Then he stood before the altar of the LORD in the **presence** <05048> of all the assembly of Israel and spread out his hands.

2 Chronicles 6:13

Now Solomon had made a bronze platform, five cubits long, five cubits wide and three cubits high, and had set it in the midst of the court; and he stood on it, knelt on his knees in the **presence** <05048> of all the assembly of Israel and spread out his hands toward heaven.

2 Chronicles 7:6

The priests stood at their posts, and the Levites also, with the instruments of music to the LORD, which King David had made for giving praise to the LORD—"for His lovingkindness is everlasting"—whenever he gave praise by their means, while the priests on the **other side** <05048> blew trumpets; and all Israel was standing.

2 Chronicles 8:14

Now according to the ordinance of his father David, he appointed the divisions of the priests for their service, and the Levites for their duties of praise and ministering **before** <05048> the priests according to the daily rule, and the gatekeepers by their divisions at every gate; for David the man of God had so commanded.

After him Nehemiah the son of Azbuk, official of half the district of Beth-zur, made repairs as far as a point **opposite** <05048> the tombs of David, and as far as the artificial pool and the house of the mighty men.

Nehemiah 3:19

Next to him Ezer the son of Jeshua, the official of Mizpah, repaired another section in **front** <05048> of the ascent of the armory at the Angle.

Nehemiah 3:23

After them Benjamin and Hasshub carried out repairs in **front** <05048> of their house. After them Azariah the son of Maaseiah, son of Ananiah, carried out repairs beside his house.

Nehemiah 3:25

Palal the son of Uzai *made repairs* in **front** <05048> of the Angle and the tower projecting from the upper house of the king, which is by the court of the guard. After him Pedaiah the son of Parosh *made repairs*.

Nehemiah 3:26

The temple servants living in Ophel *made repairs* as far as the **front** <05048> of the Water Gate toward the east and the projecting tower.

Nehemiah 3:27

After them the Tekoites repaired another section in **front** <05048> of the great projecting tower and as far as the wall of Ophel.

Nehemiah 3:28

Above the Horse Gate the priests carried out repairs, each in **front** $\leq 0.05048 \geq 0.$

Nehemiah 3:29

After them Zadok the son of Immer carried out repairs in **front** <05048> of his house. And after him Shemaiah the son of Shecaniah, the keeper of the East Gate, carried out repairs.

Numbers 7:5

Now Nahash the Ammonite came up and besieged Jabesh-gilead; and all the men of Jabesh said to Nahash, "Make a covenant with us and we will **serve** <05647> you."

1 Samuel 12:10

"They cried out to the LORD and said, 'We have sinned because we have forsaken the LORD and have **served** <05647> the Baals and the Ashtaroth; but now deliver us from the hands of our enemies, and we will **serve** <05647> You.'

"You shall set bounds for the people all around, saying, '**Beware** <08104> that you do not go up on the mountain or touch the border of it; whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death.

Exodus 20:6

but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and **keep** <08104> My commandments.

Exodus 21:29

"If, however, an ox was previously in the habit of goring and its owner has been warned, yet he does not **confine** <08104> it and it kills a man or a woman, the ox shall be stoned and its owner also shall be put to death.

Exodus 21:36

"Or *if* it is known that the ox was previously in the habit of goring, yet its owner has not **confined** <08104> it, he shall surely pay ox for ox, and the dead *animal* shall become his.

Exodus 22:7

"If a man gives his neighbor money or goods to **keep** <08104> *for him* and it is stolen from the man's house, if the thief is caught, he shall pay double.

Exodus 22:10

"If a man gives his neighbor a donkey, an ox, a sheep, or any animal to **keep** <08104> *for him*, and it dies or is hurt or is driven away while no one is looking,

Exodus 23:13

"Now concerning everything which I have said to you, be on your **guard** <08104>; and do not mention the name of other gods, nor let *them* be heard from your mouth.

Exodus 23:15

"You shall **observe** <08104> the Feast of Unleavened Bread; for seven days you are to eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, at the appointed time in the month Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt. And none shall appear before Me empty-handed.

Exodus 23:20

"Behold, I am going to send an angel before you to **guard** <08104> you along the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared.

