Developing A Personal Relationship With God

How Do you Know God exists?

Revelation: God must reveal Himself: (man is finite - God is infinite)

General Revelation: God's communication of Himself to all persons at all times and in all places (knowledge about God)

- 1. **Nature:** God left evidence of himself in the world he created (Ps. 19:1, Rom. 1:20)
- 2. **History:** God moving course of history, controlling destiny of nations, ie preservation of Israel (Job 12:23, Ps. 47:7-8, 66:7, Isa. 10:5-13, Dan. 2:21, Ac. 17:26
- 3. **Constitution of humanity:** less physical/mental, more moral/spiritual capacity Rom. 2:11-16. In all cultures, at all times and places humans believed in the existence of a higher reality than themselves and even something higher than human race collectively.

How do you know God Desires to have a relationship with you?

Specific Revelation: God's manifestation of himself to particular persons at specific times and places, enabling those persons to enter into a redemptive relationship with him. The object was relational Why? (Knowledge of God)

- 1. **Sin:** Humans lost the relationship of favor after the fall. We needed to come to know God in a fuller way.
- 2. **Limitations:** finiteness and moral limitations. Insufficient to simply know of God's existence; and something of what he is like.
- 3. **Personal:** Name (Ex. 3:14), Covenants w/individuals (Noah/Abraham/Israel), Phil. 3:10, Dreams: Daniel, Speech-Adam/Eve, Gen 3:9-10, Prophets (Jer. 18:1, Ez. 12:1, 8,17,21,26, Hos. 1:1, Joel 1:1, Amos 3:1 Jesus Heb. 1:1-2, Incarnation of Christ, and Scripture. All scripture is personal in nature.

John 17:1-26

- Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You,
- 2 "as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him.
- 3 "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
- 4 "I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do.
- 5 "And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.
- I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word.
- 7 "Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You.
- 8 "For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me.
- 9 "I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours.
- 10 "And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.
- 11 "Now I am no longer in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are.
- "While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.
- 13 "But now I come to You, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.
- "I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- 15 "I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.
- 16 "They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world.
- 17 "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.
- 18 "As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world.
- 19 "And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.
- I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word:
- 21 "that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.
- 22 "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just

- as We are one:
- 23 "I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.
- 24 "Father, I desire that they also whom You gave Me may be with Me where I am, that they may behold My glory which You have given Me; for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- 25 "O righteous Father! The world has not known You, but I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me.
- 26 "And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them."

2 Corinthians 5:19

that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Ephesians 1:4

just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love.
