Corinthians 4:12 So death works in us, but life <222 zoe> in you.
- 2 Corinthians 5:4 For indeed while we are in this tent, we groan, being burdened, because we do not want to be unclothed but to be clothed, so that what is mortal will be swallowed up by life <222 zoe>.
- Galatians 3:21 Is the Law then contrary to the promises of God? May it never be! For if a law had been given which was able to **impart life <2227 zoopoieo>**, then righteousness would indeed have been based on law.
- Galatians 6:8 For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life <222 zoe>.
- Ephesians 4:18 being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life <222 zoe> of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart;
- Philippians 1:20 according to my earnest expectation and hope, that I will not be put to shame in anything, but *that* with all boldness, Christ will even now, as always, be exalted in my body, whether by life <222 zoe> or by death.
- Philippians 2:16 holding fast the word of life <222 zoe>, so that in the day of Christ I will have reason to glory because I did not run in vain nor toil in vain.
- Philippians 4:3 Indeed, true companion, I ask you also to help these women who have shared my struggle in *the cause of* the gospel, together with Clement also and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life <222 zoe>.
- Colossians 3:3 For you have died and your life <222 zoe> is hidden with Christ in God.
- Colossians 3:4 When Christ, who is our life <222 zoe>, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.
- 1 Timothy 1:16 Yet for this reason I found mercy, so that in me as the foremost, Jesus Christ might demonstrate His perfect patience as an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life <222 zoe>.
- 1 Timothy 4:8 for bodily discipline is only of little profit, but godliness is profitable for all things, since it holds promise for the present life <222 zoe> and *also* for the *life* to come.

- 1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life <222 zoe> to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
- 1 Timothy 6:13 I charge you in the presence of God, who **gives life <2225 zoogoneo>** to all things, and of Christ Jesus, who testified the good confession before Pontius Pilate,
- 1 Timothy 6:19 storing up for themselves the treasure of a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is life <222 zoe> indeed.
- 2 Timothy 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, according to the promise of life <222 zoe> in Christ Jesus,
- 2 Timothy 1:10 but now has been revealed by the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who abolished death and brought life <222 zoe> and immortality to light through the gospel,
- Titus 1:2 in the hope of eternal life <222 zoe>, which God, who cannot lie, promised long ages ago,
- Titus 3:7 so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to *the* hope of eternal life <222 zoe>.
- Hebrews 7:3 Without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life <222 zoe>, but made like the Son of God, he remains a priest perpetually.
- Hebrews 7:16 who has become *such* not on the basis of a law of physical requirement, but according to the power of an indestructible life <222 zoe>.
- James 1:12 Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life <222 zoe> which *the Lord* has promised to those who love Him.
- James 4:14 Yet you do not know what your **life <222 zoe>** will be like tomorrow. You are *just* a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away.
- 1 Peter 3:7 You husbands in the same way, live with *your wives* in an understanding way, as with someone weaker, since she is a woman; and show her honor as a fellow heir of the grace of **life <222 zoe>**, so that your prayers will not be hindered.
- 1 Peter 3:10 For, "THE ONE WHO DESIRES LIFE <222 zoe>, TO LOVE AND SEE GOOD DAYS, MUST KEEP HIS TONGUE FROM EVIL AND HIS LIPS FROM SPEAKING DECEIT.
- 1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also died for sins once for all, *the* just for *the* unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive <2227 zoopoieo> in the spirit;
- 2 Peter 1:3 seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life <222 zoe> and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.
- 1 John 1:1 What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands, concerning the Word of Life <222 zoe>—
- 1 John 1:2 and the life <222 zoe> was manifested, and we have seen and testify and proclaim to you the eternal life <222 zoe>, which was with the Father and was manifested to us—
- 1 John 2:25 This is the promise which He Himself made to us: eternal life <222 zoe>.
- 1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed out of death into life <222 zoe>, because we love the brethren. He who does not love abides in death.
- 1 John 3:15 Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life <222 zoe> abiding in him.