Exodus 23:21

"Be on your **guard** <08104> before him and obey his voice; do not be rebellious toward him, for he will not pardon your transgression, since My name is in him.

Exodus 31:13

"But as for you, speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'You shall surely **observe** <08104> My sabbaths; for *this* is a sign between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I am the LORD who sanctifies you.

Exodus 31:14

Therefore you are to **observe** <08104> the sabbath, for it is holy to you. Everyone who profanes it shall surely be put to death; for whoever does any work on it, that person shall be cut off from among his people.

Exodus 31:16

'So the sons of Israel shall **observe** <08104> the sabbath, to celebrate the sabbath throughout their generations as a perpetual covenant.'

Exodus 34:11

"Be sure to **observe** <08104> what I am commanding you this day: behold, I am going to drive out the Amorite before you, and the Canaanite, the Hittite, the Perizzite, the Hivite and the Jebusite.

Exodus 34:12

"Watch <08104> yourself that you make no covenant with the inhabitants of the land into which you are going, or it will become a snare in your midst.

Exodus 34:18

"You shall **observe** <08104> the Feast of Unleavened Bread. For seven days you are to eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, at the appointed time in the month of Abib, for in the month of Abib you came out of Egypt.

Leviticus 8:35

"At the doorway of the tent of meeting, moreover, you shall remain day and night for seven days and **keep** <08104> the charge of the LORD, so that you will not die, for so I have been commanded."

Leviticus 18:4

You are to perform My judgments and **keep** <08104> My statutes, to live in accord with them; I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 18:5

'So you shall **keep** <08104> My statutes and My judgments, by which a man may live if he

does them; I am the LORD.

Leviticus 18:26

'But as for you, you are to **keep** <08104> My statutes and My judgments and shall not do any of these abominations, *neither* the native, nor the alien who sojourns among you

Leviticus 18:30

'Thus you are to **keep** <08104> My charge, that you do not practice any of the abominable customs which have been practiced before you, so as not to defile yourselves with them; I am the LORD your God.'"

Leviticus 19:3

'Every one of you shall reverence his mother and his father, and you shall **keep** <08104> My sabbaths; I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 19:19

You are to **keep** <08104> My statutes. You shall not breed together two kinds of your cattle; you shall not sow your field with two kinds of seed, nor wear a garment upon you of two kinds of material mixed together.

Leviticus 19:30

'You shall **keep** <08104> My sabbaths and revere My sanctuary; I am the LORD.

Leviticus 19:37

'You shall thus **observe** <08104> all My statutes and all My ordinances and do them; I am the LORD.'"

Leviticus 20:8

'You shall **keep** <08104> My statutes and practice them; I am the LORD who sanctifies you.

Leviticus 20:22

You are therefore to **keep** <08104> all My statutes and all My ordinances and do them, so that the land to which I am bringing you to live will not spew you out.

Leviticus 22:9 '

They shall therefore **keep** <08104> My charge, so that they will not bear sin because of it and die thereby because they profane it; I am the LORD who sanctifies them.

Leviticus 22:31

"So you shall **keep** <08104> My commandments, and do them; I am the LORD.

Leviticus 25:18

'You shall thus observe My statutes and **keep** <08104> My judgments, so as to carry them

out, that you may live securely on the land.

Leviticus 26:2

'You shall **keep** <08104> My sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary; I am the LORD.

Leviticus 26:3

'If you walk in My statutes and **keep** <08104> My commandments so as to carry them out,

Numbers 1:53

"But the Levites shall camp around the tabernacle of the testimony, so that there will be no wrath on the congregation of the sons of Israel. So the Levites shall **keep** <08104> charge of the tabernacle of the testimony."

Numbers 3:7

"They shall **perform** <08104> the duties for him and for the whole congregation before the tent of meeting, to do the service of the tabernacle.

Numbers 3:8

"They shall also **keep** <08104> all the furnishings of the tent of meeting, along with the duties of the sons of Israel, to do the service of the tabernacle.

Numbers 3:10

"So you shall appoint Aaron and his sons that they may **keep** <08104> their priesthood, but the layman who comes near shall be put to death."

Numbers 3:28

In the numbering of every male from a month old and upward, *there were* 8,600, **performing** <08104> the duties of the sanctuary.

