Introduction

What does the bible teach about saints? Who are they and how does one become a saint? The answer may indeed surprise you.

Saints are the holy ones of God, all born again Christians that have an indwelling of God's Holy Spirit. In essence, the bible refers to all humans who belong to the universal body of Christ as His Saints. Let's examine the Scriptural evidence on this.

Bolded Scriptures refer to the born again Christians as the saints of God

Matthew 1:18

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child by the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit.

Matthew 1:20

But when he had considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for the Child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy <40 hagios> Spirit.

Matthew 3:11

"As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will <u>baptize you with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> and fire.

Matthew 4:5

Then the devil *took Him into the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>city</u> and had Him stand on the pinnacle of the temple,

but whoever blasphemes against the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin"—

for Herod was afraid of John, knowing that he was a righteous and **Holy <40 hagios>** man, and he kept him safe. And when he heard him, he was very perplexed; but he used to enjoy listening to him.

And his father Zacharias was <u>filled with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit, and prophesied, saying:

As He spoke by the mouth of His Holy <40 hagios> prophets from of old—

Luke 1:72

To show mercy toward our fathers, And to remember His Holy <40 hagios> covenant,

Luke 2:23

(as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "EVERY *firstborn* MALE THAT OPENS THE WOMB SHALL BE CALLED **HOLY <40** hagios> TO THE LORD"),

Luke 2:25

And there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon; and this man was righteous and devout, looking for the consolation of Israel; and the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit was upon him.

Luke 2:26

And it had been <u>revealed to him by</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Luke 3:16

John answered and said to them all, "As for me, I baptize you with water; but One is coming who is mightier than I, and I am not fit to untie the thong of His sandals; He will baptize you with the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit and fire.

Luke 3:22

and the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came out of heaven, "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased."

Luke 4:1

Jesus, <u>full of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, returned from the Jordan and was led around by the Spirit in the wilderness

Luke 4:34

"Let us alone! What business do we have with each other, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are—the **Holy One <40 hagios>** of God!"

"But the Helper, the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

John 17:11

"I am no longer in the world; and *yet* they themselves are in the world, and I come to You. **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Father</u>, keep them in Your name, *the name* which You have given Me, that they may be one even as We *are*.

John 20:22

And when He had said this, He breathed on them and *said to them, "Receive the **Holy** <40 hagios> Spirit.

Acts 1:2

until the day when He was taken up to heaven, after He had by the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen.

Acts 1:5

for John baptized with water, but you will be <u>baptized with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> not many days from now."

Acts 1:8

but you will <u>receive power</u> when the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> has <u>come upon you</u>; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

Acts 1:16

"Brethren, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit foretold by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus.

Acts 2:4

And they were all <u>filled with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> and began to <u>speak with other tongues</u>, as the <u>Spirit</u> was giving them utterance.

Acts 2:33

"Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God, and having <u>received</u> from the Father the <u>promise of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, He has <u>poured forth</u> this which you both see and hear.

Acts 2:38

Peter *said* to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will <u>receive the gift</u> of the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit.

Acts 3:14

"But you disowned the **Holy <40 hagios>** and <u>Righteous One</u> and asked for a murderer to be granted to you,

Acts 3:21

whom heaven must receive until *the* period of restoration of all things about which <u>God spoke by the mouth of</u> His **Holy <40 hagios>** prophets from ancient time.

Acts 4:8

Then Peter, <u>filled with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, said to them, "Rulers and elders of the people,

Acts 4:25

who by the Holy <40 hagios> Spirit, through the mouth of our father David Your servant, said, 'WHY DID THE GENTILES RAGE, AND THE PEOPLES DEVISE FUTILE THINGS?

Acts 4:27

"For truly in this city there were <u>gathered together against</u> Your **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>servant</u> <u>Jesus</u>, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel,

Acts 4:30

while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your **Holy <40 hagios>** servant Jesus."

Acts 4:31

And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all <u>filled with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> and <u>began</u> to <u>speak the word of</u> God with boldness.

Acts 5:3

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to <u>lie to</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> and to keep back *some* of the price of the land?

Acts 5:32

"And we are witnesses of these things; and so is the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him."

Acts 6:5

The statement found approval with the whole congregation; and they chose Stephen, a man <u>full of</u> faith and of the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch.

Acts 6:13

They put forward false witnesses who said, "This man incessantly <u>speaks against</u> this **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>place</u> and the Law;

Acts 7:33

"BUT THE LORD SAID TO HIM, 'TAKE OFF THE SANDALS FROM YOUR FEET, FOR THE PLACE ON WHICH YOU ARE STANDING IS **HOLY <40** hagios> GROUND.

Acts 7:51

"You men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears are always resisting the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit; you are doing just as your fathers did.

