- 1 Chronicles 28:4 "Yet, the **LORD**, **the God of Israel**, chose me from all the house of my father to be king over Israel forever. For He has chosen Judah to be a leader; and in the house of Judah, my father's house, and among the sons of my father He took pleasure in me to make [me] king over all Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 14:4 and commanded Judah to seek the **LORD God of their fathers** and to observe the law and the commandment.
- 2 Chronicles 30:6 The couriers went throughout all Israel and Judah with the letters from the hand of the king and his princes, even according to the command of the king, saying, "O sons of Israel, return to the **LORD God of Abraham**, Isaac and Israel, that He may return to those of you who escaped [and] are left from the hand of the kings of Assyria.
- 2 Chronicles 32:17 He also wrote letters to insult the **LORD** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **Israel**, and to speak against Him, saying, "As the gods of the nations of the lands have not delivered their people from my hand, so the <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **Hezekiah** will not deliver His people from my hand."
- 2 Chronicles 32:19 They spoke of the <u>God of Jerusalem</u> as of the gods of the peoples of the earth, the work of men's hands.
- 2 Chronicles 36:23 "Thus says Cyrus king of Persia, 'The **LORD**, **the <u>God of heaven</u>**, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth, and He has appointed me to build Him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Whoever there is among you of all His people, may the LORD his God be with him, and let him go up!"
- Ezra 1:2 "Thus says Cyrus king of Persia, 'The **LORD**, the <u>God of heaven</u>, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and He has appointed me to build Him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah.
- Ezra 5:11 "Thus they answered us, saying, 'We are the servants of the <u>God of heaven</u> and earth and are rebuilding the temple that was built many years ago, which a great king of Israel built and finished.
- Ezra 5:12 'But because our fathers had provoked the <u>God</u> <u>of</u> heaven to wrath, He gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, the Chaldean, *who* destroyed this temple and deported the people to Babylon.

- Ezra 7:21 "I, even I, King Artaxerxes, issue a decree to all the treasurers who are *in the provinces* beyond the River, that whatever Ezra the priest, the scribe of the law of the **God of heaven**, may require of you, it shall be done diligently,

- Isaiah 1:24 Therefore the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts**, The **Mighty One** of Israel, declares, "Ah, I will be relieved of My adversaries And avenge Myself on My foes.
- Isaiah 3:1 For behold, the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts** is going to remove from Jerusalem and Judah Both supply and support, the whole supply of bread And the whole supply of water:
- Isaiah 3:15 "What do you mean by crushing My people And grinding the face of the poor?" Declares the **Lord GOD of hosts**.
- Isaiah 5:16 But the **LORD of hosts** will be **exalted in judgment**, And the **holy God** will show Himself holy in **righteousness**.
- Isaiah 9:6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called **Wonderful Counselor**, **Mighty God**, **Eternal Father**, **Prince of Peace**.
- Isaiah 10:16 Therefore the **Lord, the <u>GOD</u> of hosts**, will send a wasting disease among his stout warriors; And under his glory a fire will be kindled like a burning flame.
- Isaiah 10:23 For a complete destruction, one that is decreed, the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts** will execute in the midst of the whole land.
- Isaiah 10:24 Therefore thus says the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts**, "O My people who dwell in Zion, do not fear the Assyrian who strikes you with the rod and lifts up his staff against you, the way Egypt *did*.
- Isaiah 10:33 Behold, the Lord, the <u>GOD of hosts</u>, will lop off the boughs with a terrible crash; Those also who are tall in stature will be cut down And those who are lofty will be abased.
- Isaiah 17:10 For you have forgotten the <u>God of your salvation</u> And have not remembered the rock of your refuge. Therefore you plant delightful plants And set them with vine slips of a strange *god*.
- Isaiah 19:4 "Moreover, I will deliver the Egyptians into the hand of a cruel master, And a mighty king will rule over them," declares the **Lord GOD of hosts**.
- Isaiah 22:5 For the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts** has a day of panic, subjugation and confusion In the valley of vision, A breaking down of walls And a crying to the mountain.
- Isaiah 22:12 Therefore in that day the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts** called *you* to weeping, to wailing, To shaving the head and to wearing sackcloth.
- Isaiah 22:14 But the **LORD of hosts** revealed Himself to me, "Surely this iniquity shall not be forgiven you Until you die," says the Lord <u>GOD of</u> hosts.
- Isaiah 22:15 Thus says the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts**, "Come, go to this steward, To Shebna, who is in charge of the *royal* household,