Numbers 3:32

and Eleazar the son of Aaron the priest *was* the chief of the leaders of Levi, *and had* the oversight of those who **perform** <08104> the duties of the sanctuary.

Numbers 3:38

Now those who were to camp before the tabernacle eastward, before the tent of meeting toward the sunrise, are Moses and Aaron and his sons, **performing** <08104> the duties of the sanctuary for the obligation of the sons of Israel; but the layman coming near was to be put to death.

Numbers 6:24

The LORD bless you, and **keep** <08104> you;

Numbers 8:26

"They may, however, assist their brothers in the tent of meeting, to **keep** <08104> an

obligation, but they *themselves* shall do no work. Thus you shall deal with the Levites concerning their obligations."

Numbers 9:19

Even when the cloud lingered over the tabernacle for many days, the sons of Israel would **keep** <08104> the LORD'S charge and not set out.

Numbers 9:23

At the command of the LORD they camped, and at the command of the LORD they set out; they **kept** <08104> the LORD'S charge, according to the command of the LORD through Moses.

Numbers 18:3

"And they shall thus **attend** <08104> to your obligation and the obligation of all the tent, but they shall not come near to the furnishings of the sanctuary and the altar, or both they and you will die.

"They shall be joined with you and **attend** <08104> to the obligations of the tent of meeting, for all the service of the tent; but an outsider may not come near you.

Numbers 18:5

"So you shall **attend** <08104> to the obligations of the sanctuary and the obligations of the altar, so that there will no longer be wrath on the sons of Israel.

Numbers 18:7

"But you and your sons with you shall **attend** <08104> to your priesthood for everything concerning the altar and inside the veil, and you are to perform service. I am giving you the priesthood as a bestowed service, but the outsider who comes near shall be put to death."

Numbers 23:12

He replied, "Must I not be **careful** <08104> to speak what the LORD puts in my mouth?"

Numbers 28:2

"Command the sons of Israel and say to them, 'You shall be **careful** <08104> to present My offering, My food for My offerings by fire, of a soothing aroma to Me, at their appointed time.'

Numbers 31:30

"From the sons of Israel's half, you shall take one drawn out of every fifty of the persons, of the cattle, of the donkeys and of the sheep, from all the animals, and give them to the Levites who **keep** <08104> charge of the tabernacle of the LORD."

Numbers 31:47

and from the sons of Israel's half, Moses took one drawn out of every fifty, both of man and of animals, and gave them to the Levites, who **kept** <08104> charge of the tabernacle of the LORD, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Deuteronomy 2:4

and command the people, saying, "You will pass through the territory of your brothers the sons of Esau who live in Seir; and they will be afraid of you. So be very **careful** <08104>;

Deuteronomy 4:2 "You shall not add to the word which I am commanding you, nor take away from it, that you may **keep** <08104> the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

Deuteronomy 4:6

"So **keep** <08104> and do *them*, for that is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples who will hear all these statutes and say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people.'

Deuteronomy 4:9

"Only **give** <08104> **heed** <08104> to yourself and **keep** <08104> your soul diligently, so that you do not forget the things which your eyes have seen and they do not depart from your heart all the days of your life; but make them known to your sons and your grandsons.

Deuteronomy 4:40

"So you shall **keep** <08104> His statutes and His commandments which I am giving you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may live long on the land which the LORD your God is giving you for all time."

Deuteronomy 5:1

Then Moses summoned all Israel and said to them: "Hear, O Israel, the statutes and the ordinances which I am speaking today in your hearing, that you may learn them and **observe** <08104> them carefully.

Deuteronomy 5:10

but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and **keep** <08104> My commandments.

Deuteronomy 5:12

'**Observe** <08104> the sabbath day to keep it holy, as the LORD your God commanded you.

Deuteronomy 5:29

'Oh that they had such a heart in them, that they would fear Me and **keep** <08104> all My commandments always, that it may be well with them and with their sons forever!

Deuteronomy 6:2

so that you and your son and your grandson might fear the LORD your God, to **keep** <08104> all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged.

Deuteronomy 6:3

"O Israel, you should listen and be **careful** <08104> to do *it*, that it may be well with you and that you may multiply greatly, just as the LORD, the God of your fathers, has promised you, *in* a land flowing with milk and honey.