Acts 7:55

But being <u>full of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, he gazed intently into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God;

Acts 8:15

who came down and prayed for them that they might <u>receive</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit.

Acts 8:17

Then they *began* laying their hands on them, and they were <u>receiving</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>.

Acts 8:19

saying, "Give this authority to me as well, so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit."

Acts 9:13

But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he did to Your **saints <40 hagios>** at Jerusalem;

Acts 9:17

So Ananias departed and entered the house, and after laying his hands on him said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road by which you were coming, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be <u>filled with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit.</u>"

Acts 9:31

So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord and in the <u>comfort of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit, it continued to increase.

Acts 9:32

Now as Peter was traveling through all *those regions*, he came down also to the **saints** <**40 hagios>** who lived at Lydda.

Acts 9:41

And he gave her his hand and raised her up; and calling the **saints <40 hagios>** and widows, he presented her alive.

Acts 10:22

They said, "Cornelius, a centurion, a righteous and God-fearing man well spoken of by the entire nation of the Jews, was *divinely* <u>directed</u> by a **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>angel</u> to send for you *to come* to his house and hear a message from you."

Acts 10:38

"You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy <40 hagios> Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Acts 10:44

While Peter was still speaking these words, the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit fell upon all those who were listening to the message.

Acts 10:45

All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.

Acts 10:47

"Surely no one can refuse the water for these to be baptized who have <u>received</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit just as we *did*, can he?"

Acts 11:15

"And as I began to speak, the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit fell upon them just as *He did* upon us at the beginning.

Acts 11:16

"And I remembered the word of the Lord, how He used to say, 'John baptized with water, but you will be <u>baptized with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>.'

Acts 11:24

for he was a good man, and <u>full of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> and of faith. And considerable numbers were brought to the Lord.

Acts 13:2

While they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

Acts 13:4

So, being <u>sent out by</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, they went down to Seleucia and from there they sailed to Cyprus.

Acts 13:9

But Saul, who was also *known as* Paul, <u>filled with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, fixed his gaze on him,

Acts 13:52

And the disciples were continually <u>filled with</u> joy and with the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>.

Acts 15:8

"And God, who knows the heart, testified to them giving them the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit, just as He also did to us;

Acts 15:28

"For it <u>seemed good to</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> and to us to lay upon you no greater burden than these essentials:

Acts 16:6

They passed through the Phrygian and Galatian region, having been <u>forbidden by</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> to speak the word in Asia;

Acts 19:2

He said to them, "Did you <u>receive</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> when you believed?" And

they *said* to him, "No, we have not even heard whether there is a **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit."

Acts 19:6

And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit came on them, and they began speaking with tongues and prophesying.

Acts 20:23

except that the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit solemnly testifies to me in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions await me.

Acts 20:28

"Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, <u>among</u> which the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> has <u>made you overseers</u>, to <u>shepherd</u> the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Acts 21:11

And coming to us, he took Paul's belt and bound his own feet and hands, and said, "This is what the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit says: 'In this way the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.'"

Acts 21:28

crying out, "Men of Israel, come to our aid! This is the man who preaches to all men

everywhere against our people and the Law and this place; and besides he has even brought Greeks into the temple and has defiled this **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>place</u>."

Acts 26:10

"And this is just what I did in Jerusalem; not only did I lock up many of the **saints <40 hagios>** in prisons, having received authority from the chief priests, but also when they were being put to death I cast my vote against them.

Acts 28:25

And when they did not agree with one another, they *began* leaving after Paul had spoken one *parting* word, "The **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit rightly spoke through Isaiah the prophet to your fathers,

Romans 1:2

which He promised beforehand through His prophets in the **Holy <40 hagios>** scriptures,

Romans 1:7

to all who are beloved of God in Rome, called as **saints <40 hagios>**: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:5

and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 7:12

So then, the Law is Holy <40 hagios>, and the commandment is Holy <40 hagios> and righteous and good.

Romans 8:27

and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints <40 hagios> according to the will of God.

Romans 9:1

I am telling the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience testifies with me in the **Holy** <40 hagios> Spirit,

Romans 11:16

If the <u>first piece</u> of dough is **Holy <40 hagios>**, the <u>lump is</u> also; and if the <u>root is</u> **Holy <40 hagios>**, the branches are too.

Romans 12:1

Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to <u>present your bodies</u> a living and **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>sacrifice</u>, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship.

Romans 12:13

contributing to the needs of the **saints <40 hagios>**, practicing hospitality.

Romans 14:17

for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit.

Romans 15:13

Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you will abound in hope by the <u>power of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** *Spirit*.

Romans 15:16

to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles, ministering as a priest the gospel of God, so that *my* offering of the Gentiles may become acceptable, sanctified by the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit.

Romans 15:25

but now, I am going to Jerusalem serving the saints <40 hagios>.