- Isaiah 28:22 And now do not carry on as scoffers, Or your fetters will be made stronger; For I have heard from the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts** Of decisive destruction on all the earth.
- Isaiah 30:18 Therefore the **LORD** longs to be **gracious** to you, And therefore He waits **on high** to have **compassion** on you. For **the LORD** is a <u>God of justice</u>; How blessed are all those who long for Him.
- Isaiah 45:15 Truly, You are a God who hides Himself, O <u>God of Israel</u>, Savior! Isaiah 48:2 "For they call themselves after the holy city And lean on the <u>God of Israel</u>; The LORD of hosts is His name.
- Isaiah 54:5 "For your husband is your Maker, Whose name is the LORD of hosts; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel, Who is called the God of all the earth.
- Isaiah 65:16 "Because he who is blessed in the earth Will be blessed by the <u>God of</u> **truth**; And he who swears in the earth Will swear by the <u>God of</u> **truth**; Because the former troubles are forgotten, And because they are hidden from My sight!
- Jeremiah 2:19 "Your own wickedness will correct you, And your apostasies will reprove you; Know therefore and see that it is evil and bitter For you to forsake the **LORD** your **God**, And the dread of Me is not in you," declares the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts**.
- Jeremiah 5:14 Therefore, thus says the **LORD**, the <u>God</u> <u>of</u> hosts, "Because you have spoken this word, Behold, I am making My words in your mouth fire And this people wood, and it will consume them.
- Jeremiah 10:10 But the **LORD** is the true God; He is the living God and the everlasting King. At His wrath the earth quakes, And the nations cannot endure His indignation.
- Jeremiah 15:16 Your words were found and I ate them, And Your words became for me a joy and the delight of my heart; For I have been called by Your name, O **LORD God of hosts.**
- Jeremiah 29:25 "Thus says the LORD of hosts, **the <u>God of Israel</u>**, 'Because you have sent letters in your own name to all the people who are in Jerusalem, and to Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah, the priest, and to all the priests, saying,
- Jeremiah 31:1 "At that time," declares the **LORD**, "I will be the <u>God</u> of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people."
- Jeremiah 32:27 "Behold, I am the LORD, the <u>God of all flesh</u>; is anything too difficult for Me?"
- Jeremiah 35:18 Then Jeremiah said to the house of the Rechabites, "Thus says the **LORD of hosts, the <u>God of Israel</u>**, 'Because you have obeyed the command of Jonadab your father, kept all his commands and done according to all that he commanded you;
- Jeremiah 38:17 Then Jeremiah said to Zedekiah, "Thus says the **LORD <u>God of hosts</u>**, **the <u>God of Israel</u>**, 'If you will indeed go out to the officers of the king of Babylon, then you will live, this city will not be burned with fire, and you and your household will survive.
- Jeremiah 44:7 'Now then thus says the **LORD** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **hosts**, **the** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **Israel**, "Why are you doing great harm to yourselves, so as to cut off from you man and woman, child and infant, from among Judah, leaving yourselves without remnant,

- Jeremiah 46:10 For that day belongs to the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts**, A day of vengeance, so as to avenge Himself on His foes; And the sword will devour and be satiated And drink its fill of their blood; For there will be a slaughter for the **Lord <u>GOD</u> of hosts**, In the land of the north by the river Euphrates.
- Jeremiah 49:5 "Behold, I am going to bring terror upon you," Declares the **Lord GOD**of hosts, "From all *directions* around you; And each of you will be driven out headlong, With no one to gather the fugitives together.
- Jeremiah 50:18 "Therefore thus says the **LORD of hosts**, **the <u>God of Israel</u>**: 'Behold, I am going to punish the king of Babylon and his land, just as I punished the king of Assyria.
- Jeremiah 50:25 The **LORD** has opened His armory And has brought forth the weapons of His indignation, For it is a work of the **Lord GOD of hosts** In the land of the Chaldeans.
- Jeremiah 50:31 "Behold, I am against you, O arrogant one," Declares the **Lord GOD of hosts**, "For your day has come, The time when I will punish you.
- Jeremiah 51:33 For thus says the **LORD of hosts**, **the God of Israel**: "The daughter of Babylon is like a threshing floor At the time it is stamped firm; Yet in a little while the time of harvest will come for her."
- Jeremiah 51:56 For the destroyer is coming against her, against Babylon, And her mighty men will be captured, Their bows are shattered; For the **LORD** is a **God of recompense**, He will fully repay.
- Daniel 2:18 so that they might request **compassion** from the <u>God of heaven</u> concerning this mystery, so that Daniel and his friends would not be destroyed with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.
- Daniel 2:19 Then the mystery was revealed to Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the **God of heaven**;
- Daniel 2:37 "You, O king, are the king of kings, to whom the <u>God of heaven</u> has given the kingdom, the power, the strength and the glory;
- Daniel 2:44 "In the days of those kings the <u>God of heaven</u> will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and *that* kingdom will not be left for another people; it will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it will itself endure forever.
- Daniel 2:47 The king answered Daniel and said, "Surely your **God** is a <u>God</u> <u>of</u> gods and a **Lord of kings** and a **revealer of mysteries**, since you have been able to reveal this mystery."
- Daniel 3:28 Nebuchadnezzar responded and said, "Blessed be the <u>God of Shadrach</u>, **Meshach and Abed-nego**, who has sent His angel and delivered His servants who put their trust in Him, violating the king's command, and yielded up their bodies so as not to serve or worship any god except their own God.
- Daniel 6:26 "I make a decree that in all the dominion of my kingdom men are to fear and tremble before the <u>God of Daniel</u>; For He is the <u>living God</u> and <u>enduring forever</u>, And His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed, And His dominion will be forever.
- Daniel 11:36 "Then the king will do as he pleases, and he will exalt and magnify himself above every god and will speak monstrous things against the <u>God of gods</u>; and he will prosper until the indignation is finished, for that which is decreed will be done.
- Hosea 12:5 Even the **LORD**, the God of hosts. The **LORD** is His name.