Deuteronomy 6:12

then **watch** <08104> yourself, that you do not forget the LORD who brought you from the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

Deuteronomy 6:17

"You should **diligently** <08104> **keep** <08104> the commandments of the LORD your God, and His testimonies and His statutes which He has commanded you.

Deuteronomy 6:25

"It will be righteousness for us if we are **careful** <08104> to observe all this commandment before the LORD our God, just as He commanded us.

Deuteronomy 7:8

but because the LORD loved you and **kept** <08104> the oath which He swore to your forefathers, the LORD brought you out by a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 7:9

"Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, who **keeps** <08104> His covenant and His lovingkindness to a thousandth generation with those who love Him and **keep** <08104> His commandments;

Deuteronomy 7:11

"Therefore, you shall **keep** <08104> the commandment and the statutes and the judgments

which I am commanding you today, to do them.

Deuteronomy 7:12

"Then it shall come about, because you listen to these judgments and **keep** <08104> and do them, that the LORD your God will **keep** <08104> with you His covenant and His lovingkindness which He swore to your forefathers.

Deuteronomy 8:1

"All the commandments that I am commanding you today you shall be **careful** <08104> to do, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD swore *to give* to your forefathers.

Deuteronomy 8:2

"You shall remember all the way which the LORD your God has led you in the wilderness these forty years, that He might humble you, testing you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would **keep** <08104> His commandments or not.

Deuteronomy 8:6

"Therefore, you shall **keep** <08104> the commandments of the LORD your God, to walk in His ways and to fear Him.

"You shall therefore **keep** <08104> every commandment which I am commanding you today, so that you may be strong and go in and possess the land into which you are about to cross to possess it;

Deuteronomy 11:16

"Beware <08104> that your hearts are not deceived, and that you do not turn away and serve other gods and worship them.

Deuteronomy 11:22

"For if you are **careful** <08104> to **keep** <08104> all this commandment which I am

commanding you to do, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and hold fast to Him,

Deuteronomy 11:32

and you shall be **careful** <08104> to do all the statutes and the judgments which I am setting before you today.

Deuteronomy 12:1

"These are the statutes and the judgments which you shall carefully **observe** <08104> in the land which the LORD, the God of your fathers, has given you to possess as long as you live on the earth.

Deuteronomy 12:13

"Be **careful** <08104> that you do not offer your burnt offerings in every *cultic* place you see,

Deuteronomy 12:19

"Be **careful** <08104> that you do not forsake the Levite as long as you live in your land.

Deuteronomy 12:28

"Be **careful** <08104> to listen to all these words which I command you, so that it may be well with you and your sons after you forever, for you will be doing what is good and right in the sight of the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 12:30

beware <08104> that you are not ensnared to follow them, after they are destroyed before you, and that you do not inquire after their gods, saying, 'How do these nations serve their gods, that I also may do likewise?'

Deuteronomy 12:32

"Whatever I command you, you shall be **careful** <08104> to do; you shall not add to nor take away from it.

Deuteronomy 13:4

"You shall follow the LORD your God and fear Him; and you shall **keep** <08104> His commandments, listen to His voice, serve Him, and cling to Him.

Deuteronomy 13:18

if you will listen to the voice of the LORD your God, **keeping** <08104> all His commandments which I am commanding you today, and doing what is right in the sight of the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 15:9

"Beware <08104> that there is no base thought in your heart, saying, 'The seventh year, the year of remission, is near,' and your eye is hostile toward your poor brother, and you

give him nothing; then he may cry to the LORD against you, and it will be a sin in you.

Deuteronomy 16:1

"**Observe** <08104> the month of Abib and celebrate the Passover to the LORD your God, for in the month of Abib the LORD your God brought you out of Egypt by night.

Deuteronomy 16:12

"You shall remember that you were a slave in Egypt, and you shall be **careful** <08104> to observe these statutes.

Deuteronomy 17:10

"You shall do according to the terms of the verdict which they declare to you from that place which the LORD chooses; and you shall be **careful** <08104> to observe according to all that they teach you.

Deuteronomy 19:9

if you carefully **observe** <08104> all this commandment which I command you today, to love the LORD your God, and to walk in His ways always—then you shall add three more cities for yourself, besides these three.

Deuteronomy 23:9

"When you go out as an army against your enemies, you shall **keep** <08104> yourself from every evil thing.