- 1 John 5:11 And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life <222 zoe>, and this life <222 zoe> is in His Son.
- 1 John 5:12 He who has the Son has the life <222 zoe>; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life <222 zoe>.
- 1 John 5:13 These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life <222 zoe>.
- 1 John 5:16 If anyone sees his brother committing a sin not *leading* to death, he shall ask and *God* will for him give **life <222 zoe>** to those who commit sin not *leading* to death. There is a sin *leading* to death; I do not say that he should make request for this.
- 1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life <222 zoe>.
- Jude 1:21 keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life <222 zoe>.
- Revelation 2:7 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life <222 zoe> which is in the Paradise of God.'
- Revelation 2:10 'Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, so that you will be tested, and you will have tribulation for ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life <222 zoe>.
- Revelation 3:5 'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life <222 zoe>, and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels.
- Revelation 7:17 for the Lamb in the center of the throne will be their shepherd, and will guide them to springs of the water of life <222 zoe>; and God will wipe every tear from their eyes."
- Revelation 11:11 But after the three and a half days, the breath of life <222 zoe> from God came into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell upon those who were watching them.
- Revelation 13:8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, *everyone* whose name has not been written from the foundation of the world in the book of **life <222 zoe>** of the Lamb who has been slain.
- Revelation 16:3 The second *angel* poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became blood like *that* of a dead man; and every **living** <222 zoe> thing in the sea died.
- Revelation 17:8 "The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to come up out of the abyss and go to destruction. And those who dwell on the earth, whose name has not been written in the book of life <222 zoe> from the foundation of the world, will wonder when they see the beast, that he was and is not and will come.
- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life <222 zoe>; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.

- Romans 13:14 But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh <4561 sarx>, to *fulfil* the lusts *thereof*.
- 1 Corinthians 1:26 For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the **flesh** <4561 sarx>, not many mighty, not many noble, *are called*:
- 1 Corinthians 1:29 That no flesh <4561 sarx> should glory in his presence.
- 1 Corinthians 5:5 To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh <4561 sarx>, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

- 1 Corinthians 6:16 What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh <4561 sarx>.
- 1 Corinthians 7:28 But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned; and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned. Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh <4561 sarx>: but I spare you.
- 1 Corinthians 10:18 Behold Israel after the **flesh** <4561 sarx>: are not they which eat of the sacrifices partakers of the altar?
- 1 Corinthians 15:39 All flesh <4561 sarx> *is* not the same flesh <4561 sarx>: but *there is* one *kind of* flesh <4561 sarx> of men, another flesh <4561 sarx> of beasts, another of fishes, *and* another of birds.
- 1 Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh <4561 sarx>** and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.
- 2 Corinthians 1:17 When I therefore was thus minded, did I use lightness? or the things that I purpose, do I purpose according to the **flesh <4561 sarx>**, that with me there should be yea yea, and nay nay?
- 2 Corinthians 4:11 For we which live are alway delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh <4561 sarx>.
- 2 Corinthians 5:16 Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh <4561 sarx>: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh <4561 sarx>, yet now henceforth know we *him* no more.
- 2 Corinthians 7:1 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh <4561 sarx> and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
- 2 Corinthians 7:5 For, when we were come into Macedonia, our flesh <4561 sarx> had no rest, but we were troubled on every side; without *were* fightings, within *were* fears.
- 2 Corinthians 10:2 But I beseech *you*, that I may not be bold when I am present with that confidence, wherewith I think to be bold against some, which think of us as if we walked according to the **flesh** <4561 sarx>.
- 2 Corinthians 10:3 For though we walk in the flesh <4561 sarx>, we do not war after the flesh <4561 sarx>:
- 2 Corinthians 11:18 Seeing that many glory after the flesh <4561 sarx>, I will glory also.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh <4561 sarx>, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.
- Galatians 1:16 To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh <4561 sarx> and blood:
- Galatians 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh <4561 sarx> be justified.
- Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh <4561 sarx> I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Galatians 3:3 Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh <4561 sarx>?
- Galatians 4:13 Ye know how through infirmity of the flesh <4561 sarx> I preached the gospel unto you at the first.

- Galatians 4:14 And my temptation which was in my flesh <4561 sarx> ye despised not, nor rejected; but received me as an angel of God, *even* as Christ Jesus.
- Galatians 4:23 But he *who was* of the bondwoman was born after the flesh <4561 sarx>; but he of the freewoman *was* by promise.
- Galatians 4:29 But as then he that was born after the flesh <4561 sarx> persecuted him *that was born* after the Spirit, even so *it is* now.
- Galatians 5:13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only *use* not liberty for an occasion to the flesh <4561 sarx>, but by love serve one another.
- Galatians 5:16 *This* I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the **flesh** <4561 sarx>.
- Galatians 5:17 For the **flesh <4561 sarx>** lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the **flesh <4561 sarx>**: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.
- Galatians 5:19 Now the works of the **flesh** <**4561 sarx**> are manifest, which are *these*; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,
- Galatians 5:24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh <4561 sarx> with the affections and lusts.
- Galatians 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh <4561 sarx> shall of the flesh <4561 sarx> reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.
- Galatians 6:12 As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh <4561 sarx>, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
- Galatians 6:13 For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may glory in your flesh <4561 sarx>.
- Ephesians 2:3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our **flesh <4561 sarx>**, fulfilling the desires of the **flesh <4561 sarx>** and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.
- Ephesians 2:11 Wherefore remember, that ye *being* in time past Gentiles in the **flesh <4561 sarx>**, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the **flesh <4561 sarx>** made by hands;
- Ephesians 2:15 Having abolished in his **flesh <4561 sarx>** the enmity, *even* the law of commandments *contained* in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, *so* making peace;
- Ephesians 5:29 For no man ever yet hated his own flesh <4561 sarx>; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church:
- Ephesians 5:30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh <4561 sarx>, and of his bones.
- Ephesians 5:31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh <4561 sarx>.
- Ephesians 6:5 Servants, be obedient to them that are *your* masters according to the flesh <4561 sarx>, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ;
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh <4561 sarx> and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Philippians 1:22 But if I live in the flesh <4561 sarx>, this *is* the fruit of my labour: yet what I shall choose I wot not.
- Philippians 1:24 Nevertheless to abide in the flesh <4561 sarx> is more needful for you.

- Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh <4561 sarx>.
- Philippians 3:4 Though I might also have confidence in the flesh <4561 sarx>. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh <4561 sarx>, I more:
- Colossians 1:22 In the body of his **flesh** <**4561 sarx**> through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:
- Colossians 1:24 Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my **flesh** <4561 sarx> for his body's sake, which is the church:
- Colossians 2:1 For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, and *for* them at Laodicea, and *for* as many as have not seen my face in the **flesh** <4561 sarx>;
- Colossians 2:5 For though I be absent in the **flesh** <4561 sarx>, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.
- Colossians 2:11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh <4561 sarx> by the circumcision of Christ:
- Colossians 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh <4561 sarx>, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- Colossians 2:18 Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his **fleshly** <4561 sarx> mind,
- Colossians 2:23 Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh <4561 sarx>.
- Colossians 3:22 Servants, obey in all things *your* masters according to the flesh <4561 sarx>; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:
- 1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh <4561 sarx>, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.
- Philemon 1:16 Not now as a servant, but above a servant, a brother beloved, specially to me, but how much more unto thee, both in the flesh <4561 sarx>, and in the Lord?
- Hebrews 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of **flesh** <4561 sarx> and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;
- Hebrews 5:7 Who in the days of his **flesh** <**4561 sarx**>, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;
- Hebrews 9:10 *Which stood* only in meats and drinks, and divers washings, and **carnal** <4561 **sarx**> ordinances, imposed *on them* until the time of reformation.
- Hebrews 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh <4561 sarx>:
- Hebrews 10:20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh <4561 sarx>;
- Hebrews 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our **flesh** <4561 sarx> which corrected *us*, and we gave *them* reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

- James 5:3 Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your **flesh <4561 sarx>** as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the last days.
- 1 Peter 1:24 For all **flesh <4561 sarx>** *is* as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:
- 1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh <4561 sarx>, but quickened by the Spirit:
- 1 Peter 3:21 The like figure whereunto *even* baptism doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the **flesh <4561 sarx>**, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
- 1 Peter 4:1 Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the **flesh <4561 sarx>**, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the **flesh <4561 sarx>** hath ceased from sin;
- 1 Peter 4:2 That he no longer should live the rest of *his* time in the **flesh <4561 sarx>** to the lusts of men, but to the will of God.
- 1 Peter 4:6 For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh <4561 sarx>, but live according to God in the spirit.
- 2 Peter 2:10 But chiefly them that walk after the **flesh** <4561 sarx> in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous *are they*, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.
- 2 Peter 2:18 For when they speak great swelling *words* of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the **flesh <4561 sarx>**, *through much* wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error.
- 1 John 2:16 For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the **flesh** <4561 sarx>, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- 1 John 4:2 Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh <4561 sarx> is of God:
- 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh <4561 sarx> is not of God: and this is that *spirit* of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- 2 John 1:7 For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh <4561 sarx>. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.
- Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange **flesh <4561 sarx>**, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.
- Jude 1:8 Likewise also these *filthy* dreamers defile the **flesh** <4561 sarx>, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.
- Jude 1:23 And others save with fear, pulling *them* out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh <4561 sarx>.
- Revelation 17:16 And the ten horns which thou sawest upon the beast, these shall hate the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh <4561 sarx>, and burn her with fire.
- Revelation 19:18 That ye may eat the flesh <4561 sarx> of kings, and the flesh <4561 sarx> of captains, and the flesh <4561 sarx> of mighty men, and the flesh <4561 sarx> of horses, and

of them that sit on them, and the **flesh** <4561 sarx> of all *men, both* free and bond, both small and great.

Revelation 19:21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh <4561 sarx>.