- Amos 3:13 "Hear and testify against the house of Jacob," Declares the **Lord GOD**, **the God of hosts**.
- Amos 4:13 For behold, He who forms mountains and creates the wind And declares to man what are His thoughts, He who makes dawn into darkness And treads on the high places of the earth, The **LORD God of hosts** is His name.
- Amos 5:14 Seek good and not evil, that you may live; And thus may the **LORD** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **hosts** be with you, Just as you have said!
- Amos 5:15 Hate evil, love good, And establish justice in the gate! Perhaps the **LORD God of hosts** May be gracious to the remnant of Joseph.
- Amos 5:16 Therefore thus says the **LORD** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **hosts**, the Lord, "There is wailing in all the plazas, And in all the streets they say, 'Alas! Alas!' They also call the farmer to mourning And professional mourners to lamentation.
- Amos 5:27 "Therefore, I will make you go into exile beyond Damascus," says the LORD, whose name is the <u>God of</u> hosts.
- Amos 6:8 The Lord GOD has sworn by Himself, the **LORD** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **hosts** has declared: "I loathe the arrogance of Jacob, And detest his citadels; Therefore I will deliver up *the* city and all it contains."
- Amos 6:14 "For behold, I am going to raise up a nation against you, O house of Israel," declares the **LORD** <u>God</u> <u>of</u> **hosts**, "And they will afflict you from the entrance of Hamath To the brook of the Arabah."

- Nahum 1:2 A jealous and avenging <u>God</u> <u>is</u> the LORD; The LORD is avenging and wrathful. The LORD takes vengeance on His adversaries, And He reserves wrath for His enemies.
- Habakkuk 3:19 The **Lord <u>GOD</u>** is **my strength**, And He has made my feet like hinds' *feet*, And makes me walk on my high places. For the choir director, on my stringed instruments.
- Zephaniah 3:17 "The **LORD your <u>God</u>** is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will **exult** over you **with joy**, He will be **quiet in His love**, He will **rejoice over you** with shouts of joy.
- Zechariah 8:23 "Thus says the **LORD of hosts**, 'In those days ten men from all the nations will grasp the garment of a Jew, saying, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that <u>God</u> is with you.""

- Galatians 3:11 Now that no one is justified by the Law before **God is evident**; for, "THE RIGHTEOUS MAN SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."
- Galatians 3:20 Now a mediator is not for one party only; whereas **God** is only one.
- Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived, <u>God</u> <u>is</u> **not mocked**; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap.
- Philippians 1:8 For <u>God</u> <u>is</u> **my witness**, how I long for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:5 For we never came with flattering speech, as you know, nor with a pretext for greed—**God** is **witness**—
- 1 Timothy 4:4 For everything created by <u>God</u> <u>is</u> **good**, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with gratitude:
- Hebrews 1:8 But of the Son *He says*, "YOUR THRONE, O <u>GOD</u>, <u>IS</u> **FOREVER AND EVER**, AND THE RIGHTEOUS SCEPTER IS THE SCEPTER OF HIS KINGDOM.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of <u>God</u> <u>is</u> <u>living</u> and <u>active</u> and <u>sharper than any two-edged sword</u>, and <u>piercing</u> as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and <u>able to judge</u> the thoughts and intentions of the heart.
- Hebrews 6:10 For <u>God</u> <u>is</u> **not unjust** so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.
- Hebrews 11:16 But as it is, they desire a better *country*, that is, a heavenly one.