Romans 15:26

For Macedonia and Achaia have been pleased to <u>make a contribution for</u> the poor among the **saints <40 hagios>** in Jerusalem.

Romans 15:31

that I may be rescued from those who are disobedient in Judea, and *that* my service for Jerusalem may prove acceptable to the **saints <40 hagios>**;

Romans 16:2

that you <u>receive</u> her in the Lord in a manner worthy of the **saints <40 hagios>**, and that you help her in whatever matter she may have need of you; for she herself has also been a helper of many, and of myself as well.

Romans 16:15

Greet Philologus and Julia, Nereus and his sister, and Olympas, and all the **saints <40 hagios>** who are with them.

Romans 16:16

Greet one another with a **Holy <40 hagios>** kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you.

1 Corinthians 1:2

To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who have been <u>sanctified</u> in Christ Jesus, **saints <40 hagios>** <u>by calling</u>, with all who in every place call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, their *Lord* and ours:

1 Corinthians 3:17

If any man destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the <u>temple of God is</u> **Holy <40 hagios>**, and <u>that is what you are</u>.

1 Corinthians 6:1

Does any one of you, when he has a case against his neighbor, dare to go to law before the unrighteous and not before the **saints <40 hagios>**?

1 Corinthians 6:2

Or do you not know that the **saints <40 hagios>** will judge the world? If the world is judged by you, are you not competent *to constitute* the smallest law courts?

1 Corinthians 6:19

Or do you not know that <u>your body is a temple</u> of the **Holy <40 hagios> Spirit** who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?

1 Corinthians 7:14

For the unbelieving husband is sanctified through his wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified through her believing husband; for otherwise your children are unclean, but now they are **Holy <40 hagios>**.

1 Corinthians 7:34

and *his interests* are divided. The woman who is unmarried, and the virgin, is concerned about the things of the Lord, that she may be **Holy <40 hagios>** both <u>in body and spirit;</u> but one who is married is concerned about the things of the world, how she may please her husband.

1 Corinthians 12:3

Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit.

1 Corinthians 14:33

for God is not *a God* of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the **saints <40 hagios>**.

1 Corinthians 16:1

Now concerning the <u>collection for</u> the **saints <40 hagios>**, as I directed the churches of Galatia, so do you also.

1 Corinthians 16:15

Now I urge you, brethren (you know the household of Stephanas, that they were the first fruits of Achaia, and that they have devoted themselves for <u>ministry to</u> the **saints <40 hagios>**),

1 Corinthians 16:20

All the brethren greet you. <u>Greet</u> one another with a **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>kiss</u>.

2 Corinthians 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy *our* brother, To the church of God which is at Corinth <u>with all the</u> **saints <40 hagios>** who are throughout Achaia:

2 Corinthians 6:6

in purity, in knowledge, in patience, in kindness, in the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit, in genuine love,

2 Corinthians 8:4

begging us with much urging for the favor of participation in the support of the **saints <40 hagios>**,

2 Corinthians 9:1

For it is superfluous for me to write to you about this ministry to the saints <40 hagios>;

2 Corinthians 9:12

For the ministry of this service is not only fully supplying the <u>needs of</u> the **saints <40 hagios>**, but is also overflowing through many thanksgivings to God.

2 Corinthians 13:12

Greet one another with a Holy <40 hagios> kiss.

2 Corinthians 13:13

All the saints <40 hagios> greet you.

2 Corinthians 13:14

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the <u>fellowship of</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u>, be with you all.

Ephesians 1:1

Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the **saints <40 hagios>** who are at Ephesus and *who are* faithful in Christ Jesus:

Ephesians 1:4

just as <u>He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world</u>, that we would be **Holy <40 hagios>** and blameless before Him. In love

Ephesians 1:13

In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were <u>sealed in Him with</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> of promise,

Ephesians 1:15

For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you

and your love for all the saints <40 hagios>,

Ephesians 1:18

I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of <u>His inheritance in</u> the **saints <40 hagios>**,

Ephesians 2:19

So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are <u>fellow citizens with</u> the **saints <40 hagios>**, and are of <u>God's household</u>,

Ephesians 2:21

in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a **Holy <40 hagios>** temple in the Lord,

Ephesians 3:5

which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His **Holy <40 hagios>** apostles and prophets in the Spirit;

Ephesians 3:8

To me, the very least of all **saints <40 hagios>**, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ,

Ephesians 3:18

may be able to <u>comprehend with</u> all the **saints <40 hagios>** what is the breadth and length and height and depth,

Ephesians 4:12

for the <u>equipping of</u> the **saints <40 hagios>** for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;

Ephesians 4:30

<u>Do not grieve</u> the **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>Spirit</u> of God, by whom <u>you were sealed</u> for the day of redemption.