Deuteronomy 23:23

"You shall be **careful** <08104> to perform what goes out from your lips, just as you have voluntarily vowed to the LORD your God, what you have promised.

Deuteronomy 24:8

"Be **careful** <08104> against an infection of leprosy, that you diligently **observe** <08104> and do according to all that the Levitical priests teach you; as I have commanded them, so you shall be **careful** <08104> to do.

Deuteronomy 26:16

"This day the LORD your God commands you to do these statutes and ordinances. You shall therefore be **careful** <08104> to do them with all your heart and with all your soul.

Deuteronomy 26:17

"You have today declared the LORD to be your God, and that you would walk in His ways and **keep** <08104> His statutes, His commandments and His ordinances, and listen to His voice.

Deuteronomy 26:18

"The LORD has today declared you to be His people, a treasured possession, as He

Then Moses and the elders of Israel charged the people, saying, "**Keep** <08104> all the commandments which I command you today.

"Now it shall be, if you diligently obey the LORD your God, **being** <08104> **careful** <08104> to do all His commandments which I command you today, the LORD your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.

Deuteronomy 28:9

"The LORD will establish you as a holy people to Himself, as He swore to you, if you **keep** <08104> the commandments of the LORD your God and walk in His ways.

Deuteronomy 28:45

"So all these curses shall come on you and pursue you and overtake you until you are destroyed, because you would not obey the LORD your God by **keeping** <08104> His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you.

Deuteronomy 28:58

"If you are not **careful** <08104> to observe all the words of this law which are written in this book, to fear this honored and awesome name, the LORD your God,

Deuteronomy 29:9

"So **keep** <08104> the words of this covenant to do them, that you may prosper in all that you do.

Deuteronomy 30:10

if you obey the LORD your God to **keep** <08104> His commandments and His statutes which are written in this book of the law, if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and soul.

Deuteronomy 30:16

in that I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in His ways and to **keep** <08104> His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, that you may live and multiply, and that the LORD your God may bless you in the land where you are entering to possess it.

Deuteronomy 31:12

"Assemble the people, the men and the women and children and the alien who is in your town, so that they may hear and learn and fear the LORD your God, and be **careful** <08104> to observe all the words of this law.

Deuteronomy 33:9

Who said of his father and his mother, 'I did not consider them'; And he did not acknowledge his brothers, Nor did he regard his own sons, For they **observed** <08104> Your word, And kept Your covenant.

Joshua 1:7

"Only be strong and very courageous; be **careful** <08104> to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go.

Joshua 1:8

"This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be **careful** <08104> to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success.

Joshua 6:18

"But as for you, only **keep** <08104> yourselves from the things under the ban, so that you do not covet *them* and take some of the things under the ban, and make the camp of Israel accursed and bring trouble on it.

Joshua 10:18

Joshua said, "Roll large stones against the mouth of the cave, and assign men by it to **guard** <08104> them,

Joshua 22:2

and said to them, "You have **kept** <08104> all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, and have listened to my voice in all that I commanded you.

Joshua 22:3

"You have not forsaken your brothers these many days to this day, but have **kept** <08104> the charge of the commandment of the LORD your God.

Joshua 22:5

"Only be very careful <08104> to observe the commandment and the law which Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, to love the LORD your God and walk in all His ways and **keep** <08104> His commandments and hold fast to Him and serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul."

Joshua 23:6

"Be very firm, then, to **keep** <08104> and do all that is written in the book of the law of Moses, so that you may not turn aside from it to the right hand or to the left,

Joshua 23:11

"So take <08104> diligent heed <08104> to yourselves to love the LORD your God.

Joshua 24:17

for the LORD our God is He who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and who did these great signs in our sight and **preserved** <08104> us through all the way in which we went and among all the peoples through whose midst we passed.

Judges 1:24

The **spies** <08104> saw a man coming out of the city and they said to him, "Please show us the entrance to the city and we will treat you kindly."

Judges 2:22

in order to test Israel by them, whether they will keep <08104> the way of the LORD to walk in it as their fathers **did** <08104>, or not."

Judges 7:19

So Gideon and the hundred men who were with him came to the outskirts of the camp at the beginning of the middle watch, when they had just posted the **watch** <08104>; and they blew the trumpets and smashed the pitchers that were in their hands.