 Therefore <u>God</u> <u>is</u> **not ashamed** to be called their God; for He has prepared a city for them.
- Hebrews 11:19 He considered that <u>God</u> <u>is</u> **able** to raise *people* even from the dead, from which he also received him back as a type.
- Hebrews 12:29 for our **God is a consuming fire**.
- Hebrews 13:16 And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices **God** is **pleased**.
- James 2:19 You believe that **God is one**. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder.
- James 4:6 But He gives a greater grace. Therefore *it* says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE."

- 1 Peter 5:5 You younger men, likewise, be subject to *your* elders; and all of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, for <u>GOD</u> <u>IS</u> OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.
- 1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that **God is Light**, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

- 1 John 4:16 We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. **God is love**, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

- Psalms 12:7 You, O <u>LORD</u>, <u>will</u> **keep them**; You will preserve him from this generation forever.
- Psalms 21:9 You will make them as a fiery oven in the time of your anger; The **LORD** will swallow them up in His wrath, And fire will devour them.

- Psalms 55:16 As for me, I shall call upon God, And the **LORD** will save me.
- Psalms 66:18 If I regard wickedness in my heart, The <u>Lord will</u> not hear;
- Psalms 68:16 Why do you look with envy, O mountains with *many* peaks, At the mountain which God has desired for His abode? Surely the **LORD** will dwell there forever.
- Psalms 85:12 Indeed, the **LORD will give** what is good, And our land will yield its produce.

- Isaiah 19:22 The <u>LORD will</u> **strike Egypt**, <u>striking but healing</u>; so they will return to the LORD, and He will respond to them and will heal them.
- Isaiah 24:21 So it will happen in that day, That the **LORD** will **punish the host of heaven** on high, And the kings of the earth on earth.
- Isaiah 25:10 For the hand of the <u>LORD</u> <u>will</u> **rest on this mountain**, And Moab will be trodden down in his place As straw is trodden down in the water of a manure pile.
- Isaiah 27:1 In that day the <u>LORD will punish</u> Leviathan the fleeing serpent, With His fierce and great and mighty sword, Even Leviathan the twisted serpent; And He will kill the dragon who *lives* in the sea.
- Isaiah 27:12 In that day the <u>LORD will</u> start *His* threshing from the flowing stream of the Euphrates to the brook of Egypt, and you will be gathered up one by one, O sons of Israel.

- John 8:28 So Jesus said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am [He,] and I do nothing on My own initiative, but I speak these things as the Father taught Me.
- John 8:58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."
- John 10:7 So Jesus said to them again, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.
- John 10:9 "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
- John 10:11 "I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.
- John 10:14 "I am the good shepherd, and I know My own and My own know Me,
- John 10:36 do you say of Him, whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?
- John 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies,

- John 12:32 "And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself."
- John 13:13 "You call Me **Teacher** and **Lord**; and you are right, for [so] **I am**.
- John 14:6 Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.
- John 14:10 "Do you not believe that **I am in the Father**, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.
- John 15:1 ¶ "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.
- John 15:5 "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.
- John 17:14 "I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- John 17:16 "They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- Acts 5:31 "He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a **Prince** and a **Savior**, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.
- Acts 10:42 "And He ordered us to preach to the people, and solemnly to testify that this is the **One** who has been appointed by God as **Judge** of the **living and the dead**.
- Acts 13:23 "From the descendants of this man, according to promise, God has brought to Israel a **Savior**, **Jesus**,
- Romans 9:5 whose are the fathers, and from whom is the Christ according to the flesh, who is **over all**, God **blessed forever**. Amen.
- Romans 11:26 and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, "**THE DELIVERER** WILL COME FROM ZION, HE WILL REMOVE UNGODLINESS FROM JACOB."
- Romans 14:9 For to this end Christ died and lived again, that He might be **Lord both** of the dead and of the living.
- 1 Corinthians 1:24 but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, **Christ the power of God** and the **wisdom of God**.
- 1 Corinthians 1:30 But by His doing you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption,

- 1 Corinthians 11:3 But I want you to understand that **Christ is the head of every man**, and the man is the head of a woman, and God is the head of Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 9:15 Thanks be to God for His **indescribable gift!**

Galatians 3:16 Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as [referring] to many, but [rather] to one, "And to your seed," that is, Christ.

