- Psalms 150:1 Praise the LORD! Praise God <0410 'el> in His sanctuary; Praise Him in His mighty expanse.
- Isaiah 5:16 But the LORD of hosts will be exalted in judgment, And the holy God <0410 'el> will show Himself holy in righteousness.
- Isaiah 8:10 "Devise a plan, but it will be thwarted; State a proposal, but it will not stand, For God <0410 'el> is with us."
- Isaiah 9:6 For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God <0410 'el>, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.
- Isaiah 10:21 A remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, to the mighty God <0410 'el>. Isaiah 12:2 "Behold, God <0410 'el> is my salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; For the LORD GOD is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation."
- Isaiah 14:13 "But you said in your heart, 'I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God <0410 'el>, And I will sit on the mount of assembly In the recesses of the north.
- Isaiah 31:3 Now the Egyptians are men and not God <0410 'el>, And their horses are flesh and not spirit; So the LORD will stretch out His hand, And he who helps will stumble And he who is helped will fall, And all of them will come to an end together.
- Isaiah 40:18 To whom then will you liken God <0410 'el>? Or what likeness will you compare with Him?
- Isaiah 42:5 Thus says God <0410 'el> the LORD, Who created the heavens and stretched them out, Who spread out the earth and its offspring, Who gives breath to the people on it And spirit to those who walk in it,
- Isaiah 43:10 "You are My witnesses," declares the LORD, "And My servant whom I have chosen, So that you may know and believe Me And understand that I am He. Before Me there was no God <0410 'el> formed, And there will be none after Me.
- Isaiah 43:12 "It is I who have declared and saved and proclaimed, And there was no strange *god* among you; So you are My witnesses," declares the LORD, "And I am God <0410 'el>.
- Isaiah 44:10 Who has fashioned a god <0410 'el> or cast an idol to no profit?
  Isaiah 44:15 Then it becomes *something* for a man to burn, so he takes one of them and warms himself; he also makes a fire to bake bread. He also makes a god <0410 'el> and worships it; he makes it a graven image and falls down before it.

- Isaiah 44:17 But the rest of it he makes into a god <0410 'el>, his graven image. He falls down before it and worships; he also prays to it and says, "Deliver me, for you are my god <0410 'el>."
- Isaiah 45:14 Thus says the LORD, "The products of Egypt and the merchandise of Cush And the Sabeans, men of stature, Will come over to you and will be yours; They will walk behind you, they will come over in chains And will bow down to you; They will make supplication to you: 'Surely, God <0410 'el> is with you, and there is none else, No other God.'"
- Isaiah 45:15 Truly, You are a God <0410 'el> who hides Himself, O God of Israel, Savior!
- Isaiah 45:20 "Gather yourselves and come; Draw near together, you fugitives of the nations; They have no knowledge, Who carry about their wooden idol And pray to a god <0410 'el> who cannot save.
- Isaiah 45:21 "Declare and set forth *your case;* Indeed, let them consult together. Who has announced this from of old? Who has long since declared it? Is it not I, the LORD? And there is no other God besides Me, A righteous God <0410 'el> and a Savior; There is none except Me.
- Isaiah 45:22 "Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth; For I am God <0410 'el>, and there is no other.
- Isaiah 46:6 "Those who lavish gold from the purse And weigh silver on the scale Hire a goldsmith, and he makes it *into* a god <0410 'el>; They bow down, indeed they worship it.
- Isaiah 46:9 "Remember the former things long past, For I am God <0410 'el>, and there is no other; *I am* God, and there is no one like Me,
- Jeremiah 32:18 who shows lovingkindness to thousands, but repays the iniquity of fathers into the bosom of their children after them, O great and mighty God <0410 'el>. The LORD of hosts is His name;
- Jeremiah 51:56 For the destroyer is coming against her, against Babylon, And her mighty men will be captured, Their bows are shattered; For the LORD is a God <0410 'el> of recompense, He will fully repay.
- Lamentations 3:41 We lift up our heart and hands Toward God <0410 'el> in heaven; Ezekiel 10:5 Moreover, the sound of the wings of the cherubim was heard as far as the outer court, like the voice of God <0410 'el> Almighty when He speaks.
- Ezekiel 28:2 "Son of man, say to the leader of Tyre, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Because your heart is lifted up And you have said, 'I am a god <0410 'el>, I sit in the seat of gods In the heart of the seas'; Yet you are a man and not God <0410 'el>, Although you make your heart like the heart of God—
- Ezekiel 28:9 'Will you still say, "I am a god," In the presence of your slayer, Though you are a man and not God <0410 'el>, In the hands of those who wound you?
- Ezekiel 32:21 "The strong <0410 'el> among the mighty ones shall speak of him and his helpers from the midst of Sheol, 'They have gone down, they lie still, the uncircumcised, slain by the sword.'
- Daniel 9:4 I prayed to the LORD my God and confessed and said, "Alas, O Lord, the great and awesome God <0410 'el>, who keeps His covenant and lovingkindness for those who love Him and keep His commandments,

- Daniel 11:36 "Then the king will do as he pleases, and he will exalt and magnify himself above every god <0410 'el> and will speak monstrous things against the God <0410 'el> of gods <0410 'el>; and he will prosper until the indignation is finished, for that which is decreed will be done.
- Hosea 1:10 Yet the number of the sons of Israel Will be like the sand of the sea, Which cannot be measured or numbered; And in the place Where it is said to them, "You are not My people," It will be said to them, "You are the sons of the living God <0410 'el>."
- Hosea 11:9 I will not execute My fierce anger; I will not destroy Ephraim again. For I am God <0410 'el> and not man, the Holy One in your midst, And I will not come in wrath.
- Hosea 11:12 Ephraim surrounds Me with lies And the house of Israel with deceit; Judah is also unruly against God <0410 'el>, Even against the Holy One who is faithful.
- Jonah 4:2 He prayed to the LORD and said, "Please LORD, was not this what I said while I was still in my *own* country? Therefore in order to forestall this I fled to Tarshish, for I knew that You are a gracious and compassionate God <0410 'el>, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, and one who relents concerning calamity.
- Micah 2:1 Woe to those who scheme iniquity, Who work out evil on their beds! When morning comes, they do it, For it is in the power <0410 'el> of their hands.
- Micah 7:18 Who is a God <0410 'el> like You, who pardons iniquity And passes over the rebellious act of the remnant of His possession? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in unchanging love.
- Nahum 1:2 A jealous and avenging God <0410 'el> is the LORD; The LORD is avenging and wrathful. The LORD takes vengeance on His adversaries, And He reserves wrath for His enemies.
- Malachi 1:9 "But now will you not entreat God's <0410 'el> favor, that He may be gracious to us? With such an offering on your part, will He receive any of you kindly?" says the LORD of hosts.
- Malachi 2:10 "Do we not all have one father? Has not one God <0410 'el> created us? Why do we deal treacherously each against his brother so as to profane the covenant of our fathers?
- Malachi 2:11 "Judah has dealt treacherously, and an abomination has been committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah has profaned the sanctuary of the LORD which He loves and has married the daughter of a foreign god <0410 'el>.