Judges 13:4

"Now therefore, be **careful** <08104> not to drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing.

Judges 13:13

So the angel of the LORD said to Manoah, "Let the woman **pay** <08104> **attention** <08104> to all that I said.

Judges 13:14

"She should not eat anything that comes from the vine nor drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing; let her **observe** <08104> all that I commanded."

1 Samuel 1:12

Now it came about, as she continued praying before the LORD, that Eli was **watching** <08104> her mouth.

1 Samuel 2:9

"He **keeps** <08104> the feet of His godly ones, But the wicked ones are silenced in darkness; For not by might shall a man prevail.

1 Samuel 7:1

And the men of Kiriath-jearim came and took the ark of the LORD and brought it into the house of Abinadab on the hill, and consecrated Eleazar his son to **keep** <08104> the ark

of the LORD.

1 Samuel 9:24

Then the cook took up the leg with what was on it and set *it* before Saul. And *Samuel* said, "Here is what has been reserved! Set *it* before you *and* eat, because it has been **kept** <08104> for you until the appointed time, since I said I have invited the people." So Saul ate with Samuel that day.

1 Samuel 13:13

Samuel said to Saul, "You have acted foolishly; you have not **kept** <08104> the commandment of the LORD your God, which He commanded you, for now the LORD would have established your kingdom over Israel forever.

1 Samuel 13:14

"But now your kingdom shall not endure. The LORD has sought out for Himself a man after His own heart, and the LORD has appointed him as ruler over His people, because you have not **kept** <08104> what the LORD commanded you."

1 Samuel 17:20

So David arose early in the morning and left the flock with a **keeper** <08104> and took *the* supplies and went as Jesse had commanded him. And he came to the circle of the camp while the army was going out in battle array shouting the war cry.

1 Samuel 17:22

Then David left his baggage in the care of the baggage **keeper** <08104>, and ran to the battle line and entered in order to greet his brothers.

1 Samuel 19:2

So Jonathan told David saying, "Saul my father is seeking to put you to death. Now therefore, please be on **guard** <08104> in the morning, and stay in a secret place and hide yourself.

1 Samuel 19:11

Then Saul sent messengers to David's house to **watch** <08104> him, in order to put him to death in the morning. But Michal, David's wife, told him, saying, "If you do not save your life tonight, tomorrow you will be put to death."

1 Samuel 21:4

The priest answered David and said, "There is no ordinary bread on hand, but there is consecrated bread; if only the young men have **kept** <08104> themselves from women."

1 Samuel 25:21

Now David had said, "Surely in vain I have **guarded** <08104> all that this *man* has in the wilderness, so that nothing was missed of all that belonged to him; and he has returned me

evil for good.

1 Samuel 26:15

So David said to Abner, "Are you not a man? And who is like you in Israel? Why then have you not **guarded** <08104> your lord the king? For one of the people came to destroy the king your lord.

1 Samuel 26:16

"This thing that you have done is not good. As the LORD lives, *all* of you must surely die, because you did not **guard** <08104> your lord, the LORD'S anointed. And now, see where the king's spear is and the jug of water that was at his head."

1 Samuel 28:2

David said to Achish, "Very well, you shall know what your servant can do." So Achish said to David, "Very well, I will make you my **bodyguard** <08104> for life."

1 Samuel 30:23

Then David said, "You must not do so, my brothers, with what the LORD has given us, who has **kept** <08104> us and delivered into our hand the band that came against us.

2 Samuel 11:16

So it was as Joab **kept** <08104> **watch** <08104> on the city, that he put Uriah at the place where he knew there *were* valiant men.

2 Samuel 15:16

So the king went out and all his household with him. But the king left ten concubines to **keep** <08104> the house.

2 Samuel 16:21

Ahithophel said to Absalom, "Go in to your father's concubines, whom he has left to **keep** <08104> the house; then all Israel will hear that you have made yourself odious to your father. The hands of all who are with you will also be strengthened."

2 Samuel 18:12

The man said to Joab, "Even if I should receive a thousand *pieces of* silver in my hand, I would not put out my hand against the king's son; for in our hearing the king charged you and Abishai and Ittai, saying, '**Protect** <08104> for me the young man Absalom!'