Ephesians 1:6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in **the Beloved**.

Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as **Christ** also is the **head of the church**, He Himself [being] the **Savior of the body**.

Philippians 3:20 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a **Savior**, the **Lord Jesus Christ**;

- 1 Timothy 1:12 ¶ I thank **Christ Jesus our Lord**, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service,
- 1 Timothy 3:16 By common confession, great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, Believed on in the world, Taken up in glory.
- 1 Timothy 6:15 which He will bring about at the proper time—He who is **the blessed** and **only Sovereign**, the **King of kings** and **Lord of lords**,
- Titus 2:13 looking for the **blessed hope** and the appearing of the glory of our **great God and Savior, Christ Jesus**,
- Titus 3:6 whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
- Hebrews 1:2 in these last days has spoken to us in **His Son**, whom He appointed **heir of all things**, through whom also He **made the world**.
- Hebrews 1:3 And He is the **radiance of His glory** and the **exact representation of His nature**, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Hebrews 6:20 where Jesus has entered as a **forerunner** for us, having become **a high priest** forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 7:17 For it is attested [of Him,] "YOU ARE A **PRIEST** FOREVER ACCORDING TO THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK."

Hebrews 13:20 Now the **God of peace**, who brought up from the dead the **great Shepherd** of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, [even] Jesus our Lord.

- 1 Peter 1:19 but with precious blood, as of **a lamb** unblemished and spotless, [the blood] of Christ.
- 1 Peter 2:4 ¶ And coming to Him as to a **living stone** which has been rejected by men, but is **choice** and **precious** in the sight of God,
- 1 Peter 2:25 For you were continually straying like sheep, but now you have returned to **the Shepherd** and **Guardian** of your souls.
- 1 Peter 5:4 And when the **Chief Shepherd** appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.
- 2 Peter 1:19 ¶ [So] we have the prophetic word [made] more sure, to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the **morning star** arises in your hearts.
- 1 John 5:20 And we know that the **Son of God** has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know **Him who is true**; and we are in Him who is true, in **His Son Jesus Christ**. This is the **true God** and **eternal life**.
- 2 John 1:3 Grace, mercy [and] peace will be with us, from God the Father and from Jesus Christ, the **Son of the Father**, in truth and love.
- Jude 1:25 to the **only God our Savior**, through Jesus Christ our Lord, [be] glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.
- Revelation 1:5 and from **Jesus Christ**, the **faithful witness**, the **firstborn of the dead**, and the **ruler of the kings of the earth**. To Him who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood—
- Revelation 1:8 "I am the **Alpha and the Omega**," says the **Lord God**, "who is and who was and who is to come, **the Almighty**."
- Revelation 1:17 When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. And He placed His right hand on me, saying, "Do not be afraid; I am the first and the last,
- Revelation 1:18 and the living One; and I was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of death and of Hades.
- Revelation 2:5 'Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else **I am coming to you** and will remove your lampstand out of its place—unless you repent.

Revelation 2:23 'And I will kill her children with pestilence, and all the churches will know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your deeds.

Revelation 3:14 ¶ "To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: The **Amen**, the **faithful** and true Witness, the **Beginning of the creation** of God, says this:

Revelation 5:5 and one of the elders *said to me, "Stop weeping; behold, the **Lion that** is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome so as to open the book and its seven seals."

Revelation 5:6 ¶ And I saw between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a **Lamb standing, as if slain**, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.

Revelation 5:12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing."

Revelation 6:16 and they *said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the **wrath of the Lamb**;

Revelation 7:17 for the **Lamb in the center of the throne** will be their shepherd, and will guide them to springs of the water of life; and God will wipe every tear from their eyes."

Revelation 14:1 ¶ Then I looked, and behold, the **Lamb [was] standing on Mount Zion**, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His name and the name of His Father written on their foreheads.

Revelation 15:3 And they *sang the song of Moses, the bond-servant of God, and the song of the **Lamb**, saying, "Great and marvelous are Your works, O **Lord God**, the **Almighty**; **Righteous** and **true** are Your ways, **King of the nations**!

Revelation 19:11 ¶ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it [is] called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness He judges and wages war.

Revelation 21:5 And He who sits on the throne said, "Behold, **I am making all things new.**" And He *said, "Write, for these words are faithful and true."

Revelation 22:12 "Behold, **I am coming quickly**, and My reward [is] with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done.

Revelation 22:16 "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things for the churches. I am the root and the descendant of David, the bright morning star."