Ephesians 5:3

But immorality or any impurity or greed must not even be named among you, as is proper among **saints <40 hagios>**;

Ephesians 5:27

that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be **Holy <40 hagios>** and blameless.

Ephesians 6:18

<u>With all prayer and petition</u> pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, <u>be on the</u> alert with all perseverance and petition for all the **saints <40 hagios>**,

Philippians 1:1

Behind the second veil there was a tabernacle which is called the **Holy <40 hagios>** of **Holies <40 hagios>**,

Hebrews 9:8

The **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit is signifying this, that the way into the **Holy place <40** hagios> has not yet been disclosed while the outer tabernacle is still standing,

Hebrews 9:12

and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the **Holy place <40 hagios>** once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Hebrews 9:24

For Christ did not enter a **Holy place <40 hagios>** made with hands, a *mere* copy of the true one, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us;

Hebrews 9:25

nor was it that He would offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the **Holy place** <40 hagios> year by year with blood that is not his own.

Hebrews 10:15

And the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit also testifies to us; for after saying,

Hebrews 10:19

Therefore, brethren, since <u>we have confidence to enter</u> the **Holy place <40 hagios>** by the blood of Jesus.

Hebrews 13:11

For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the **Holy place <40 hagios>** by the high priest *as an offering* for sin, are burned outside the camp.

Hebrews 13:24

Greet all of your leaders and all the saints <40 hagios>. Those from Italy greet you.

1 Peter 1:12

It was revealed to them that they were not serving themselves, but you, in these things which now have been announced to you through those who preached the gospel to you by the **Holy <40 hagios>** Spirit sent from heaven—things into which angels long to look.

1 Peter 1:15

but like the **Holy One <40 hagios>** who <u>called you</u>, be **Holy <40 hagios>** yourselves also in all *your* behavior;

1 Peter 1:16

because it is written, "YOU SHALL BE **HOLY <40 hagios>**, FOR I AM **HOLY <40 hagios>**."

1 Peter 2:5

you also, as living stones, are being built up as a <u>spiritual house</u> for a **Holy <40 hagios>** <u>priesthood</u>, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 2:9

But you are A <u>CHOSEN RACE</u>, A <u>royal PRIESTHOOD</u>, A **HOLY <40 hagios>** <u>NATION</u>, A PEOPLE FOR *God's* OWN POSSESSION, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

Are You not from everlasting, O LORD, my God, my **Holy One <06918 qadowsh>**? We will not die. You, O LORD, have appointed them to judge; And You, O Rock, have established them to correct.

God comes from Teman, And the **Holy One <06918 qadowsh>** from Mount Paran. Selah. His splendor covers the heavens, And the earth is full of His praise.

Zechariah 14:5

You will flee by the valley of My mountains, for the valley of the mountains will reach to Azel; yes, you will flee just as you fled before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Then the LORD, my God, will come, *and* all the **Holy ones <06918 qadowsh>** with Him!

Daniel 4:8

'O Belteshazzar, chief of the magicians, since I know that a spirit of the **Holy <06922 qaddiysh>** gods is in you and no mystery baffles you, tell *me* the visions of my dream which I have seen, along with its interpretation.

'I was looking in the visions in my mind as I lay on my bed, and behold, an angelic watcher, a **Holy one <06922 qaddiysh>**, descended from heaven.

Daniel 4:17

"This sentence is by the decree of the *angelic* watchers And the decision is a command of the **Holy ones <06922 qaddiysh>**, In order that the living may know That the Most High is ruler over the realm of mankind, And bestows it on whom He wishes And sets over it the lowliest of men."

Daniel 4:18

'This is the dream *which* I, King Nebuchadnezzar, have seen. Now you, Belteshazzar, tell *me* its interpretation, inasmuch as none of the wise men of my kingdom is able to make known to me the interpretation; but you are able, for a spirit of the **Holy <06922 qaddiysh>** gods is in you.'

Daniel 4:23

'In that the king saw an *angelic* watcher, a **Holy one <06922 qaddiysh>**, descending from heaven and saying, "Chop down the tree and destroy it; yet leave the stump with its roots in the ground, but with a band of iron and bronze *around it* in the new grass of the field, and let him be drenched with the dew of heaven, and let him share with the beasts of the field until seven periods of time pass over him,"

Daniel 5:11

until the Ancient of Days came and judgment was passed in favor of the **saints <06922 qaddiysh>** of the Highest One, and the time arrived when the **saints <06922 qaddiysh>** took possession of the kingdom.

Daniel 7:25

'He will speak out against the Most High and wear down the **saints <06922 qaddiysh>** of the Highest One, and he will intend to make alterations in times and in law; and they will be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.

Daniel 7:27

Then the sovereignty, the dominion and the greatness of *all* the kingdoms under the whole heaven will be given to the people of the **saints <06922 qaddiysh>** of the