2 Samuel 20:3

Then David came to his house at Jerusalem, and the king took the ten women, the concubines whom he had left to **keep** <08104> the house, and placed them under guard and provided them with sustenance, but did not go in to them. So they were shut up until the day of their death, living as widows.

2 Samuel 20:10

But Amasa was not on **guard** <08104> against the sword which was in Joab's hand so he struck him in the belly with it and poured out his inward parts on the ground, and did not *strike* him again, and he died. Then Joab and Abishai his brother pursued Sheba the son of Bichri.

2 Samuel 22:22

"For I have **kept** <08104> the ways of the LORD, And have not acted wickedly against my God.

2 Samuel 22:24

"I was also blameless toward Him, And I **kept** <08104> myself from my iniquity.

2 Samuel 22:44

"You have also delivered me from the contentions of my people; You have **kept** <08104> me as head of the nations; A people whom I have not known serve me.

2 Samuel 23:5

"Truly is not my house so with God? For He has made an everlasting covenant with me, Ordered in all things, and **secured** <08104>; For all my salvation and all *my* desire, Will He not indeed make *it* grow?

1 Kings 3:6

Then Solomon said, "You have shown great lovingkindness to Your servant David my father, according as he walked before You in truth and righteousness and uprightness of heart toward You; and You have **reserved** <08104> for him this great lovingkindness, that You have given him a son to sit on his throne, as *it is* this day.

1 Kings 3:14

"If you walk in My ways, **keeping** <08104> My statutes and commandments, as your father David walked, then I will prolong your days."

Then it will be, that if you listen to all that I command you and walk in My ways, and do what is right in My sight by **observing** <08104> My statutes and My commandments, as My servant David did, then I will be with you and build you an enduring house as I built for David, and I will give Israel to you.

1 Kings 13:21

and he cried to the man of God who came from Judah, saying, "Thus says the LORD, 'Because you have disobeyed the command of the LORD, and have not **observed** <08104> the commandment which the LORD your God commanded you,

1 Kings 14:8

and tore the kingdom away from the house of David and gave it to you—yet you have not been like My servant David, who **kept** <08104> My commandments and who followed Me with all his heart, to do only that which was right in My sight;

1 Kings 14:27

So King Rehoboam made shields of bronze in their place, and committed them to the care of the commanders of the guard who **guarded** <08104> the doorway of the king's house.

1 Kings 20:39

As the king passed by, he cried to the king and said, "Your servant went out into the midst of the battle; and behold, a man turned aside and brought a man to me and said, 'Guard <08104> this man; if for any reason he is missing, then your life shall be for his life, or else you shall pay a talent of silver.'

2 Kings 6:9

The man of God sent *word* to the king of Israel saying, "**Beware** <08104> that you do not pass this place, for the Arameans are coming down there."

The king of Israel sent to the place about which the man of God had told him; thus he

2 Kings 23:3

The king stood by the pillar and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to **keep** <08104> His commandments and His testimonies and His statutes with all *his* heart and all *his* soul, to carry out the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people entered into the covenant.

2 Kings 23:4

Then the king commanded Hilkiah the high priest and the priests of the second order and the **doorkeepers** <08104>, to bring out of the temple of the LORD all the vessels that were made for Baal, for Asherah, and for all the host of heaven; and he burned them outside Jerusalem in the fields of the Kidron, and carried their ashes to Bethel.

2 Kings 25:18

Then the captain of the guard took Seraiah the chief priest and Zephaniah the second priest, with the three **officers** <08104> of the temple.

1 Chronicles 9:19

Shallum the son of Kore, the son of Ebiasaph, the son of Korah, and his relatives of his father's house, the Korahites, *were* over the work of the service, **keepers** <08104> of the thresholds of the tent; and their fathers had been over the camp of the LORD, **keepers** <08104> of the entrance.

1 Chronicles 10:13

So Saul died for his trespass which he committed against the LORD, because of the word of the LORD which he did not **keep** <08104>; and also because he asked counsel of a medium, making inquiry *of it*,

Keep <08104> me from the jaws of the trap which they have set for me, And from the snares of those who do iniquity.

The LORD **keeps** <08104> all who love Him, But all the wicked He will destroy.
